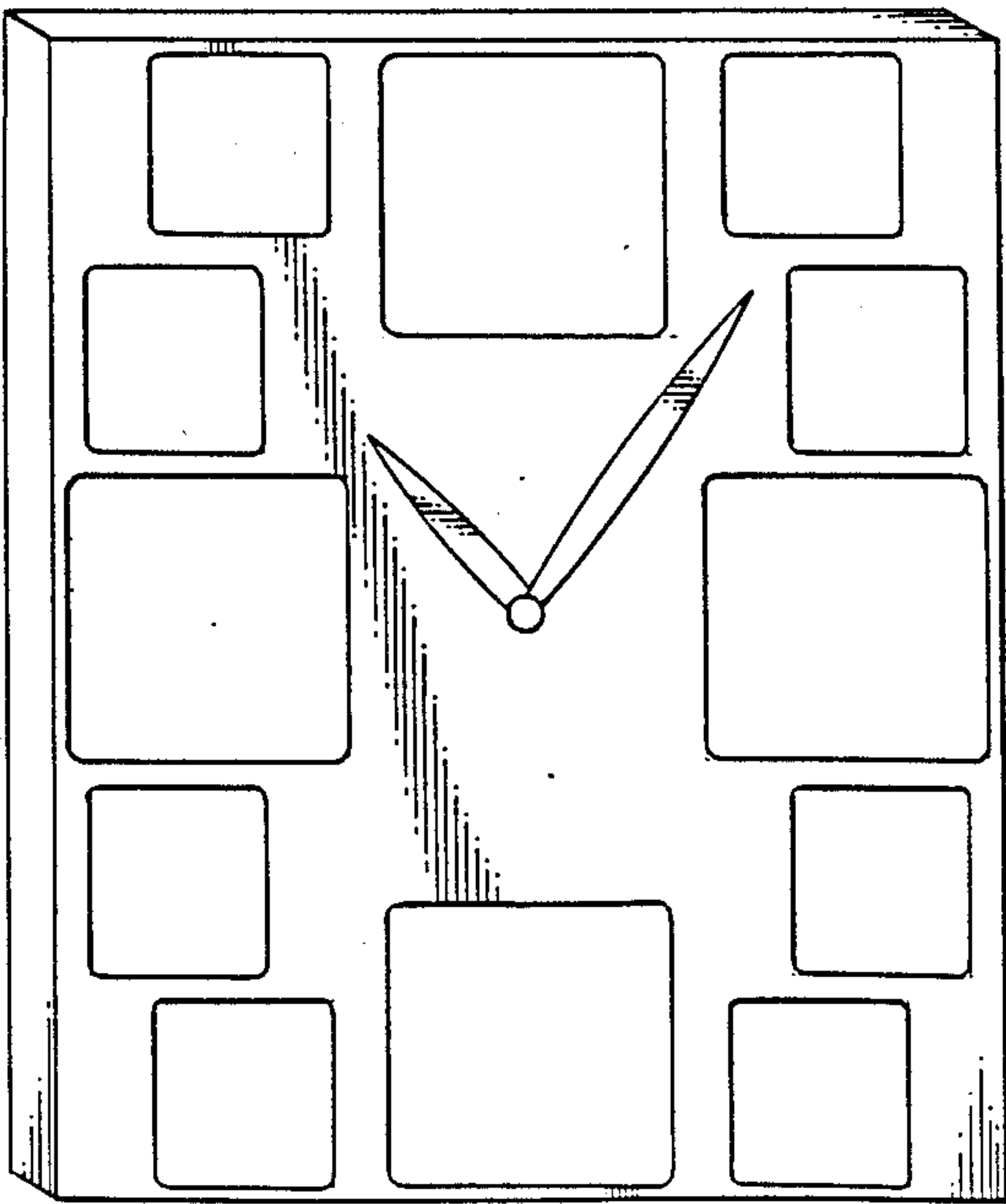

image thereof.



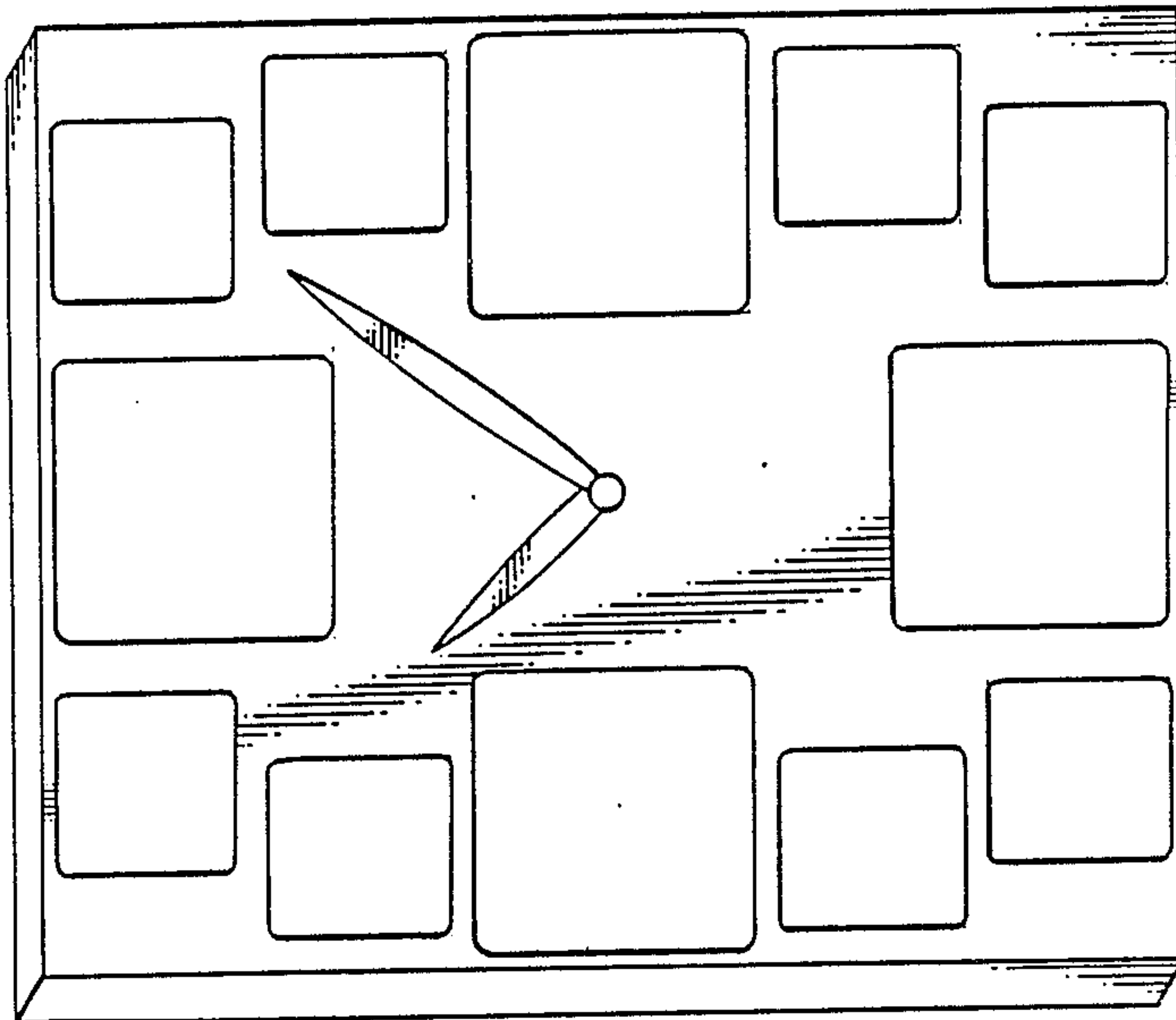

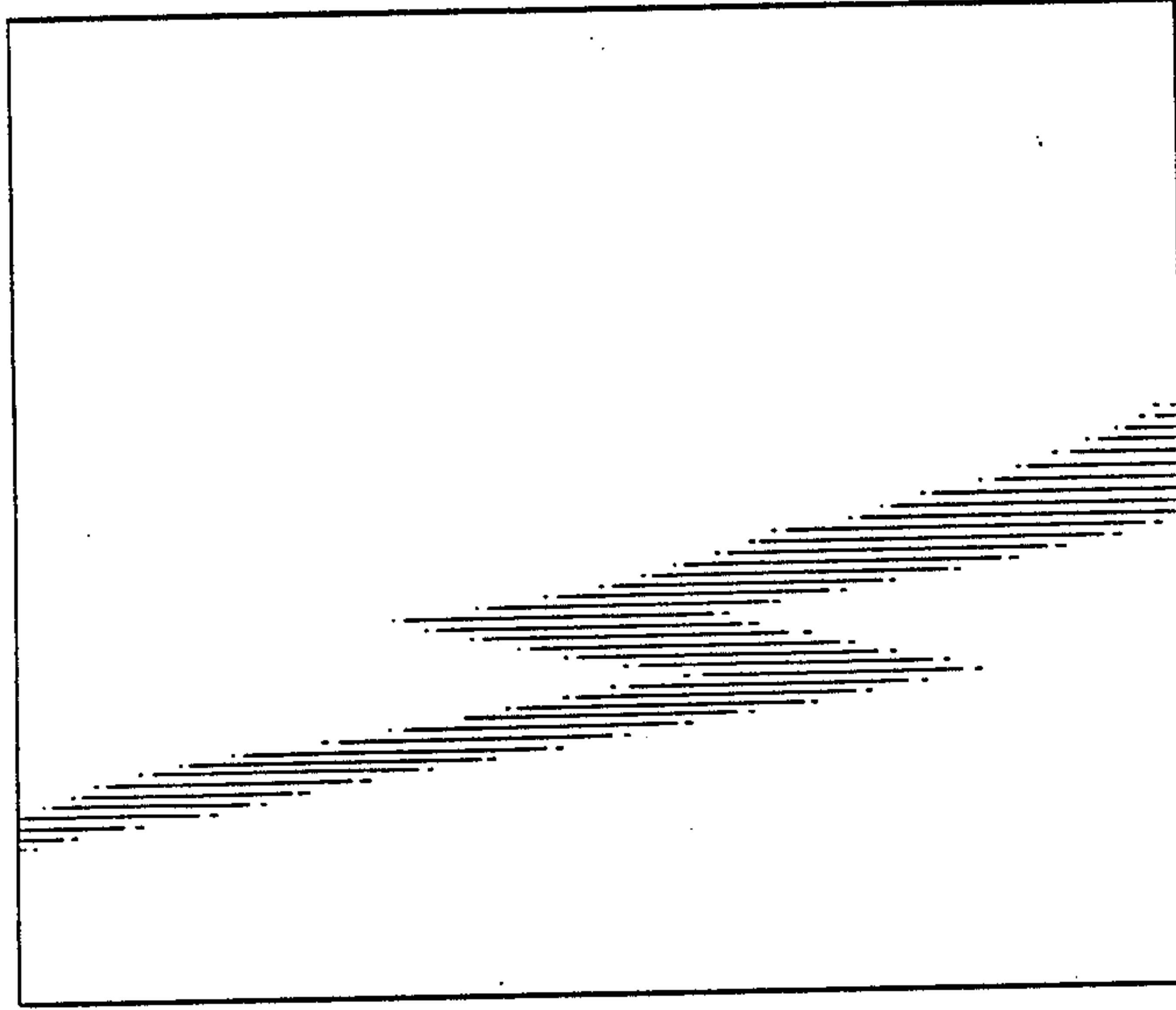
