The ornamental design for illuminated signal, as shown and described.

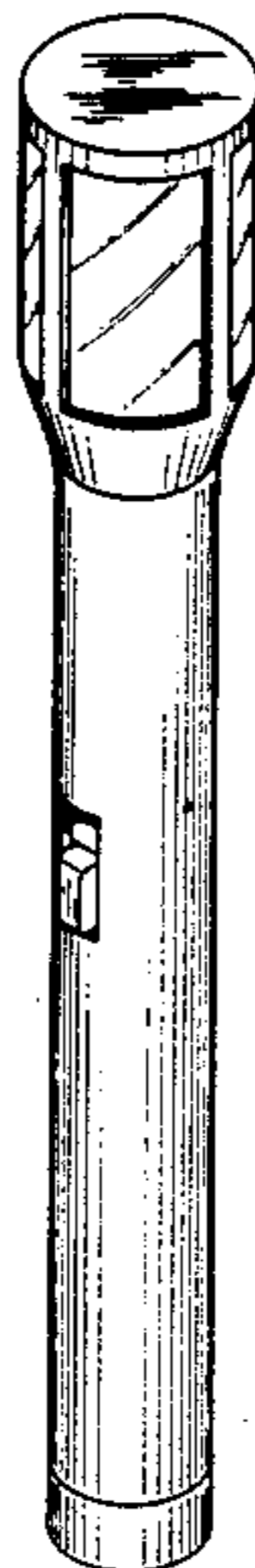
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



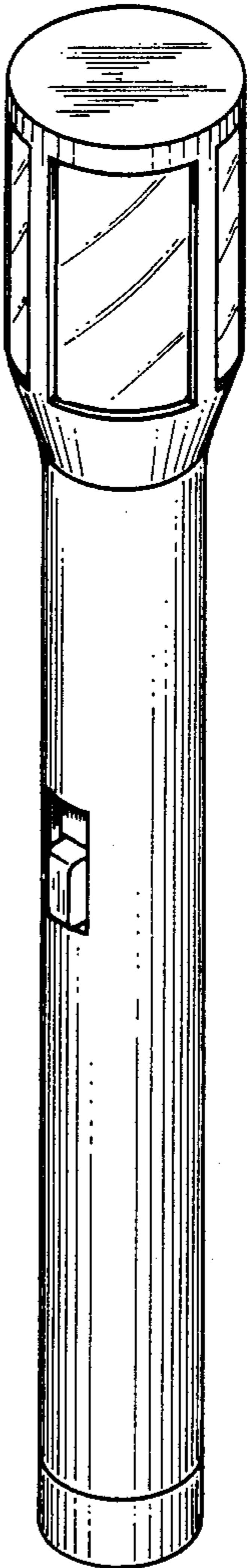

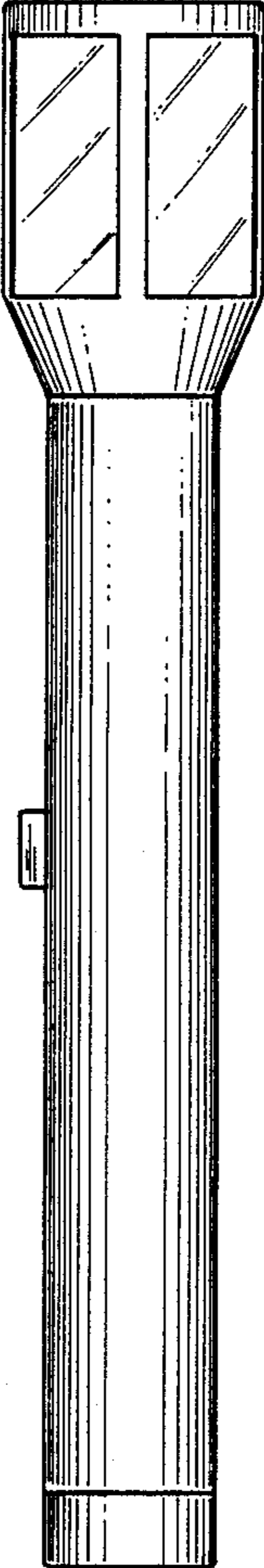

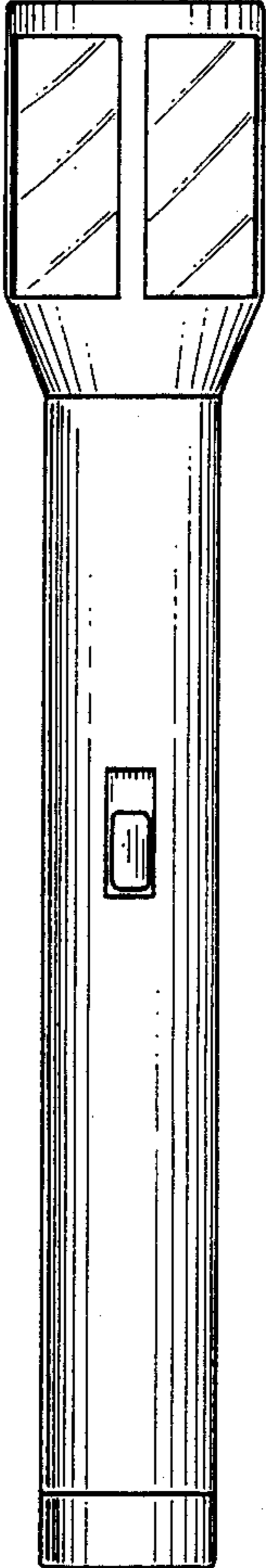

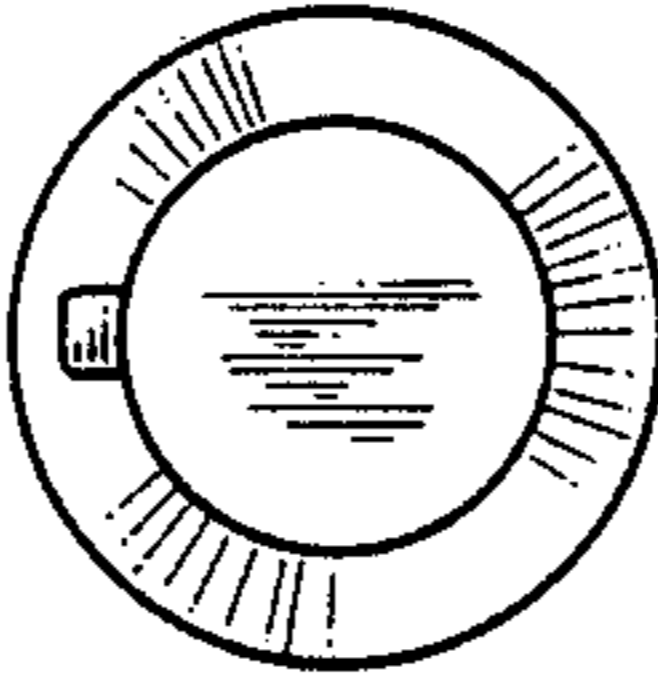
