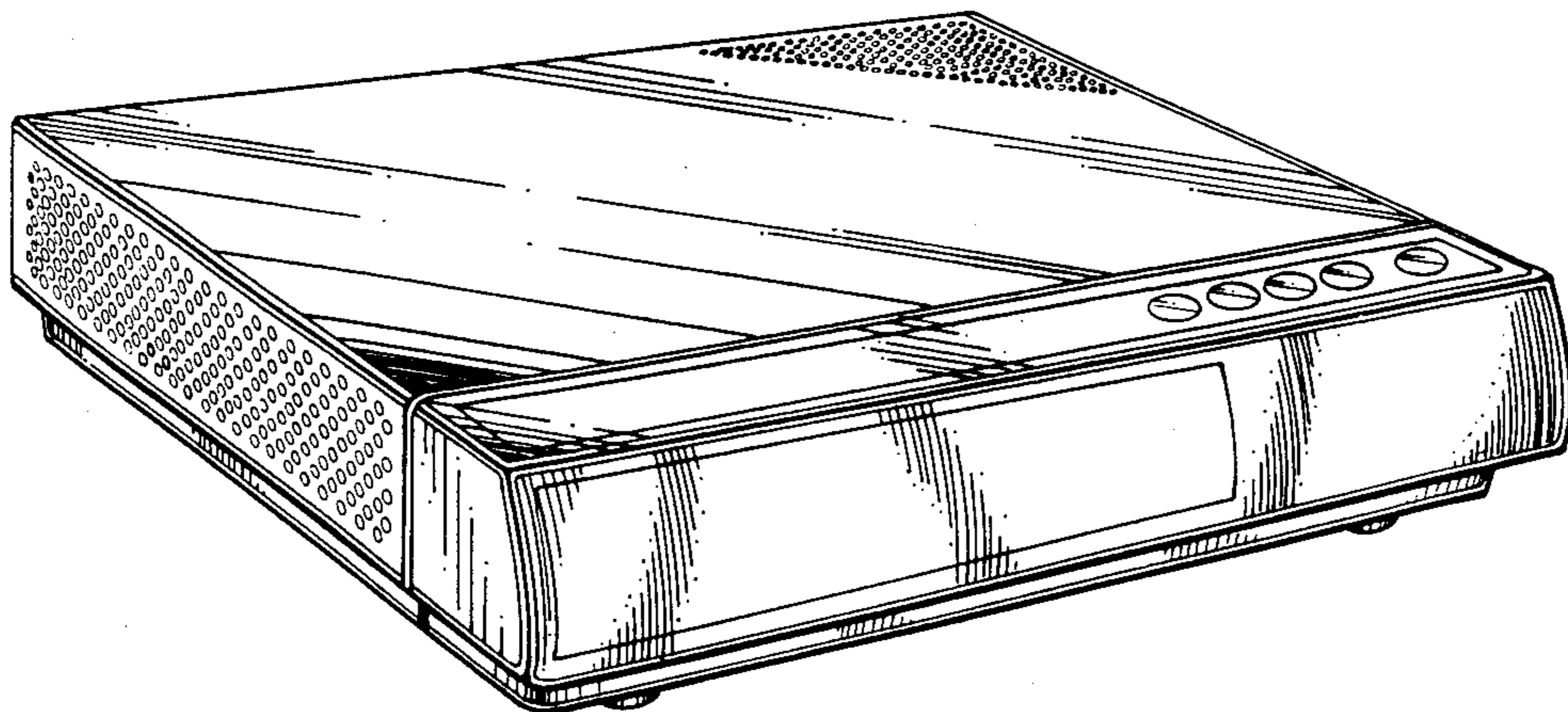

The ornamental design for a television converter housing, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a television converter housing showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.



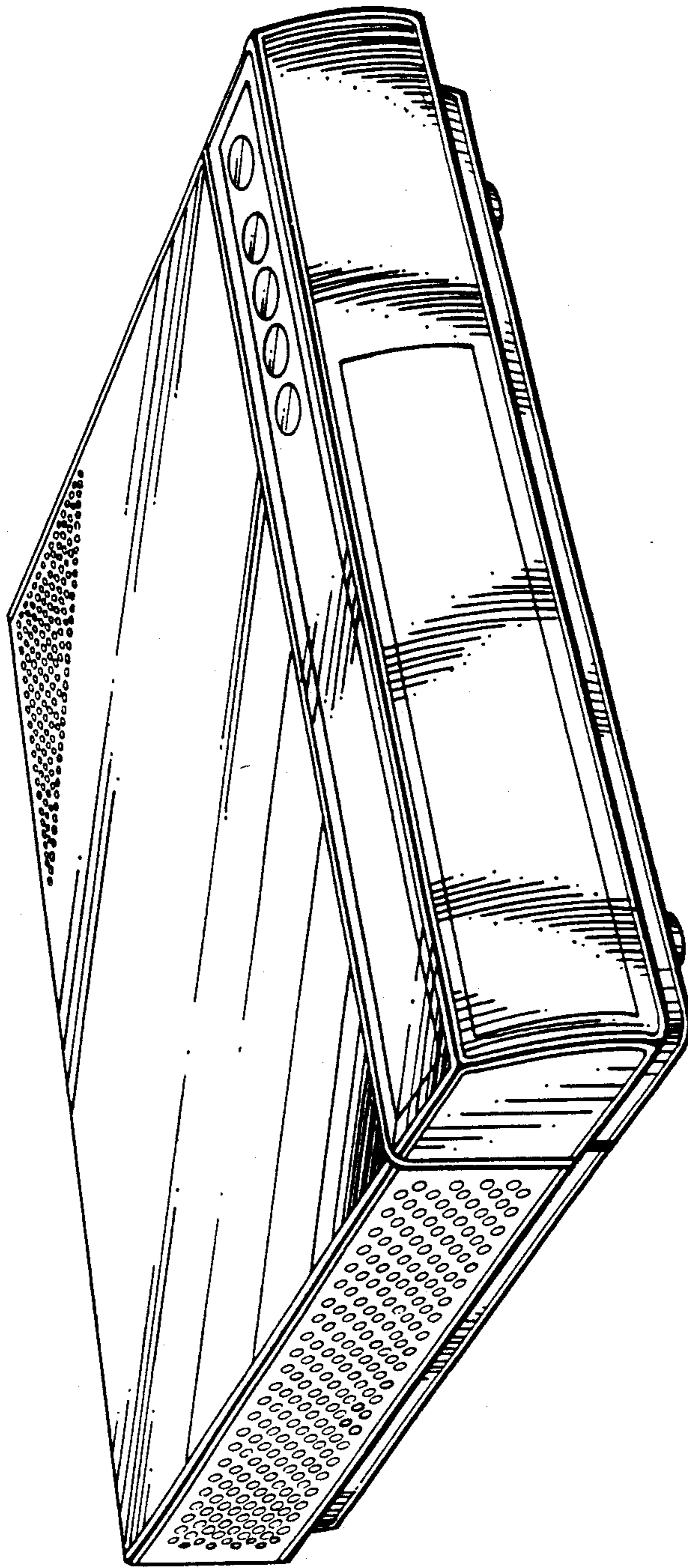

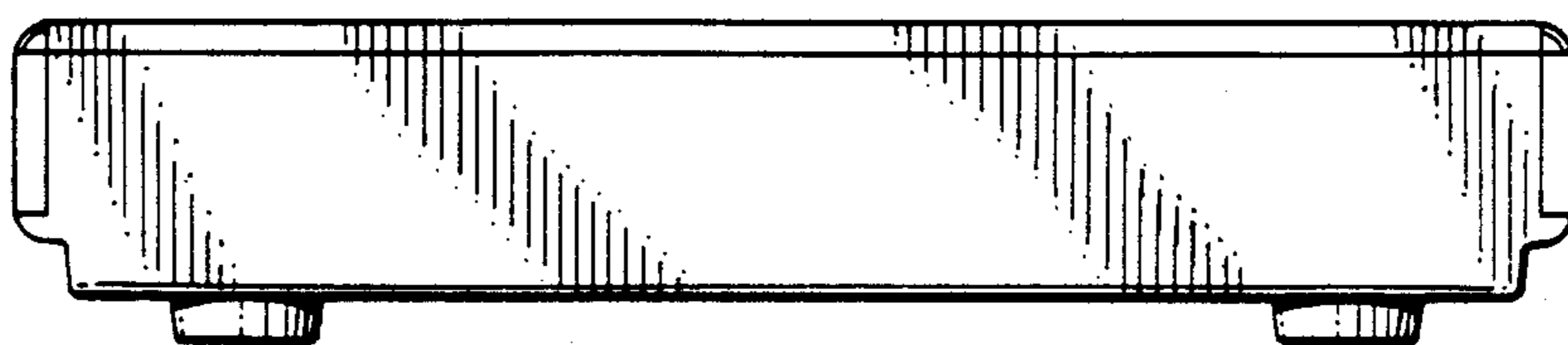

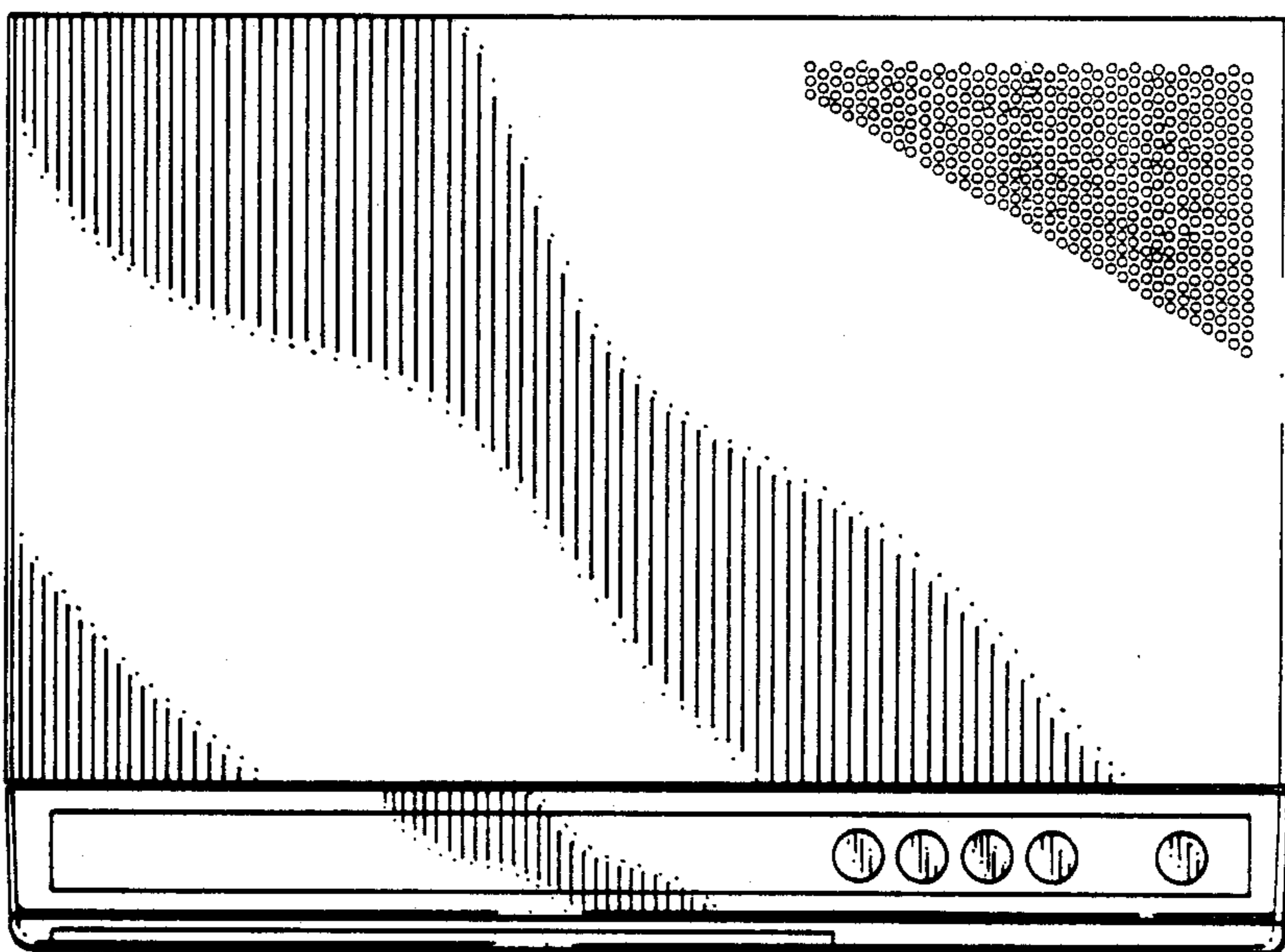

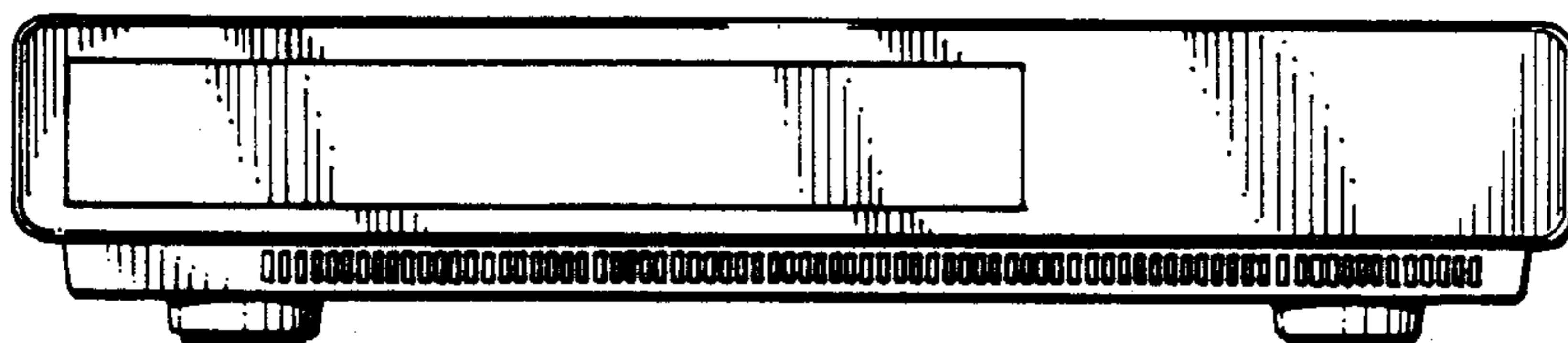

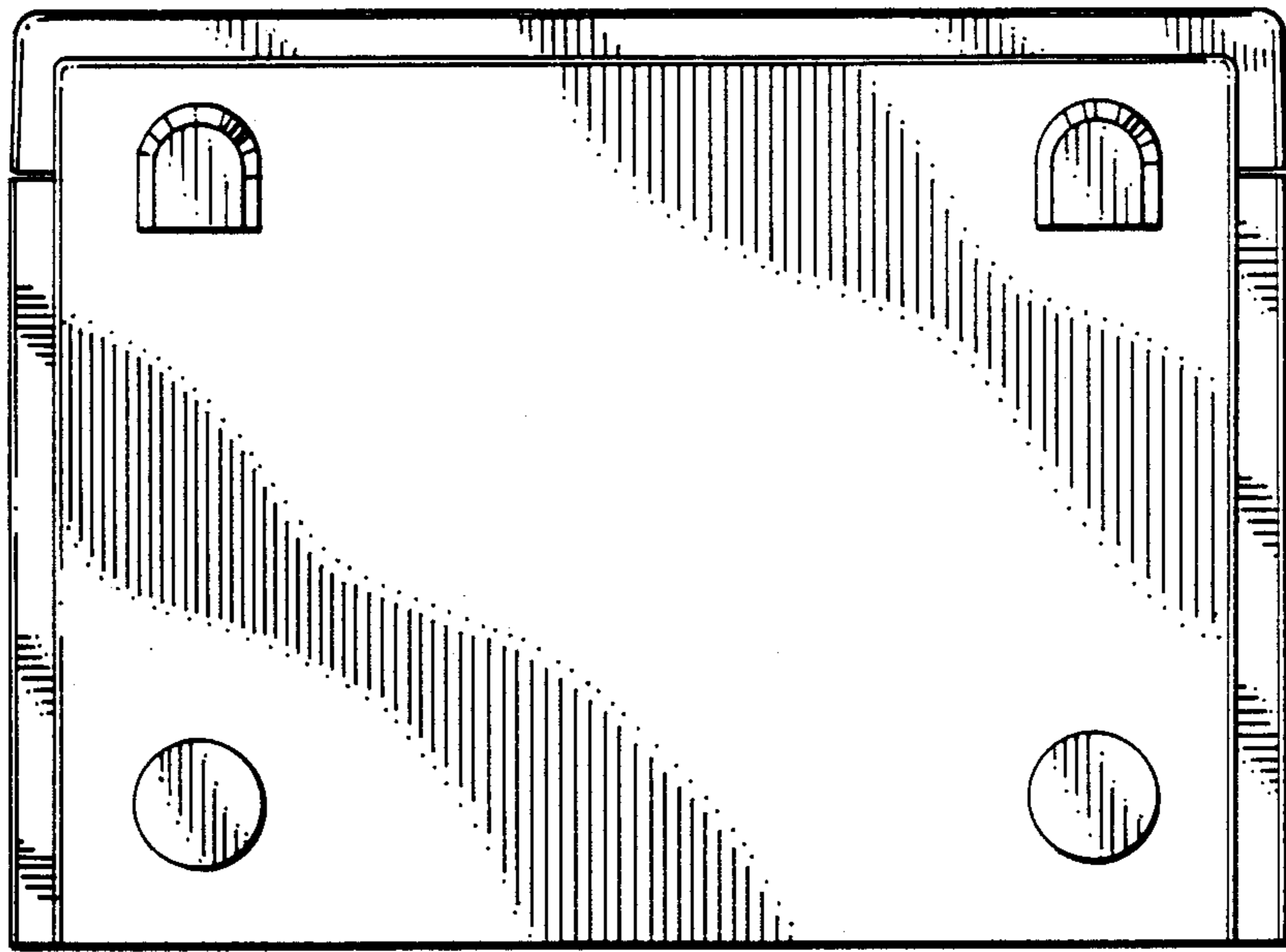

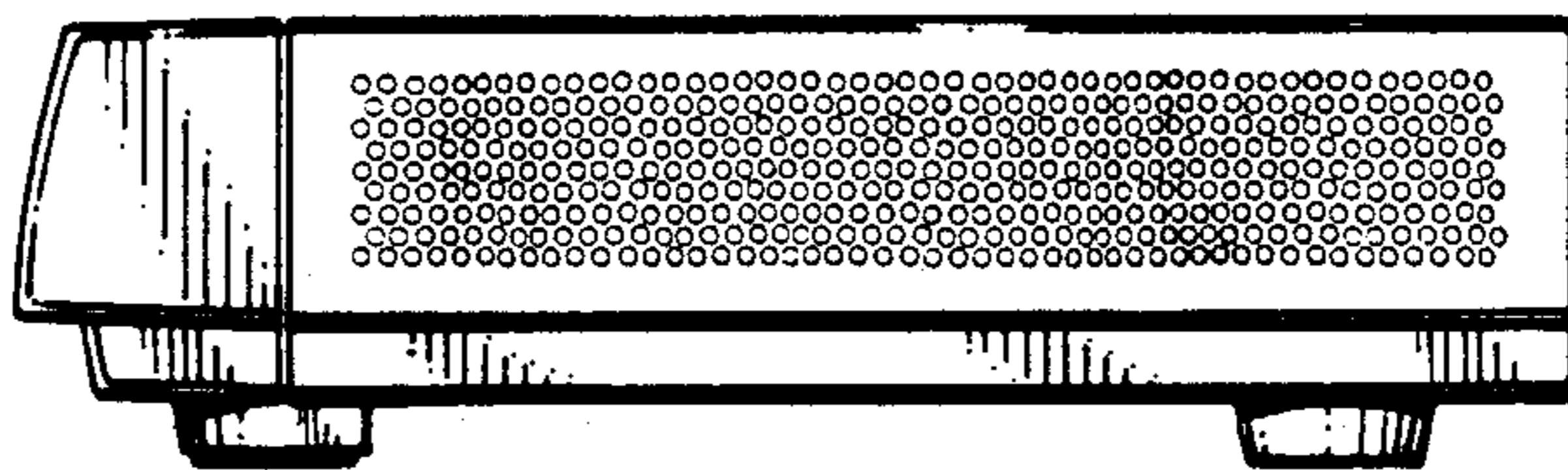
