DESCRIPTION

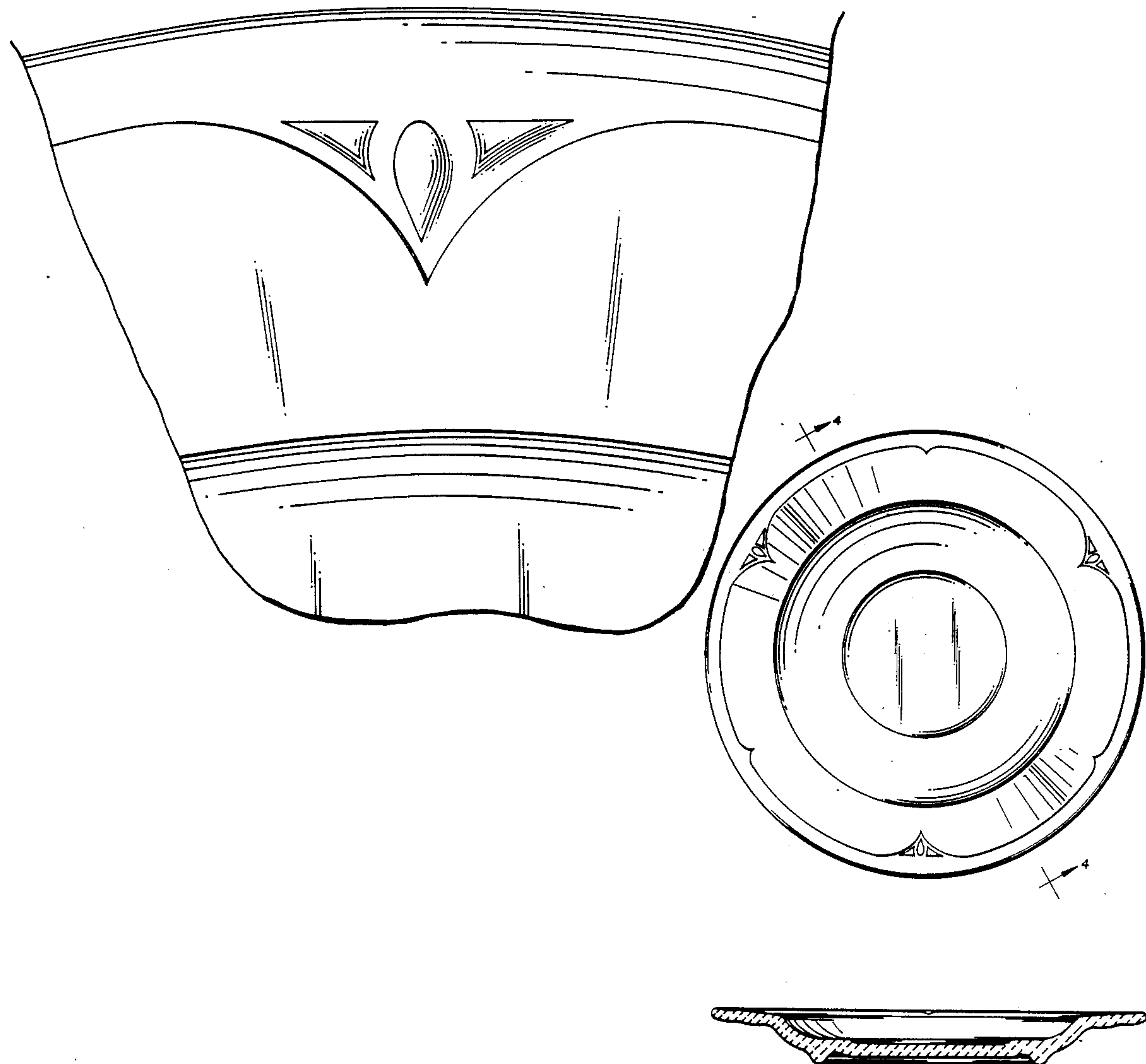
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a saucer or similar article showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary view of a portion of the rim of FIG. 1.



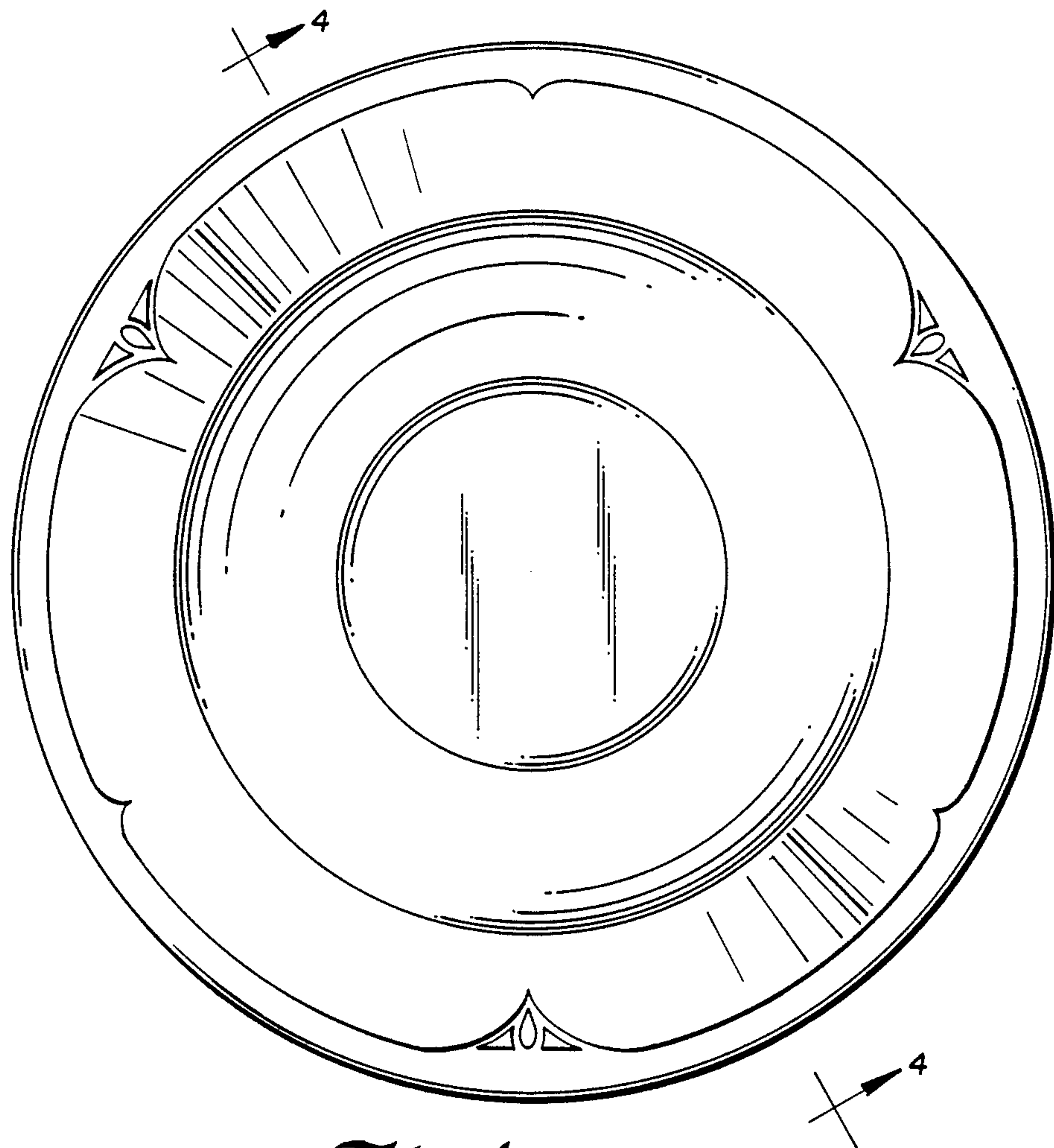

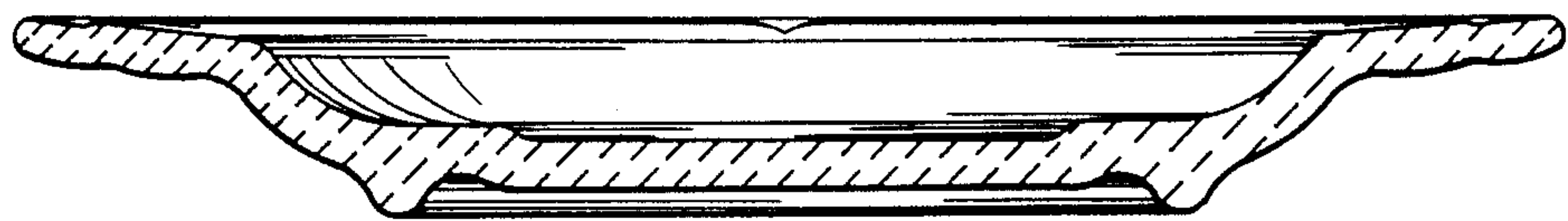

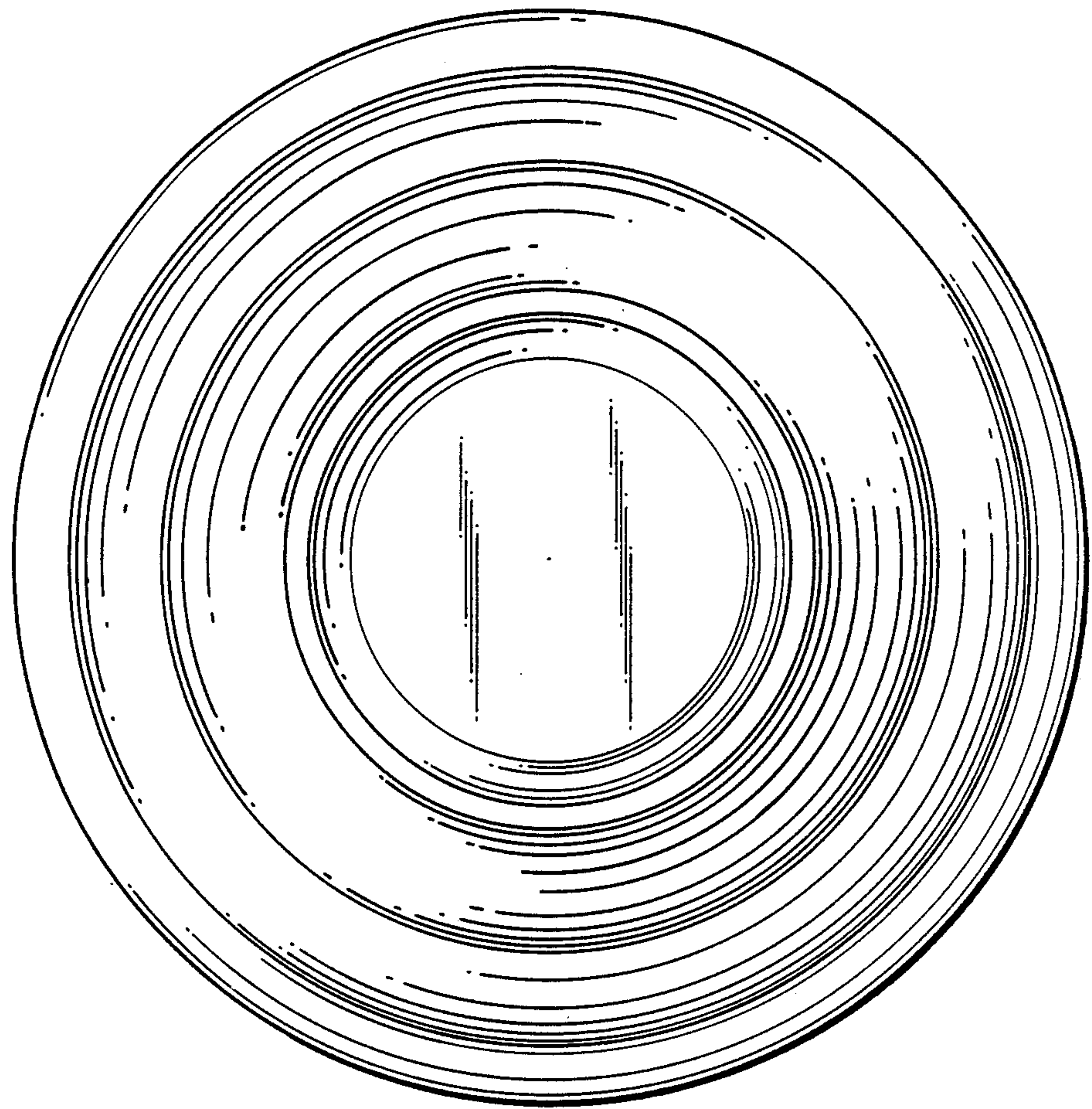

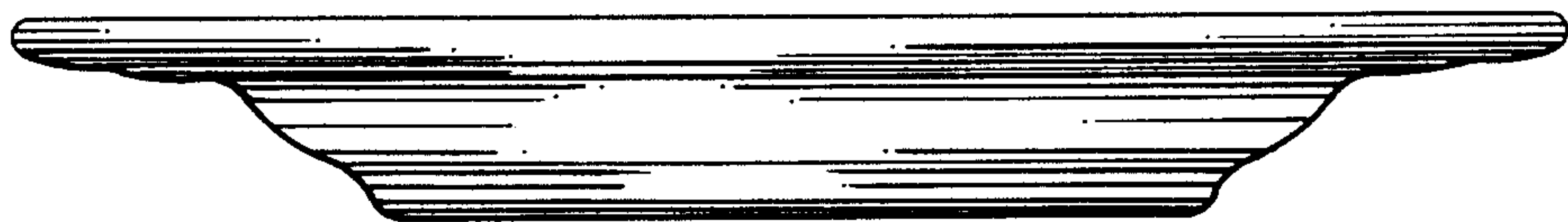

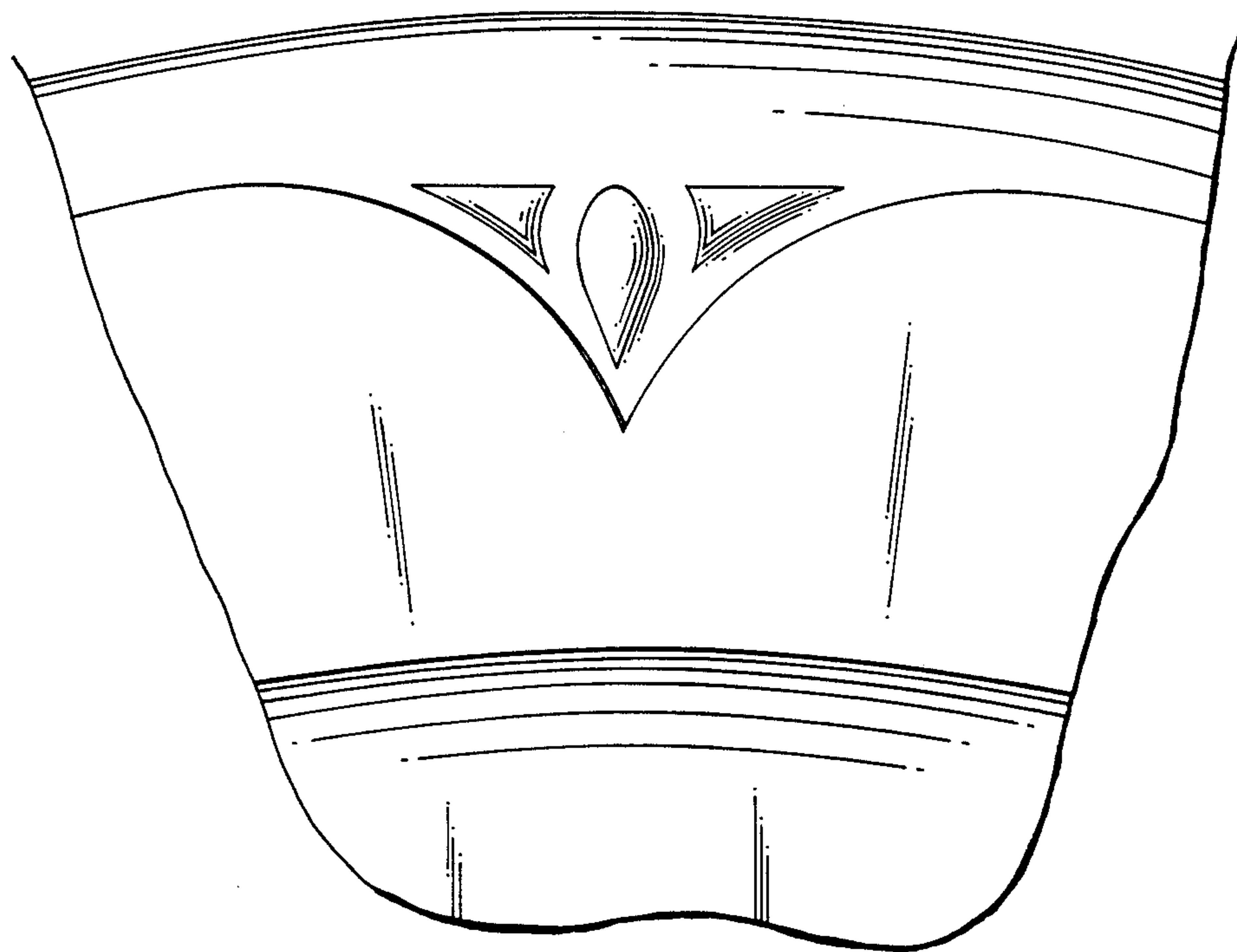
