The ornamental design for an electronic keyboard musical instrument, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of an electronic keyboard musical instrument showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof.

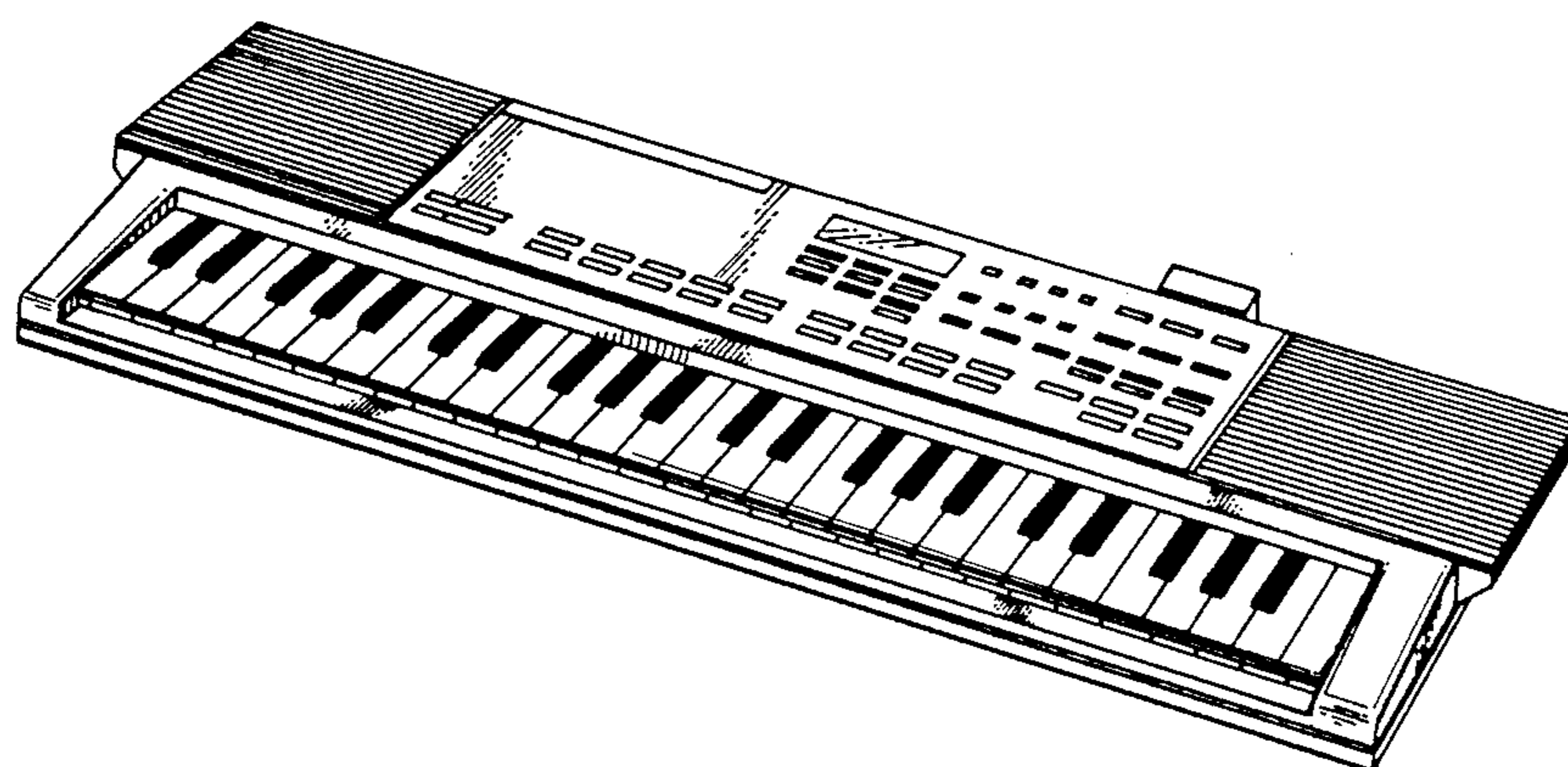

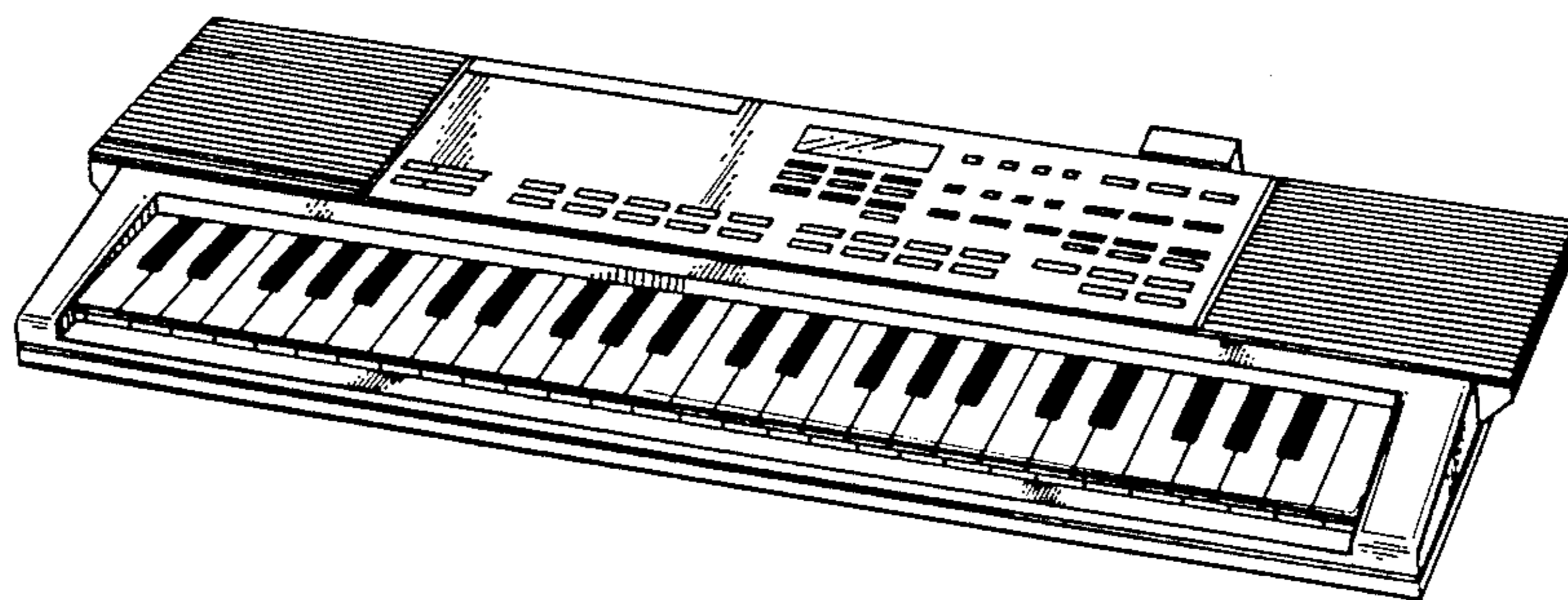

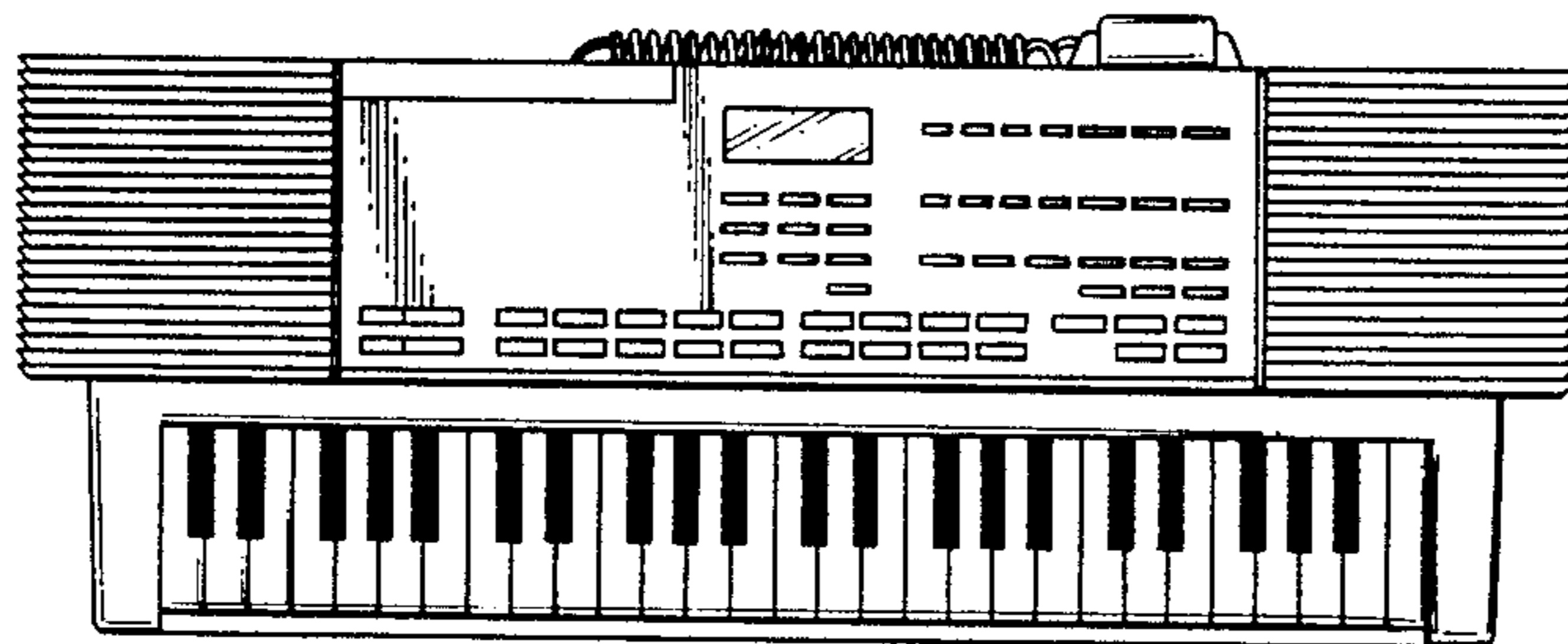

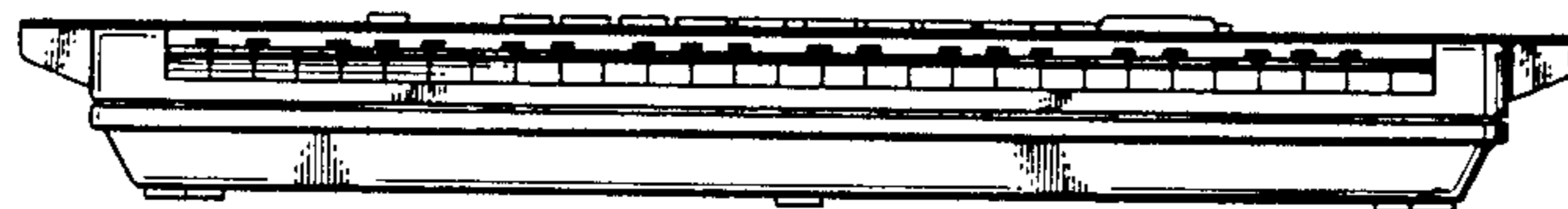

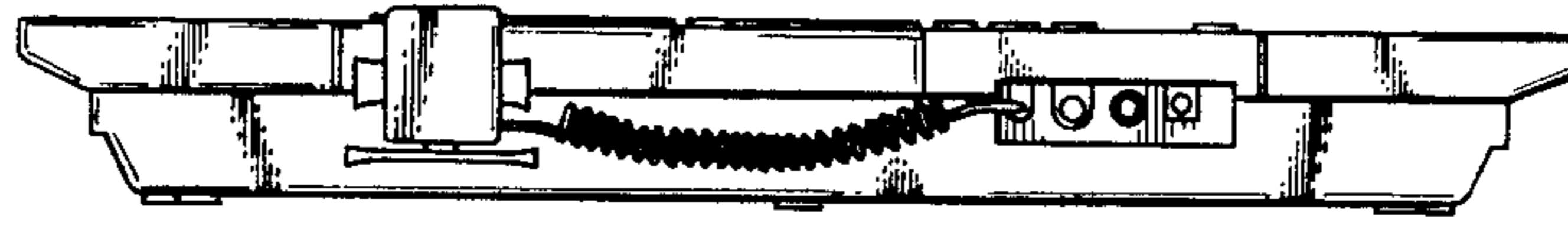

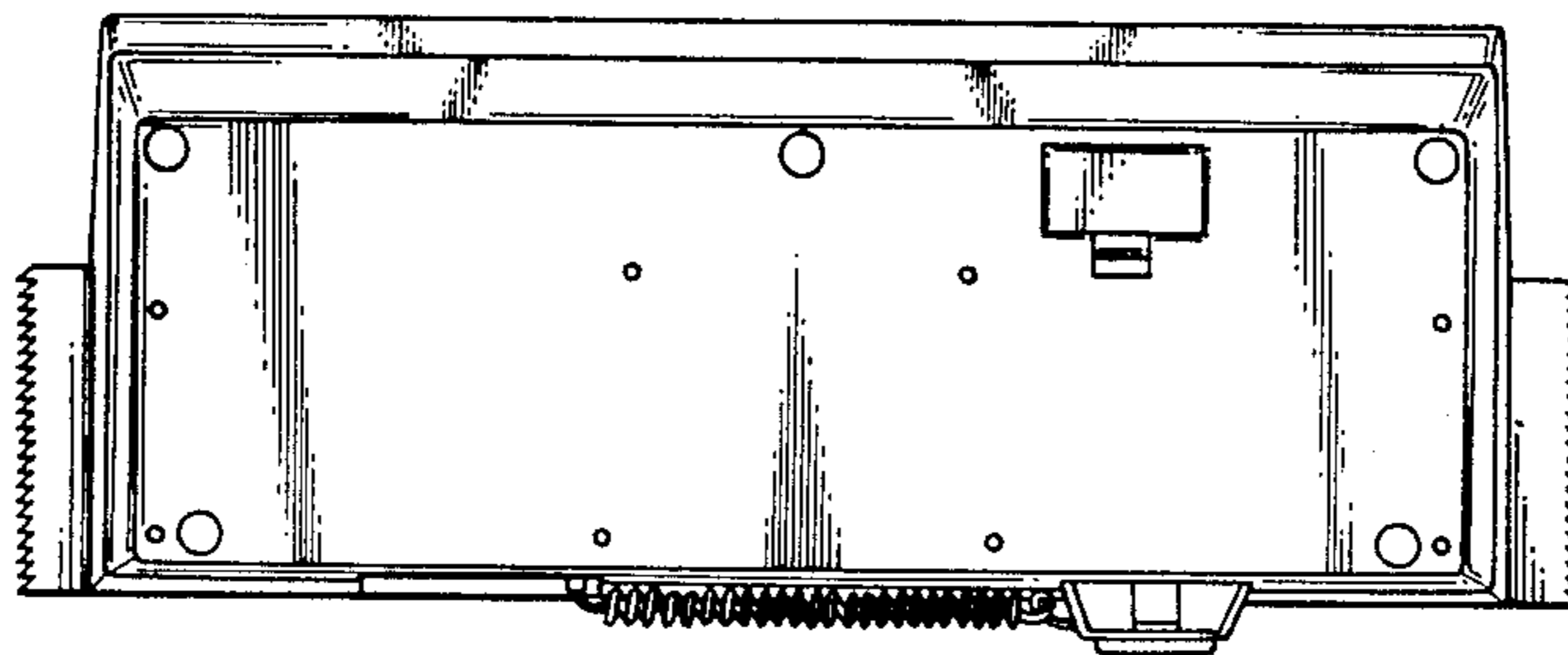

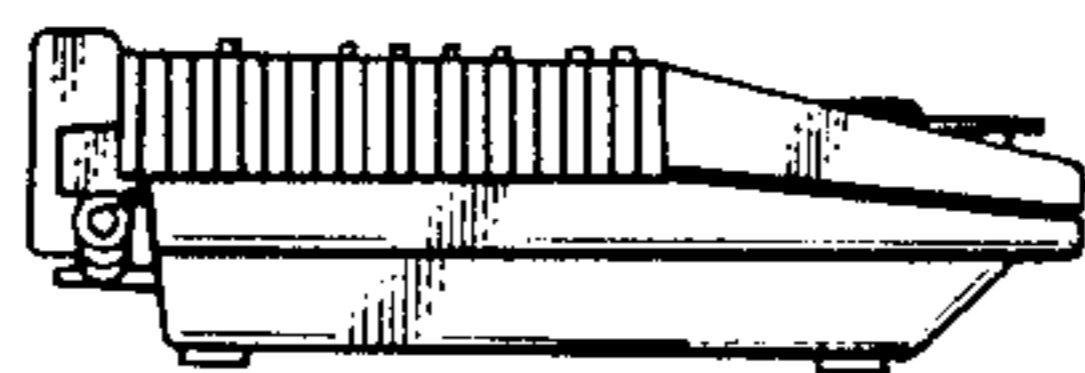
