

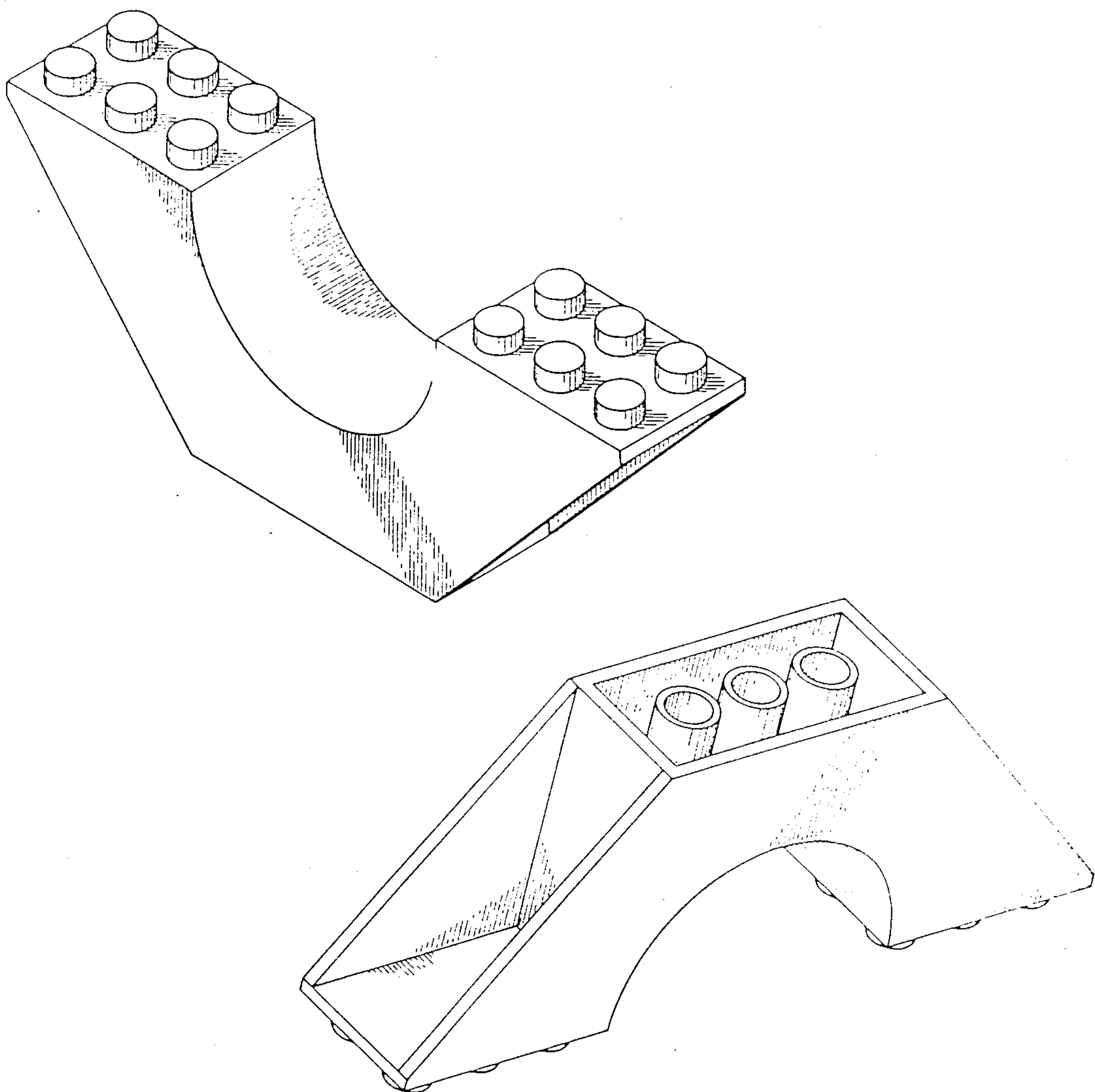

site being identical.



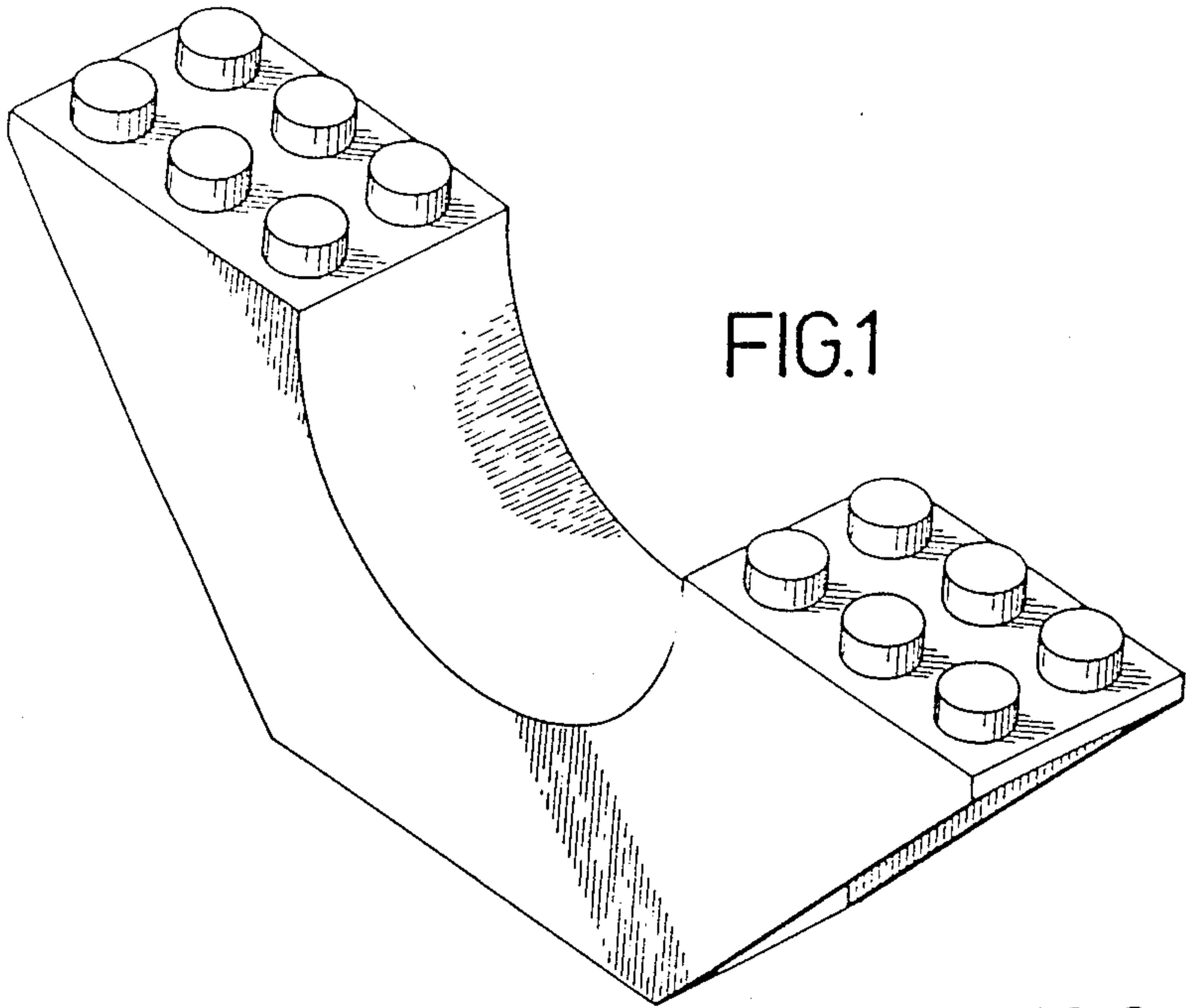

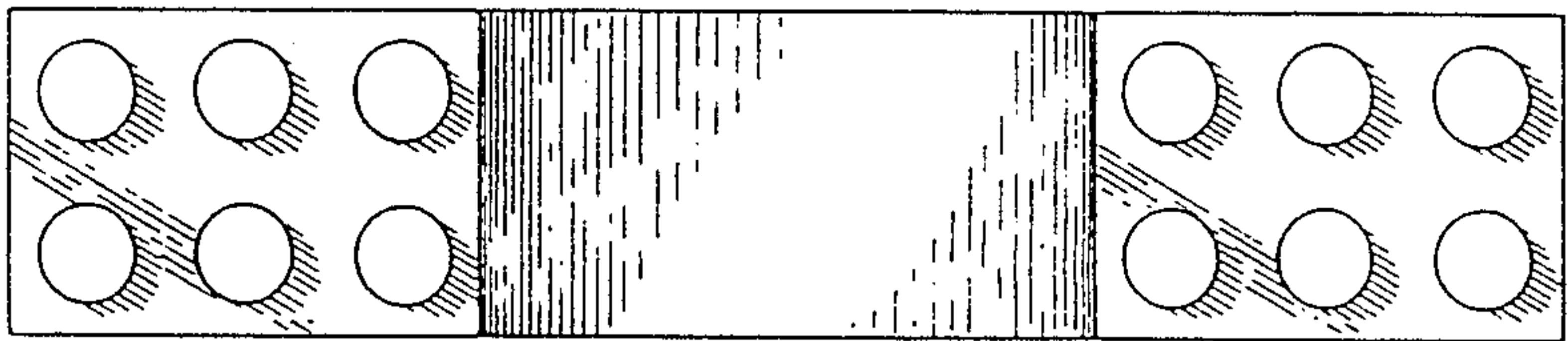

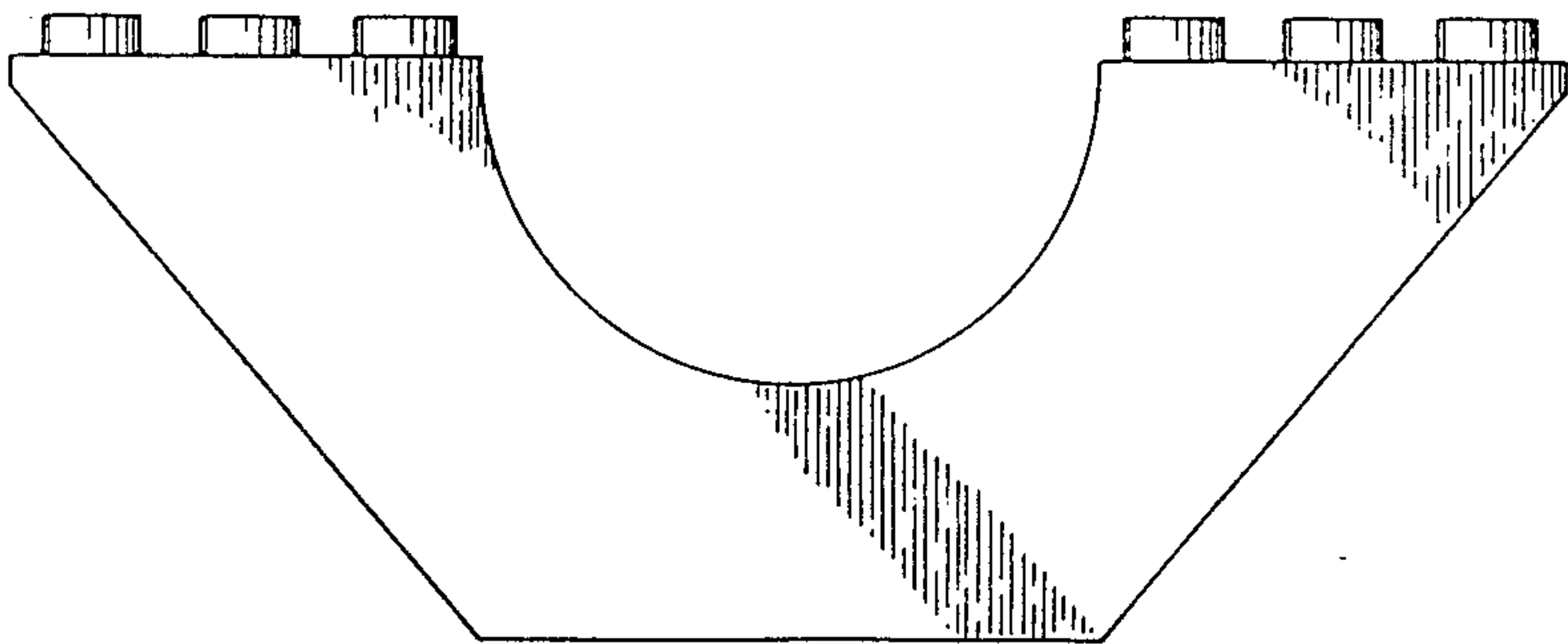

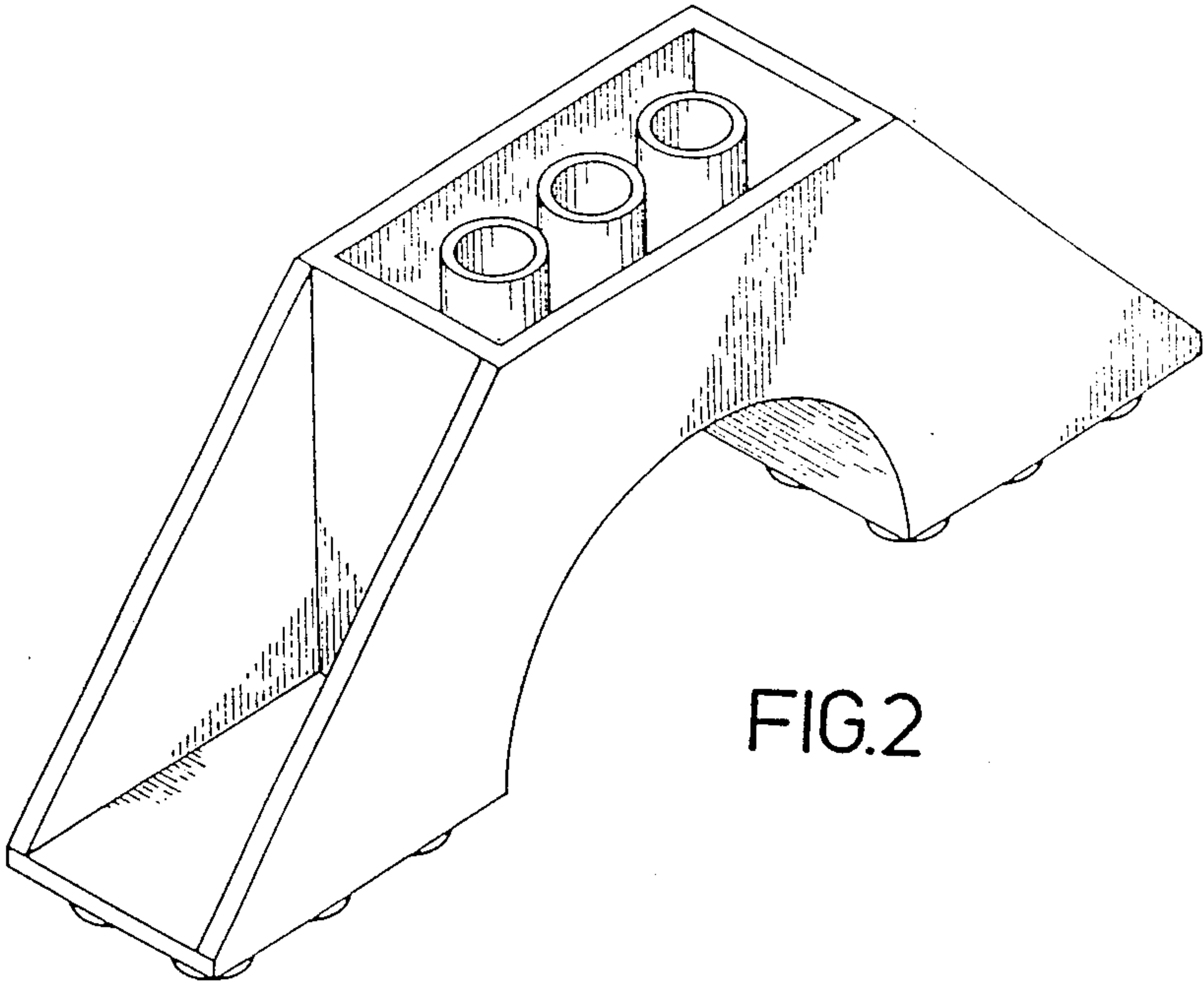

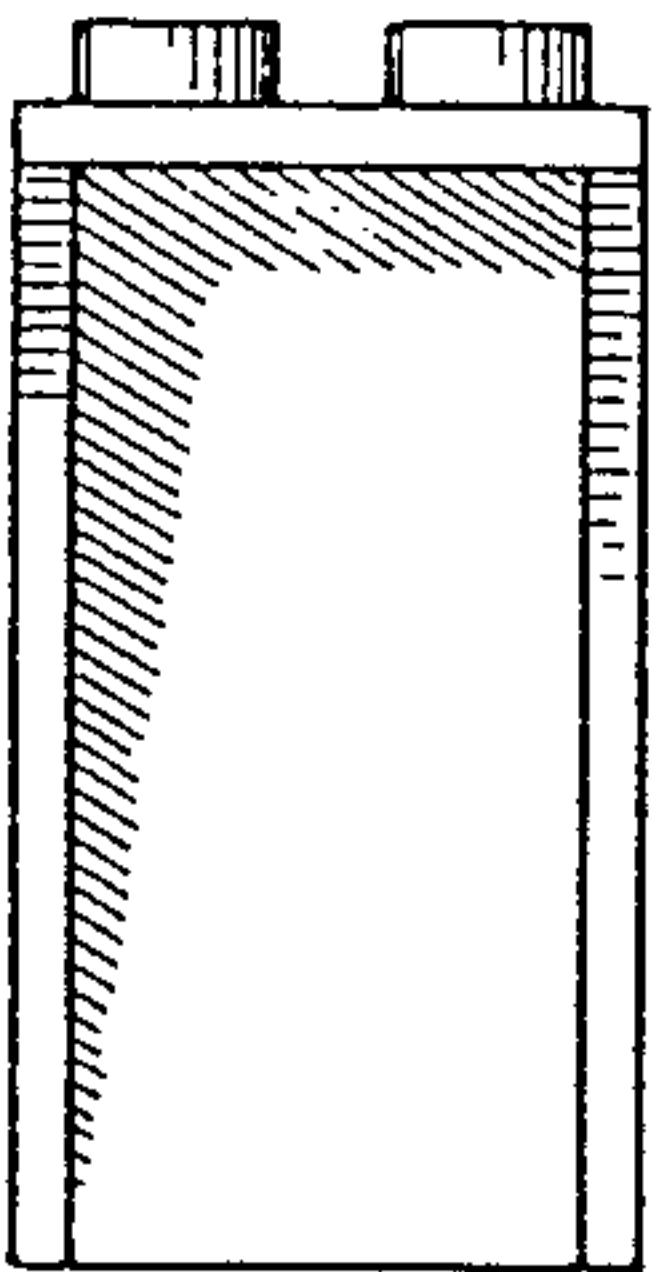
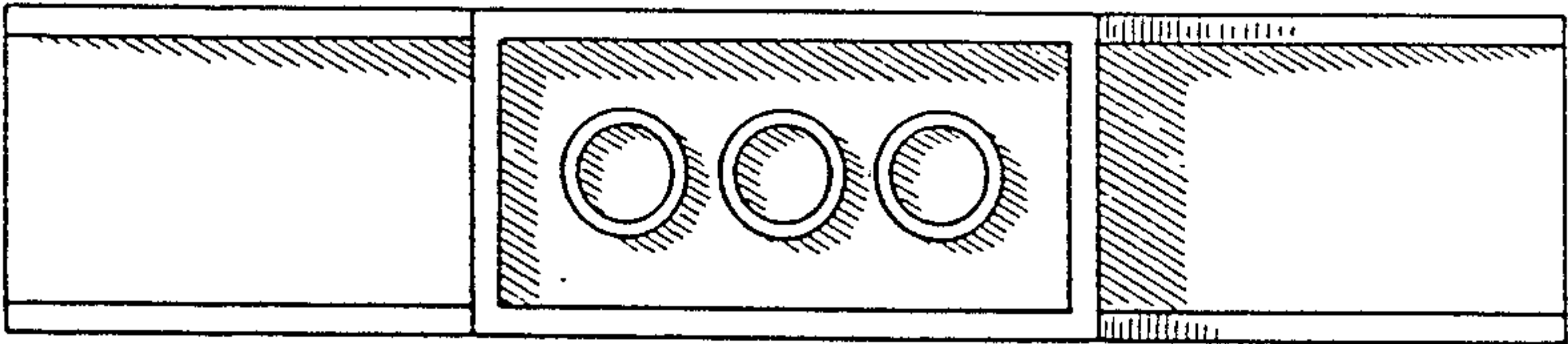
