DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a child's carrying case showing my new design;

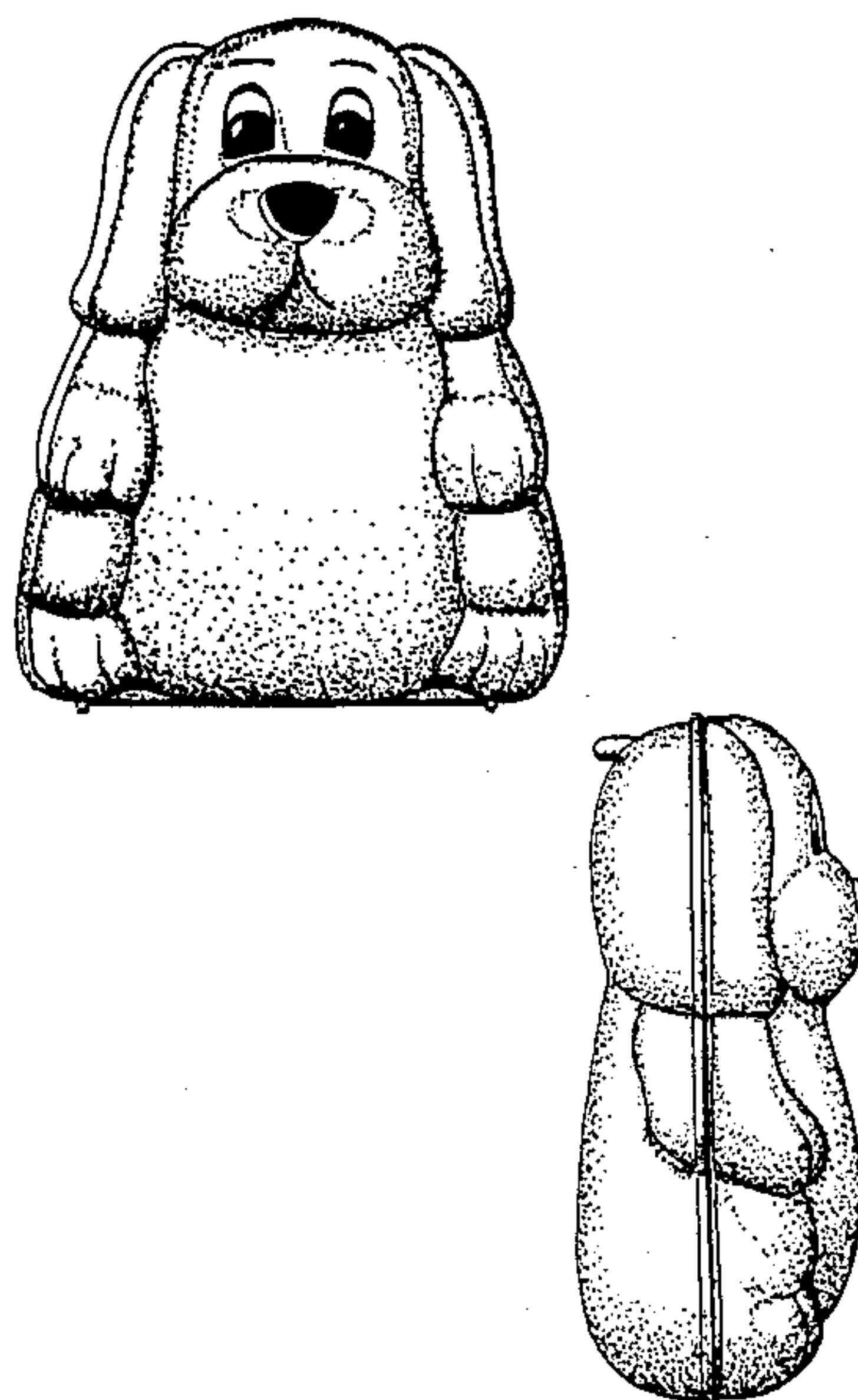
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view with the handle extended;

FIG. 6 is an external elevational view of the case in its fully open position;



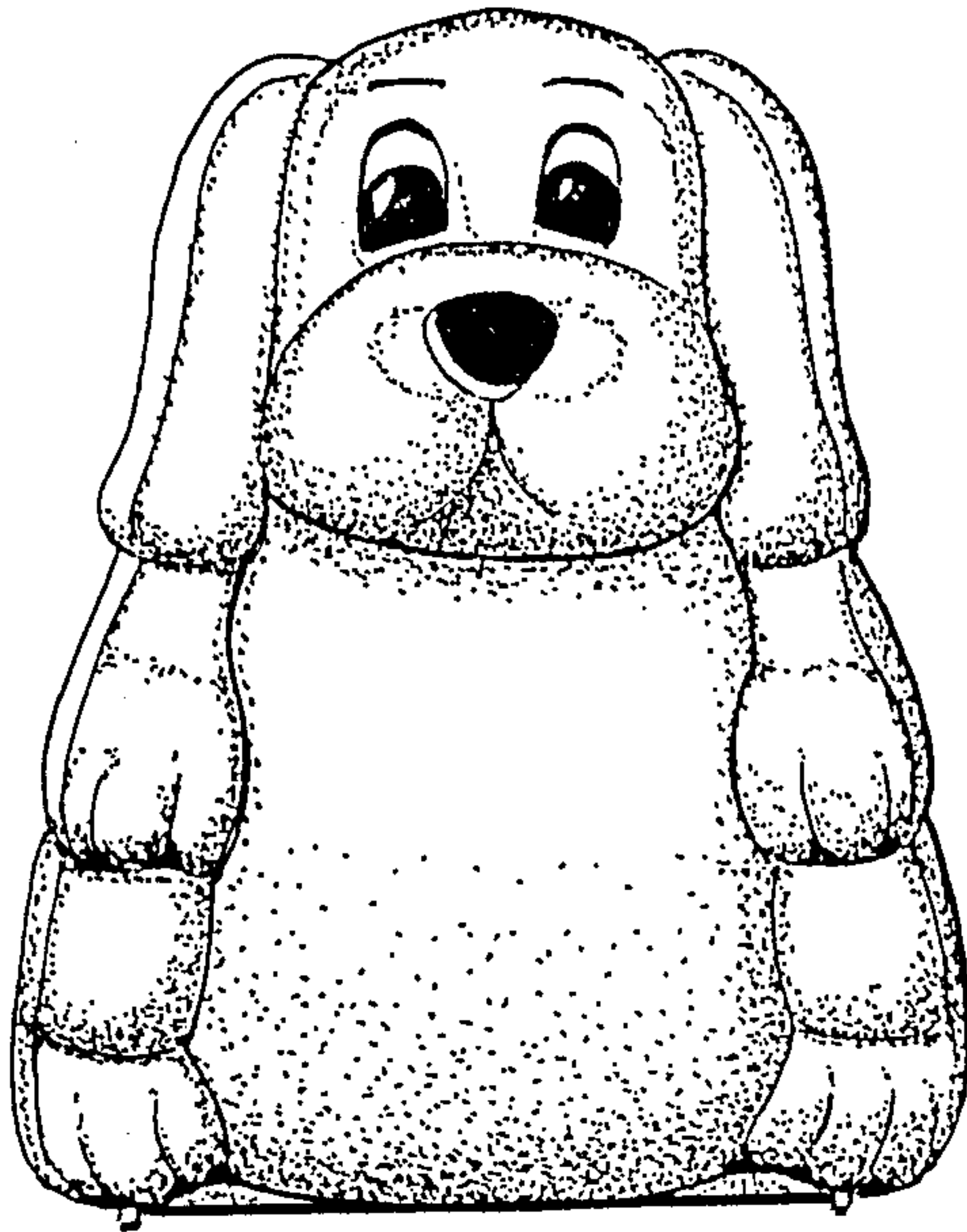

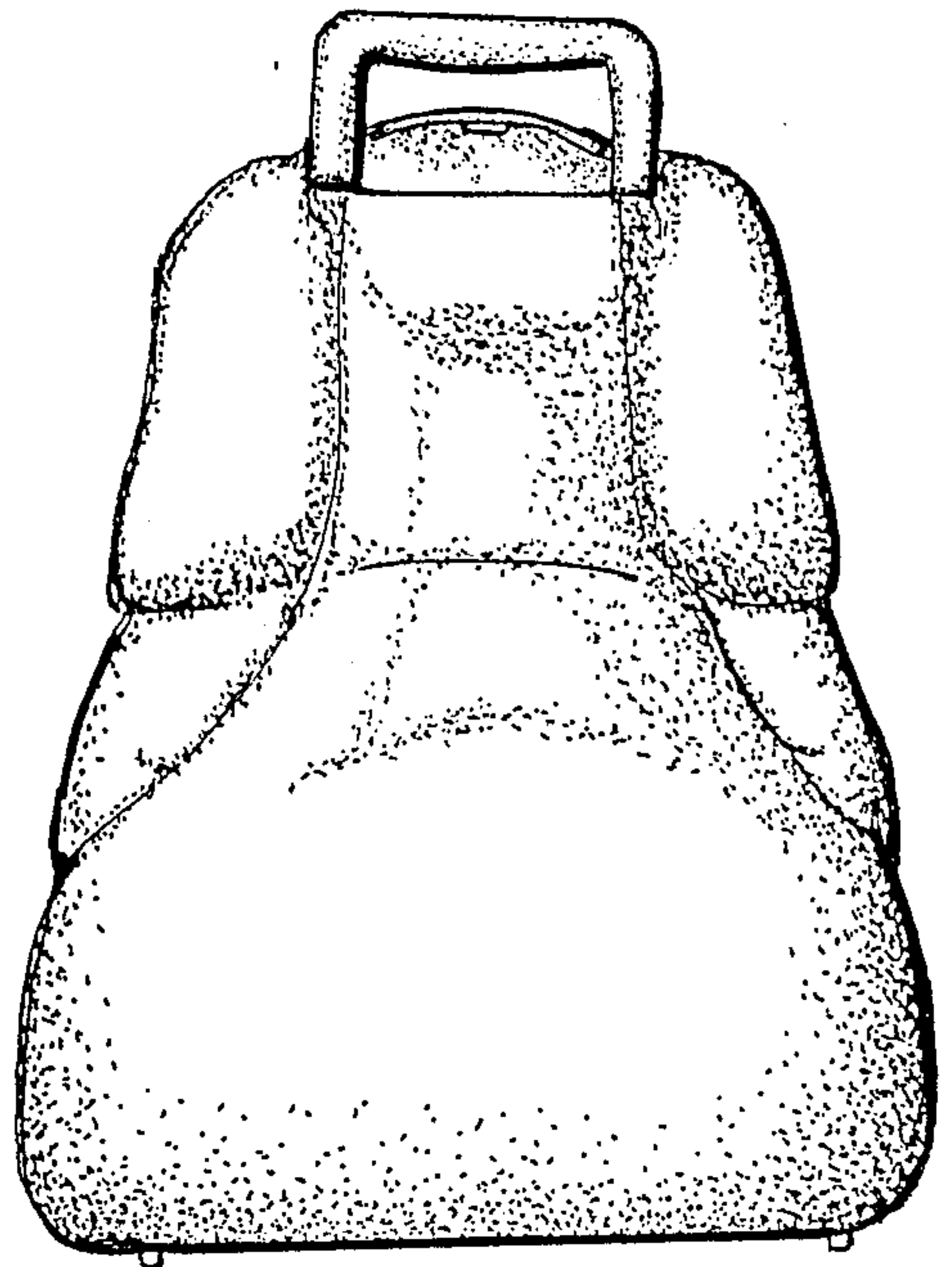

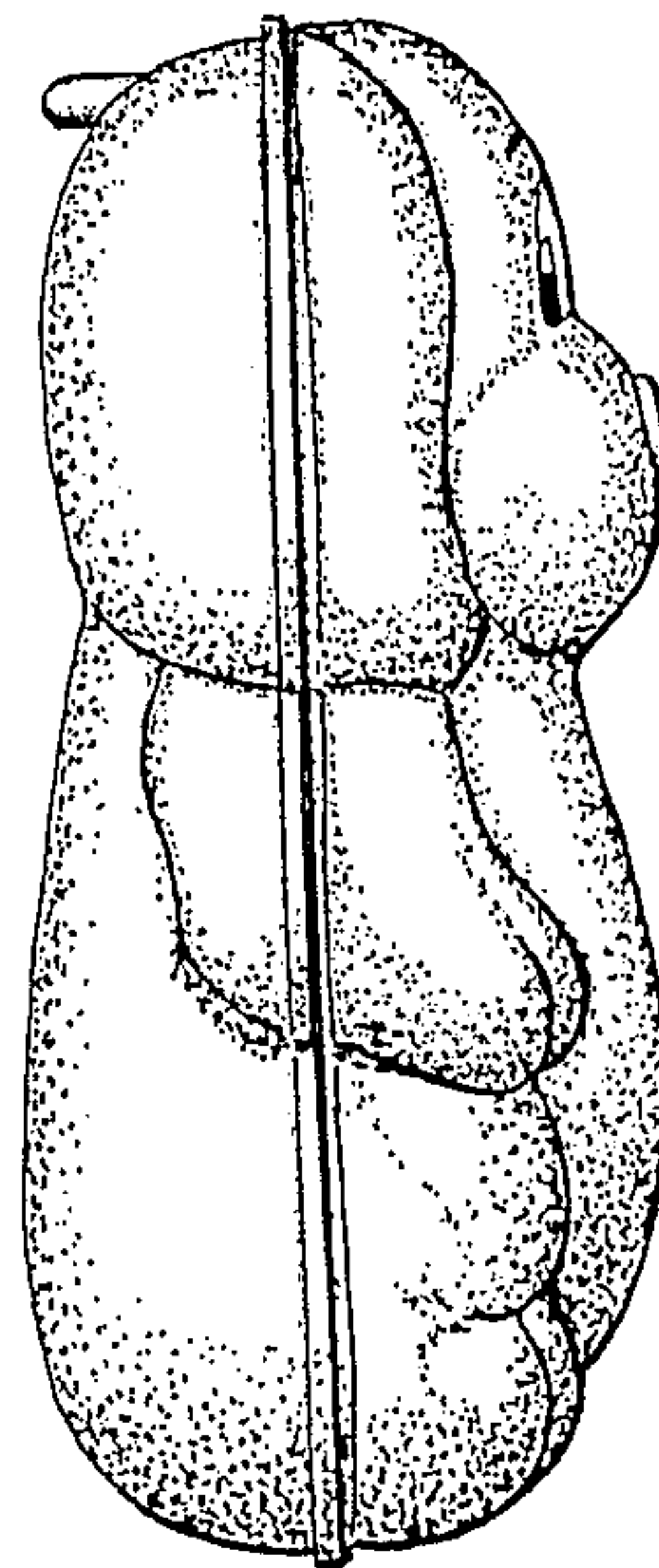

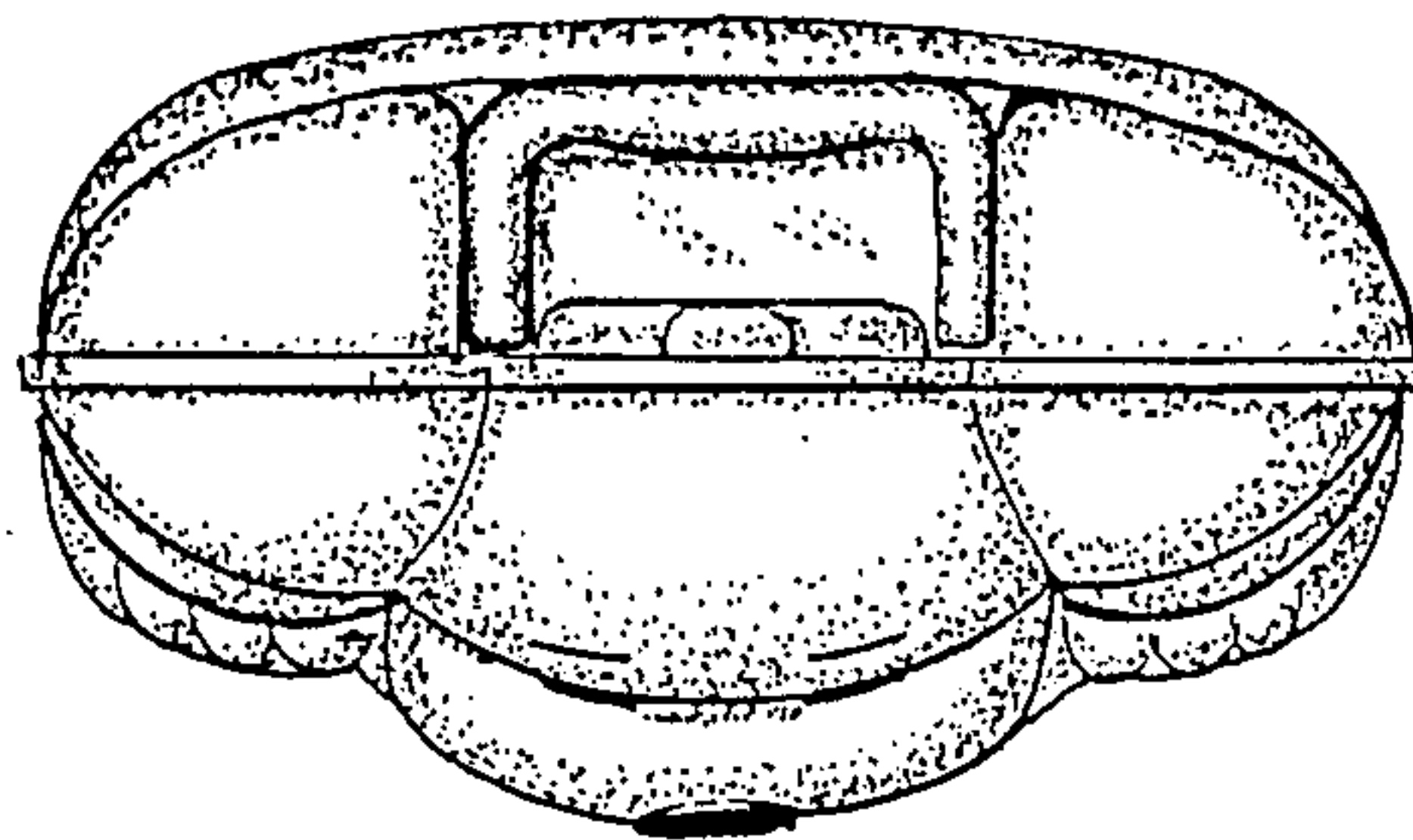

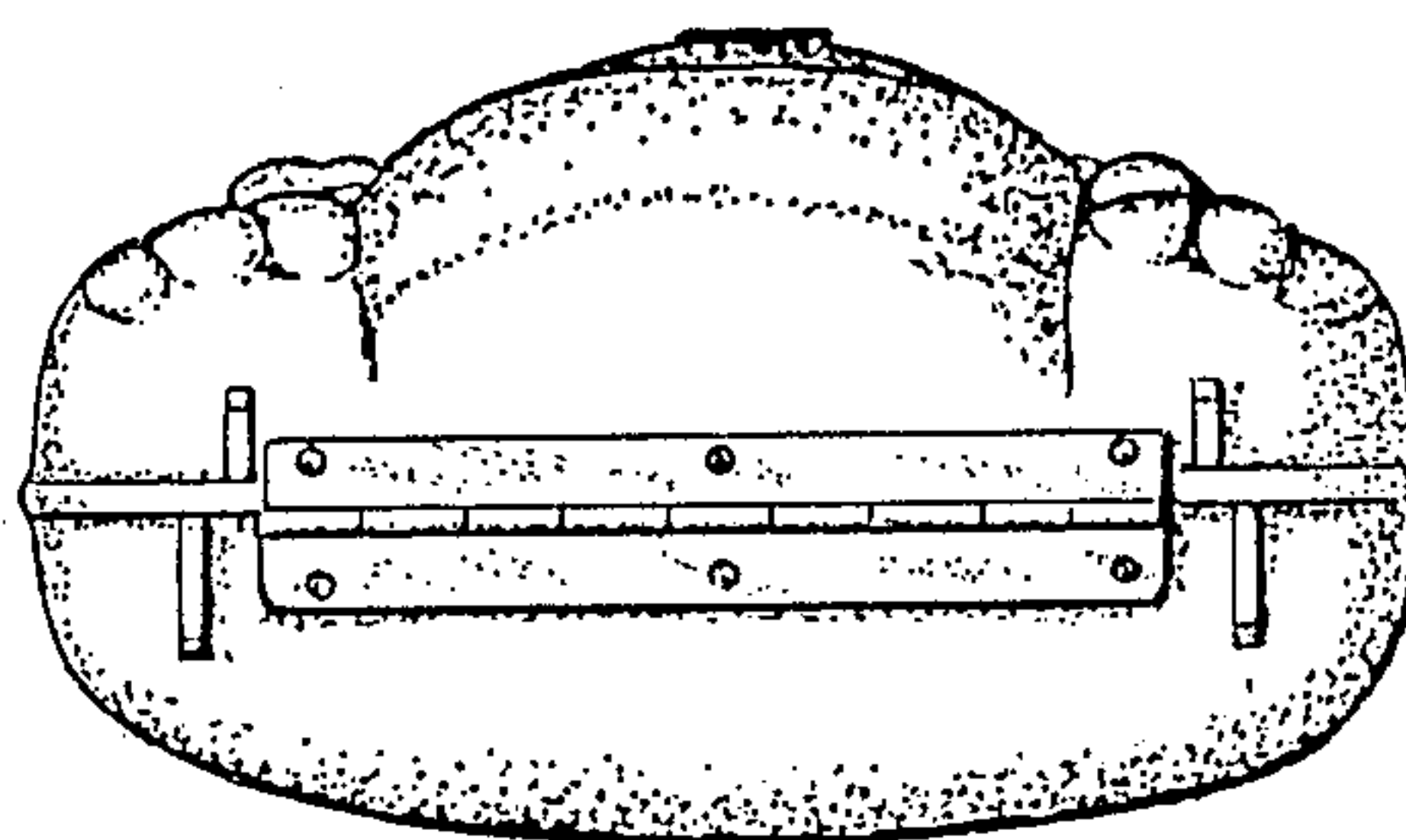

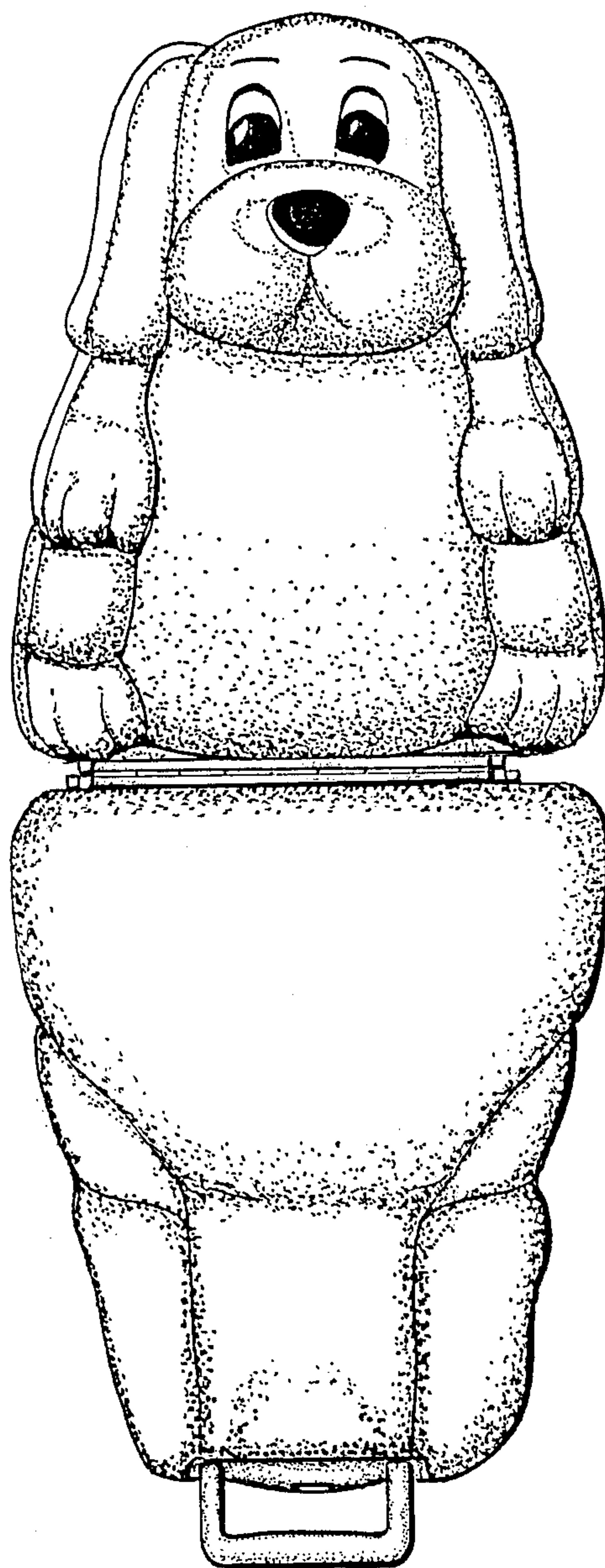
