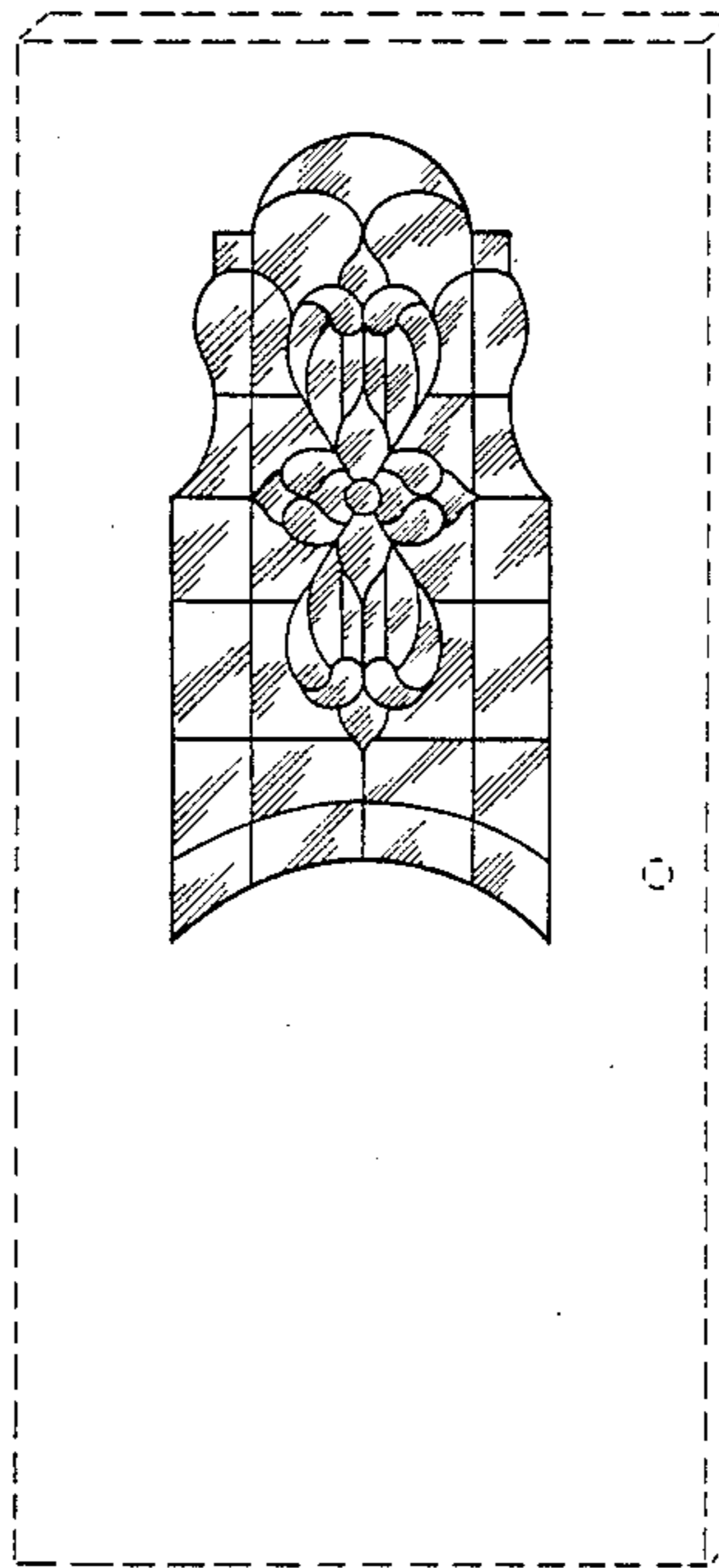
The ornamental design for a door light panel, as shown  
and described.

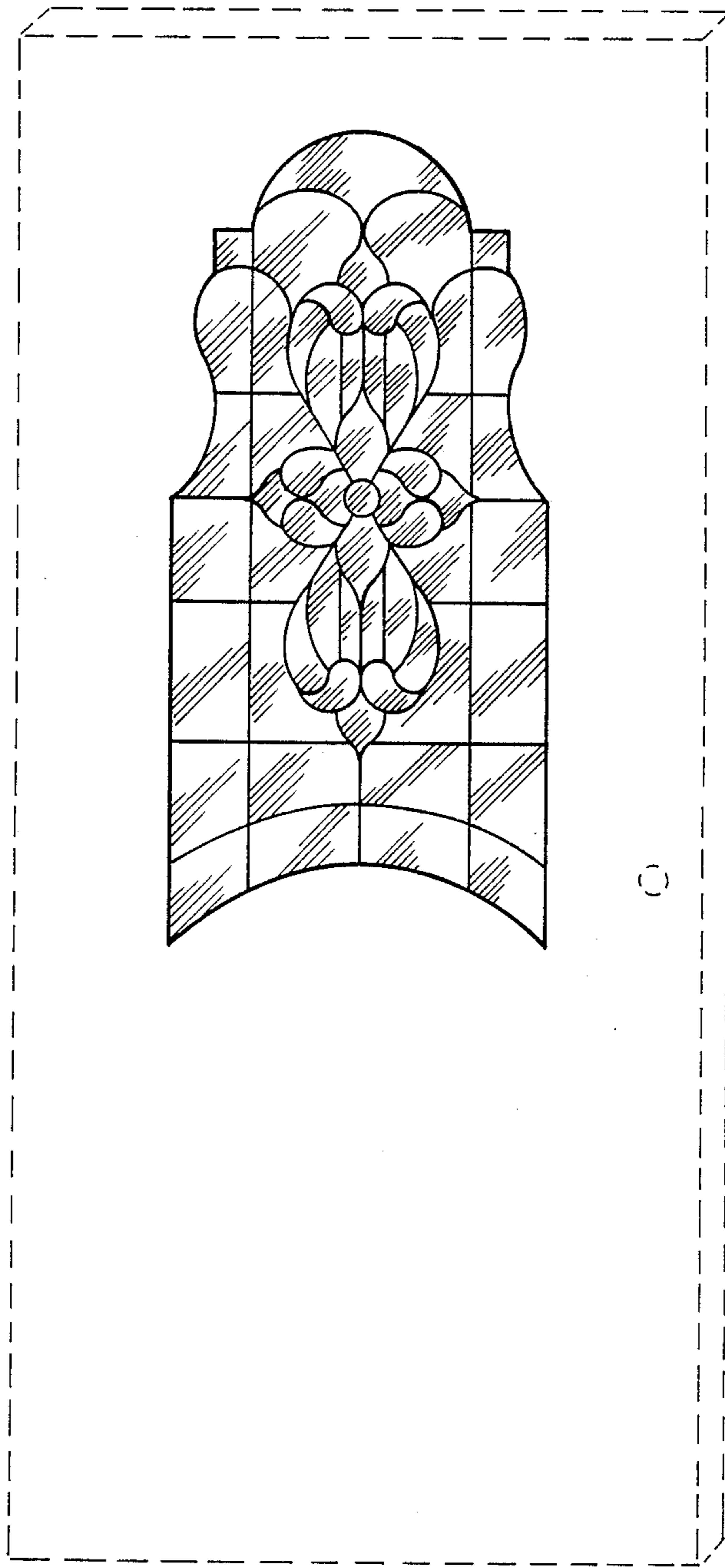
**DESCRIPTION**
