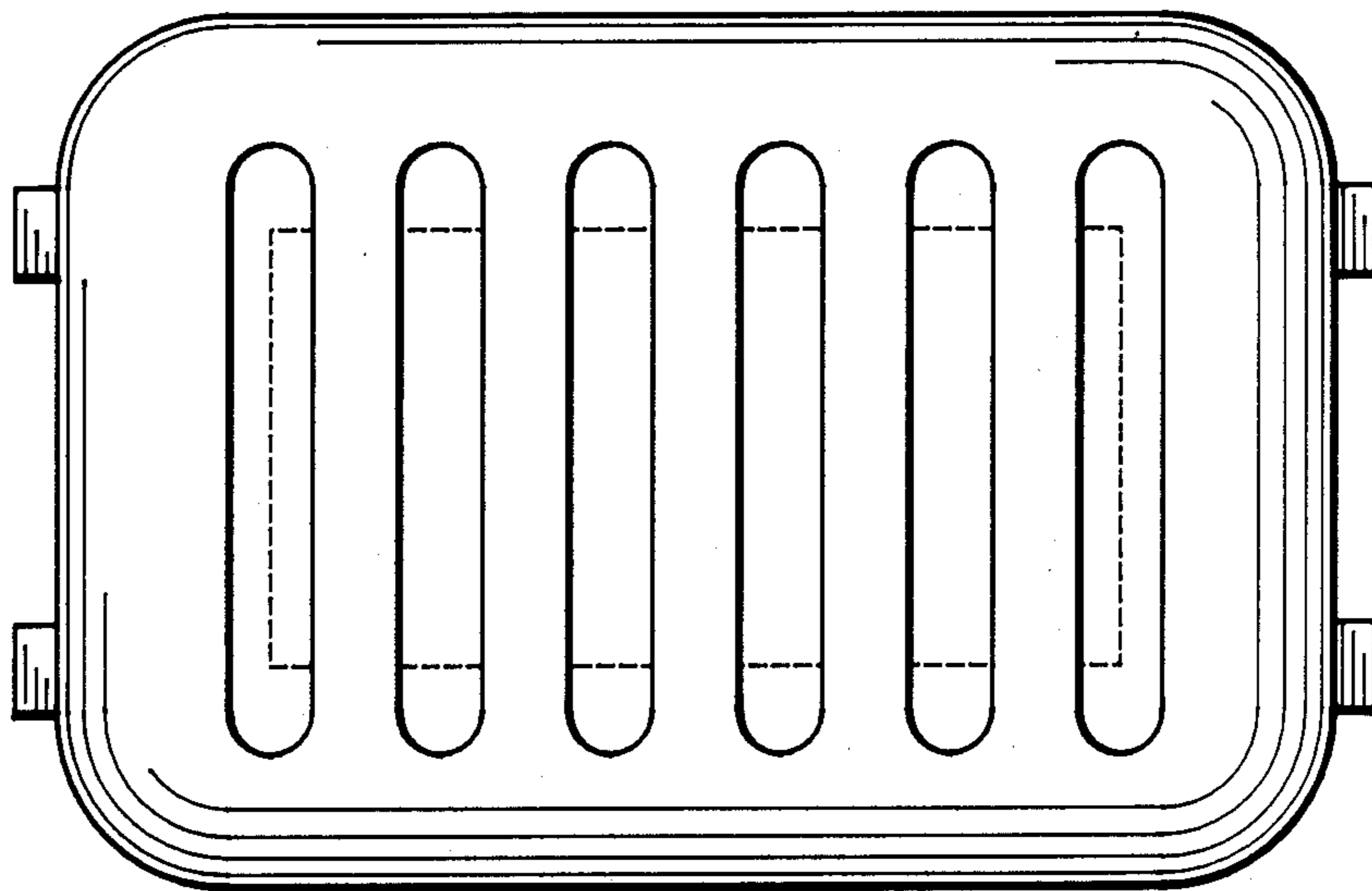
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a house deodorizer enclosure, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a house deodorizer enclosure showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken-line showing of a deodorant bar in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only, and forms no part of the claimed design.



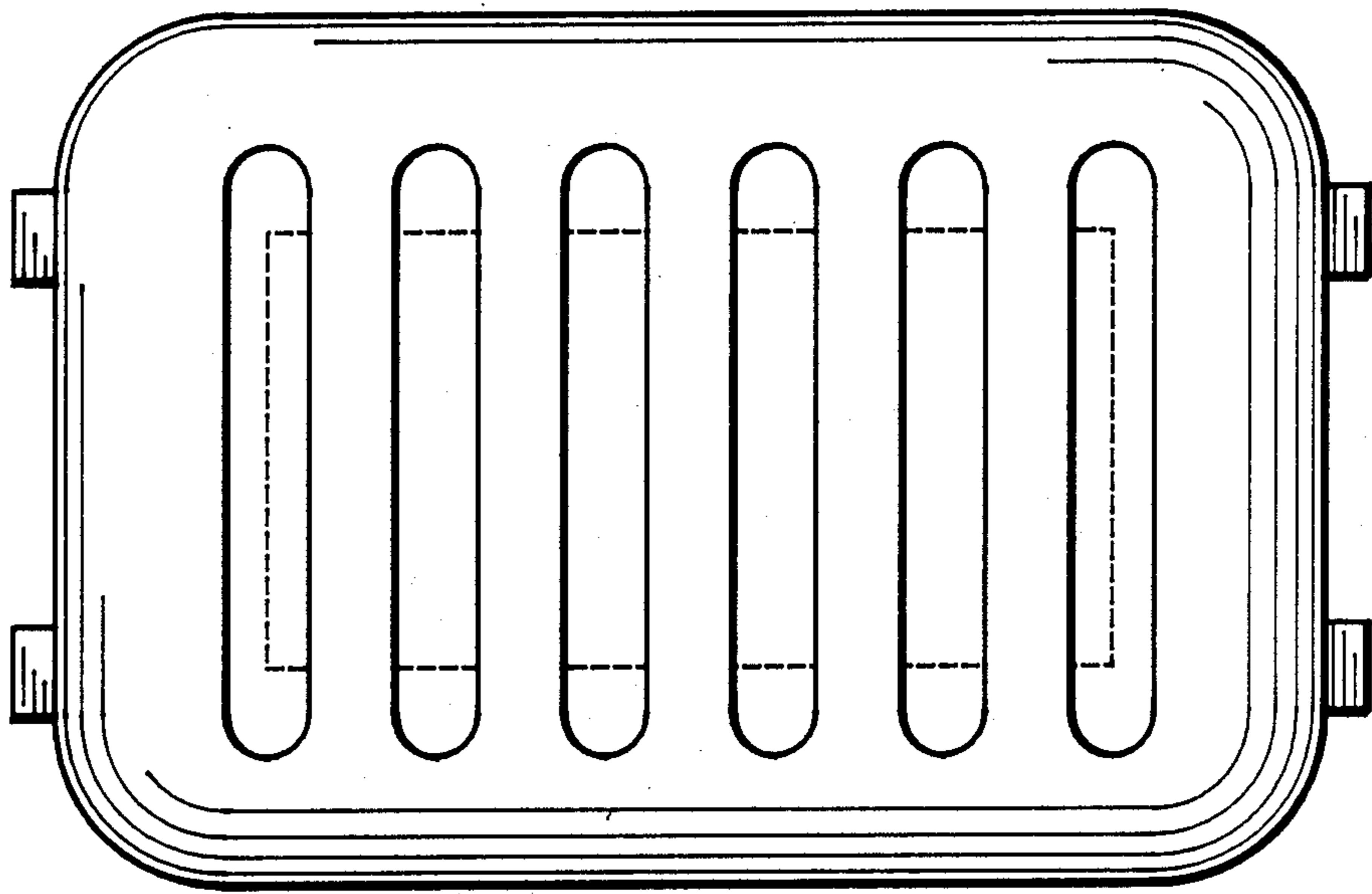

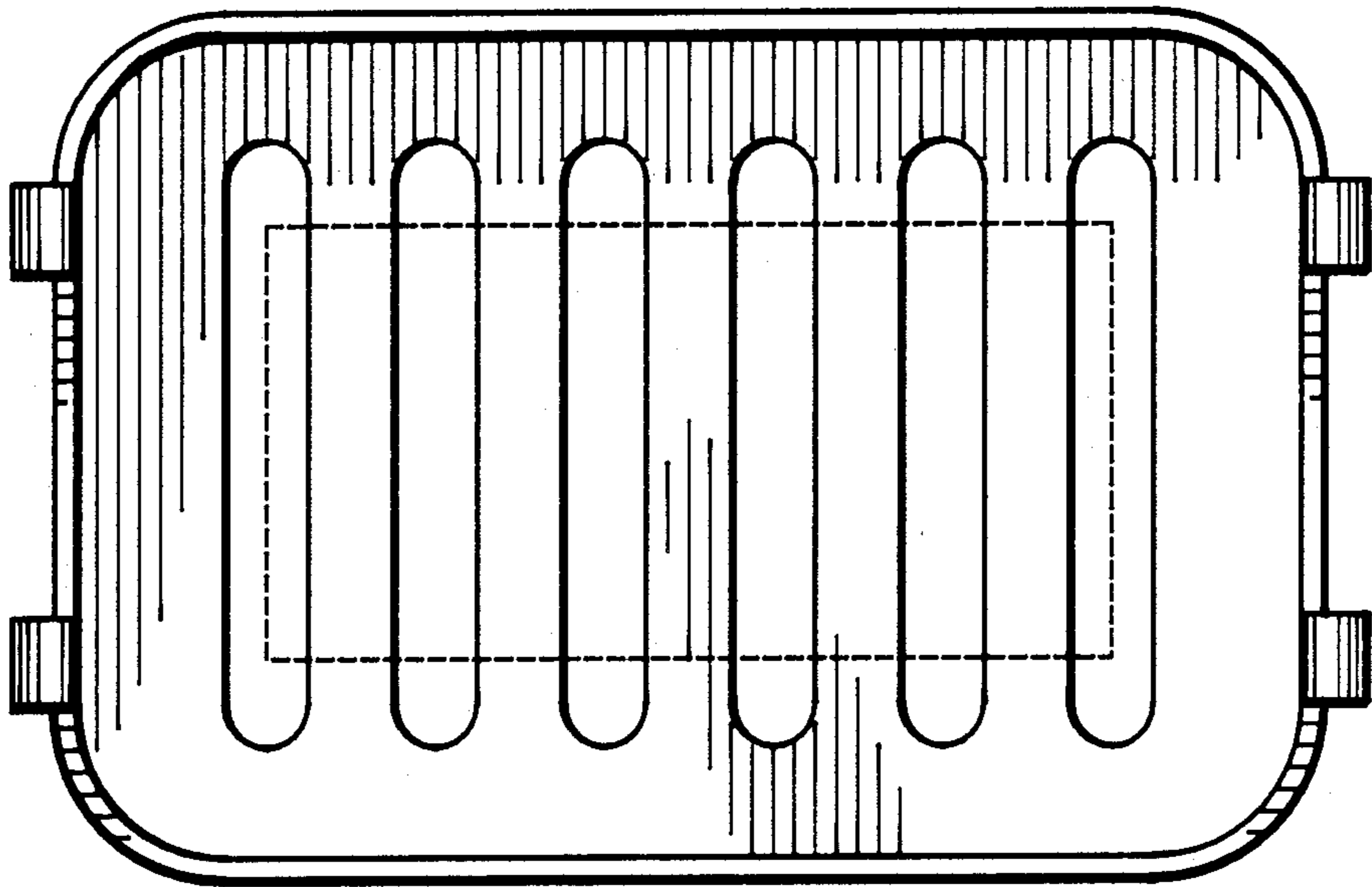

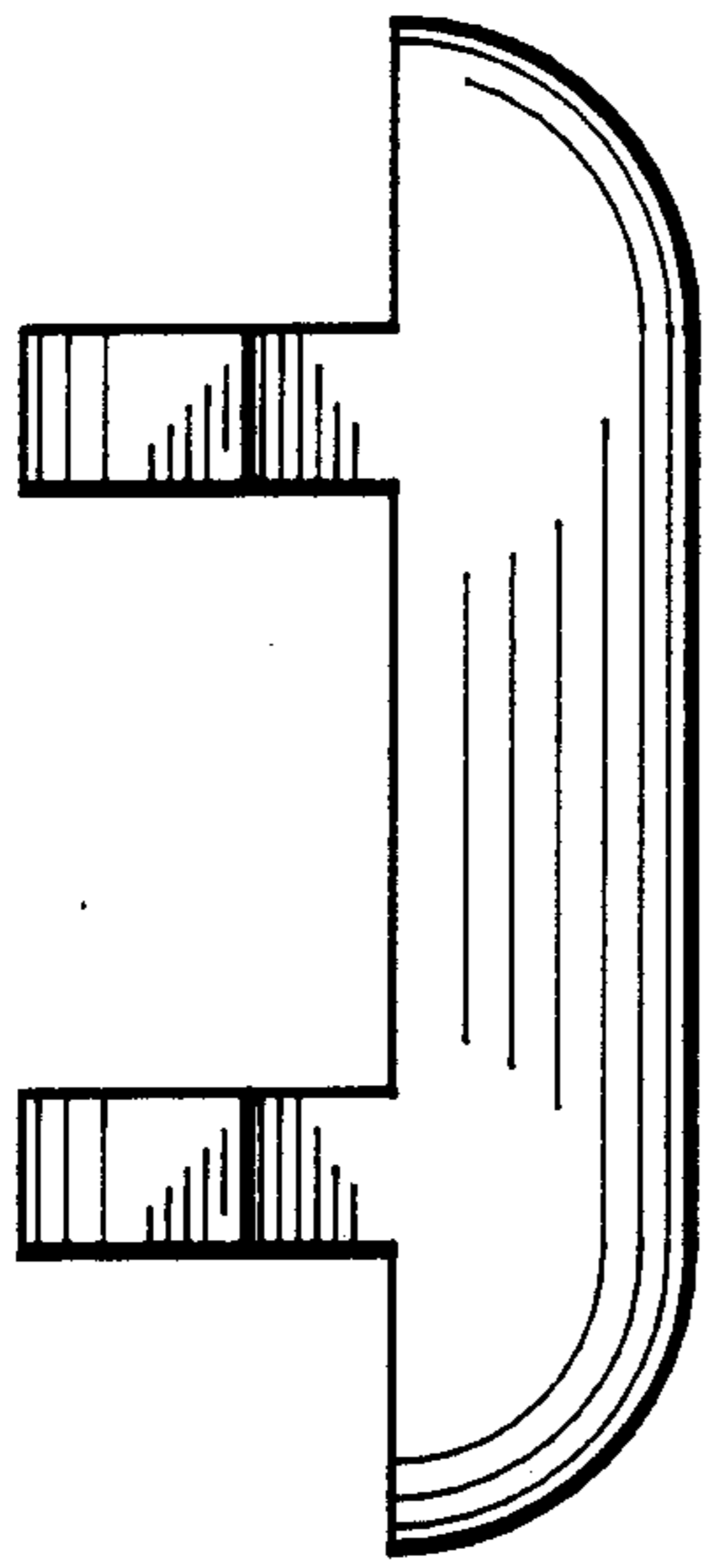

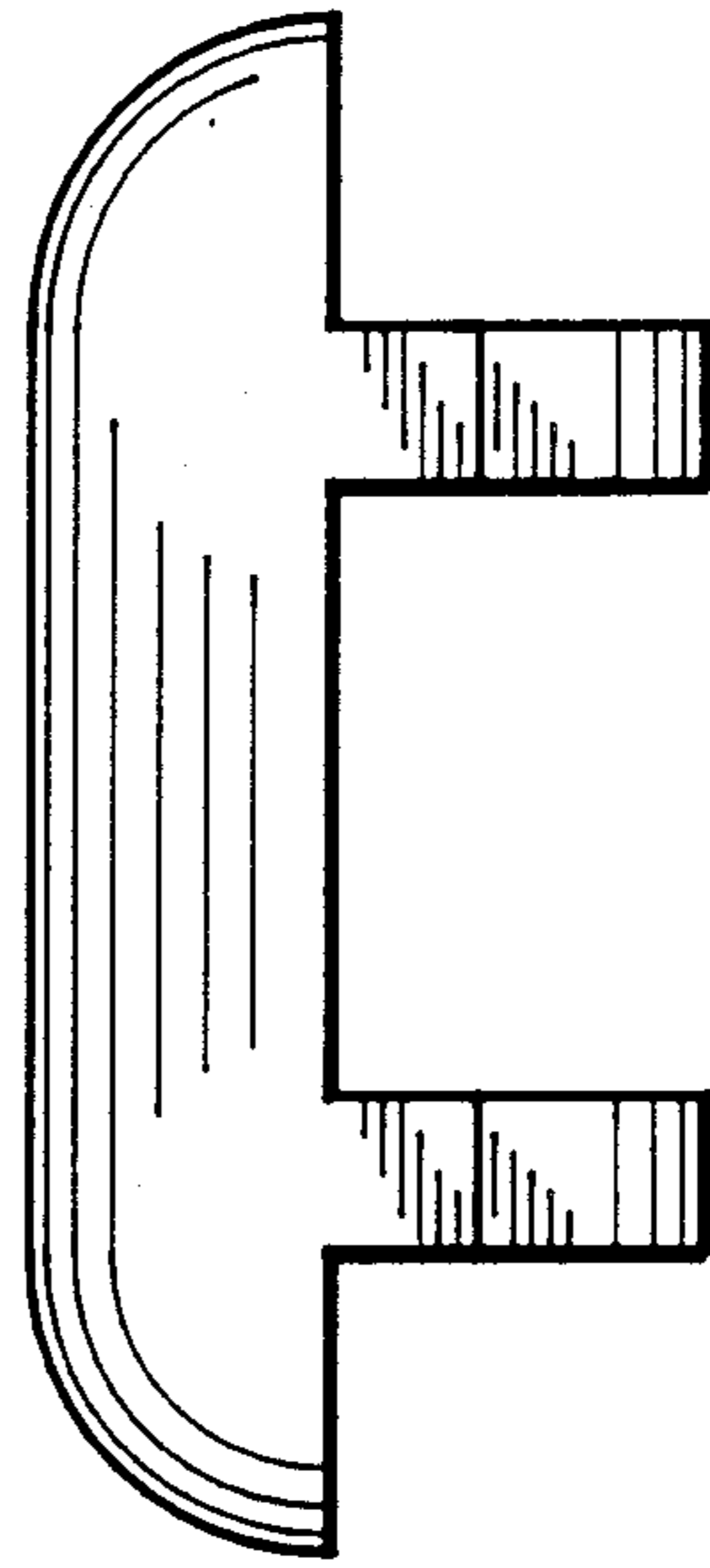

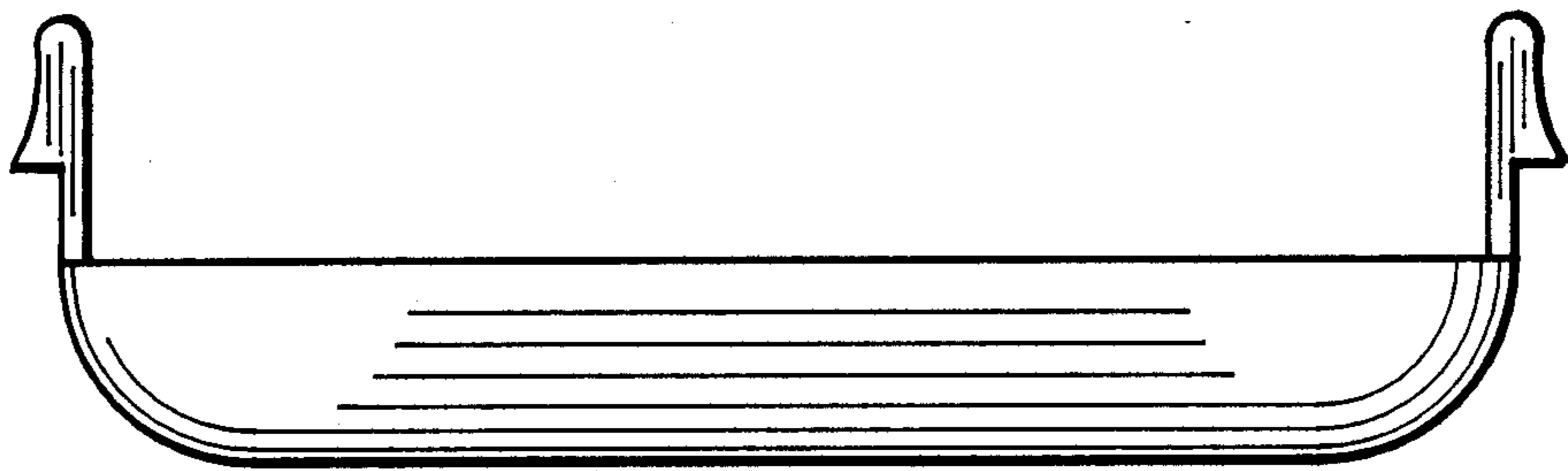

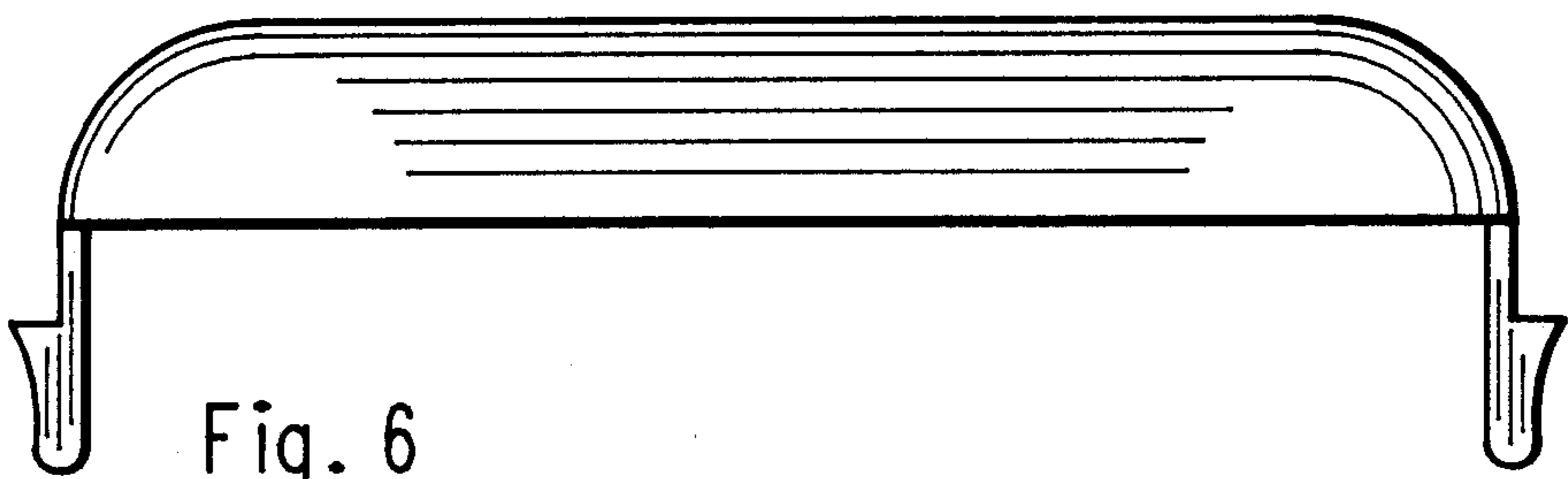
