DESCRIPTION

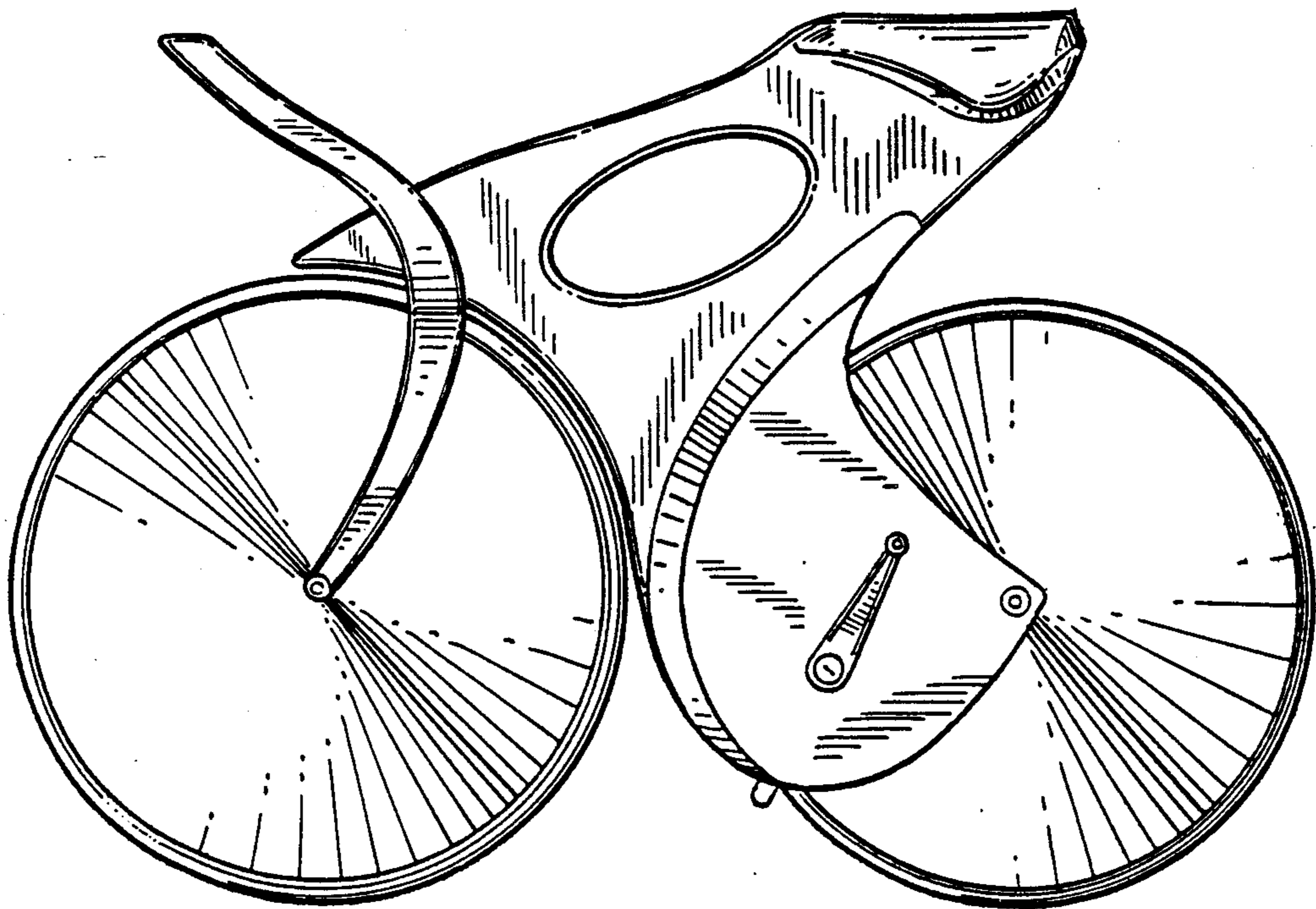
FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a bicycle showing my new design it being understood that the opposite side is a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



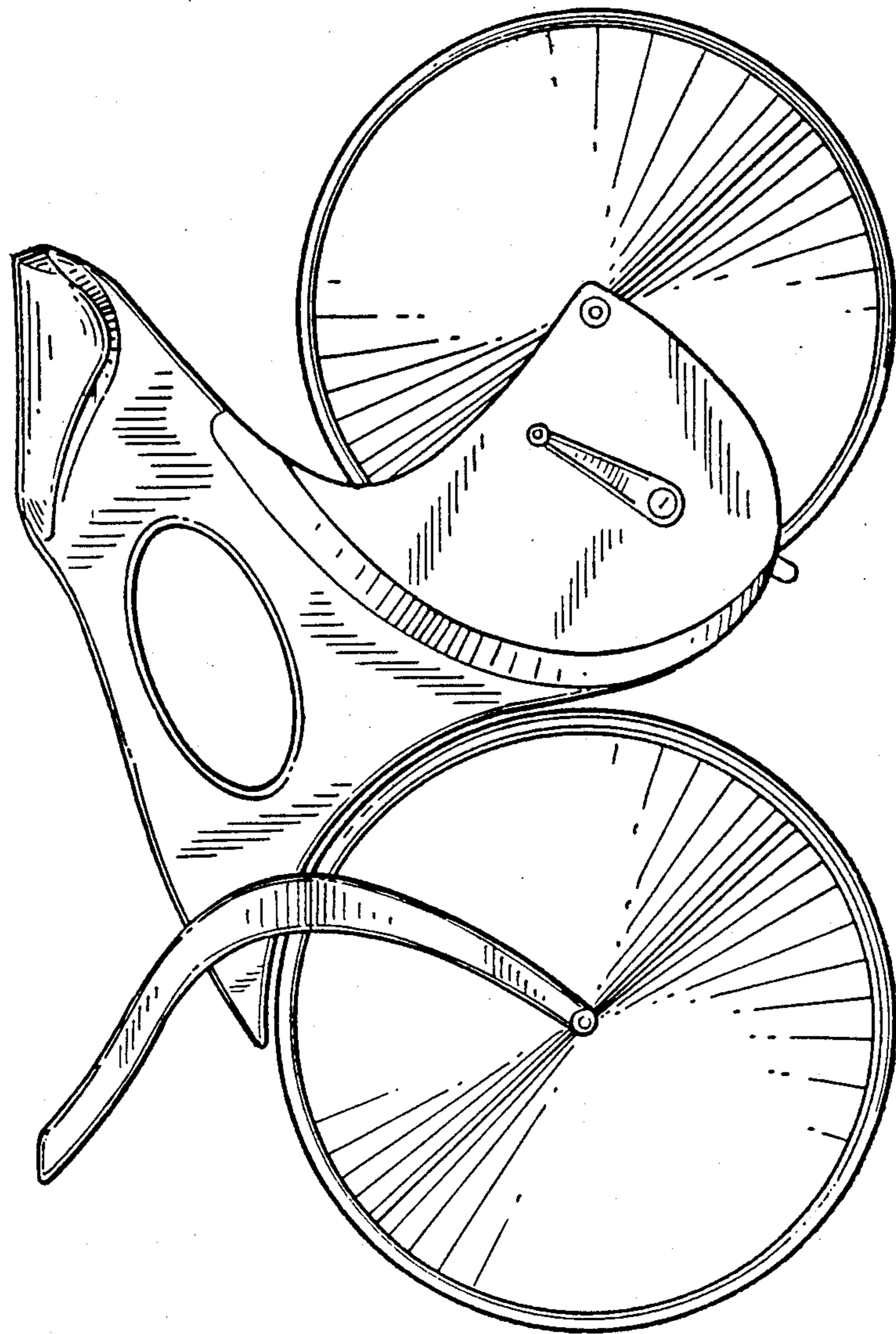

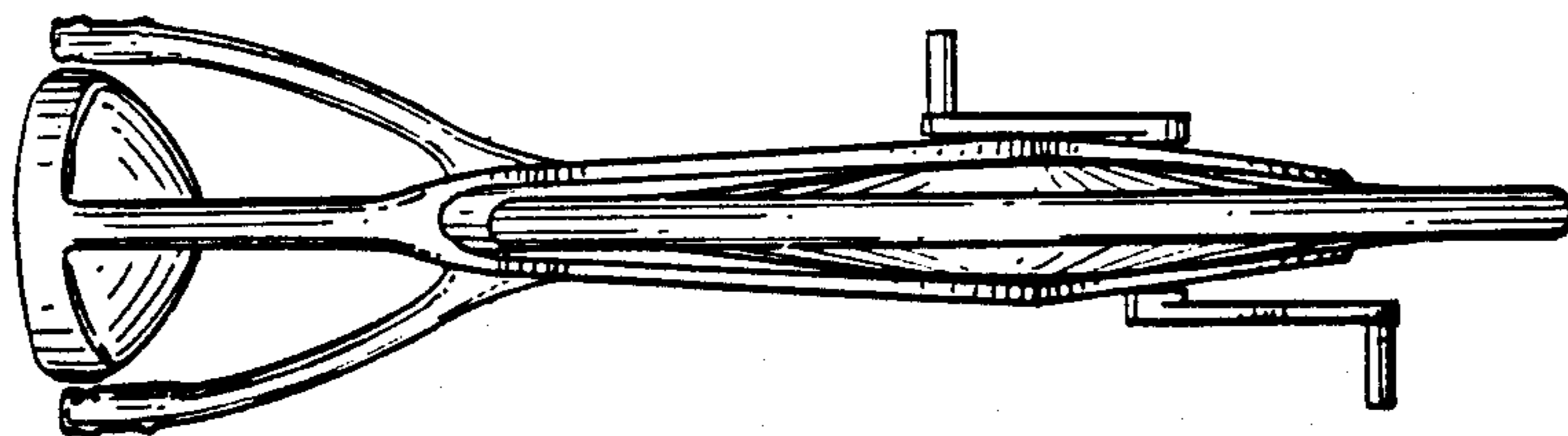

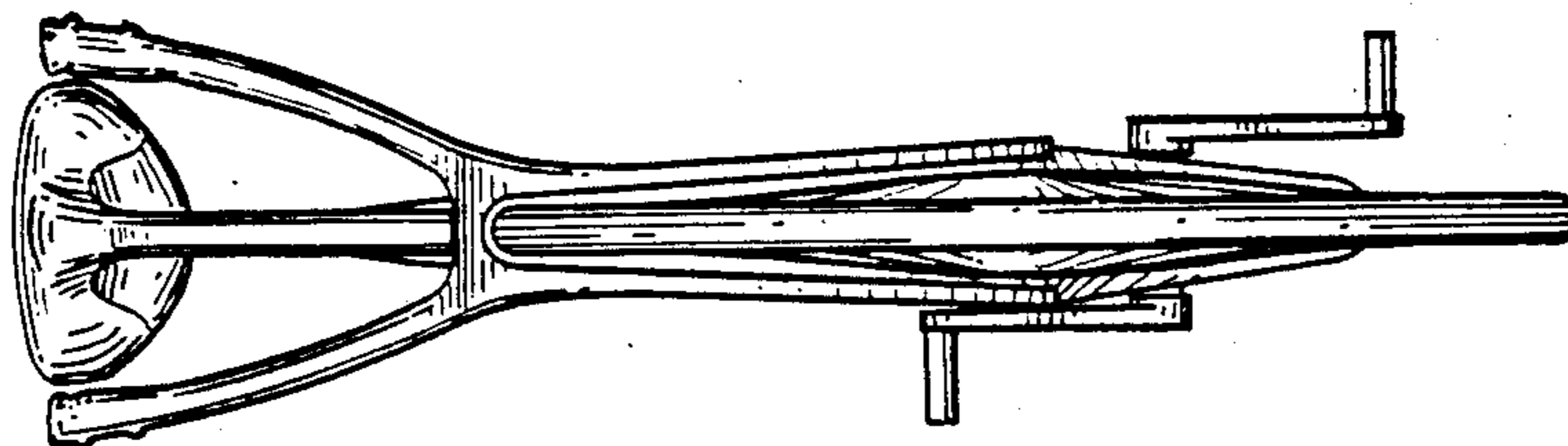

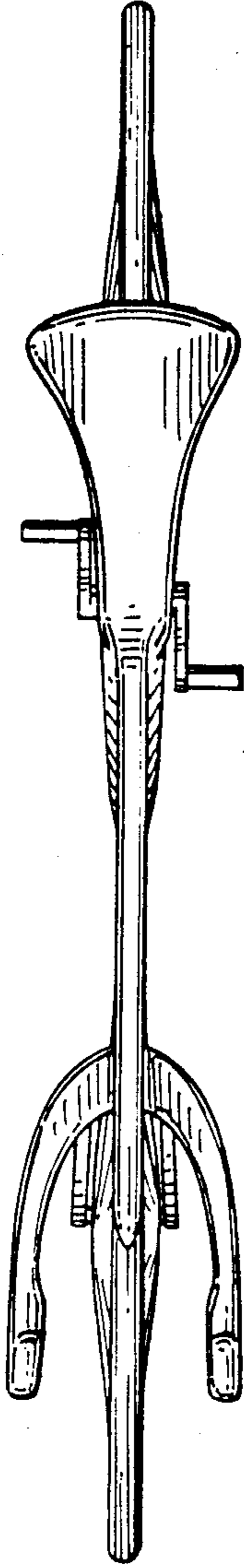

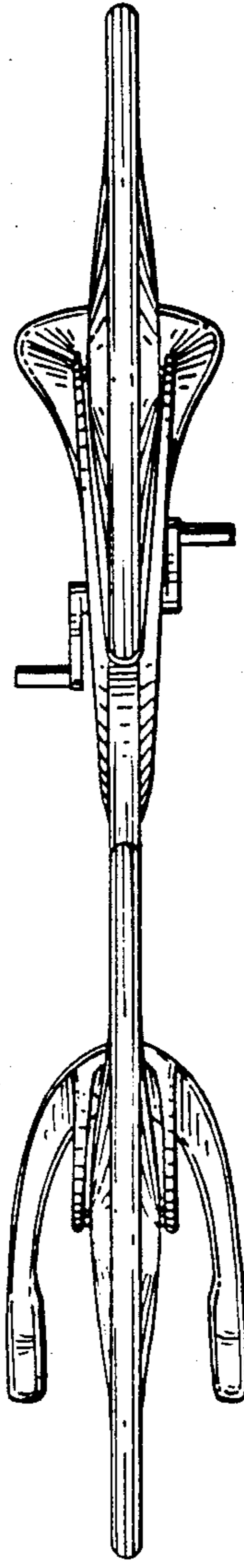
