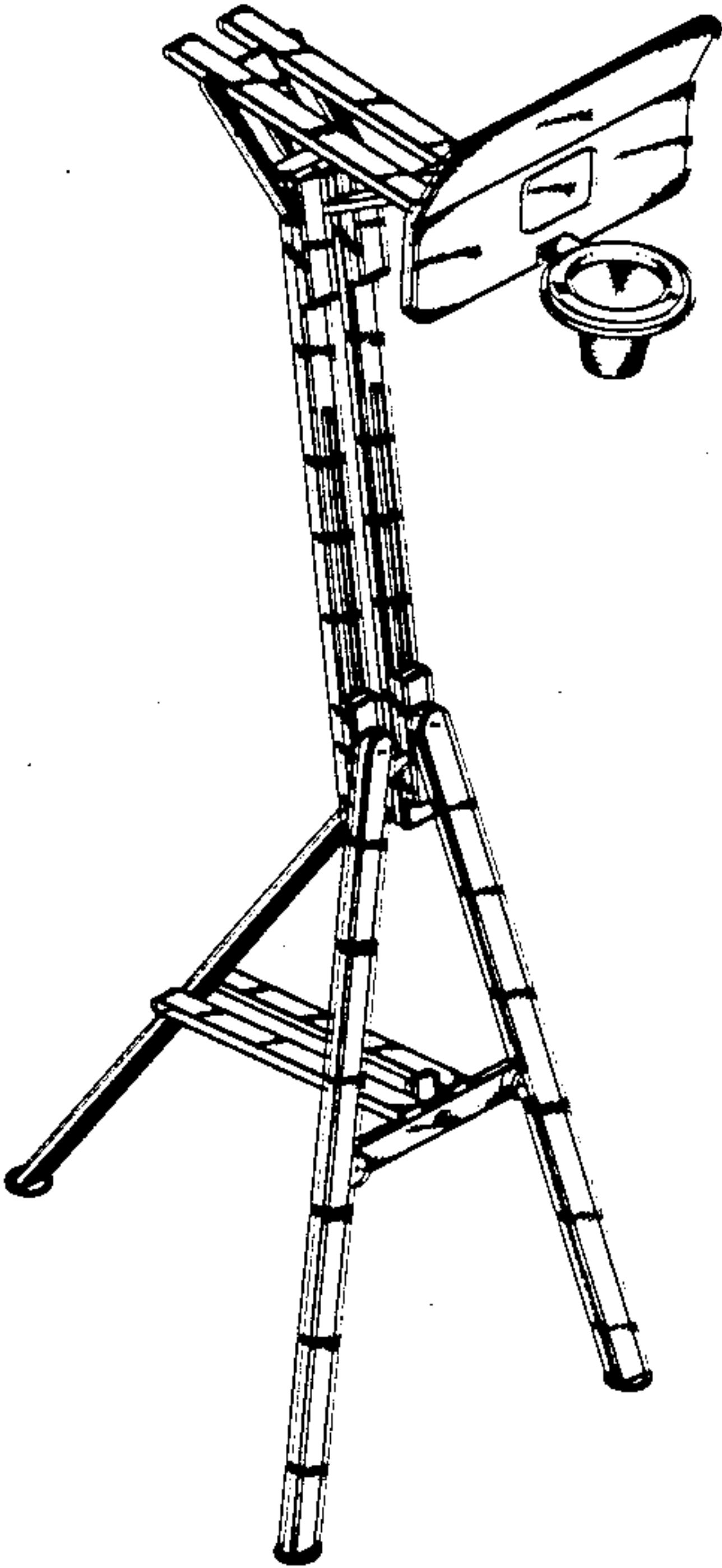

The ornamental design for a ball game goal, as shown
and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a ball game goal,
showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view of one side thereof, the
opposite side being a mirror image of the figure shown;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The broken line showing of the four balls in FIG. 2 is
for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the
design.



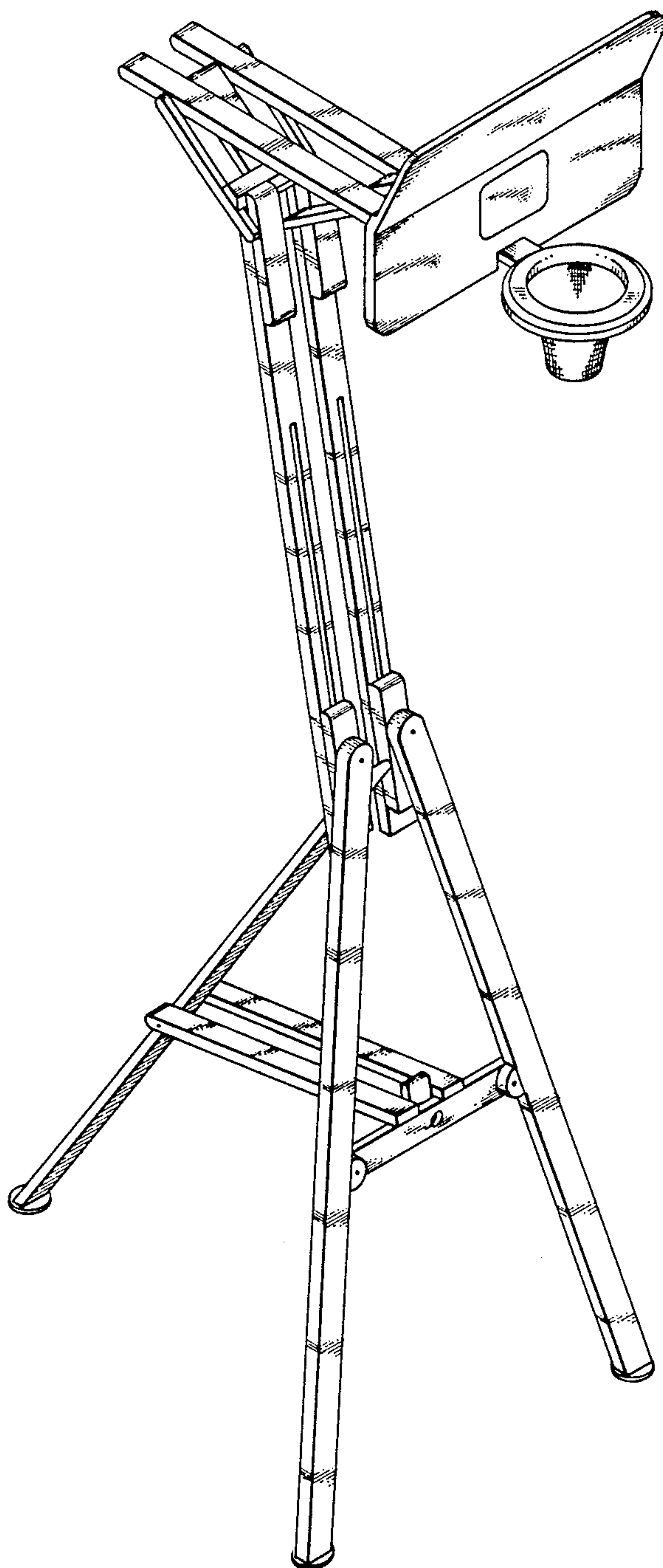

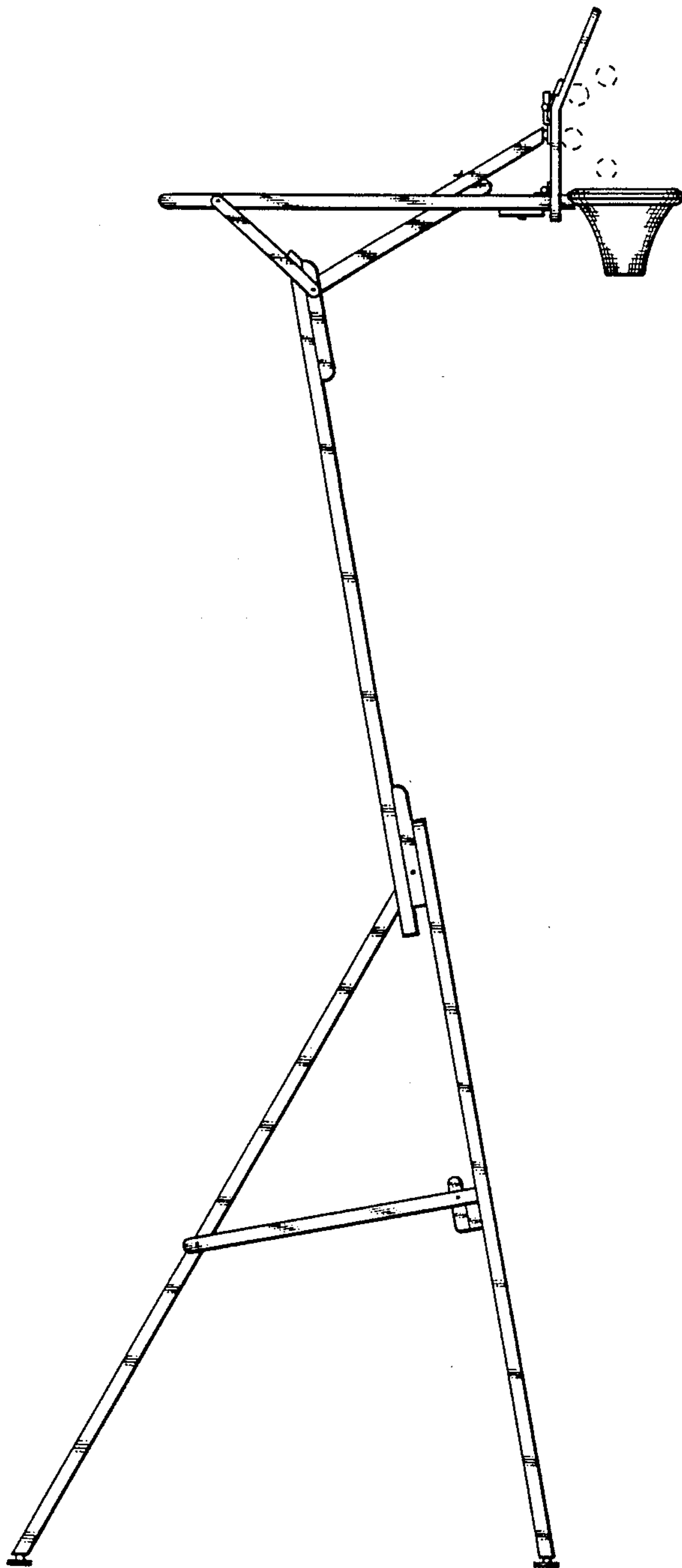

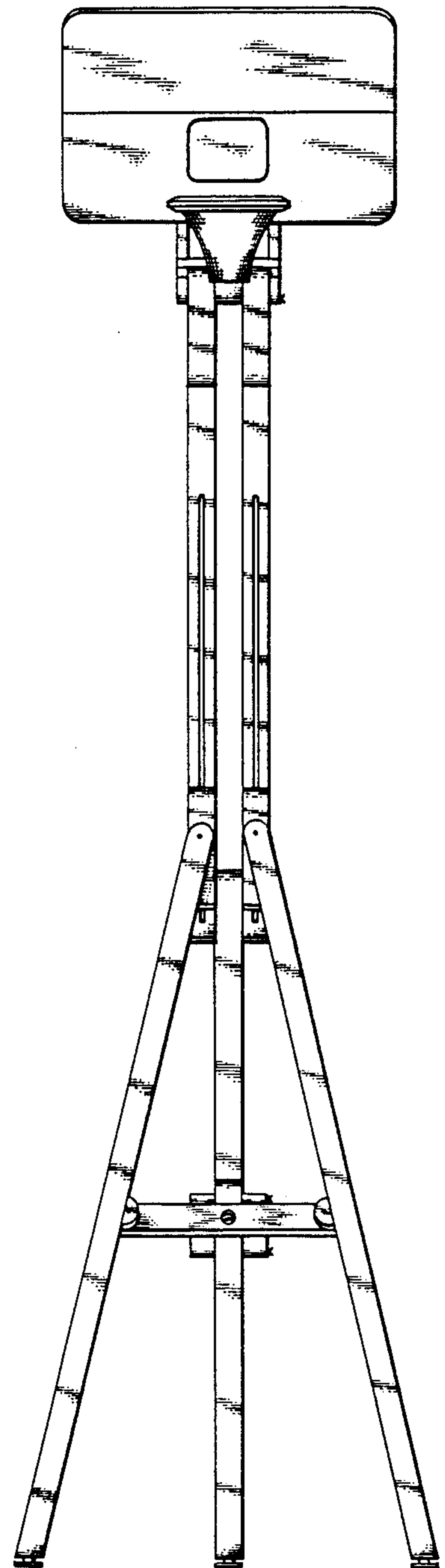

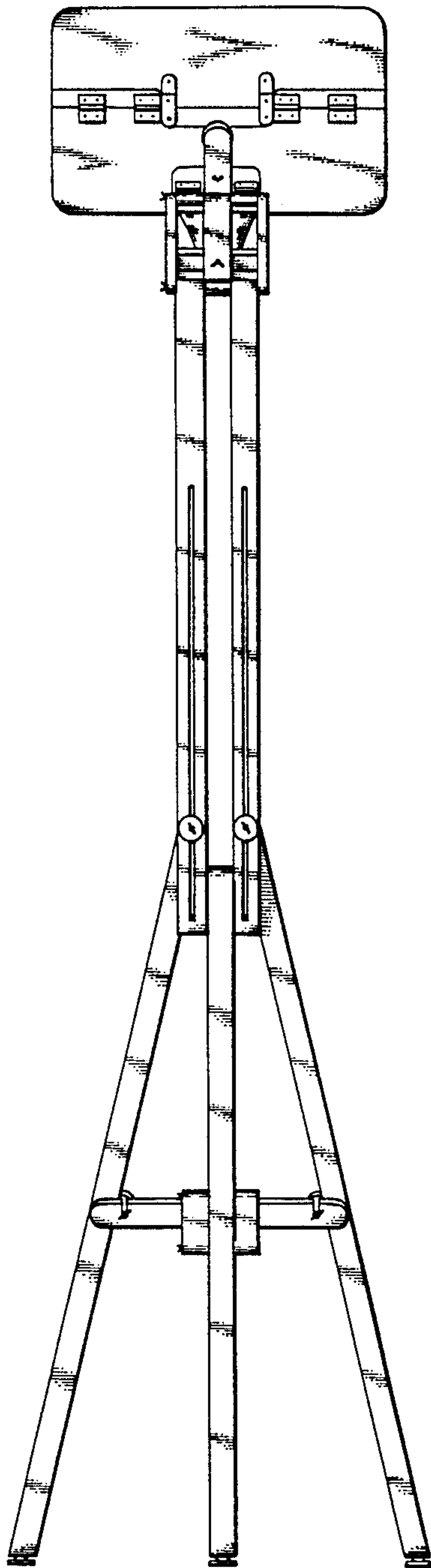

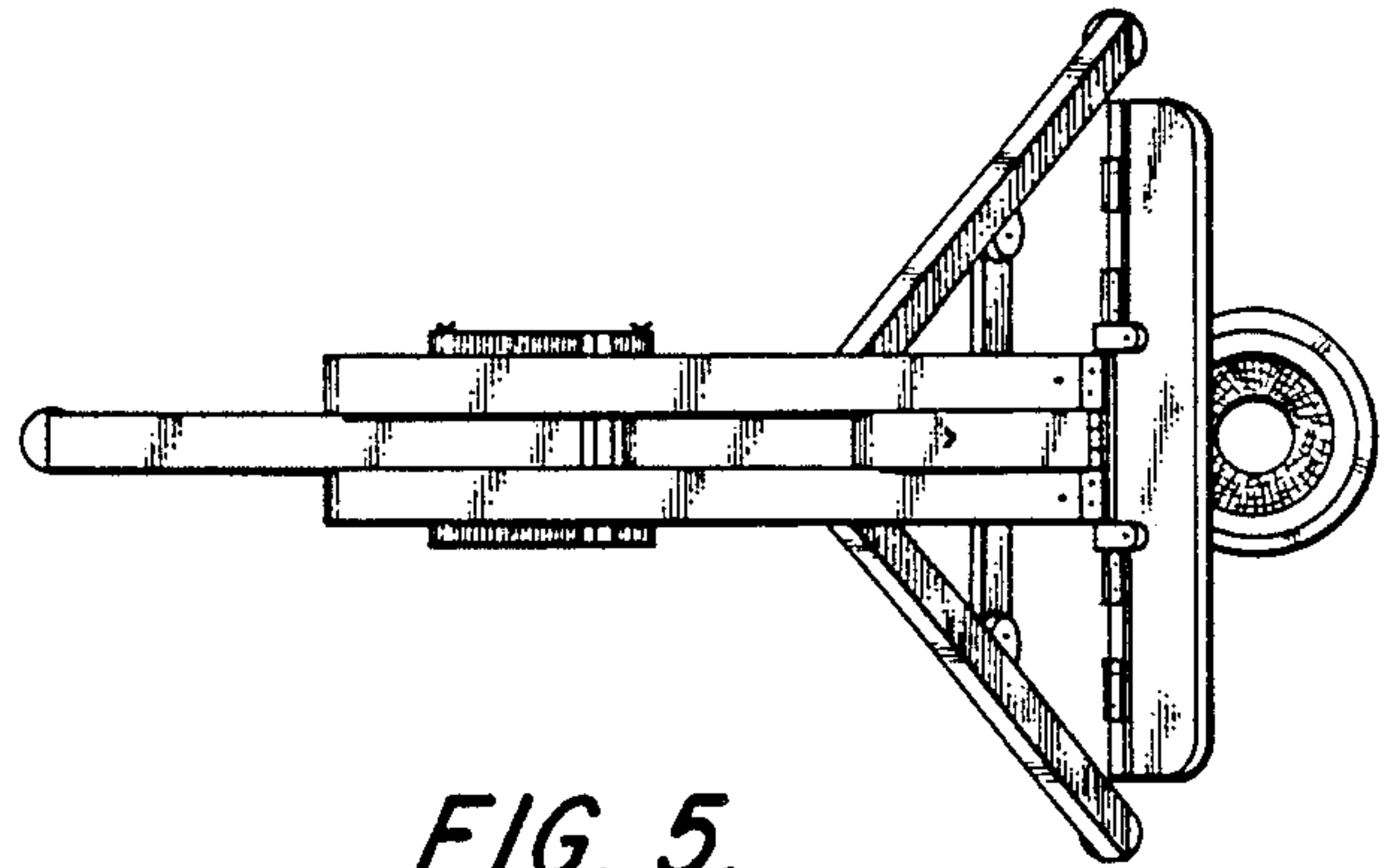

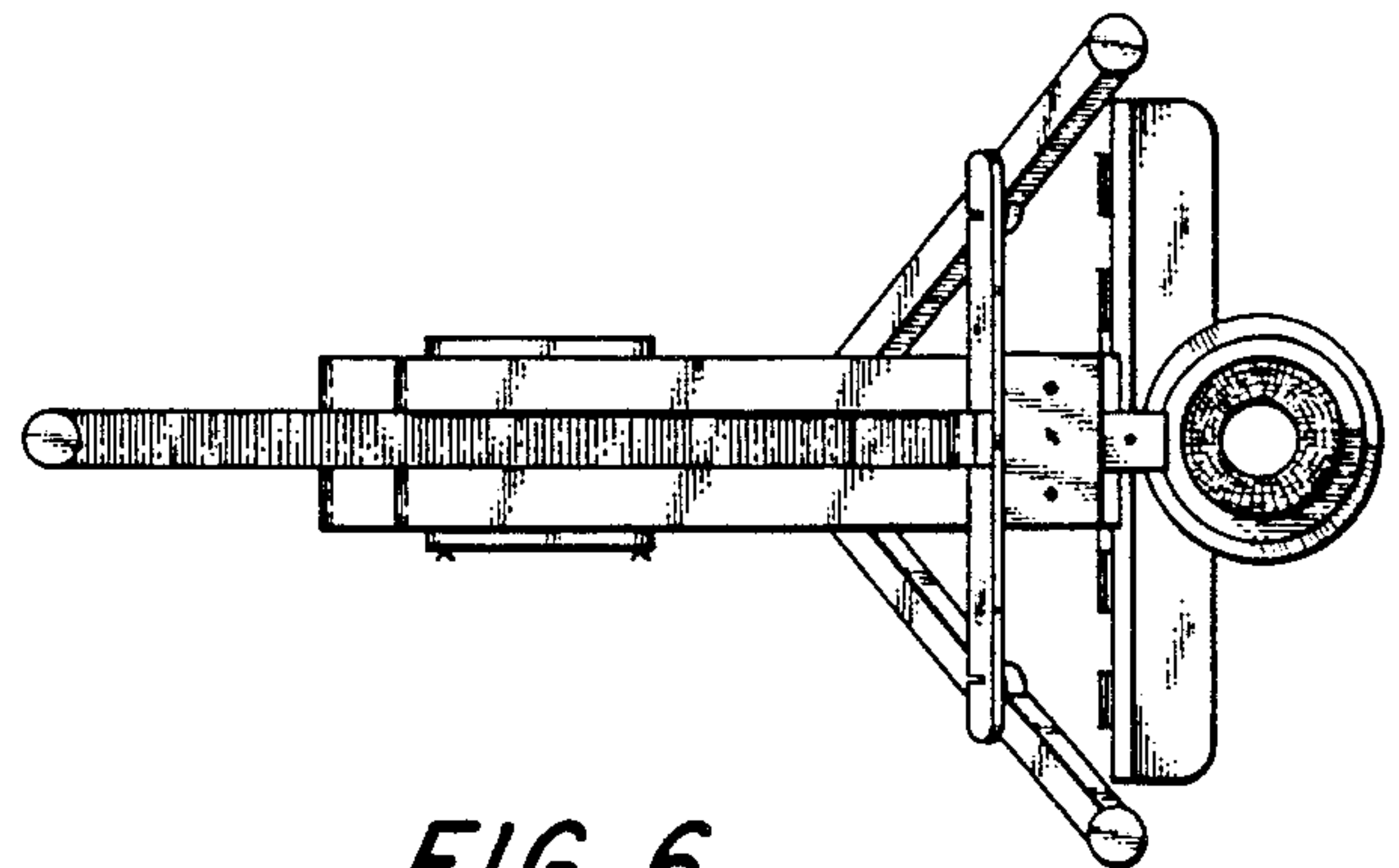
