[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a base heating plate for a travel hairsetter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a base heating plate for a travel hairsetter showing our new design;

The cord portion is shown partially drawn for ease of illustration;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing of the hair roller in FIGS. 5 and 6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

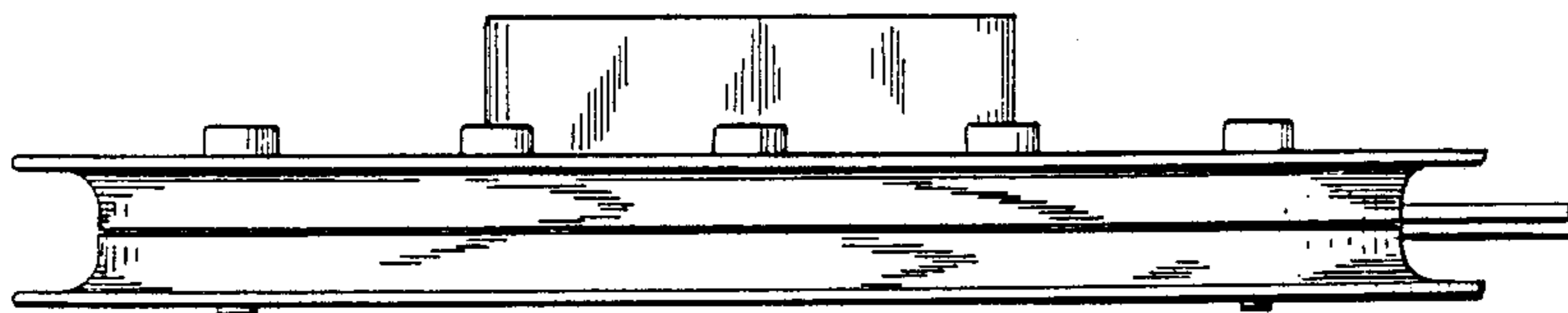
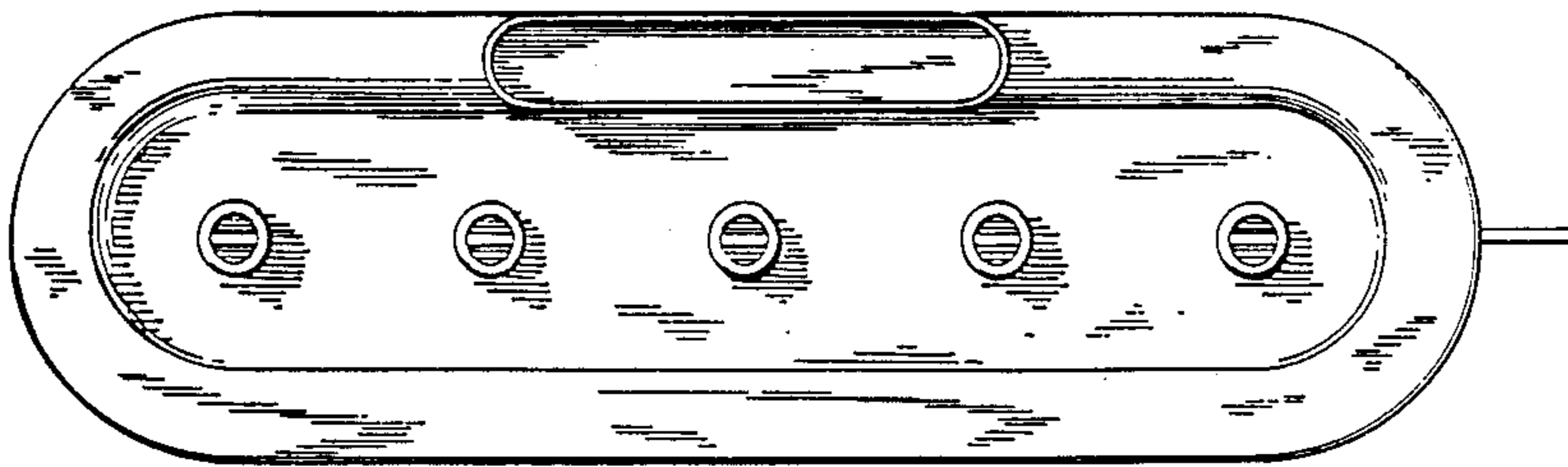

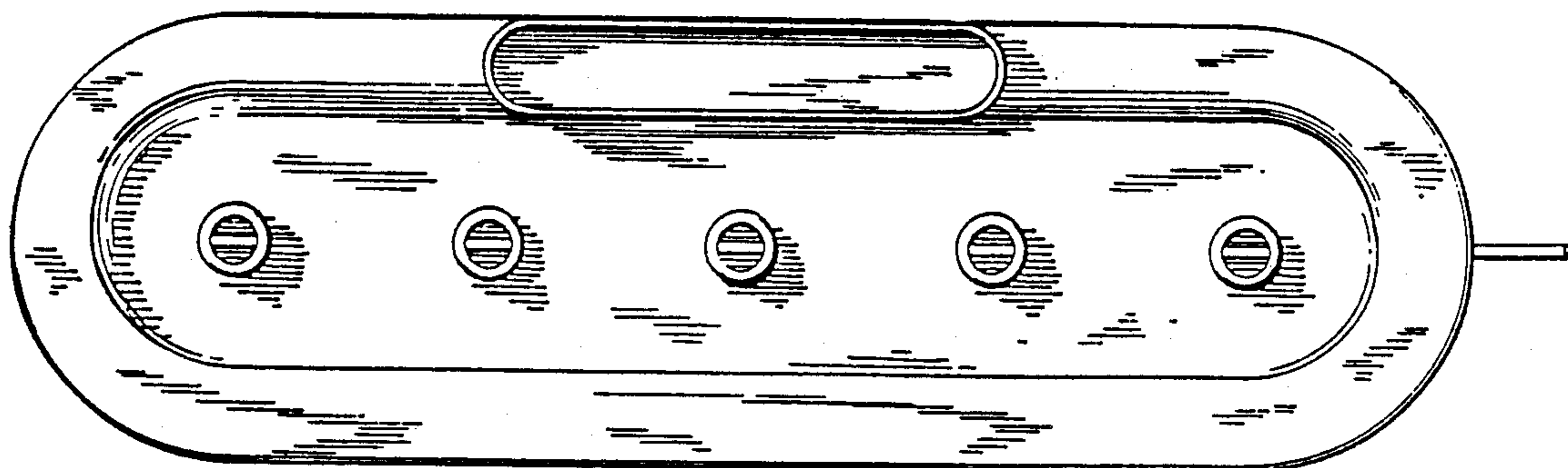

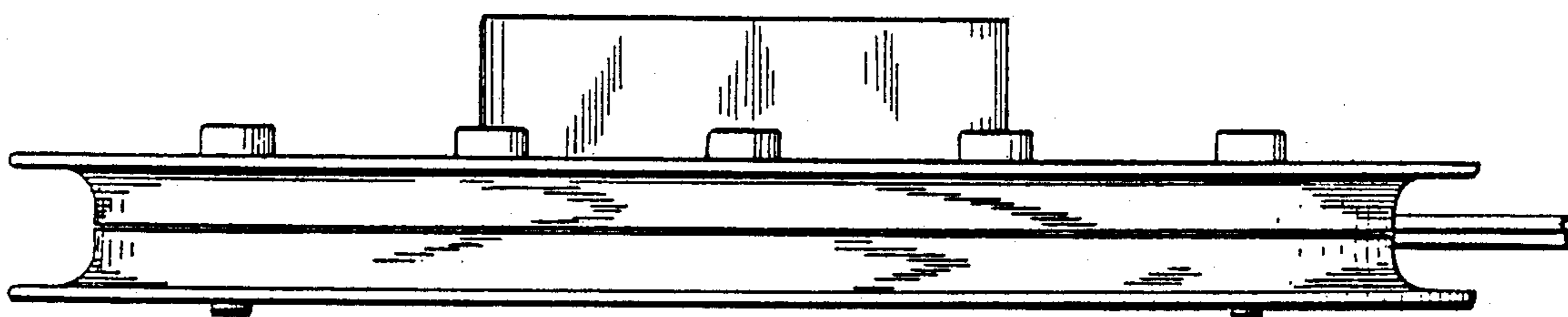

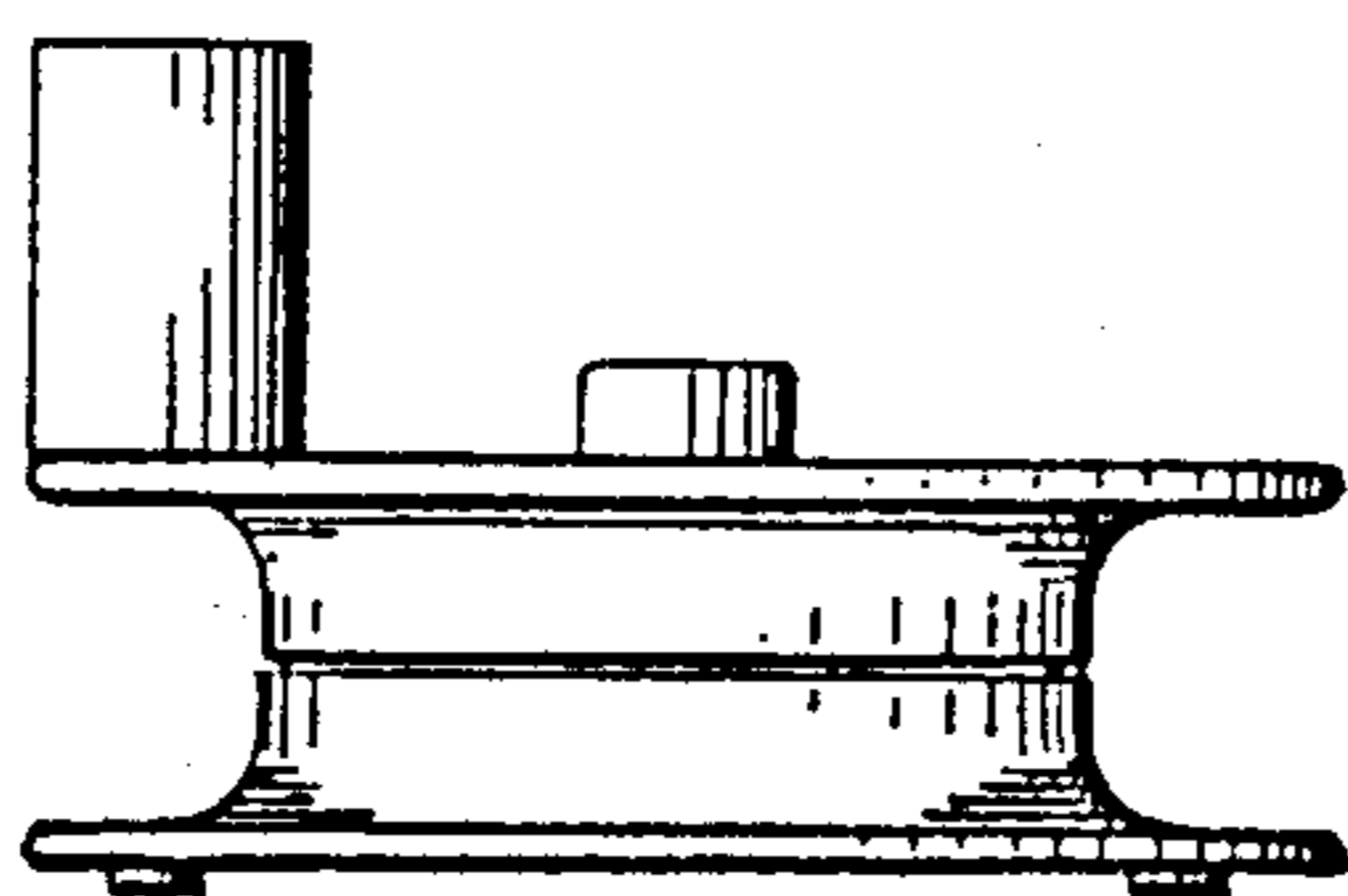

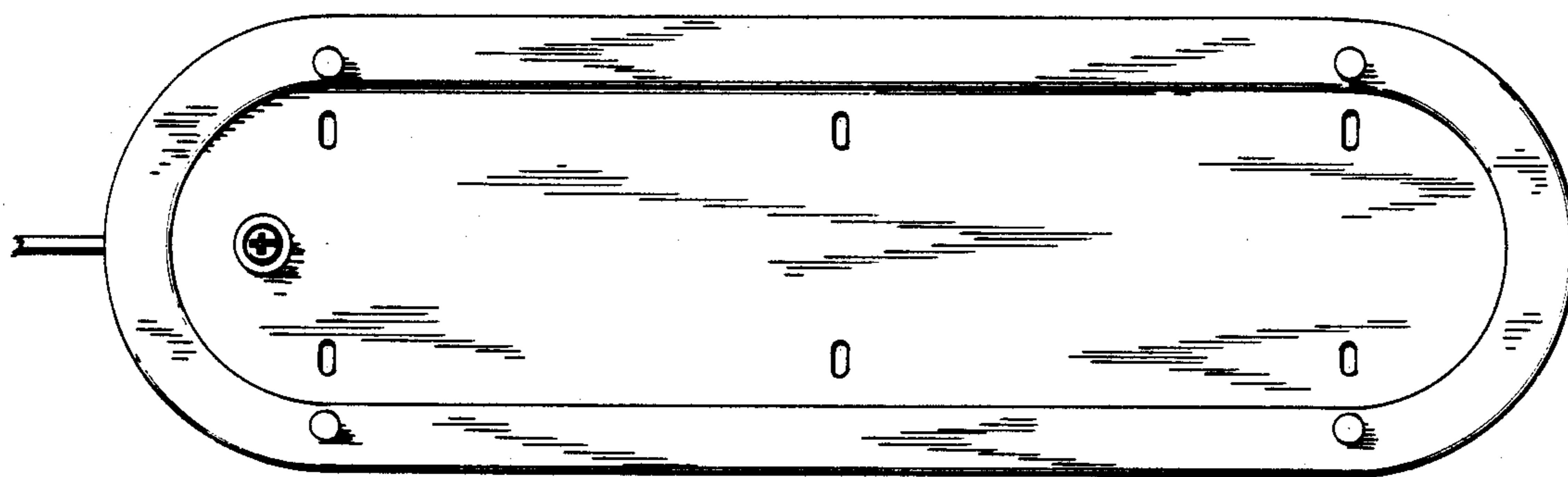

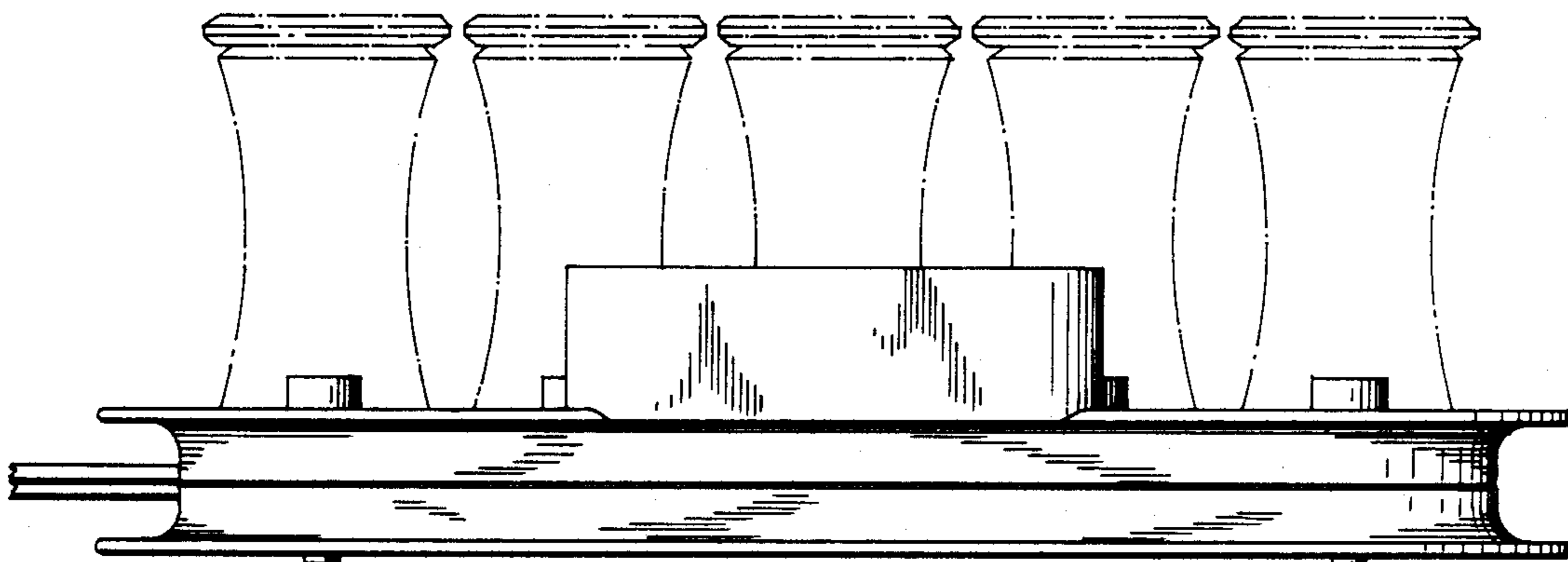
