[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a handle for an article of flatware, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a handle for an article of flatware showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof viewed from the left of FIG. 1, the opposite side elevation being substantially the mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof, viewed from above FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof, viewed from below FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a sectional view on an enlarged scale taken on line 6—6 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 7 is a sectional view on an enlarged scale taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 1.

The broken line showing of the fork tines in FIGS. 1-3 and 5 is illustrative of environmental structure only and forms no part of the claimed design.

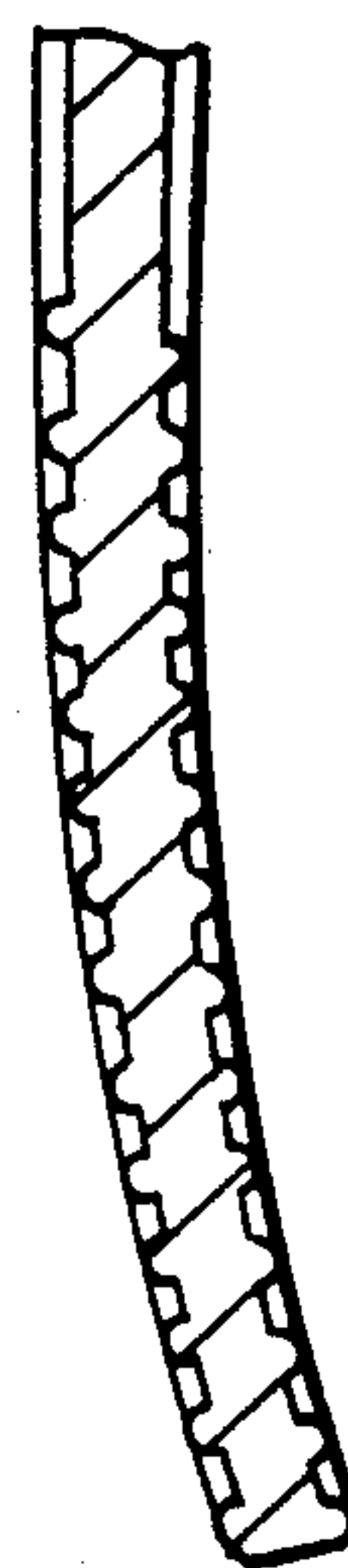
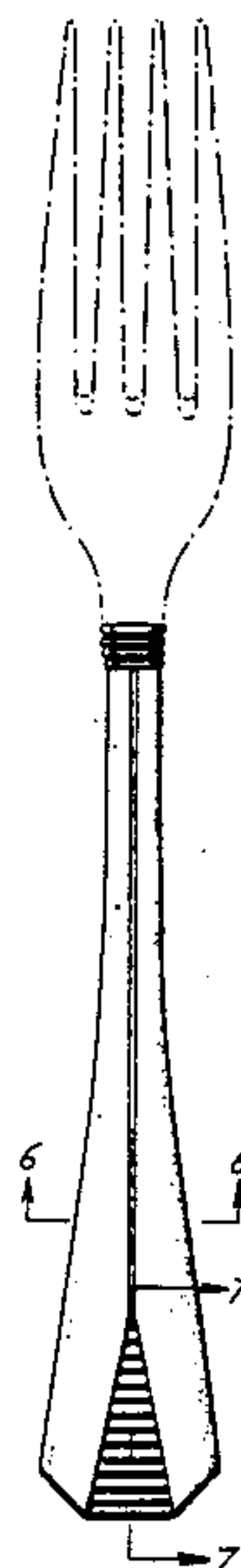

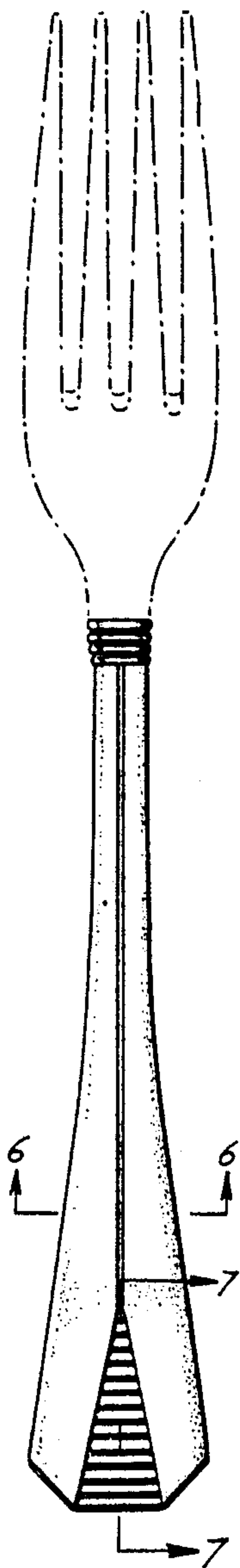

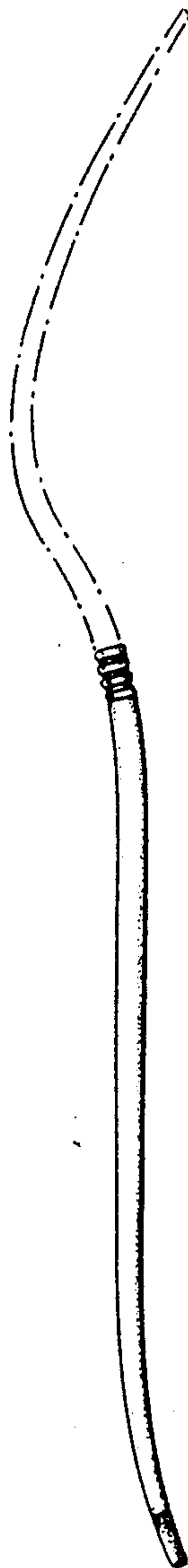

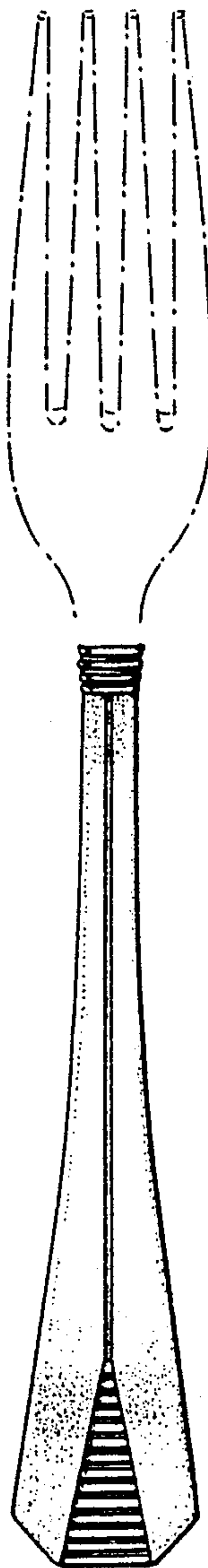

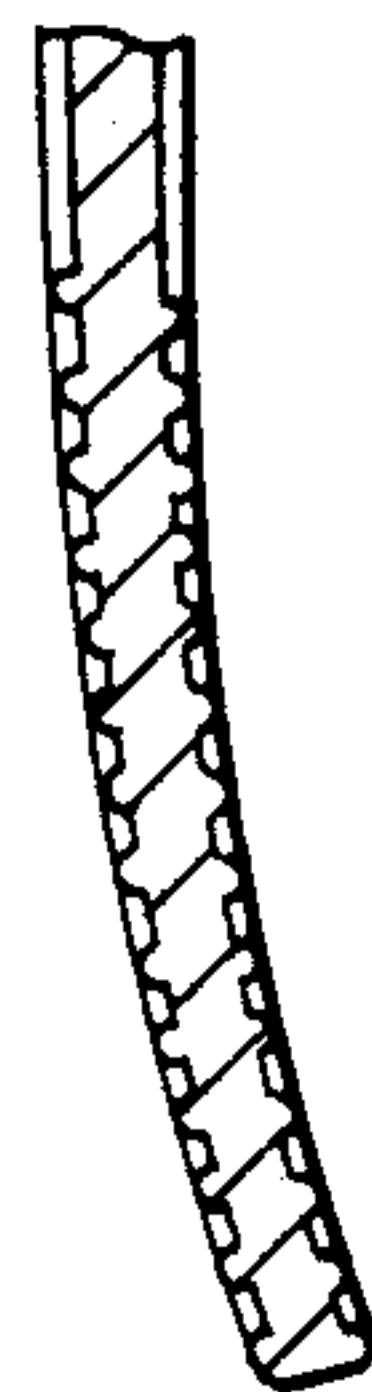

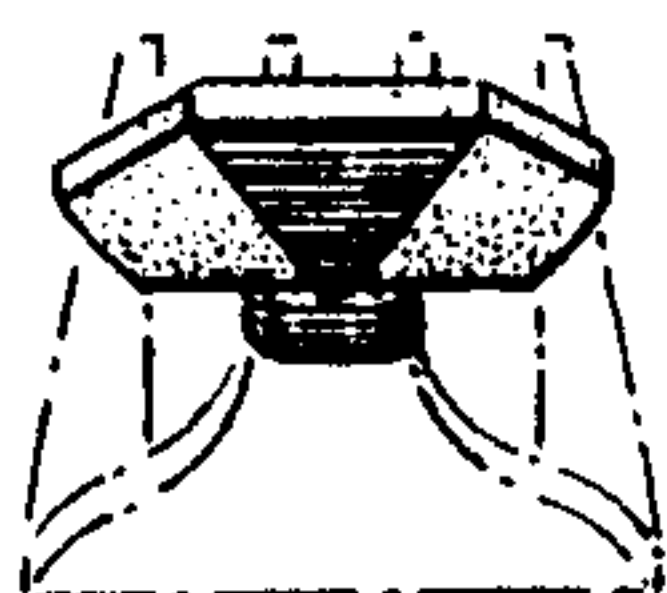
