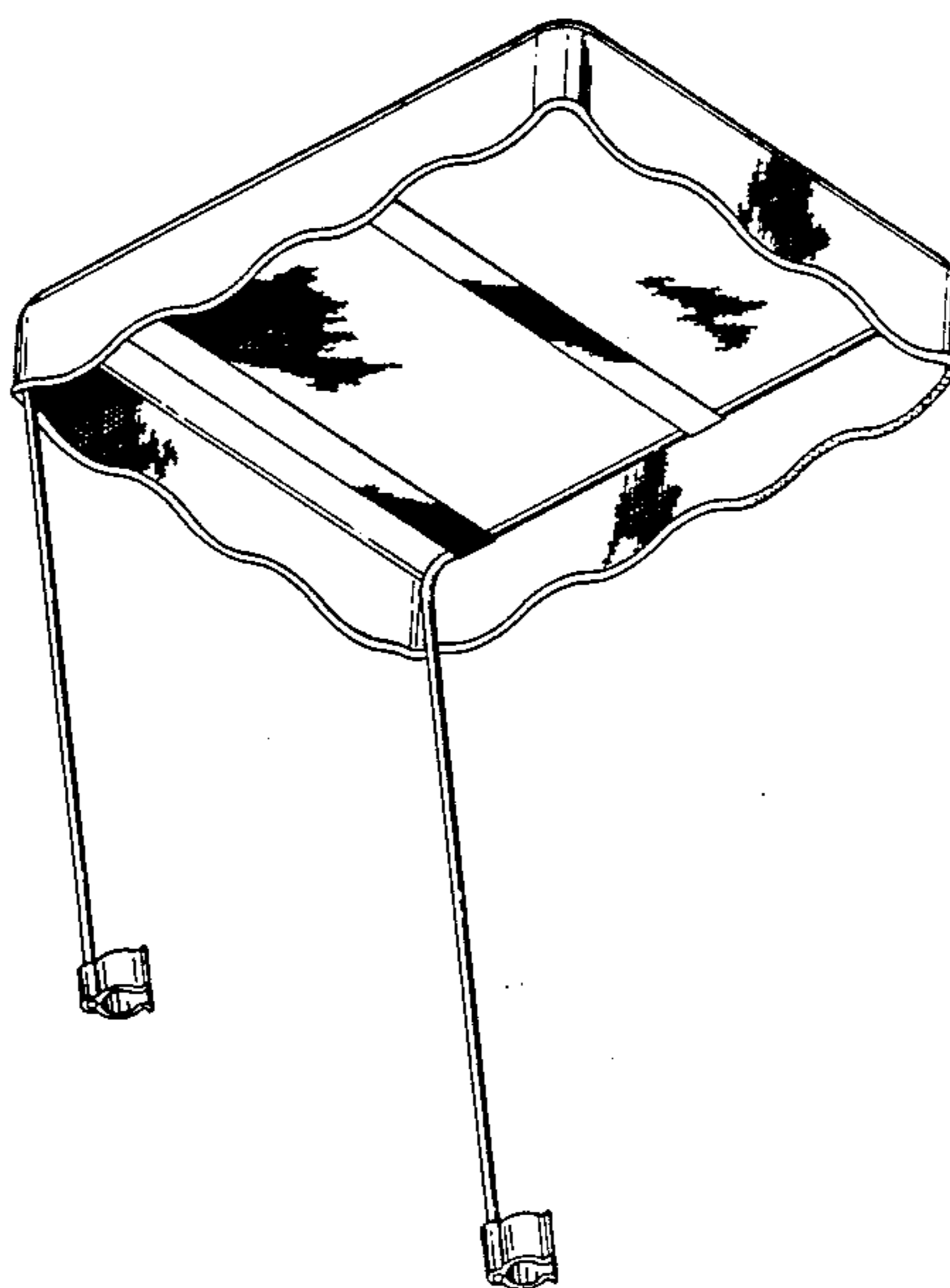
FIG. 1 is a front and bottom perspective view of a sun shade for a lawn chair or the like showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.



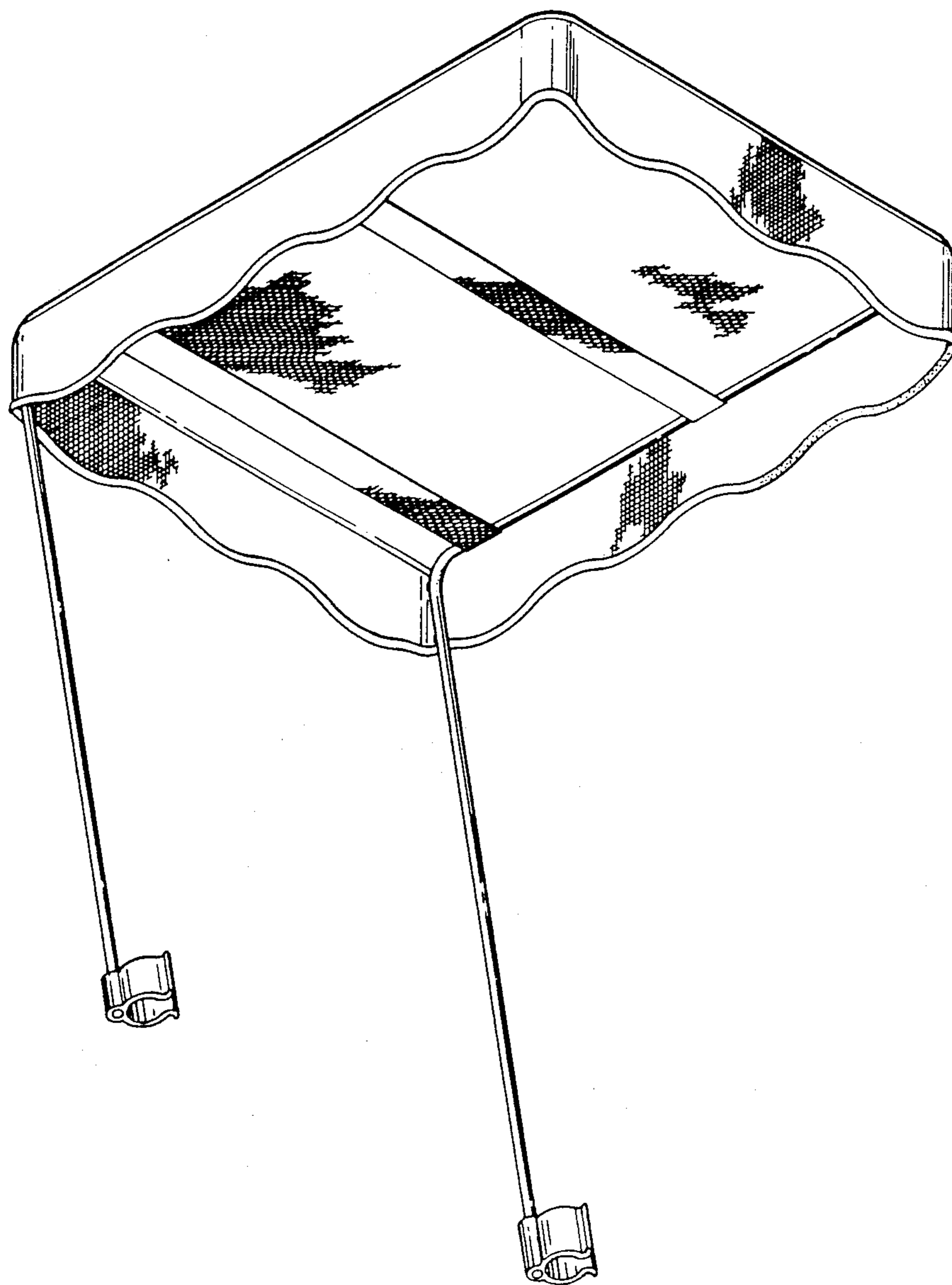

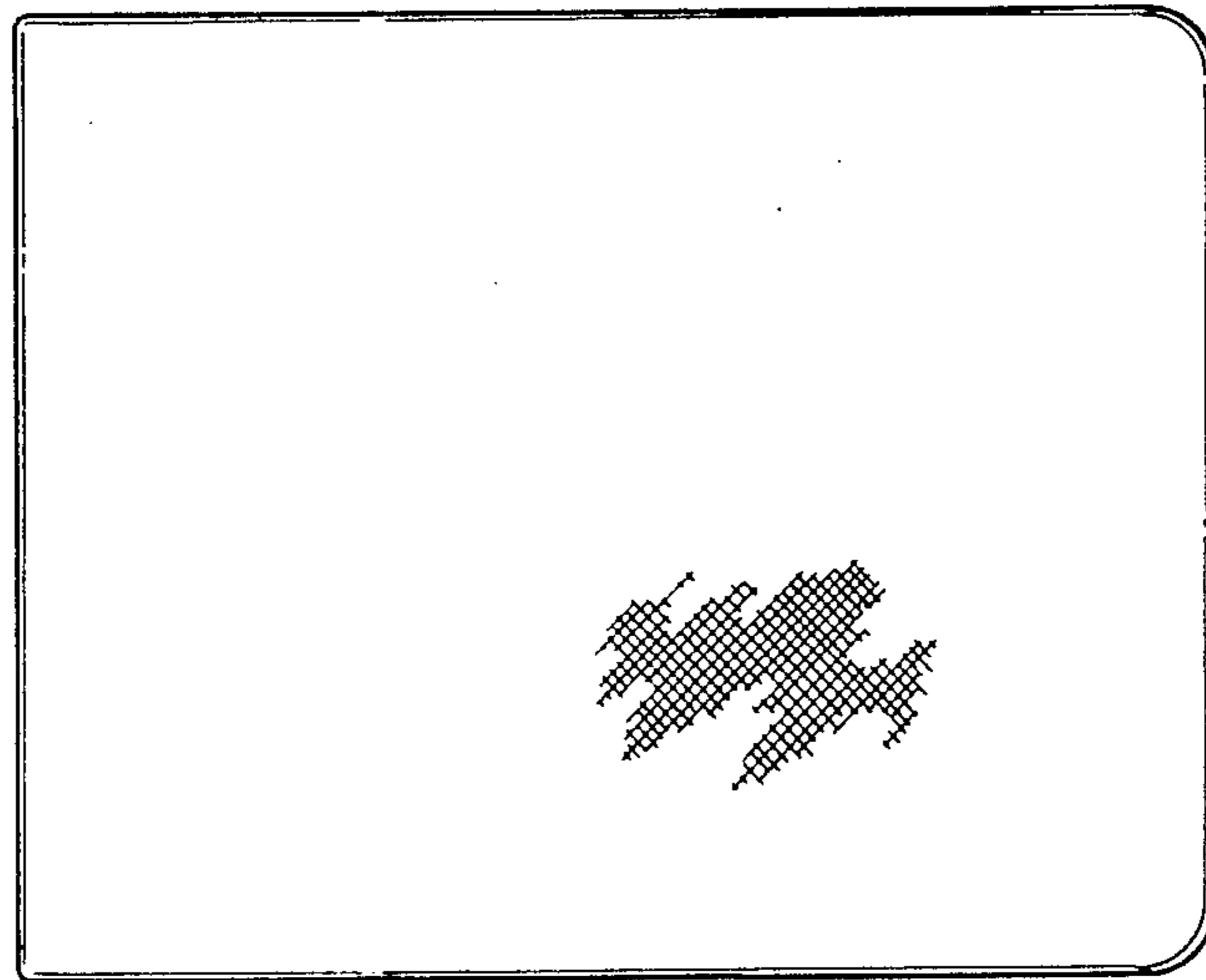

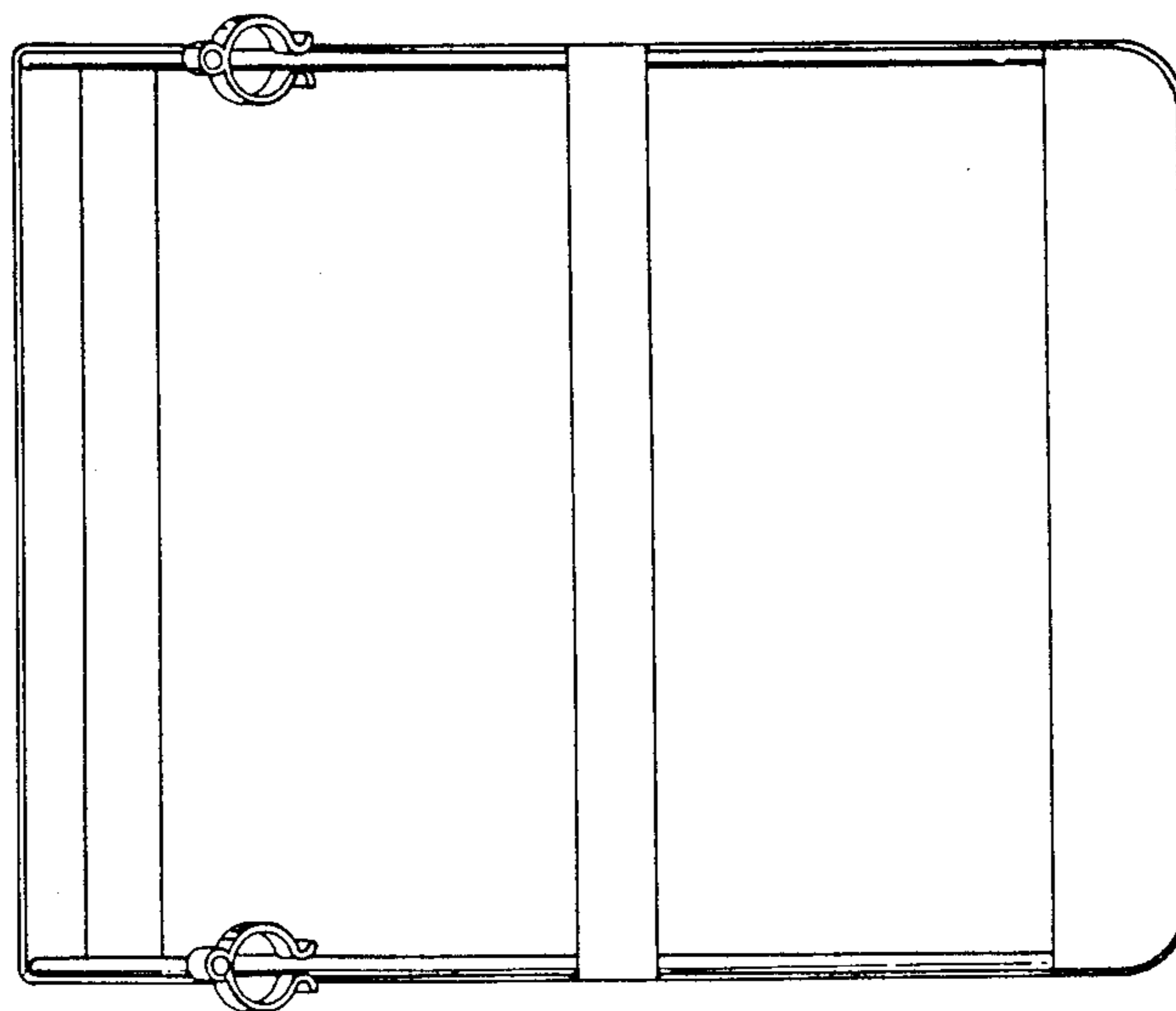

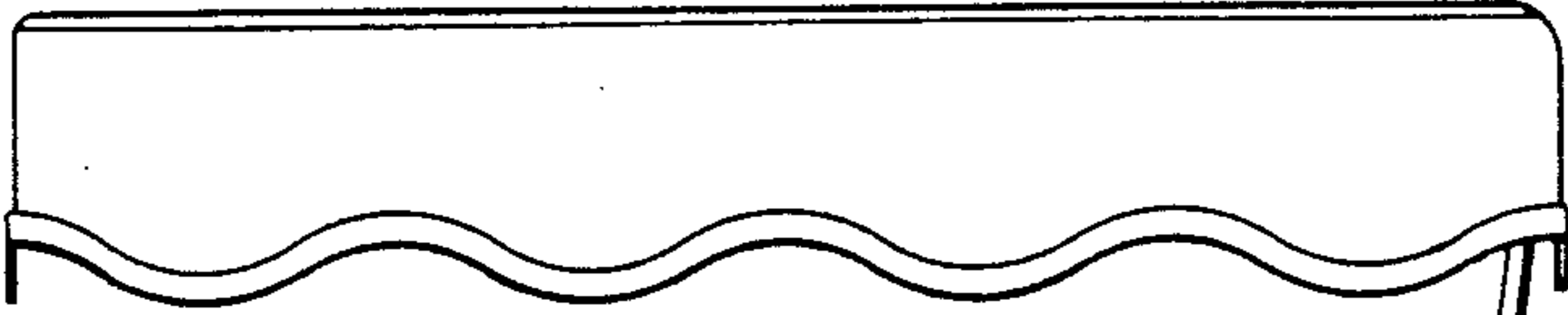

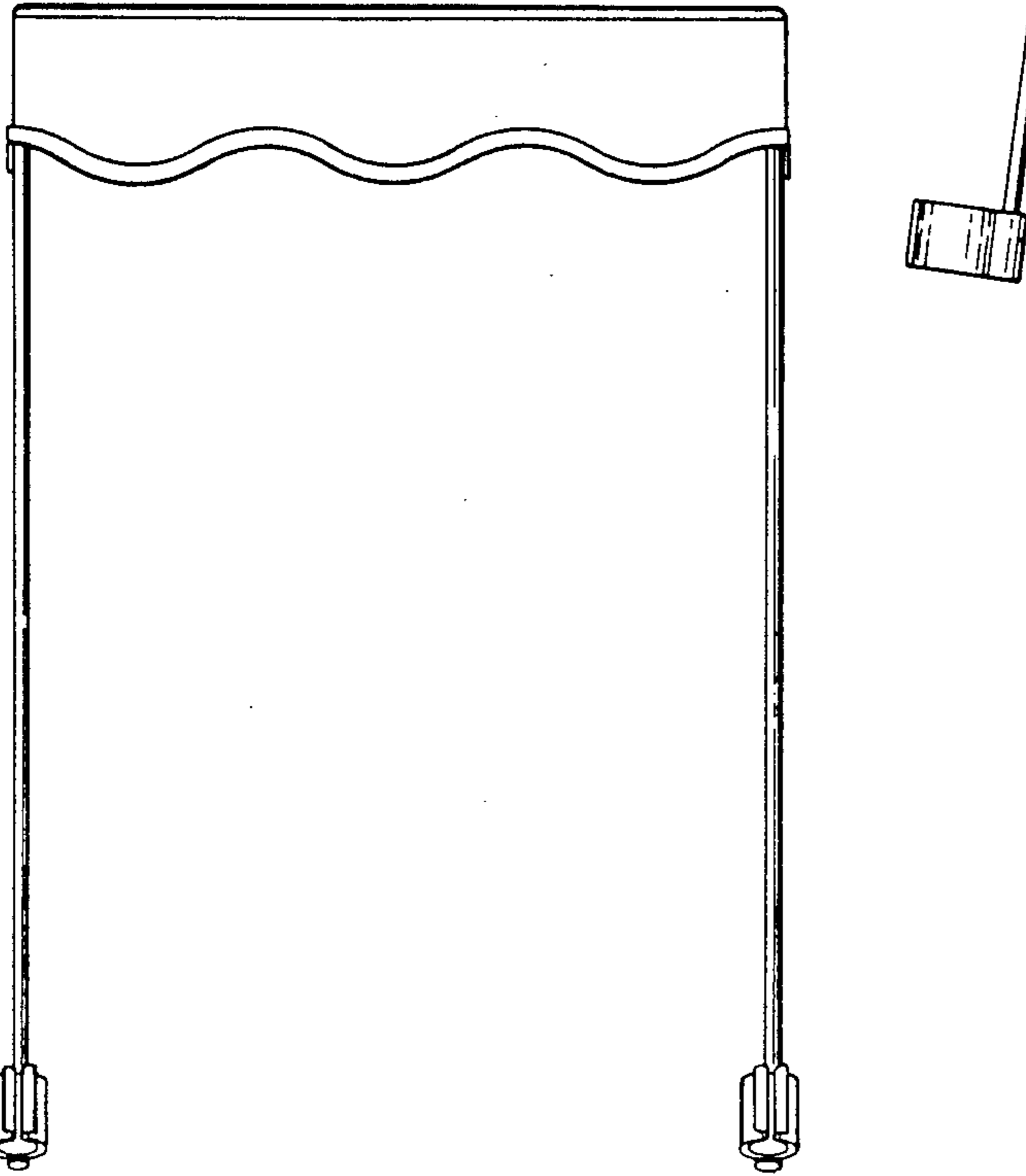
