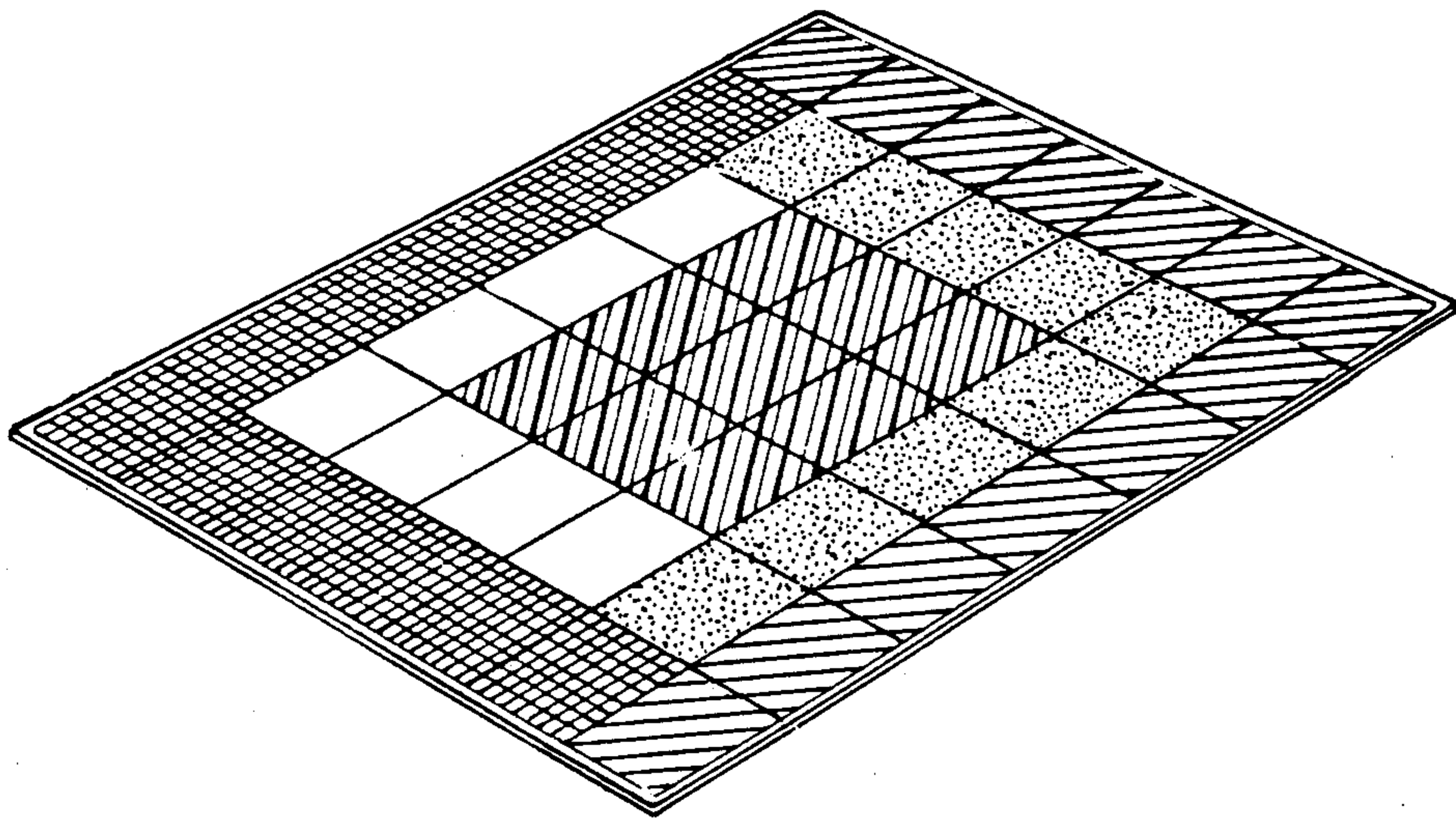

FIG. 3 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof.



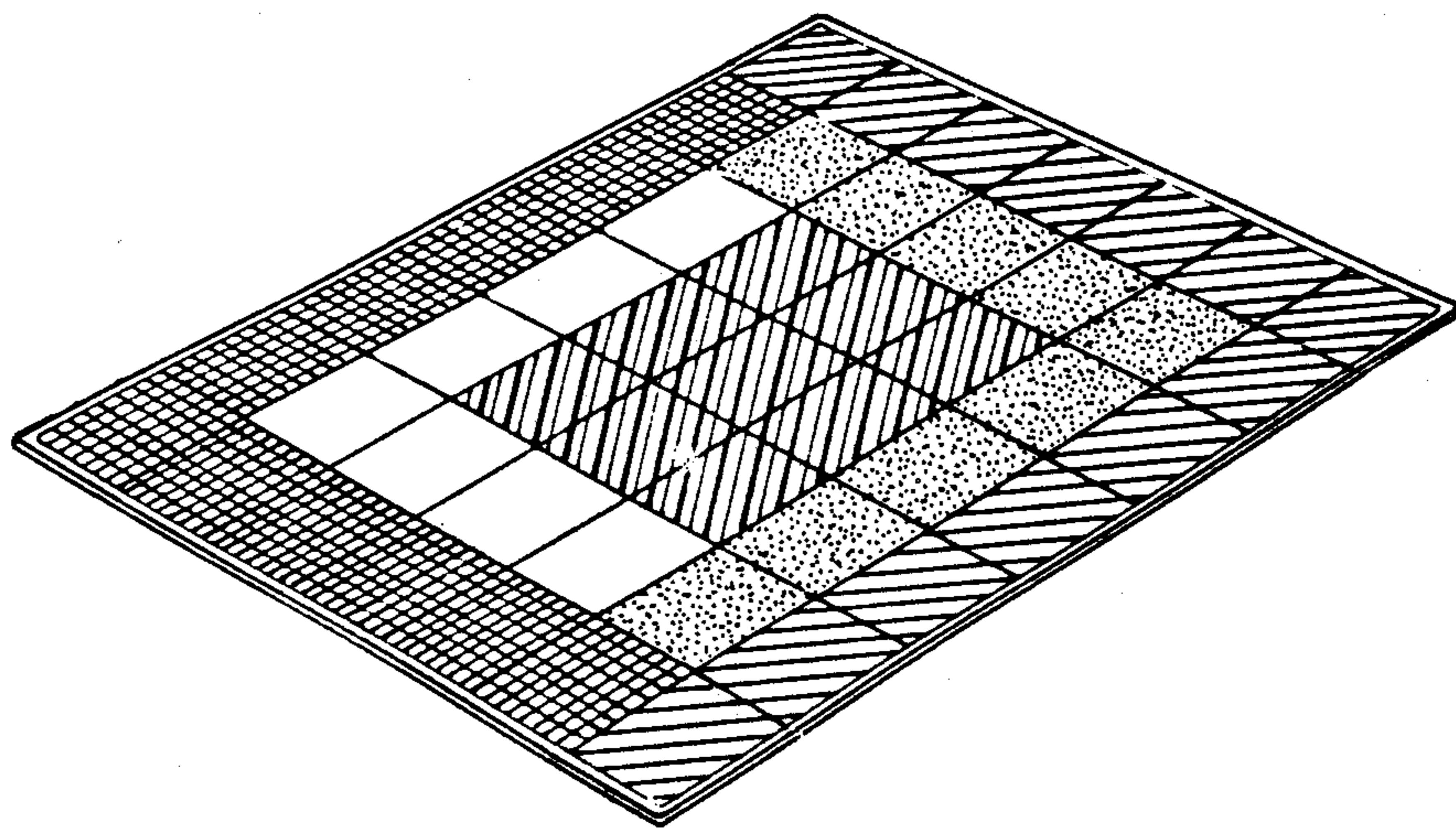

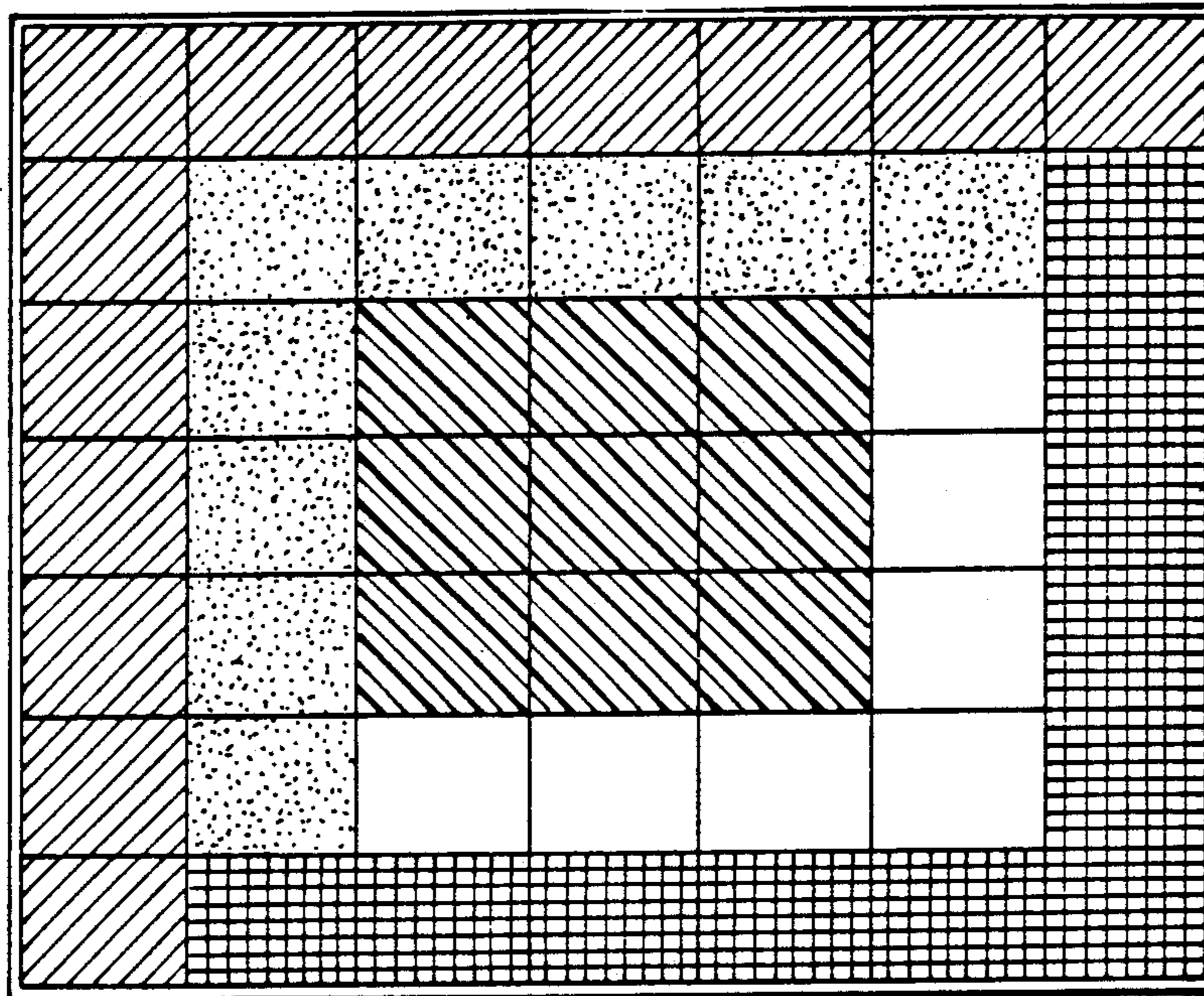

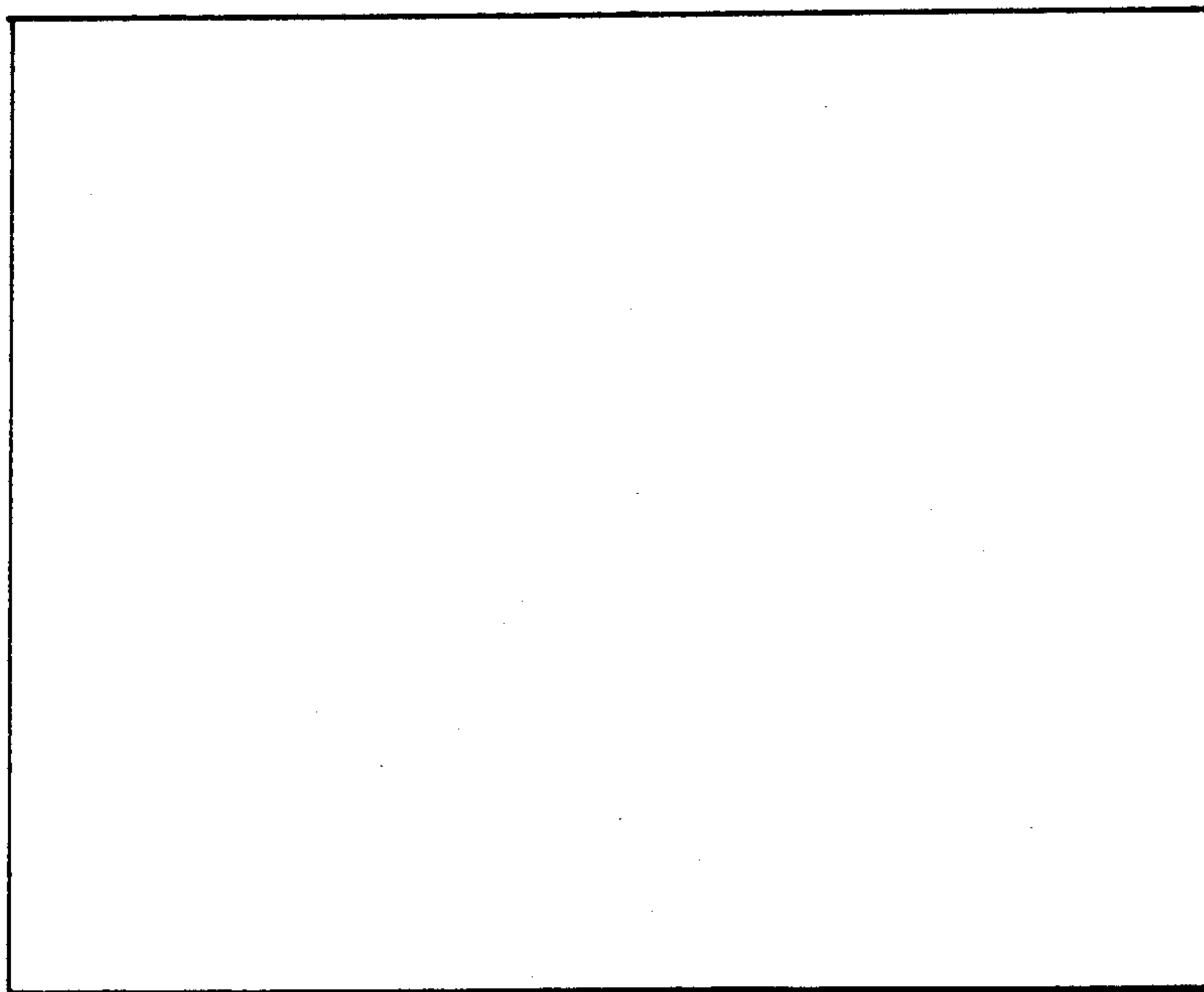
