The ornamental design for an electronic keyboard musical instrument, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of an electronic keyboard musical instrument showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a top, front perspective view thereof.

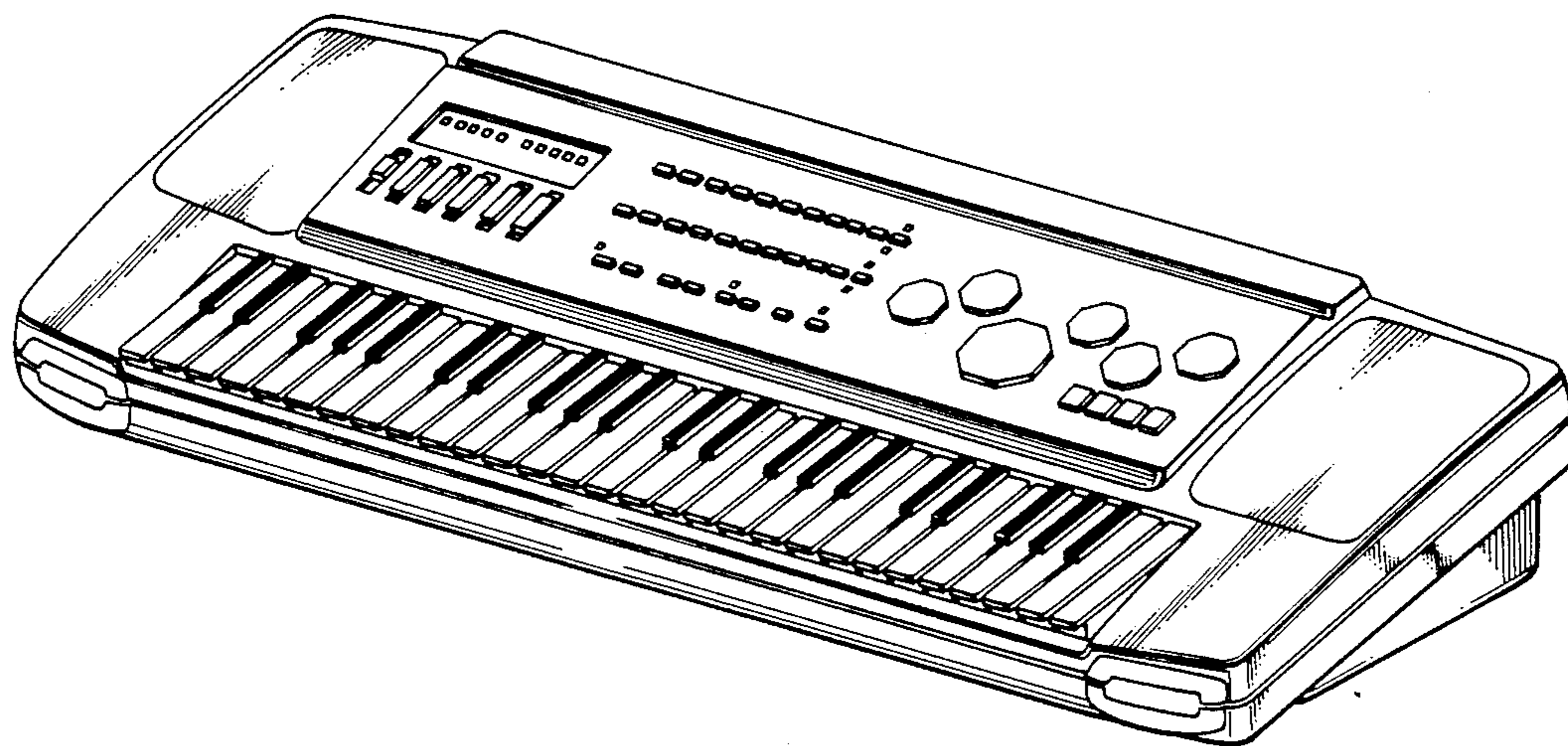

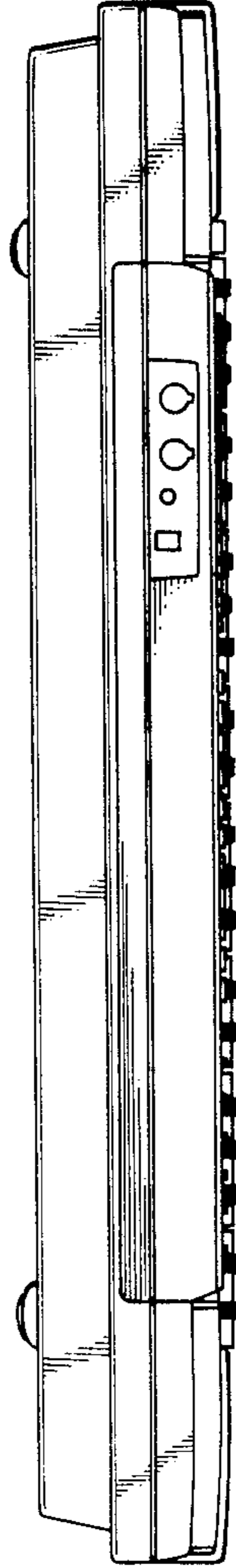

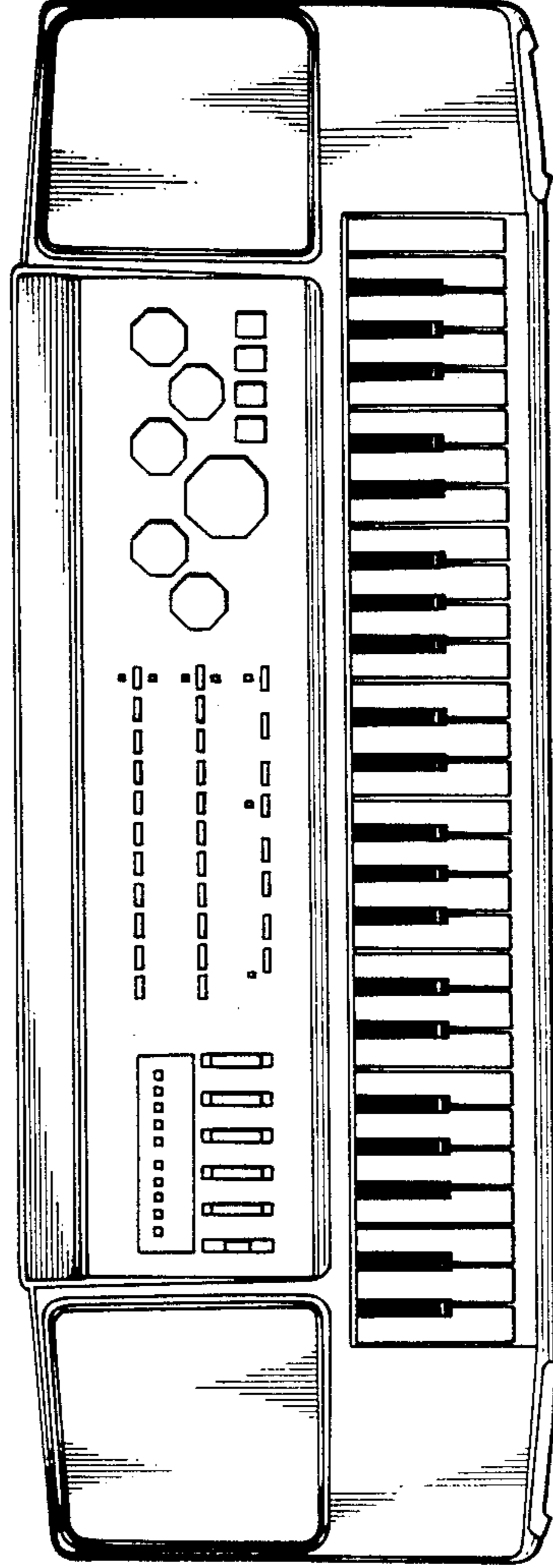

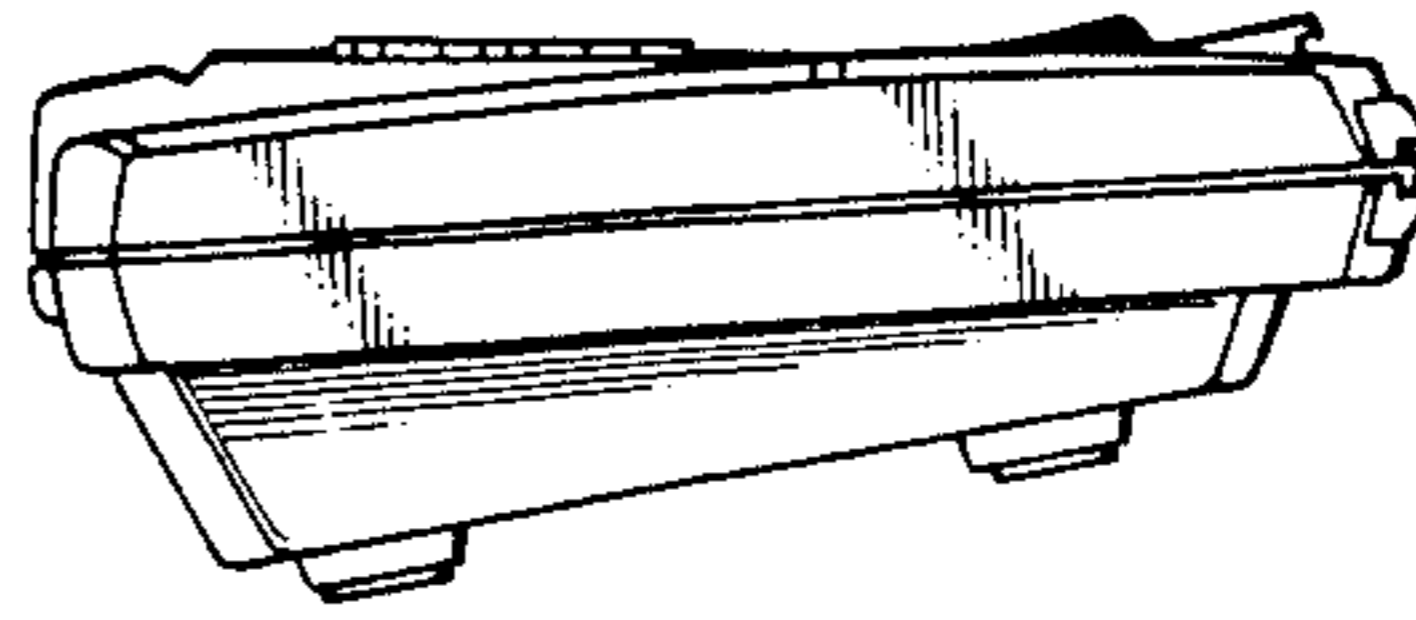

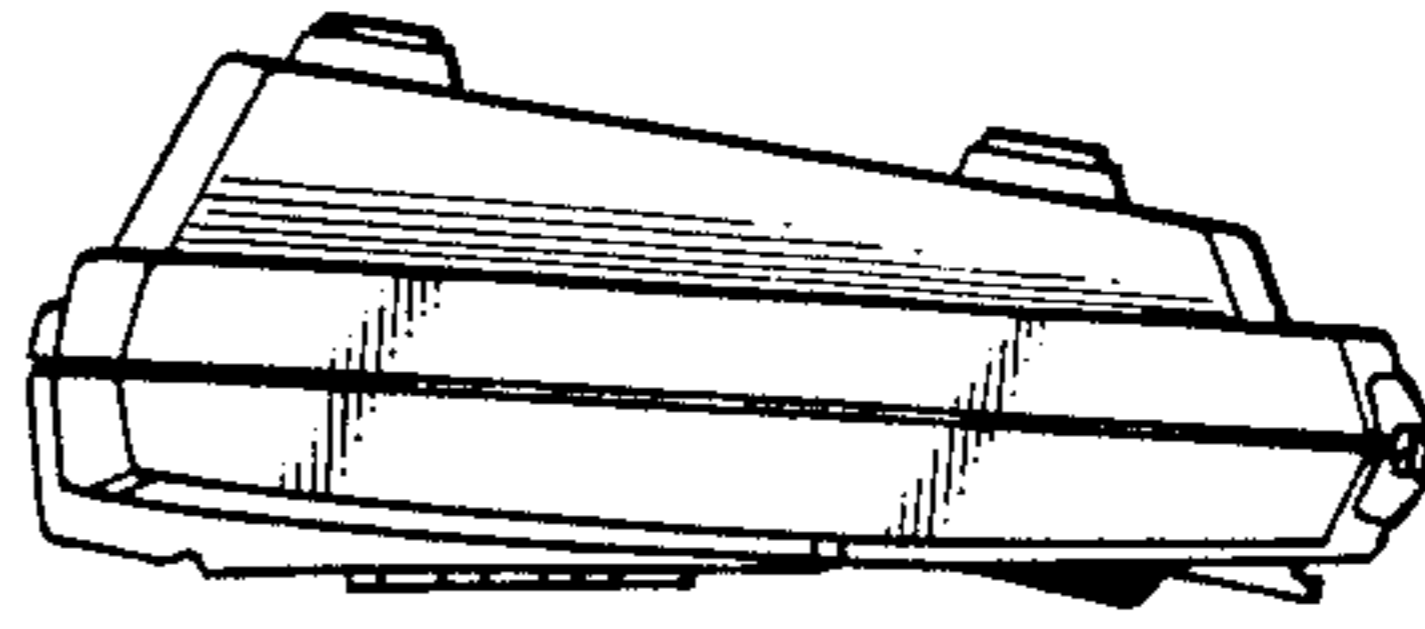

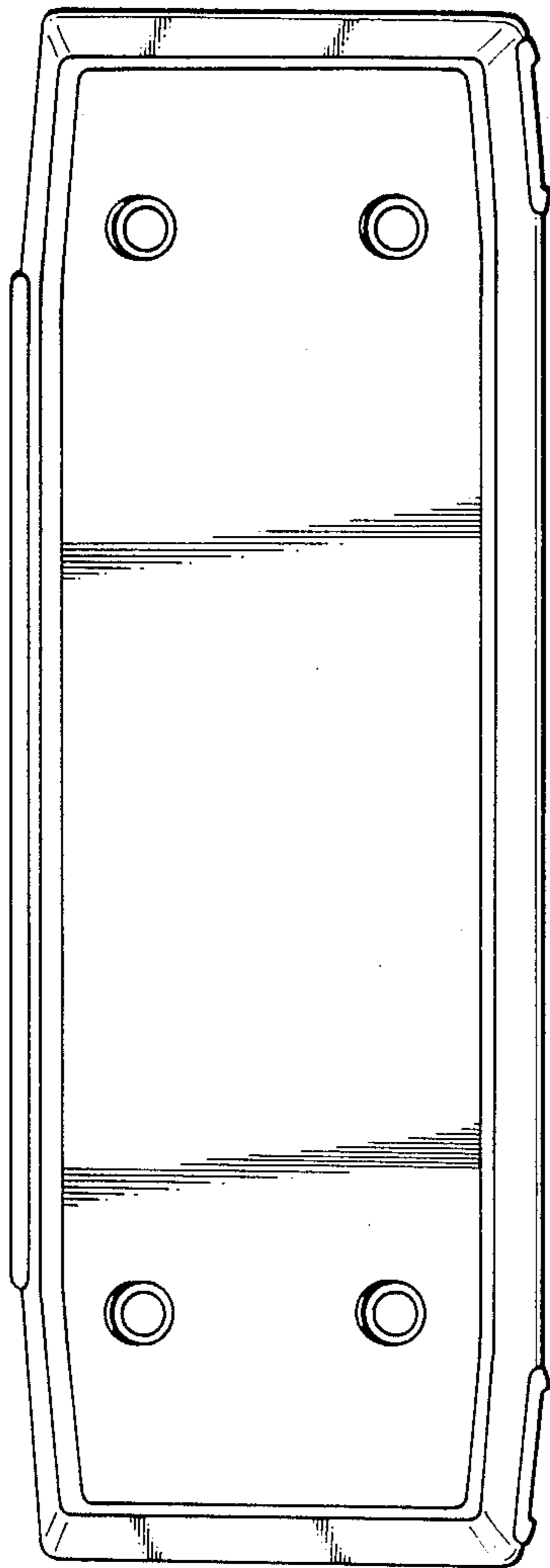

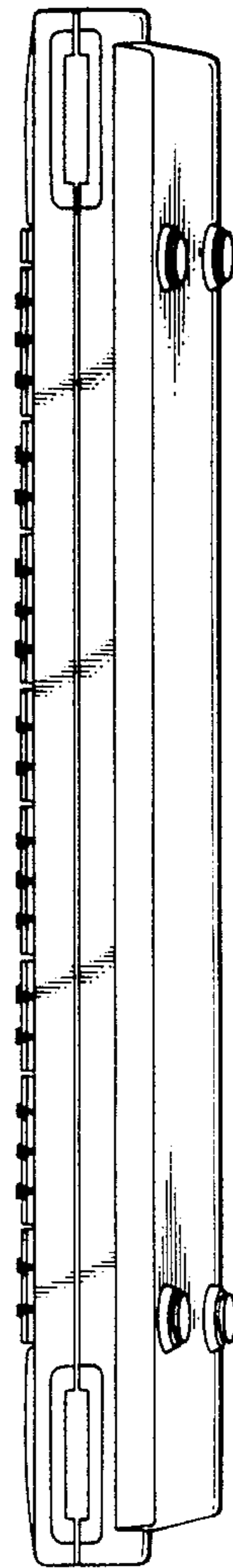
