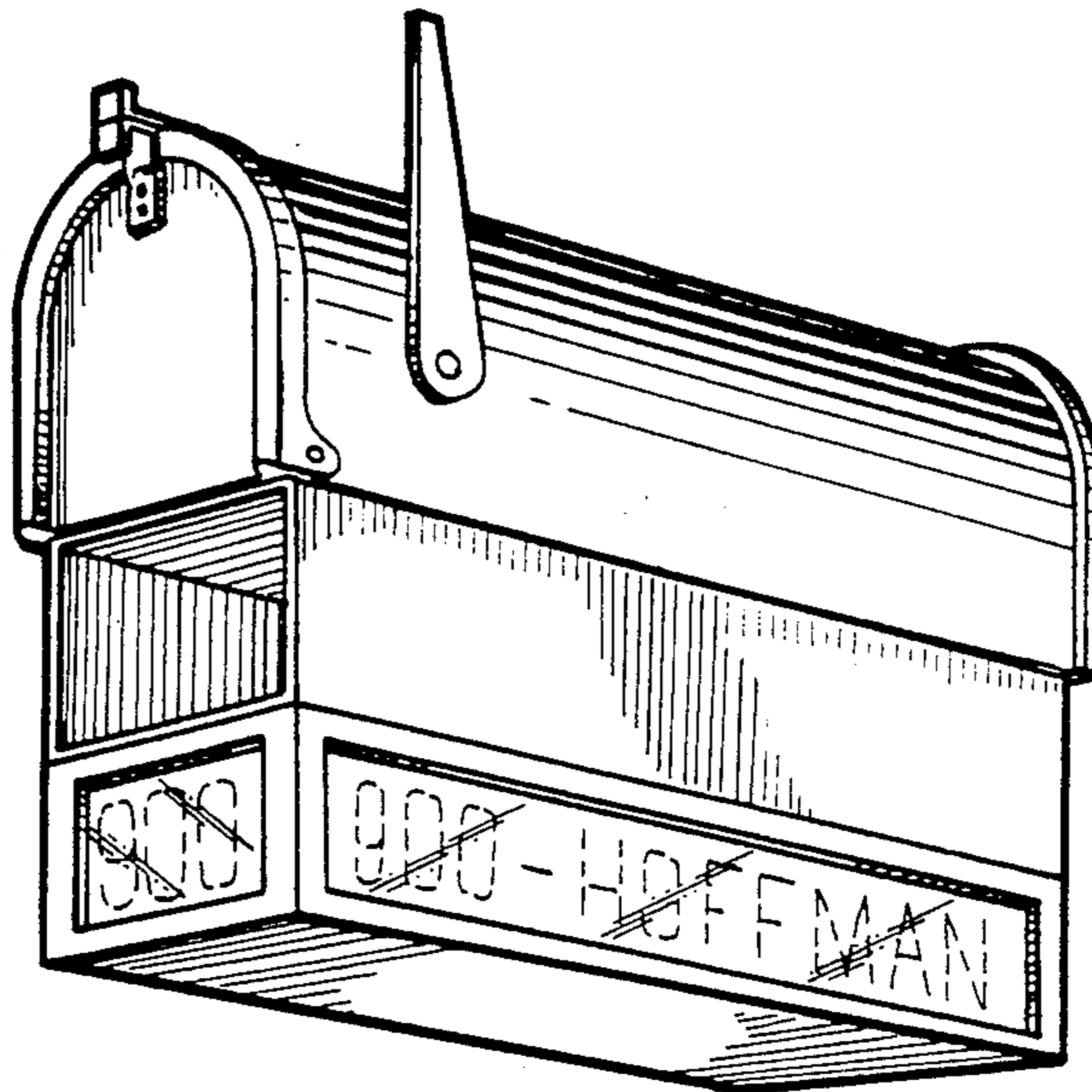
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an illuminated mail box with newspaper holder or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom, front and right side perspective view of an illuminated mailbox with newspaper holder or similar article showing our new design; and FIG. 2 is a top, rear, and left side perspective view thereof.

The broken line showing of the wording and numerals is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



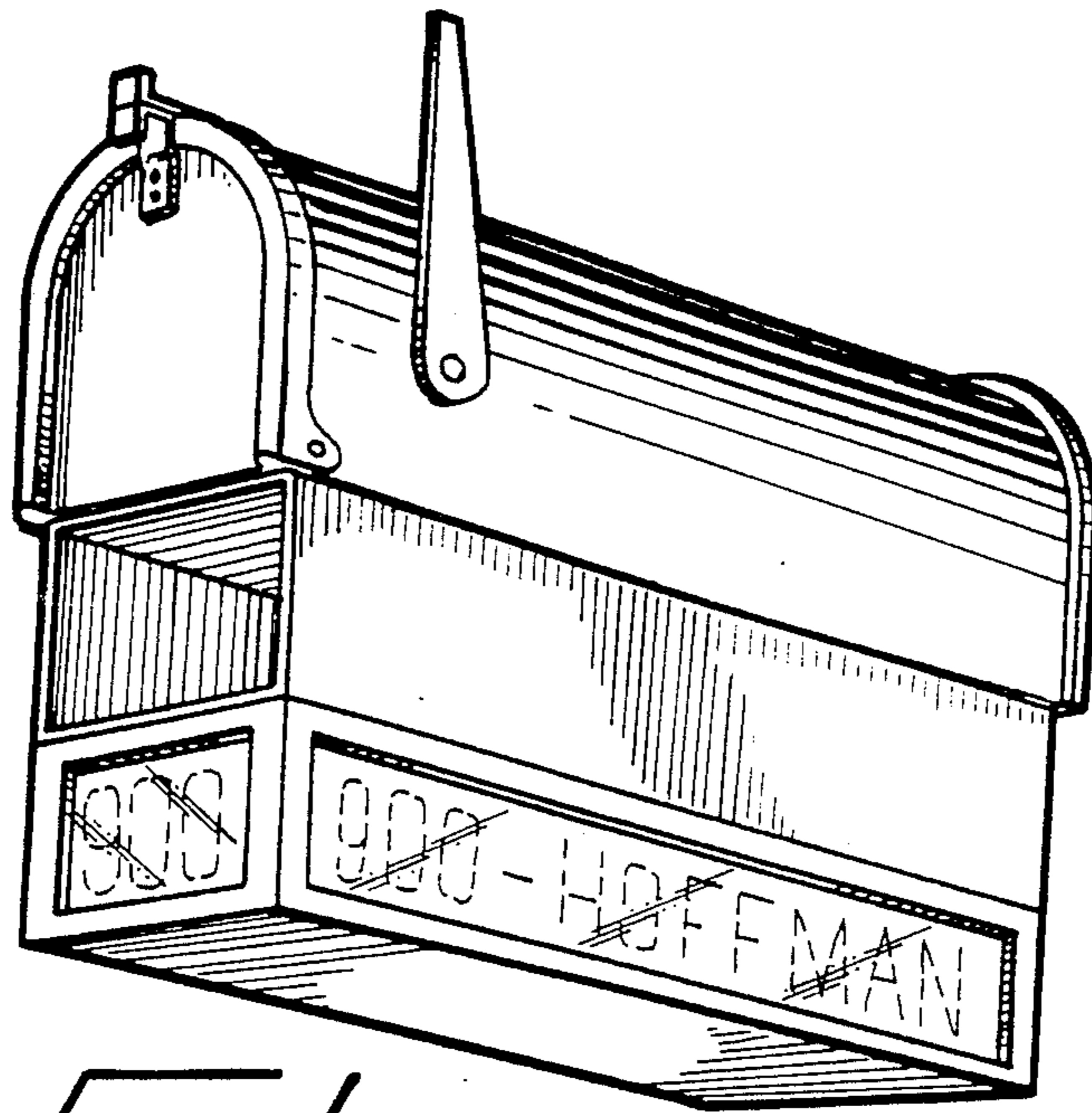

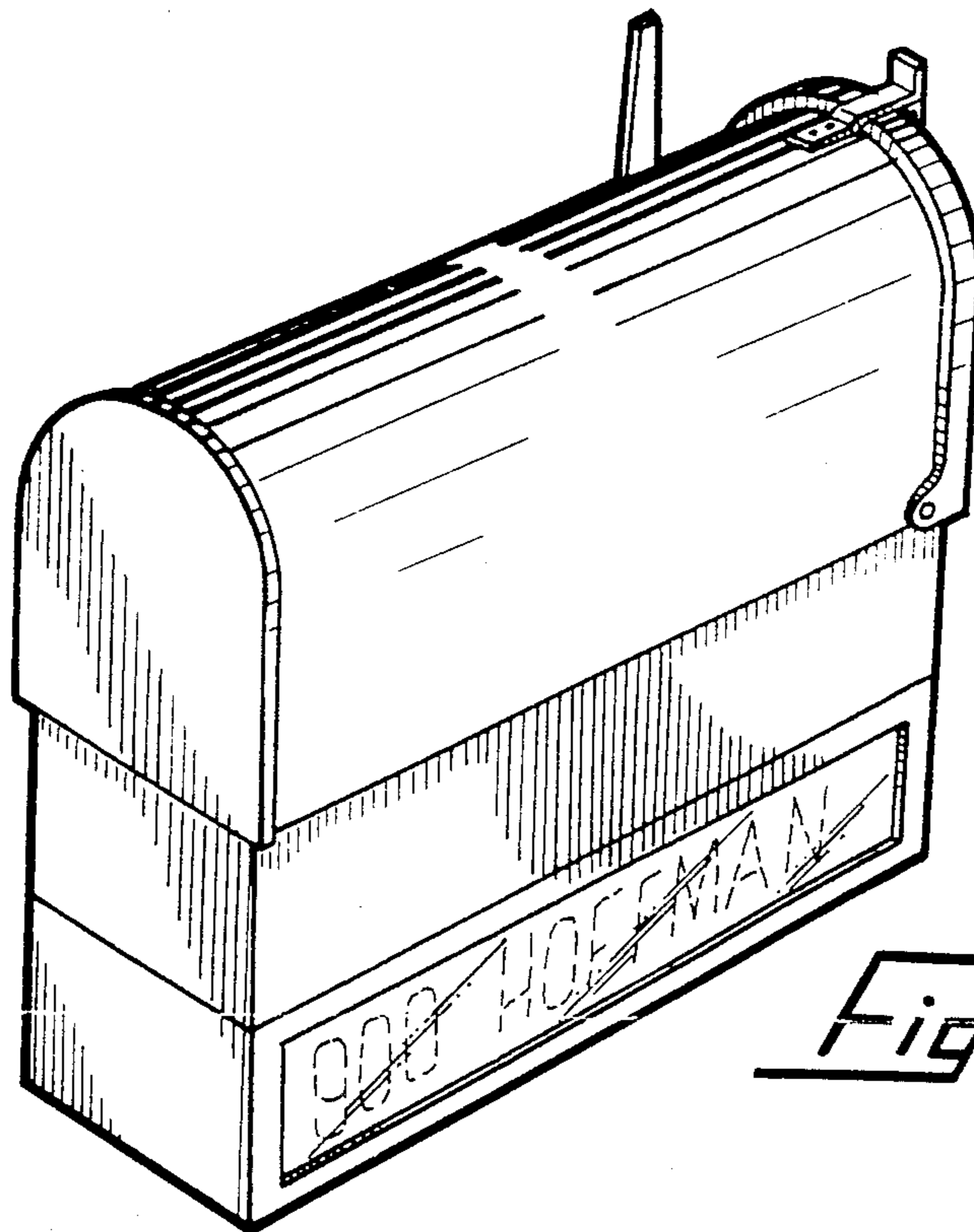
