The ornamental design for a belt-mounted hammer holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a belt-mounted hammer holder showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken line showing of a belt is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

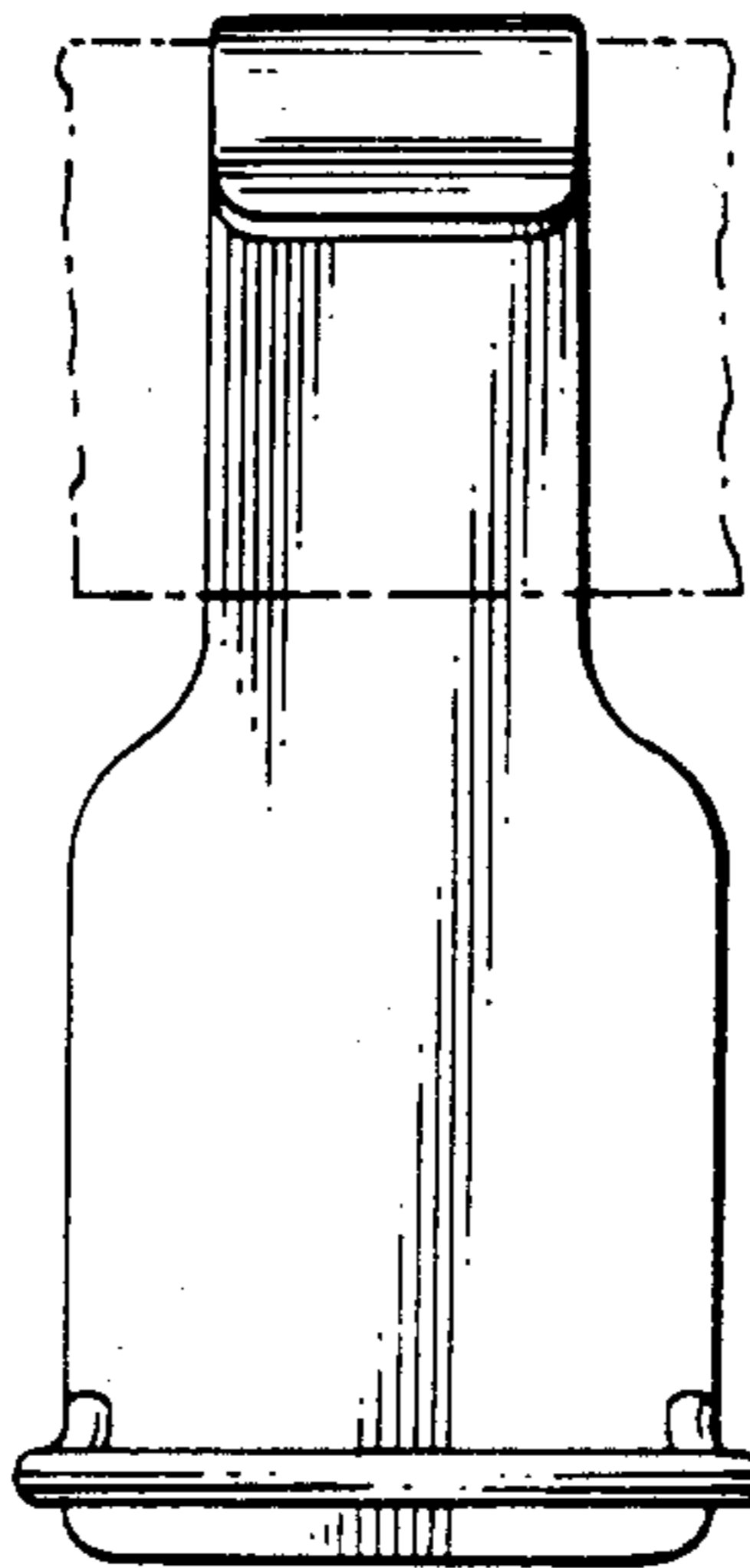

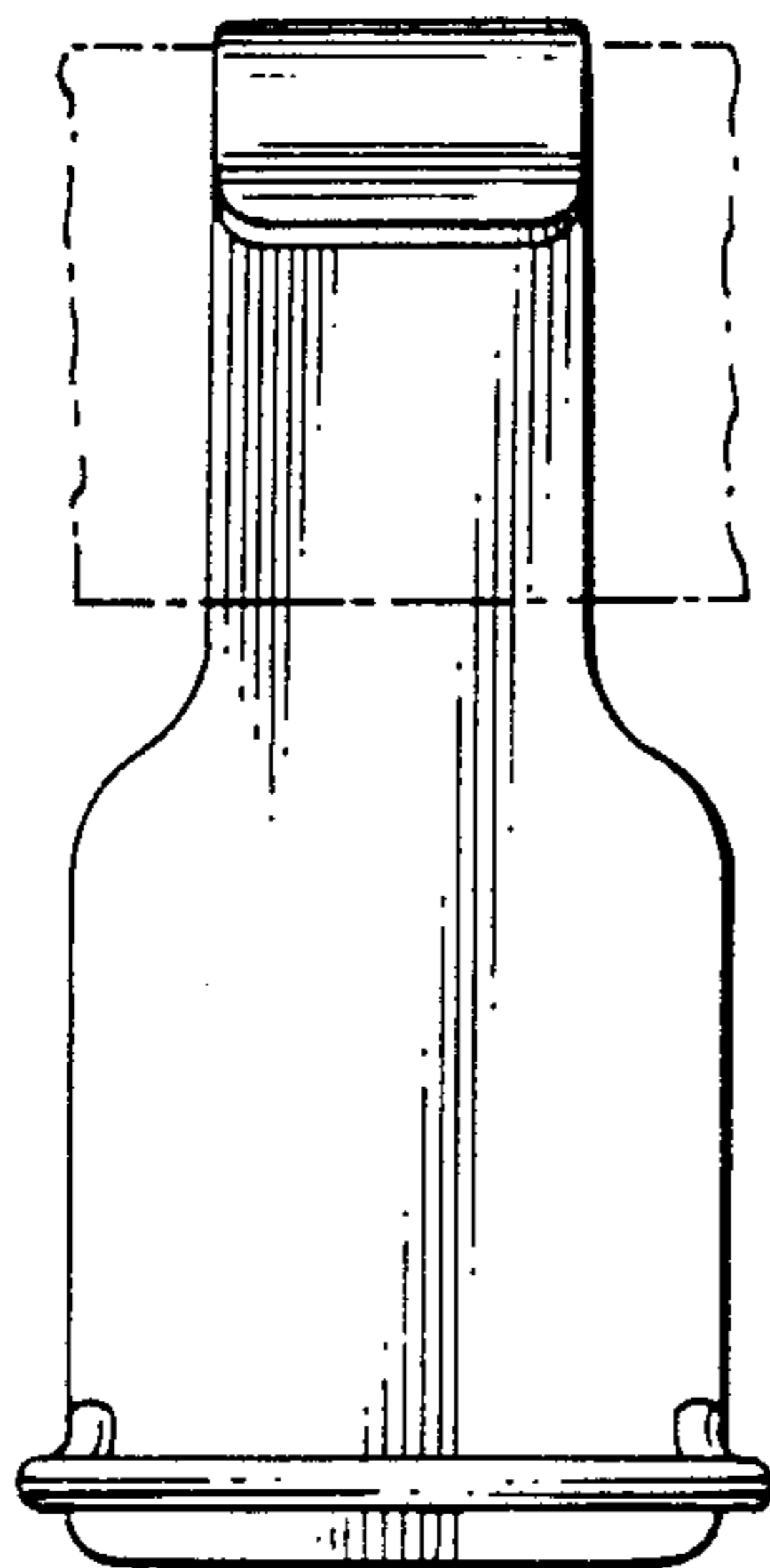

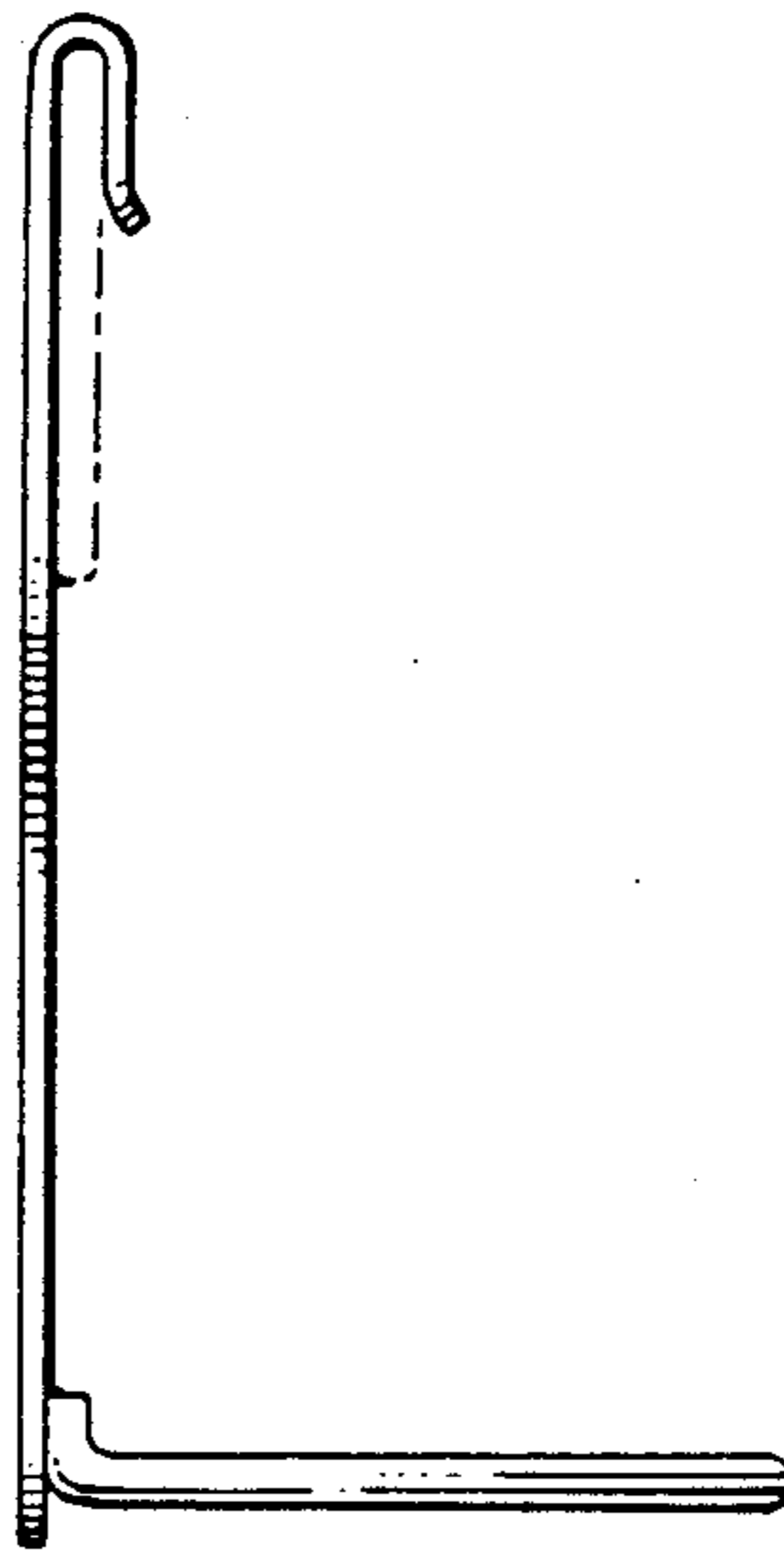

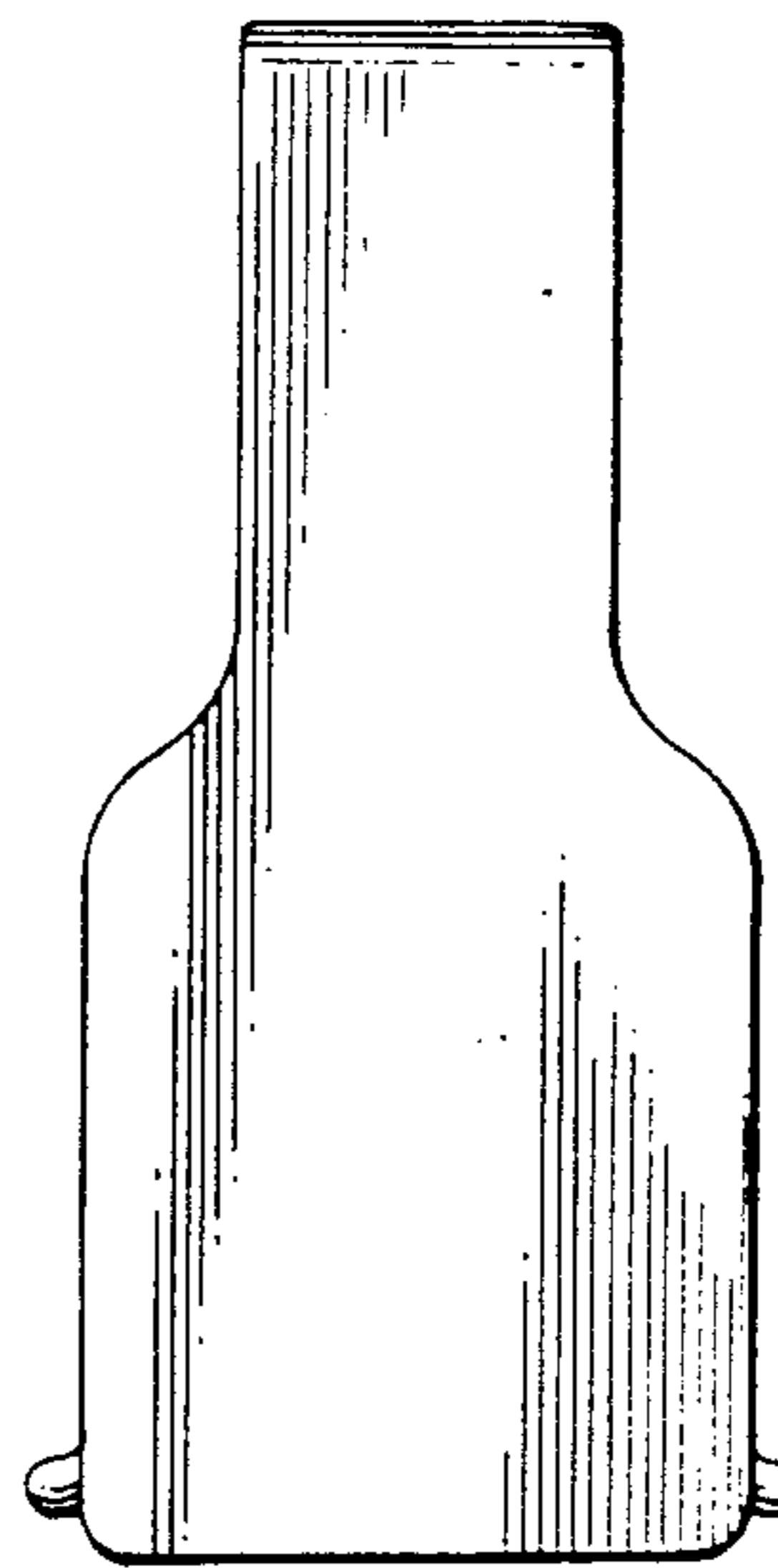

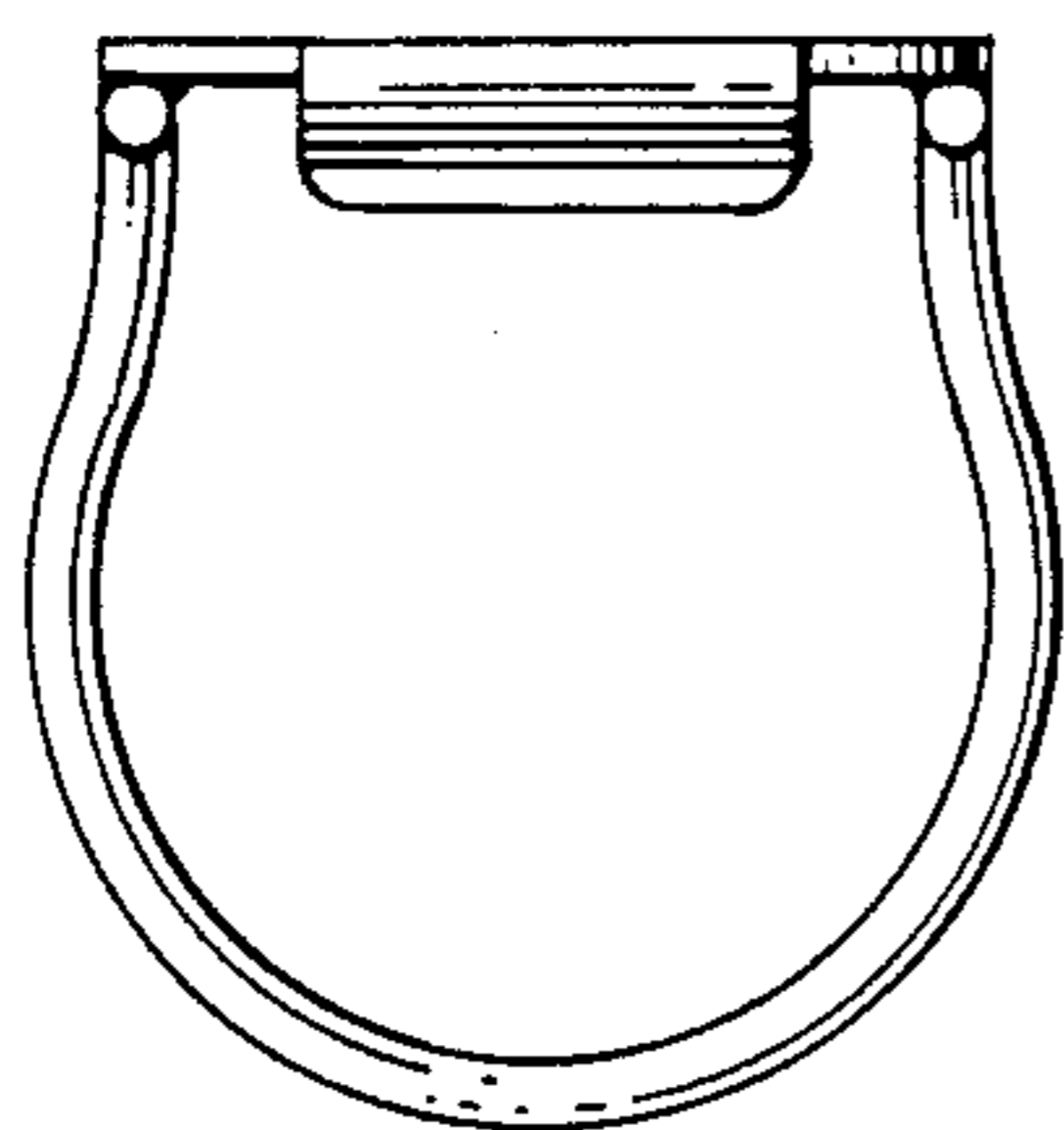
