FIG. 3 is an end elevational view;

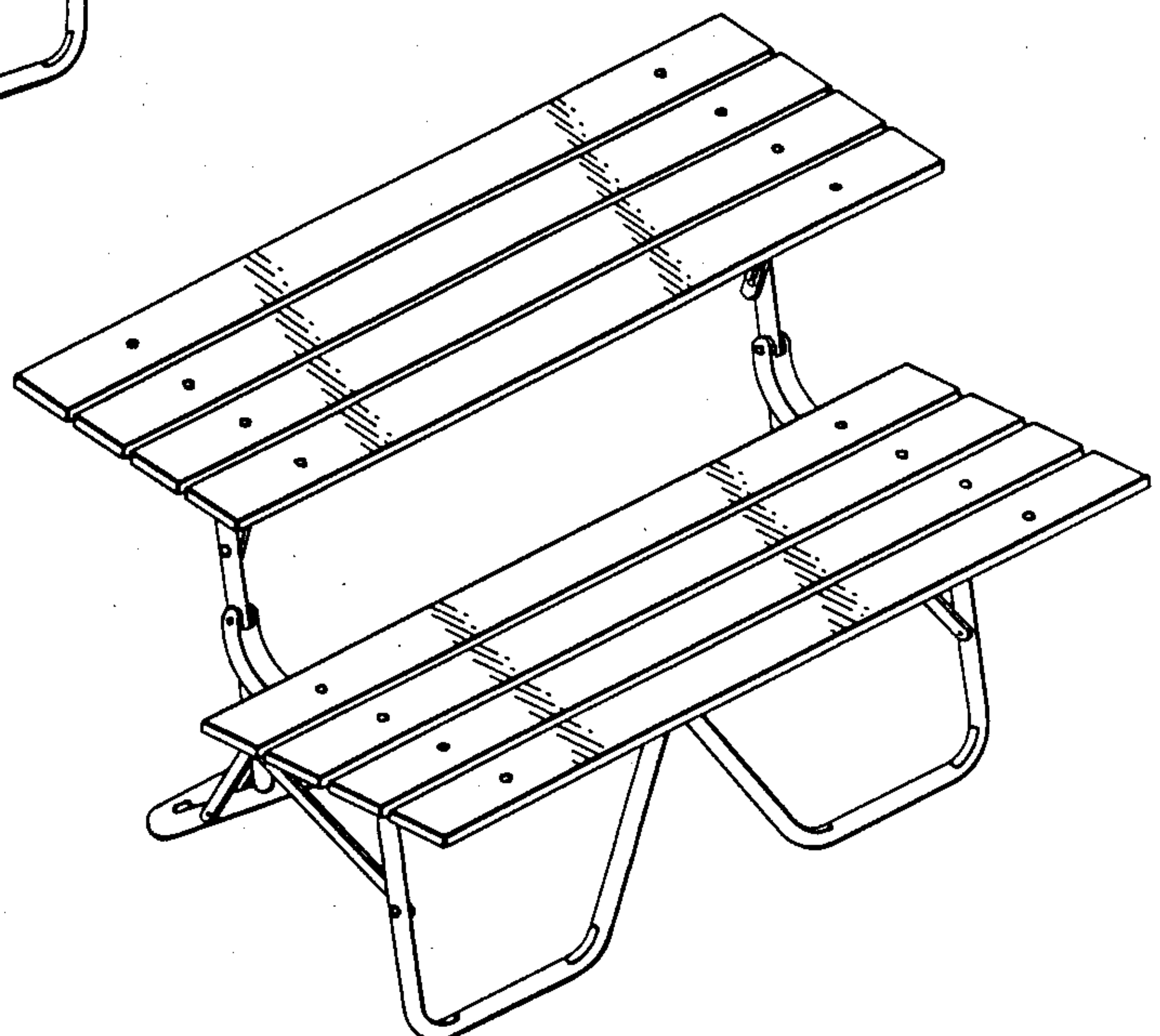
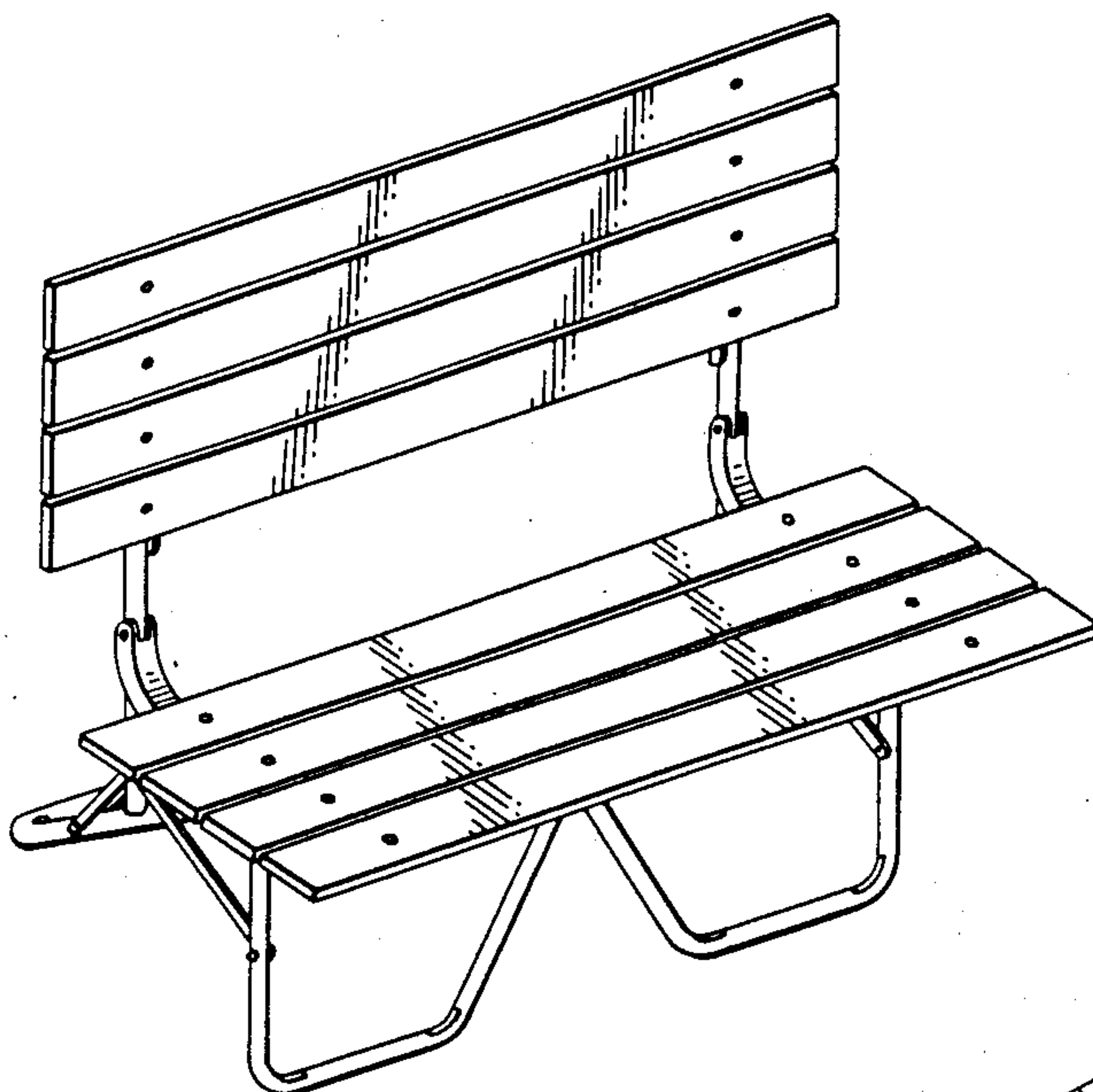
FIG. 4 is a top plan view;

FIG. 9 is a rear perspective view thereof.



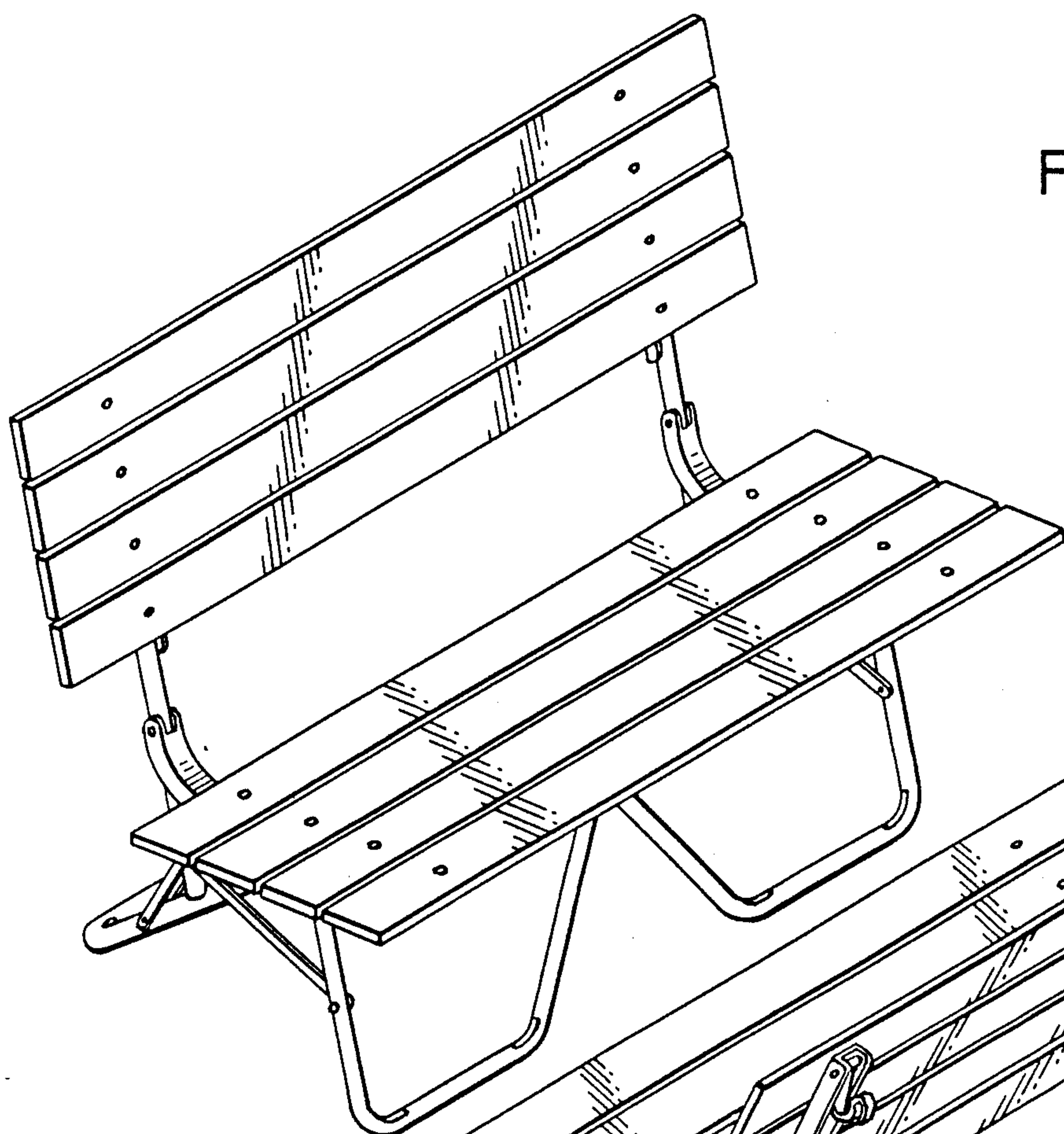

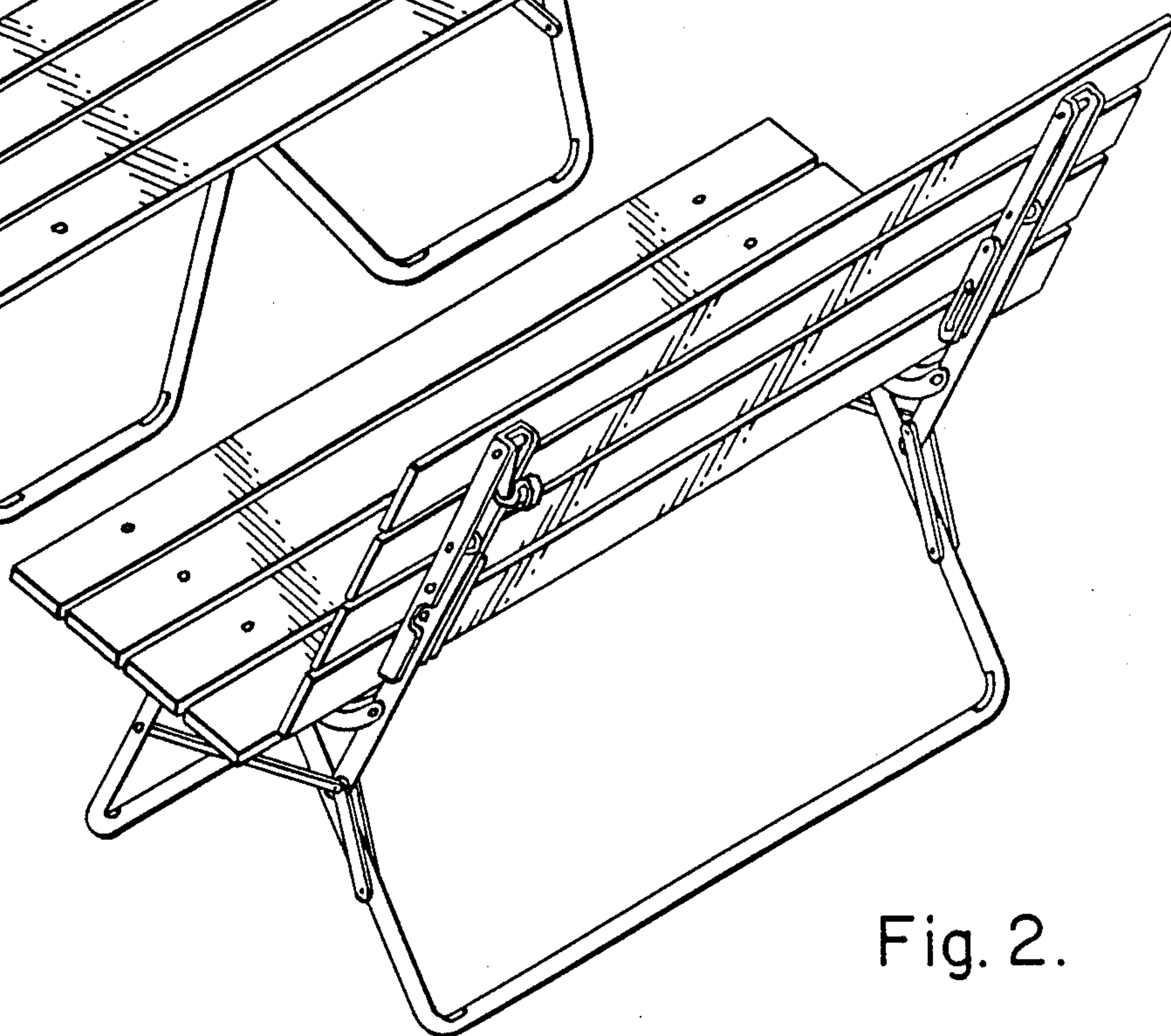

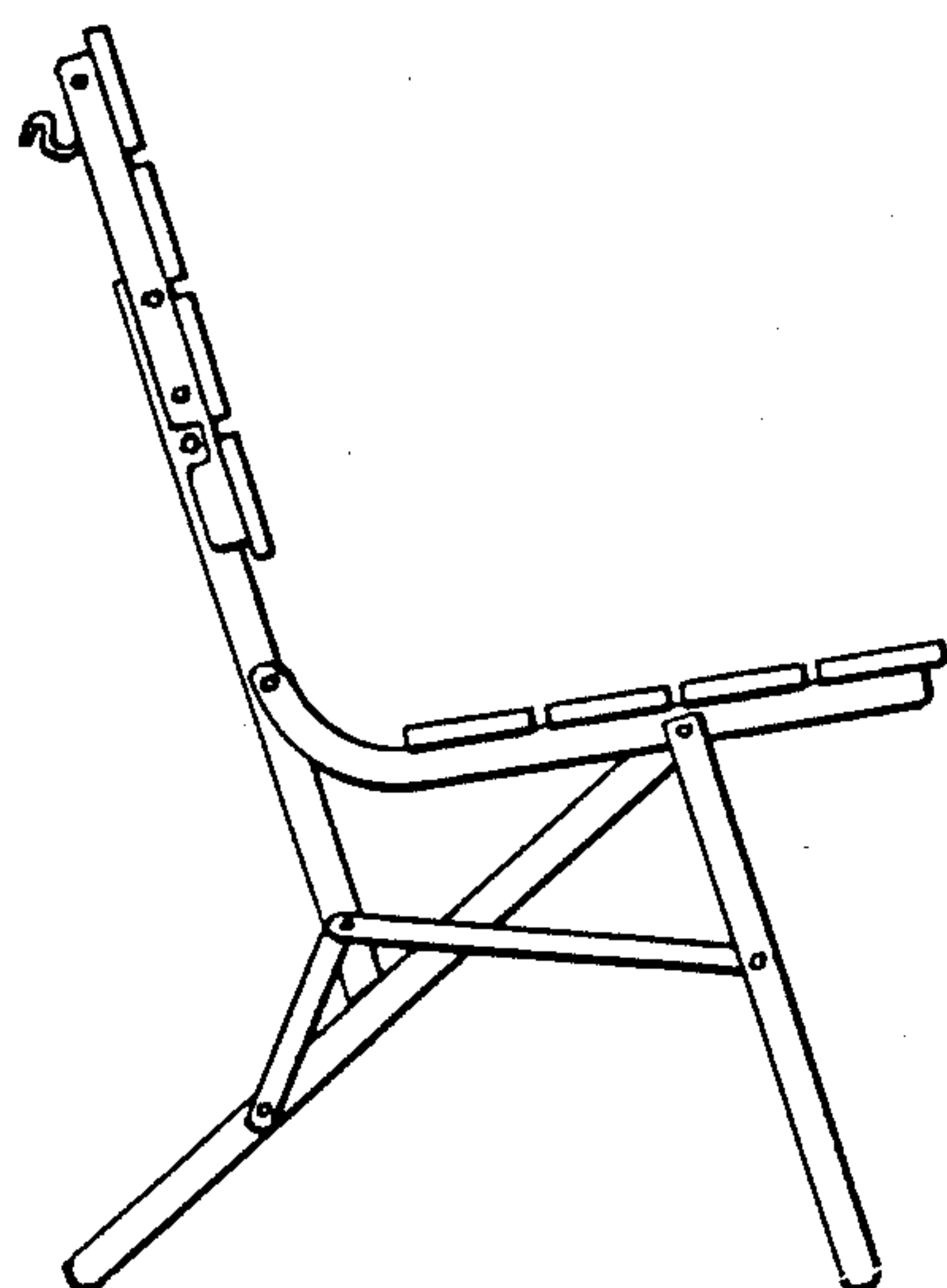

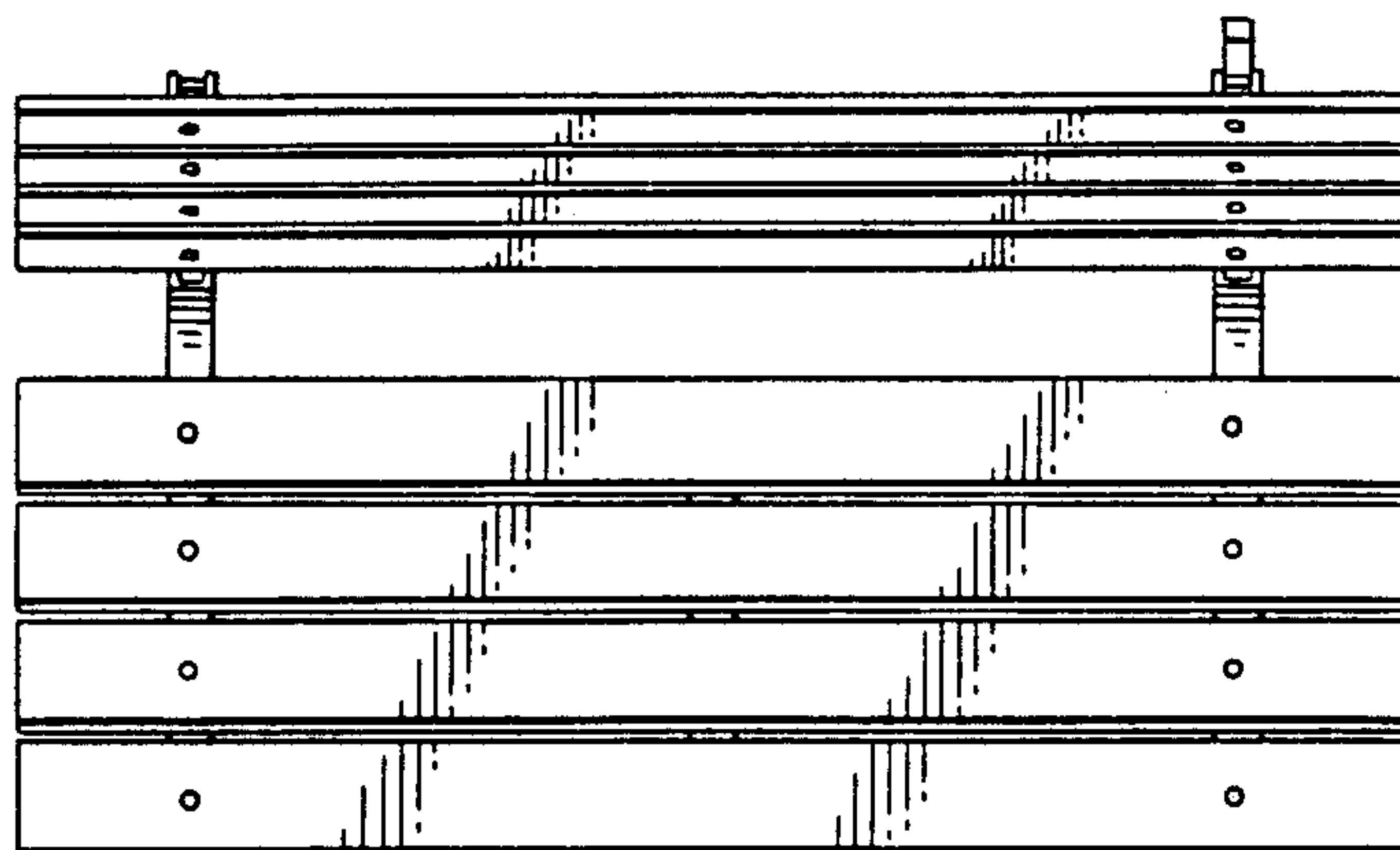

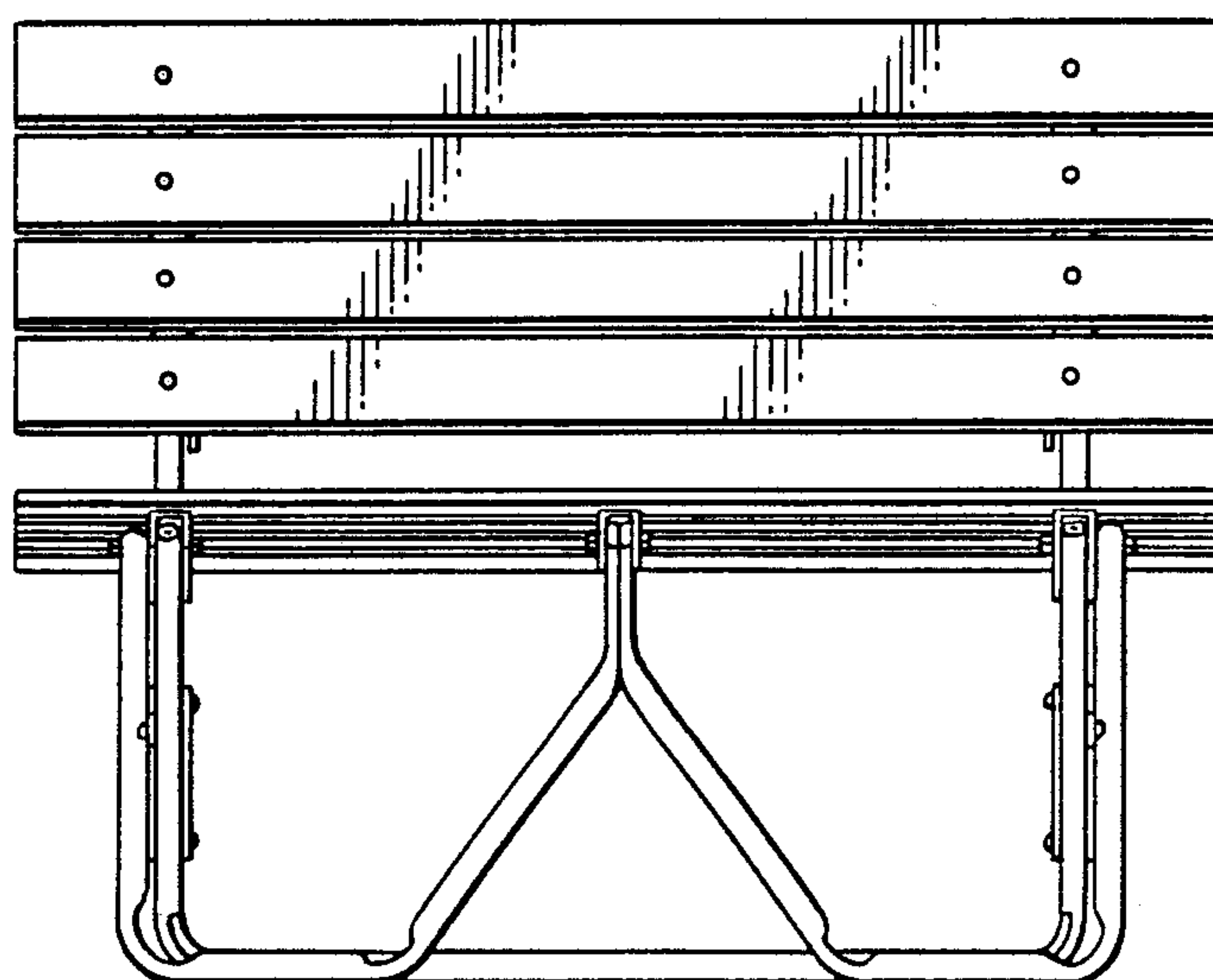

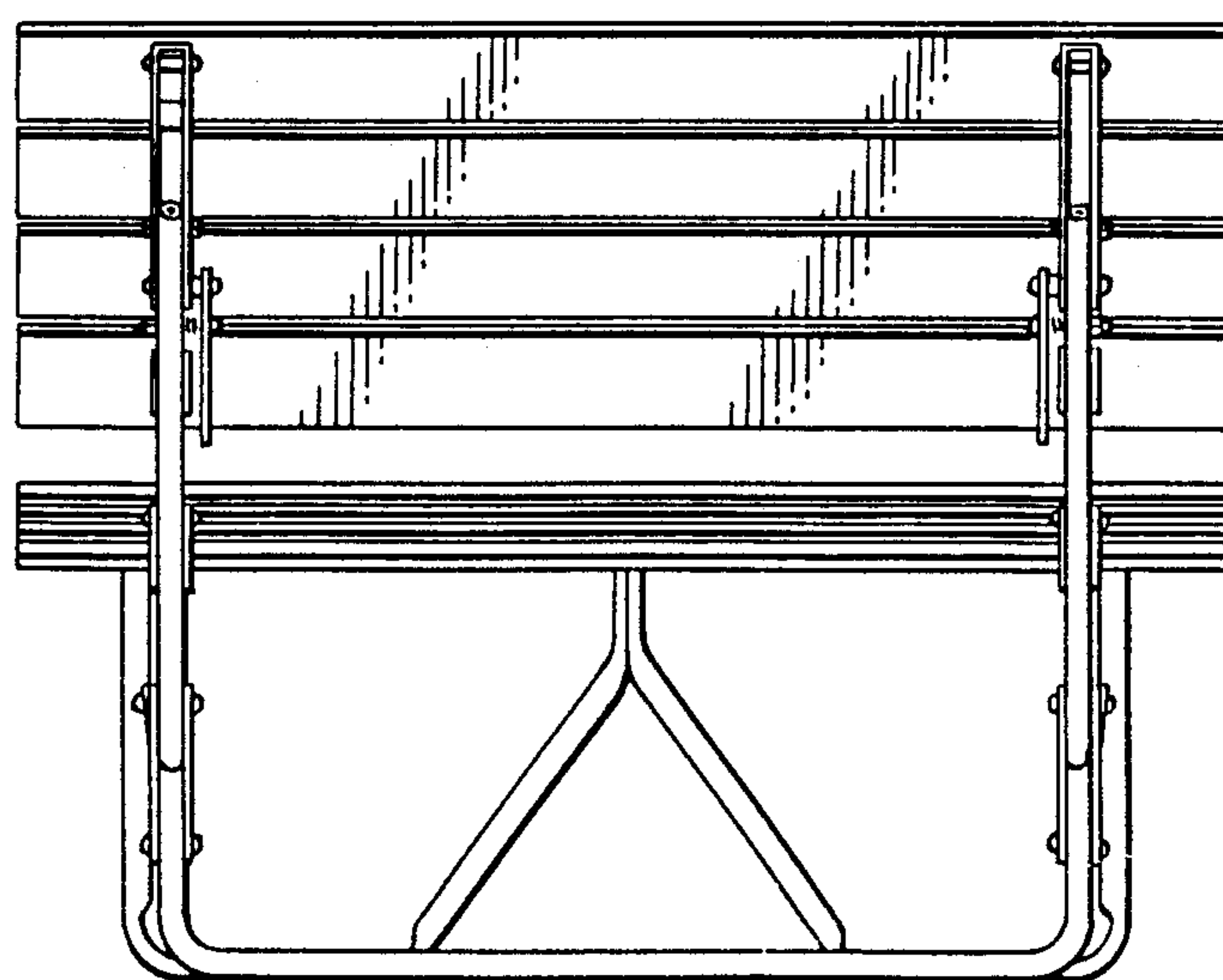

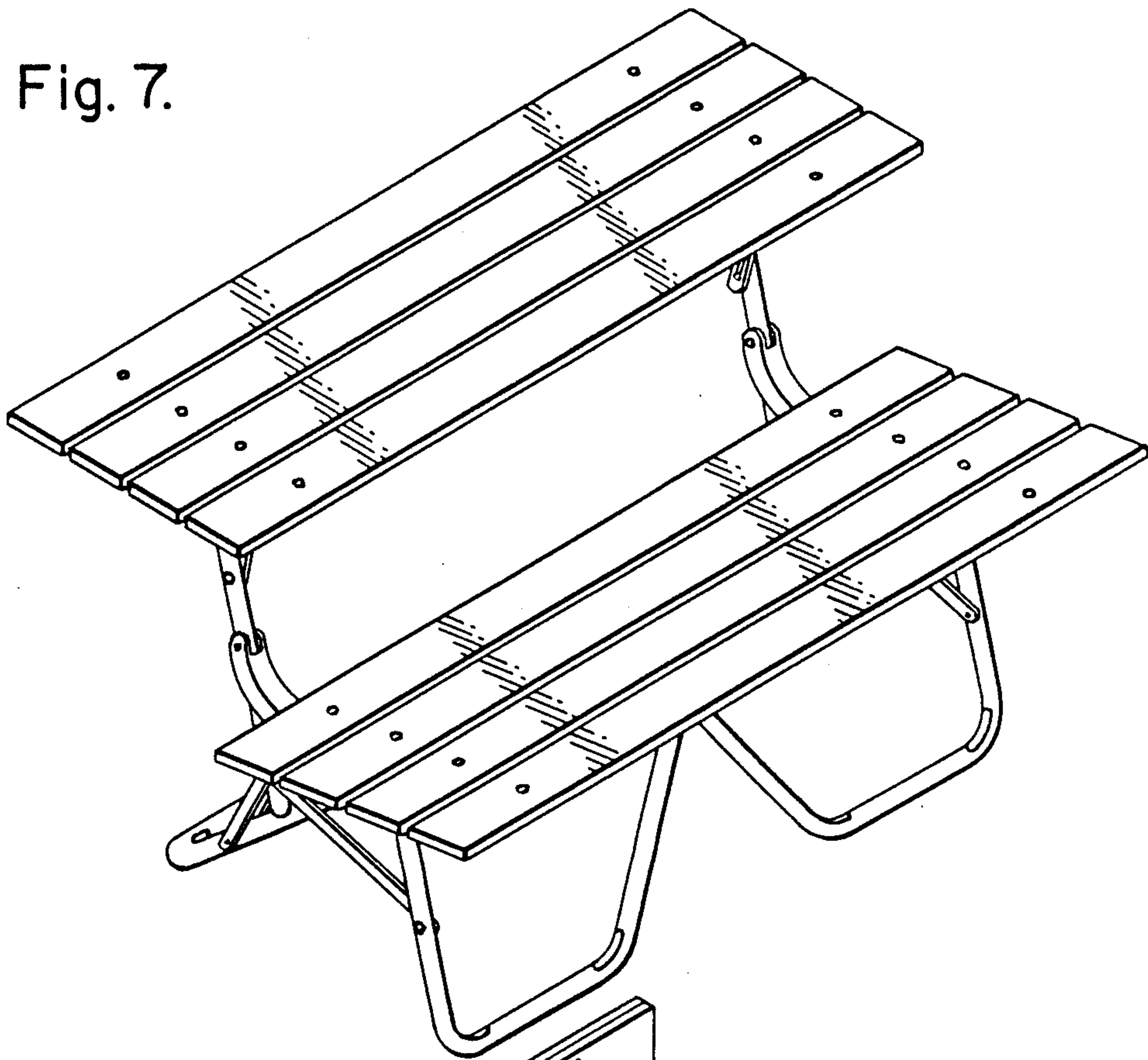

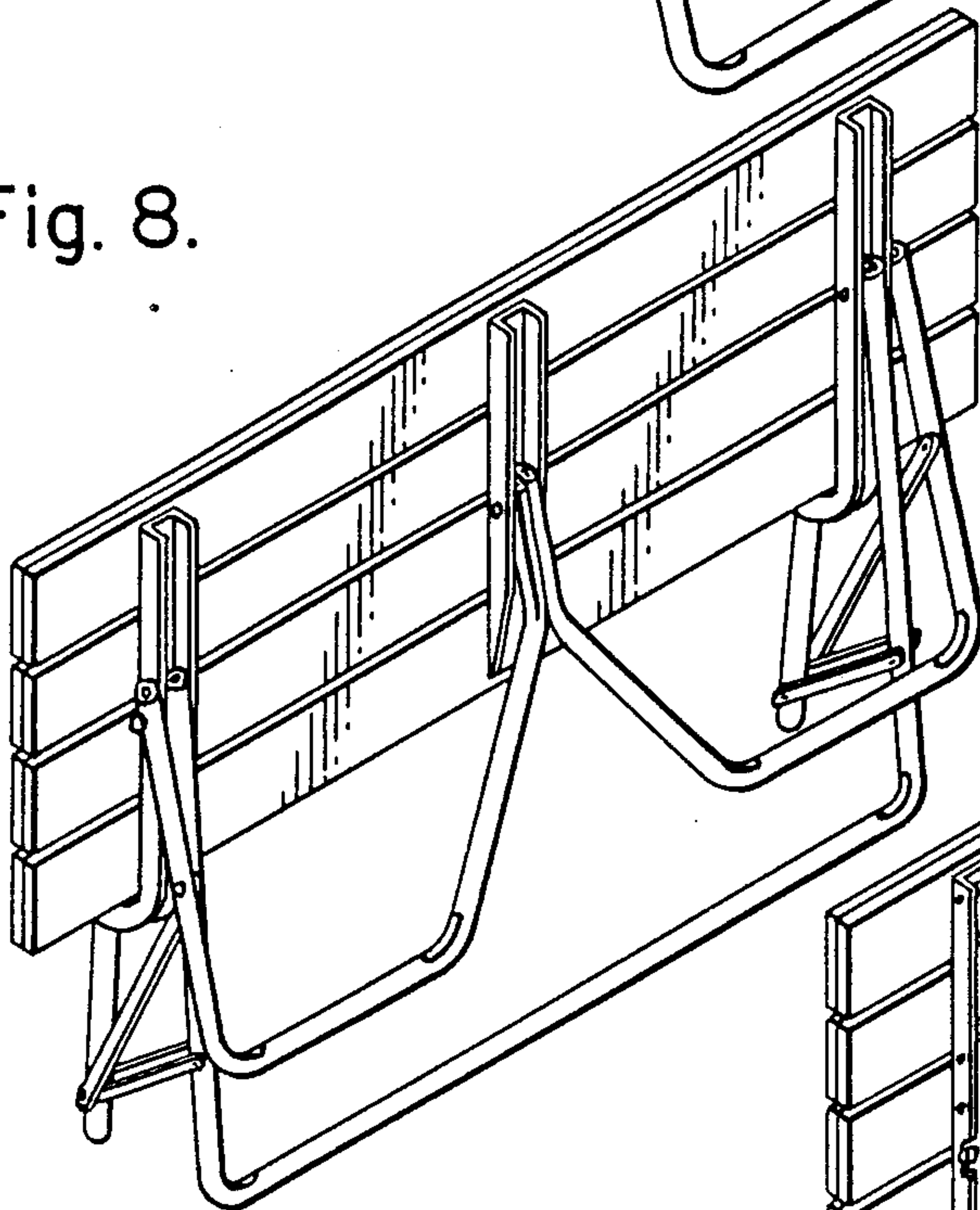
