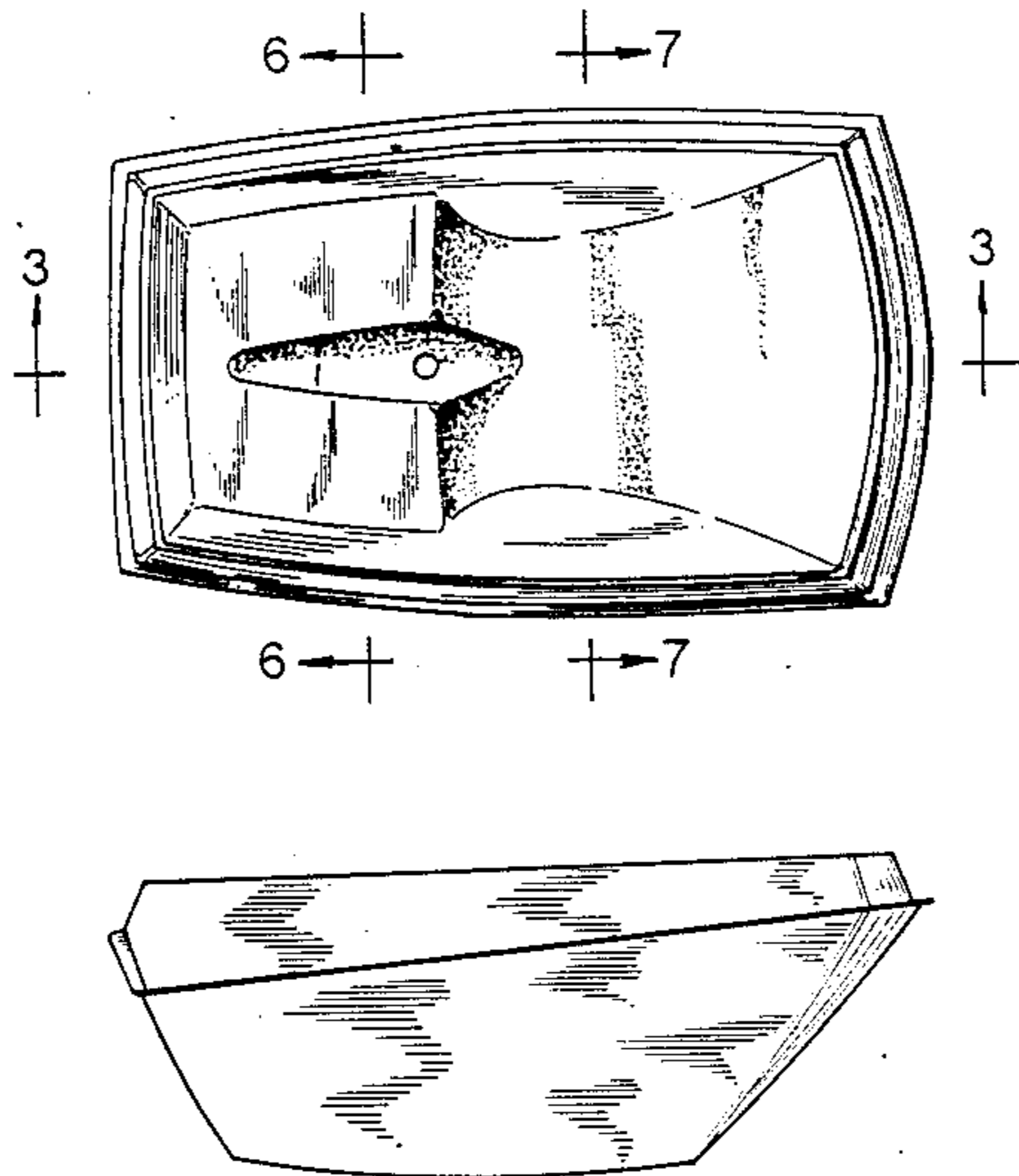

[57] **CLAIM**

The design for a bathtub for handicapped, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a bathtub for handicapped showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;
FIG. 3 is a cross sectional view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is an elevational view showing the end opposite that shown in FIG. 4;
FIG. 6 is a cross sectional view taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 7 is a cross sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 1.



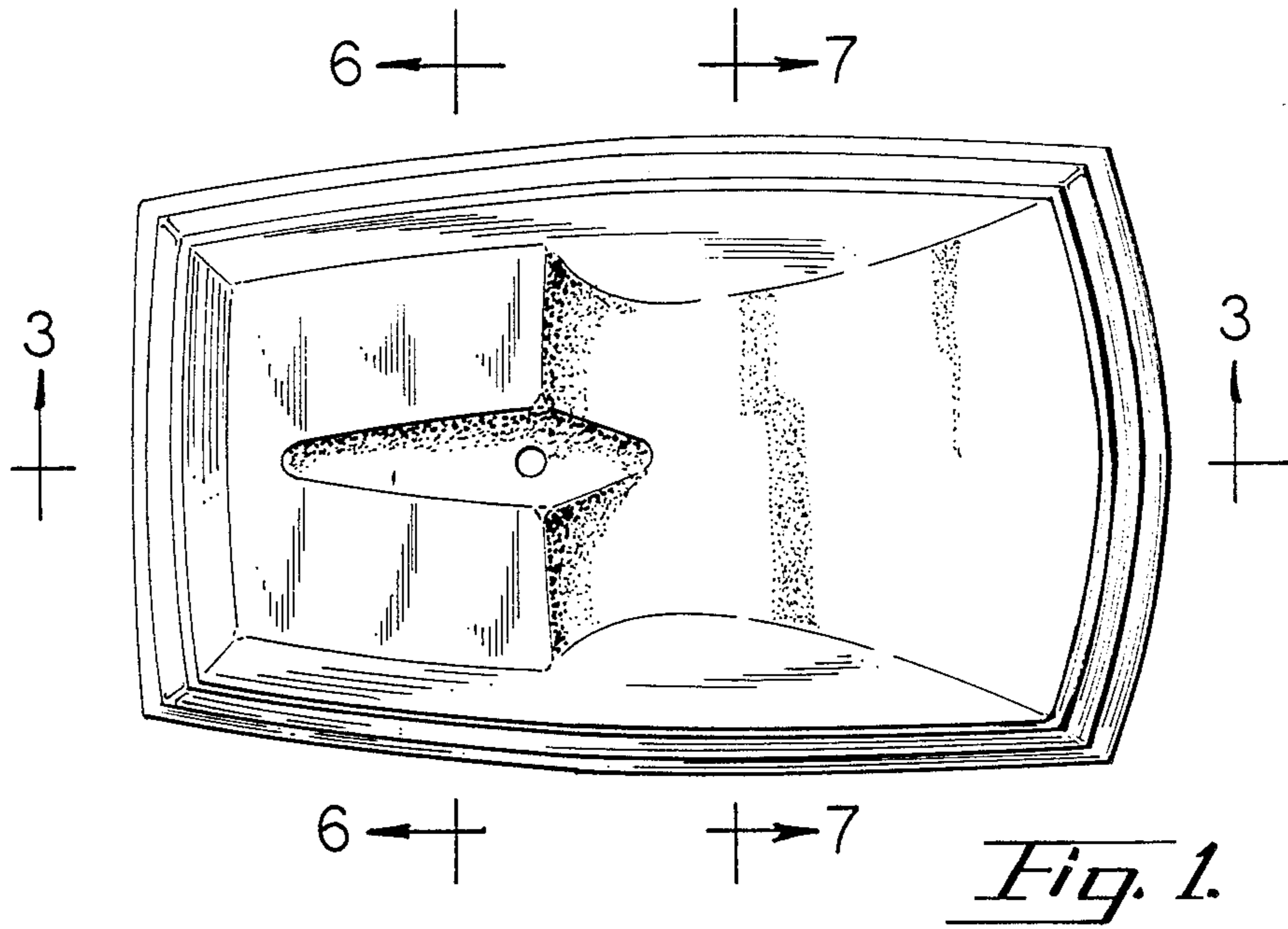

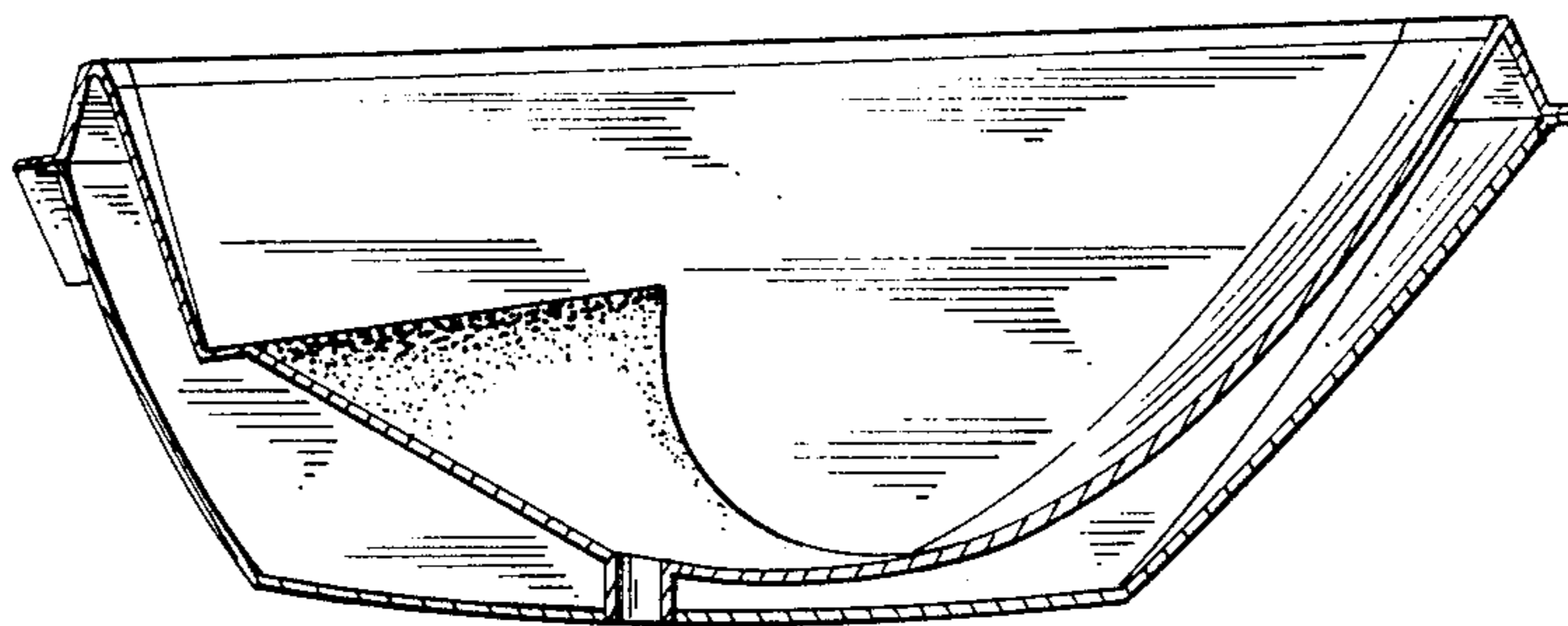

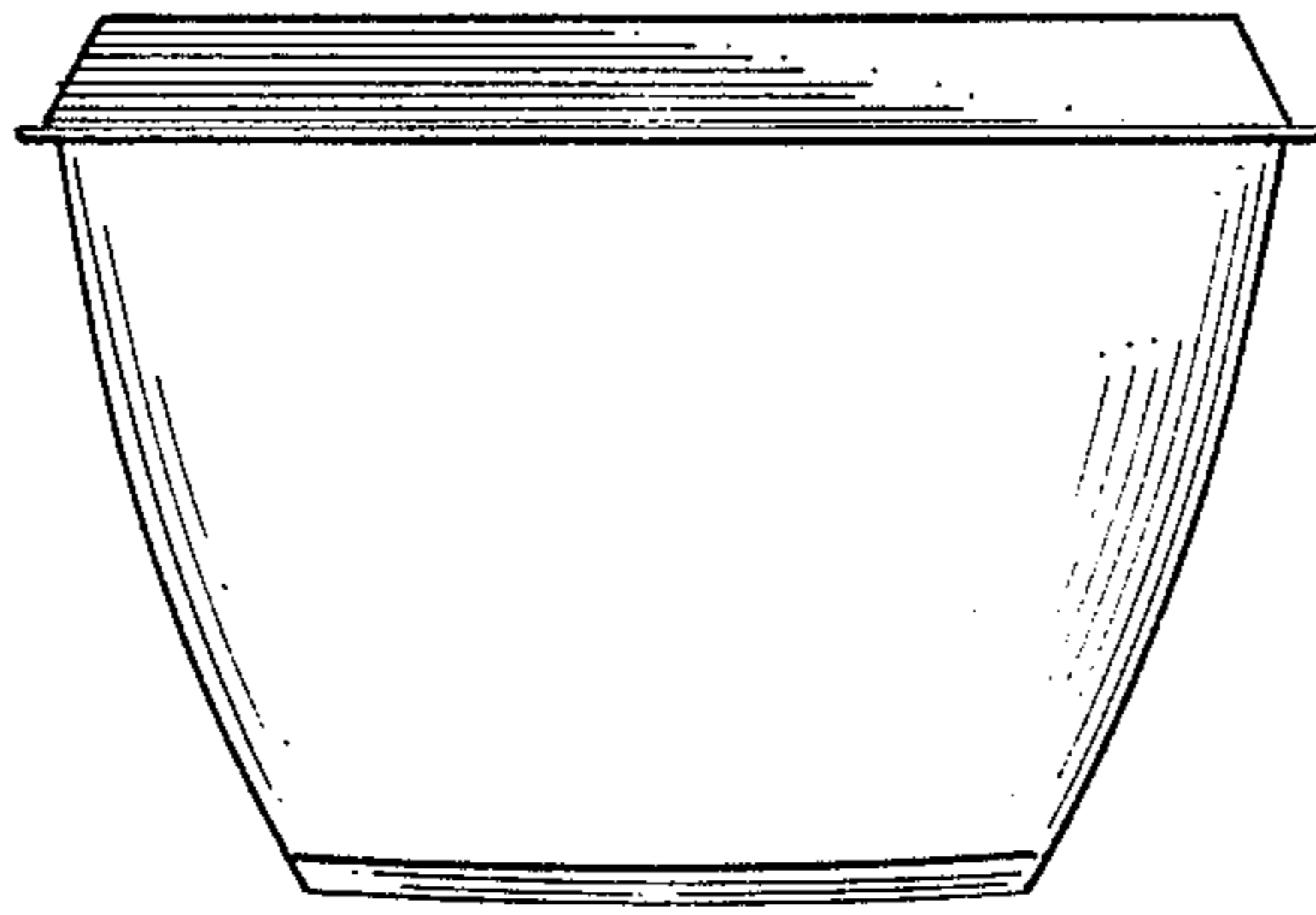

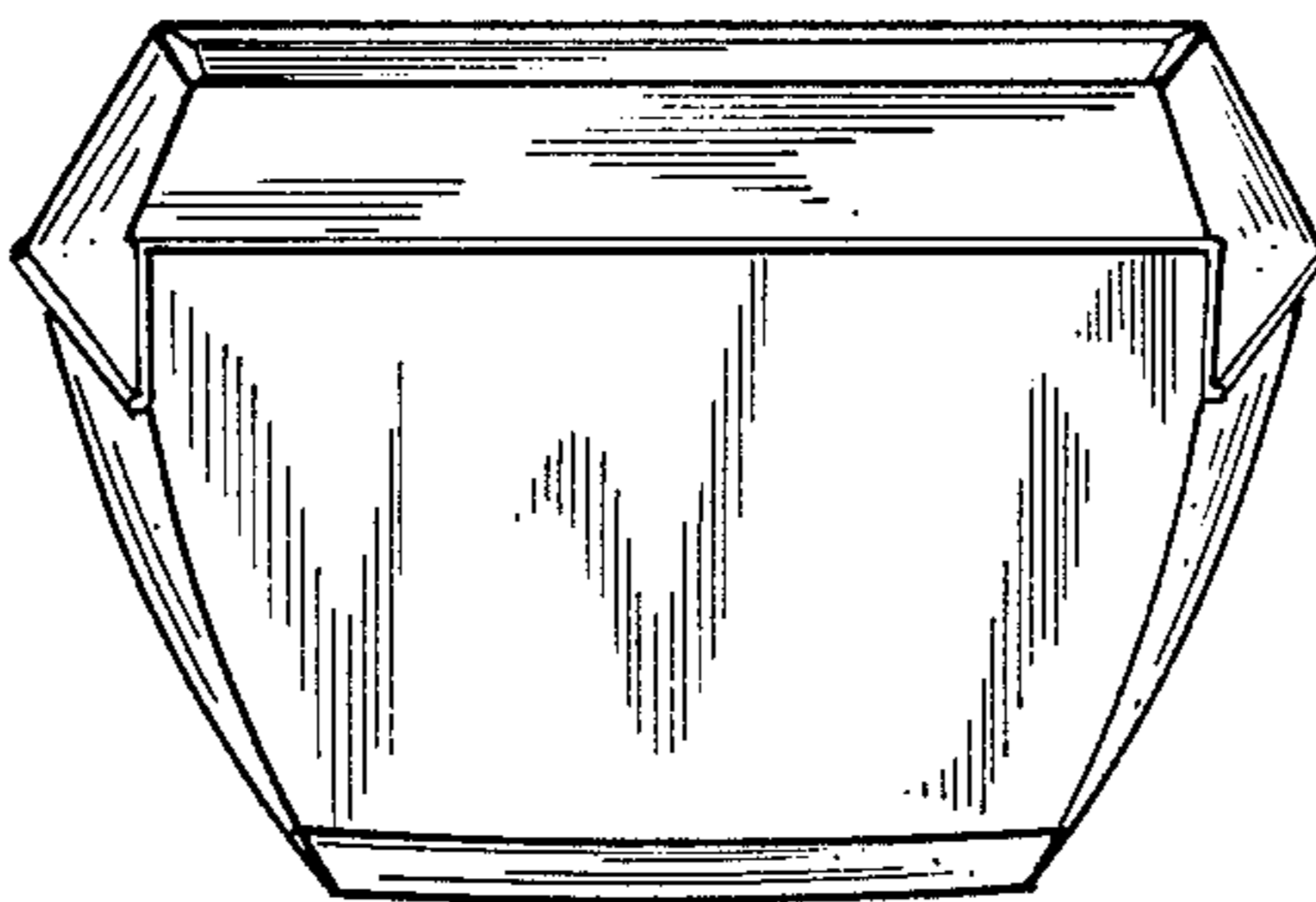

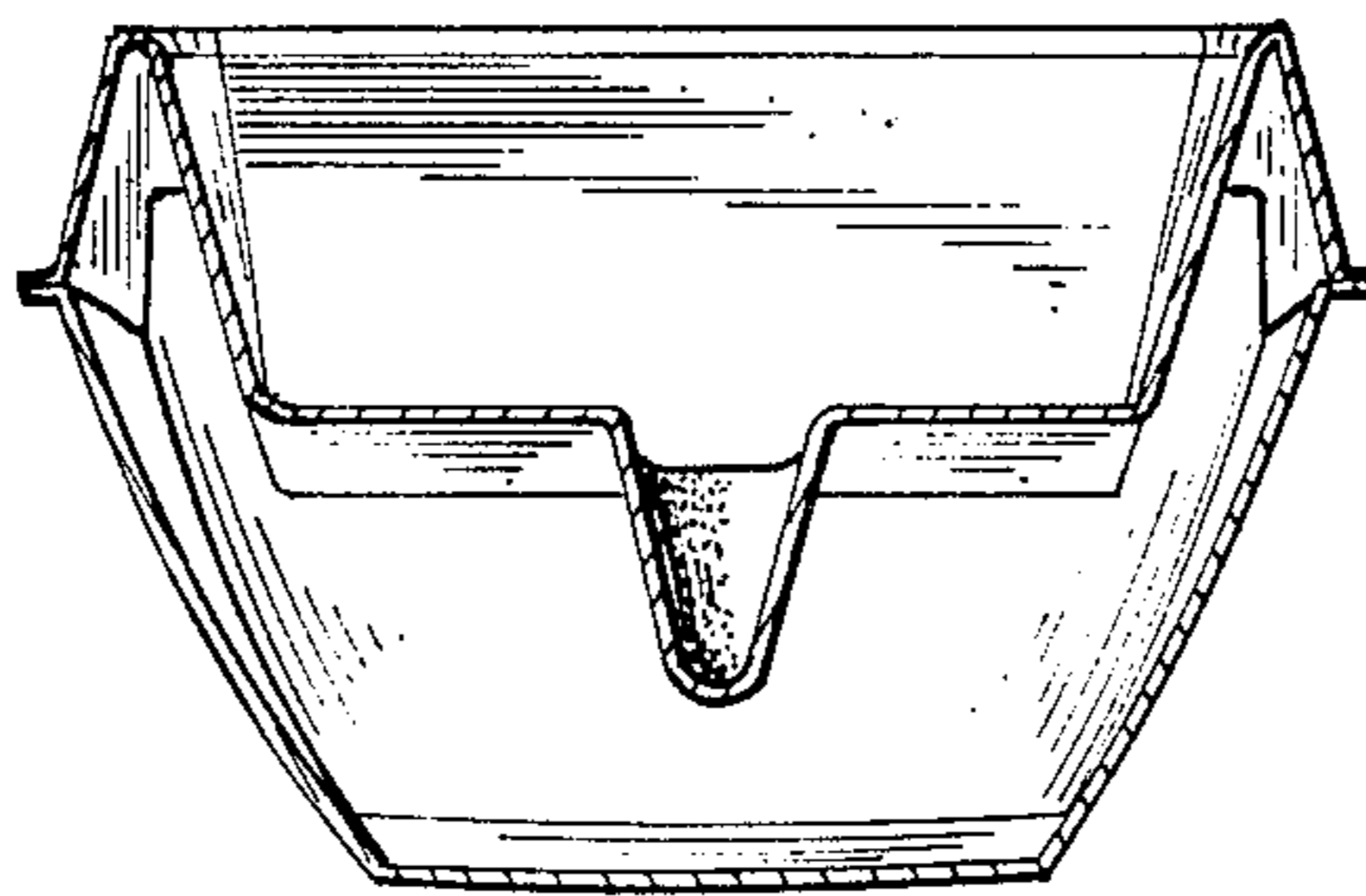

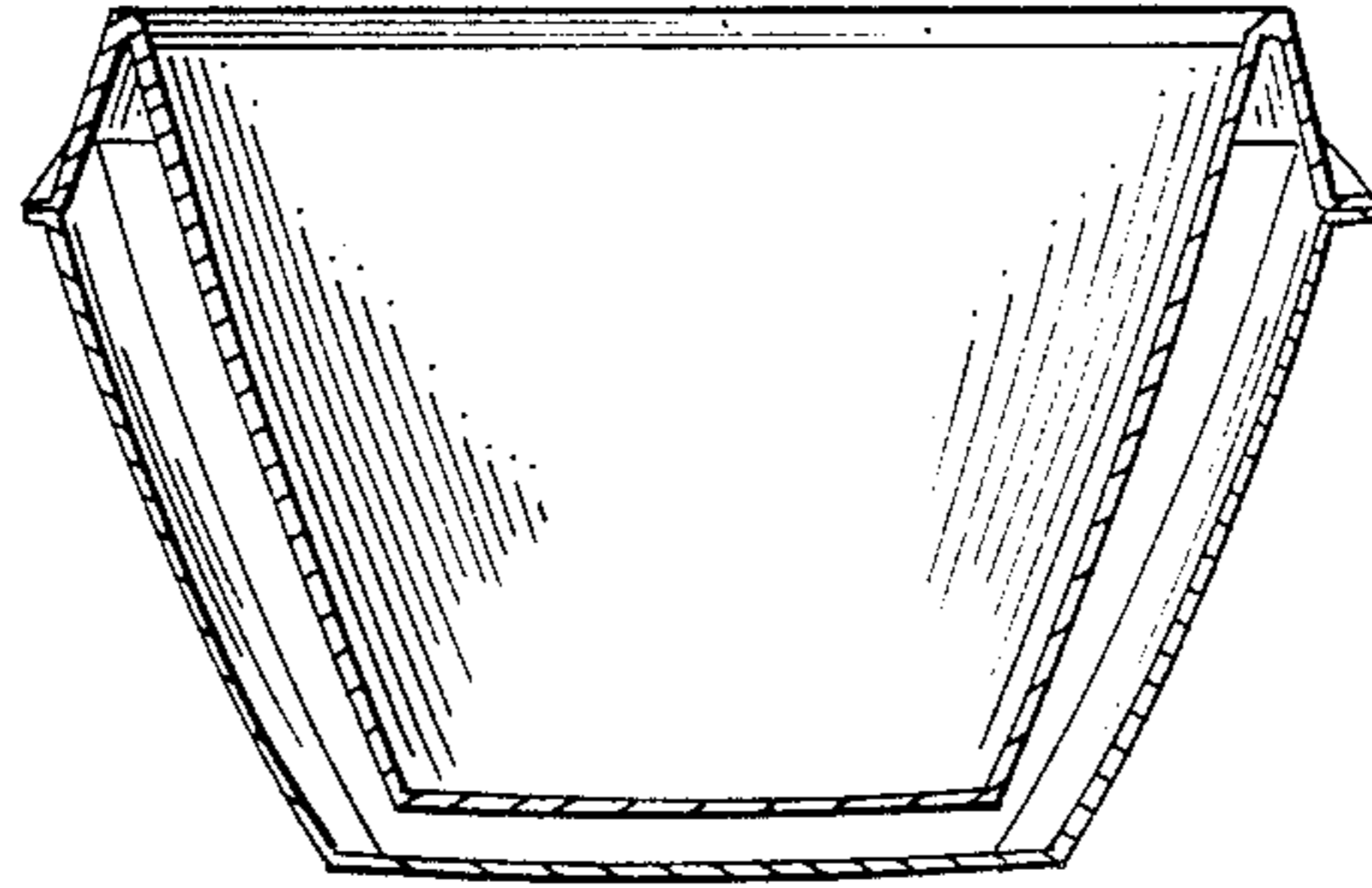
