FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively rear and front elevational views thereof.

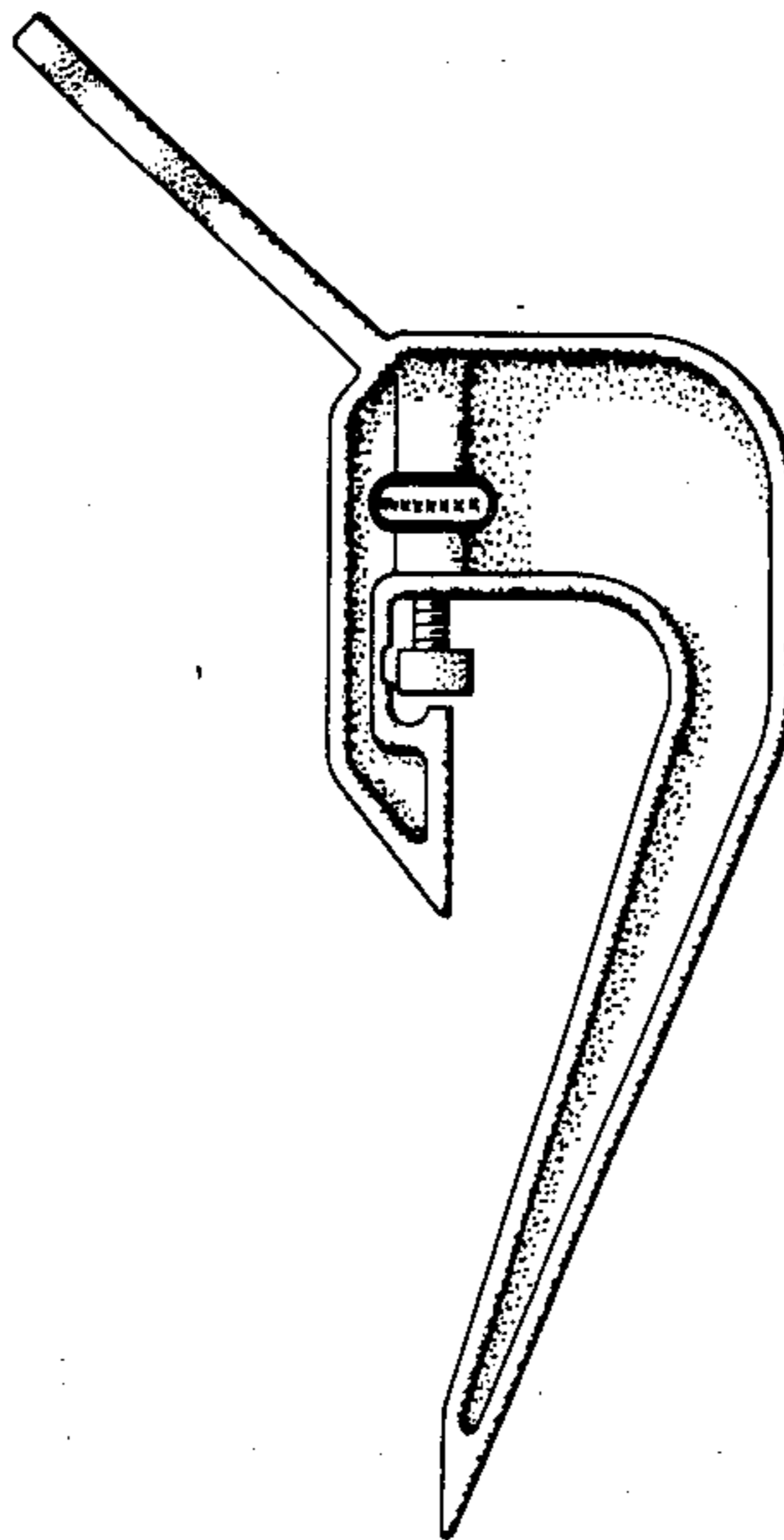

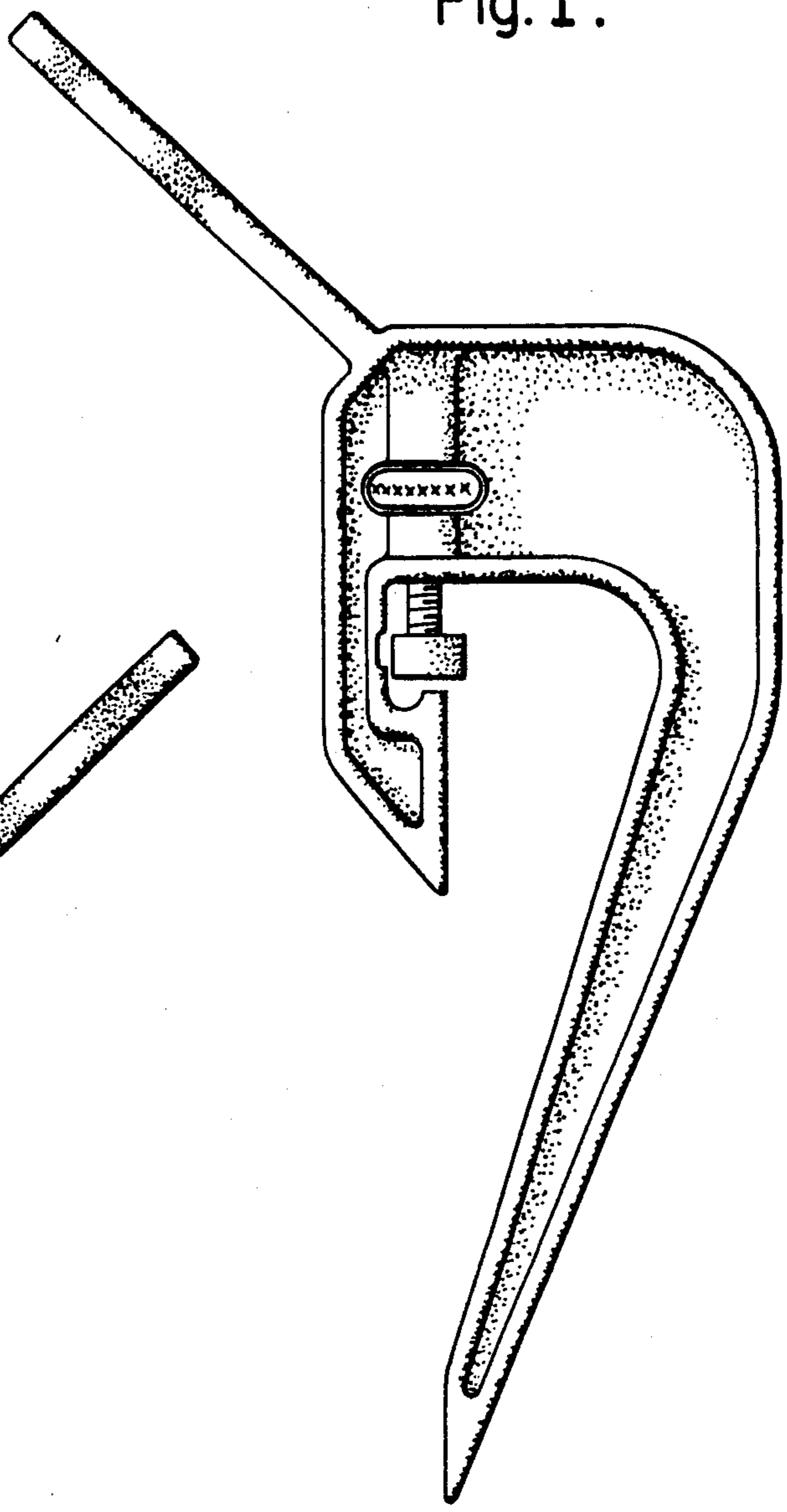

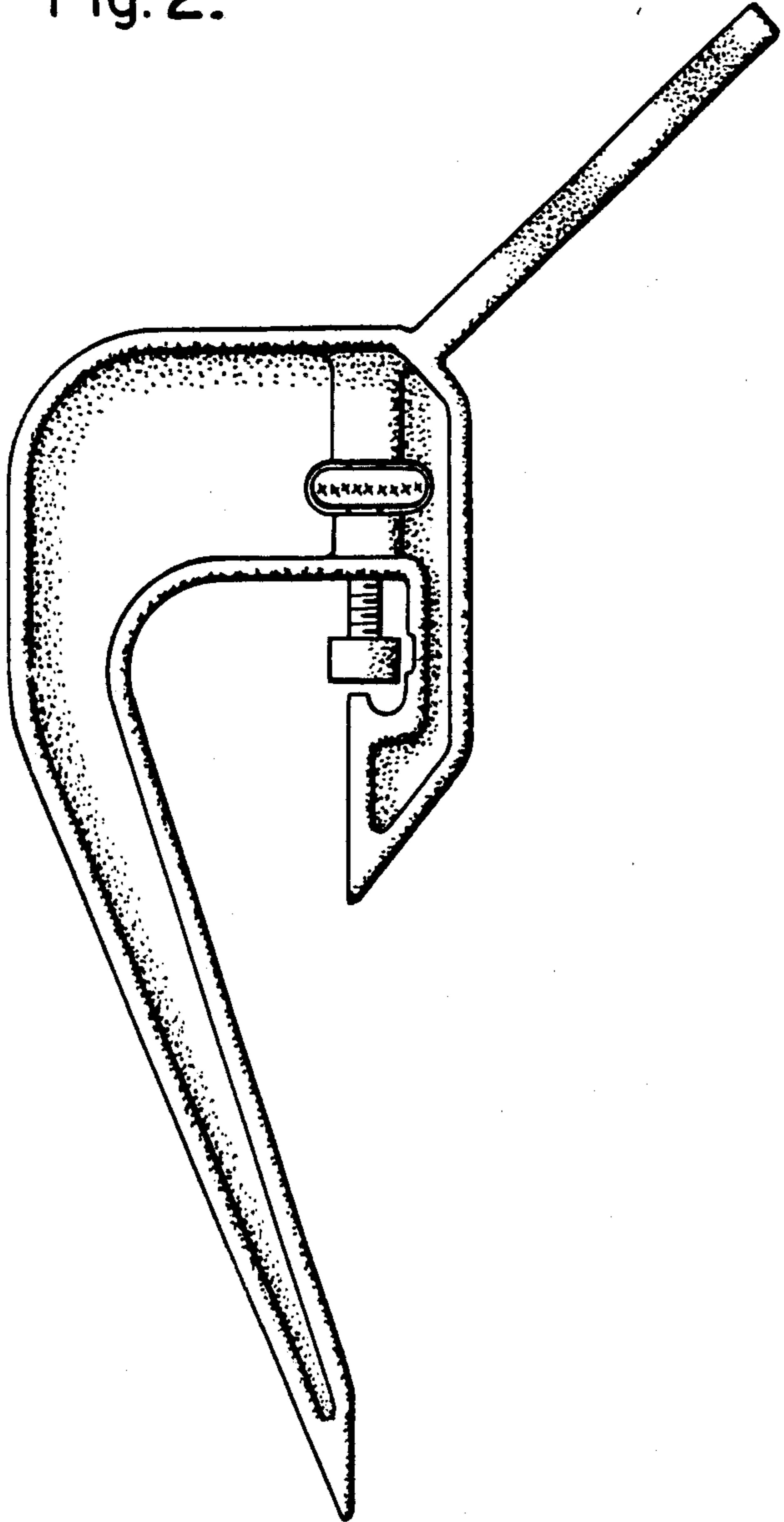

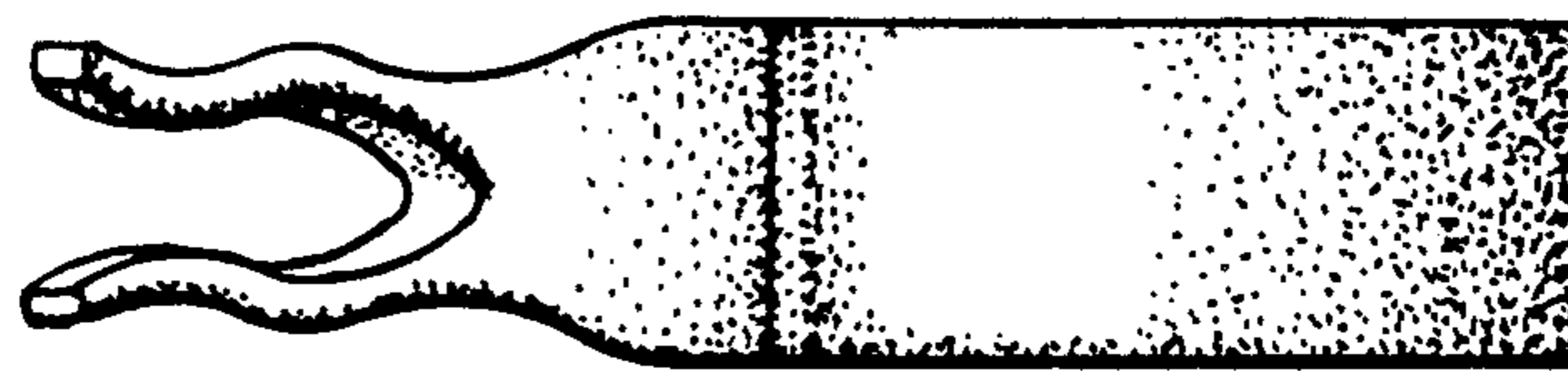

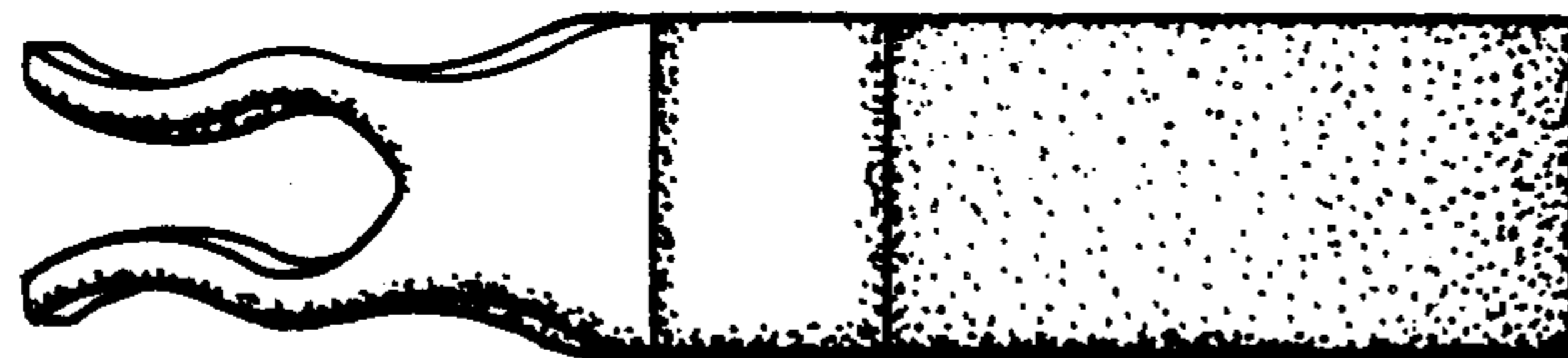
