FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a playing card showing my new design;

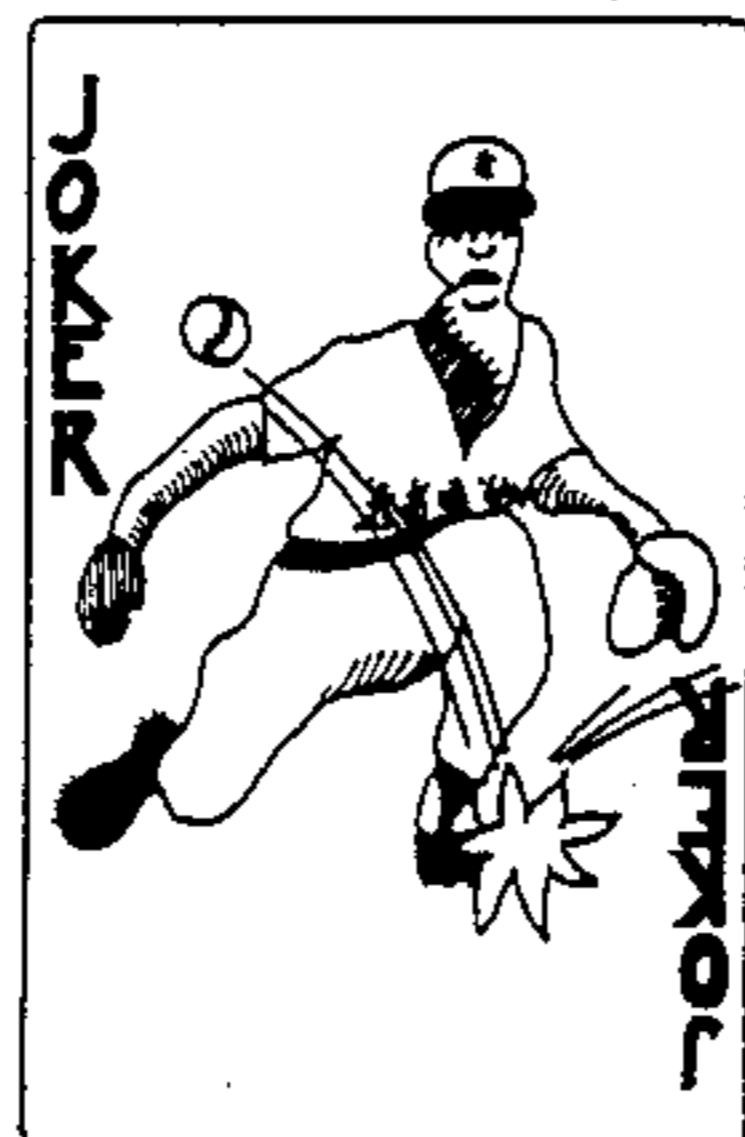
FIG. 2 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a side view thereof, the side opposite appearing the same.



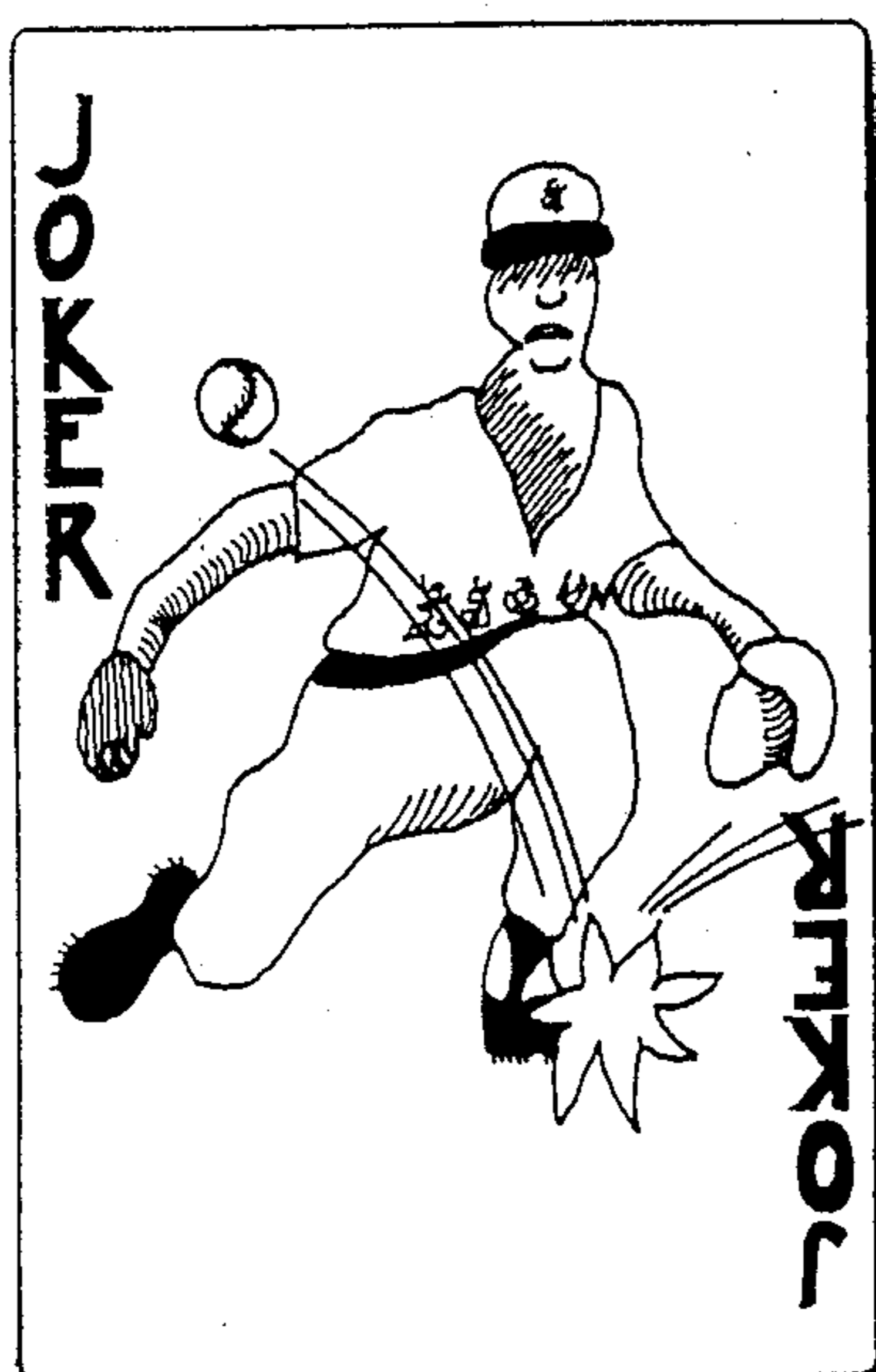

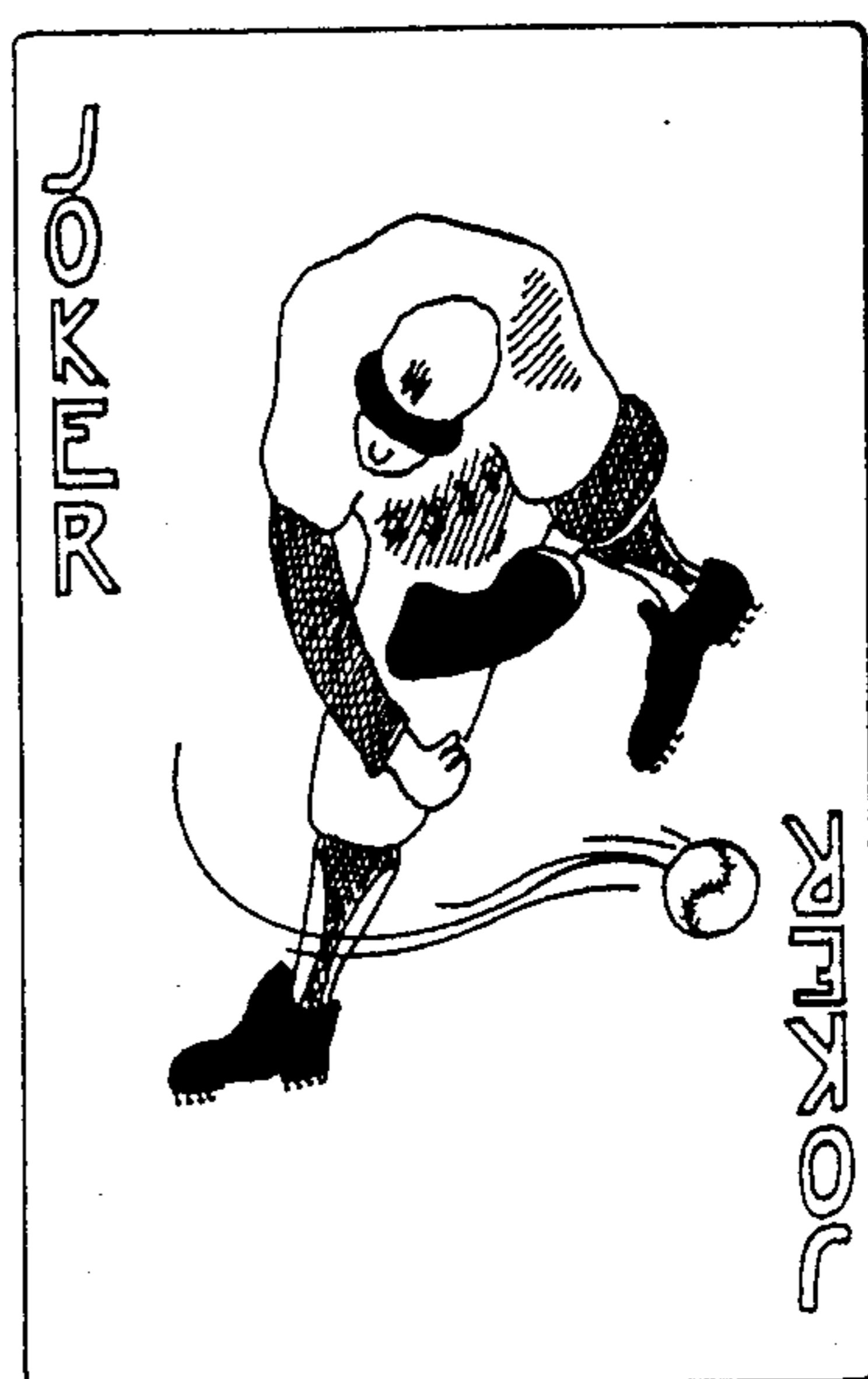

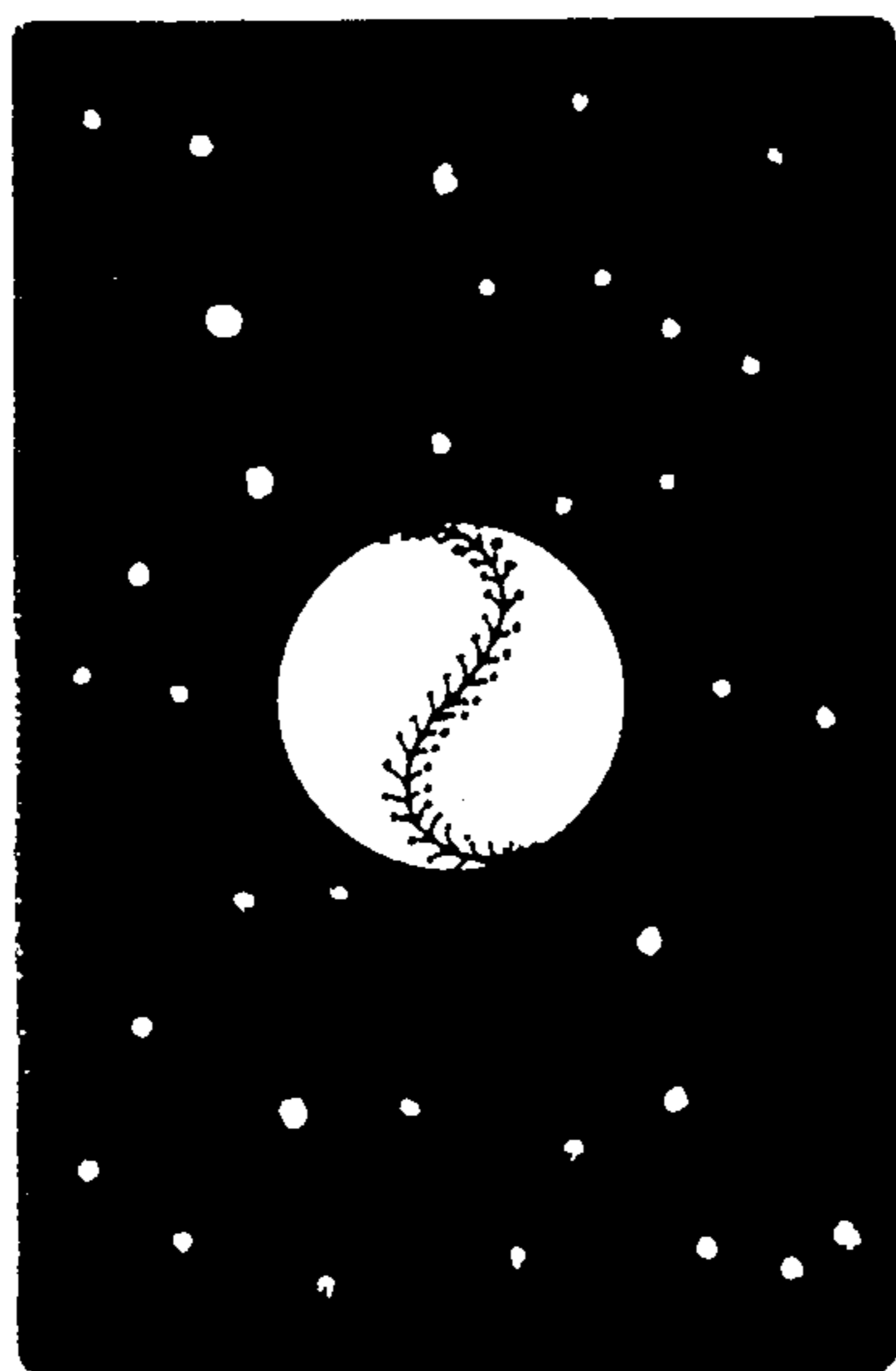

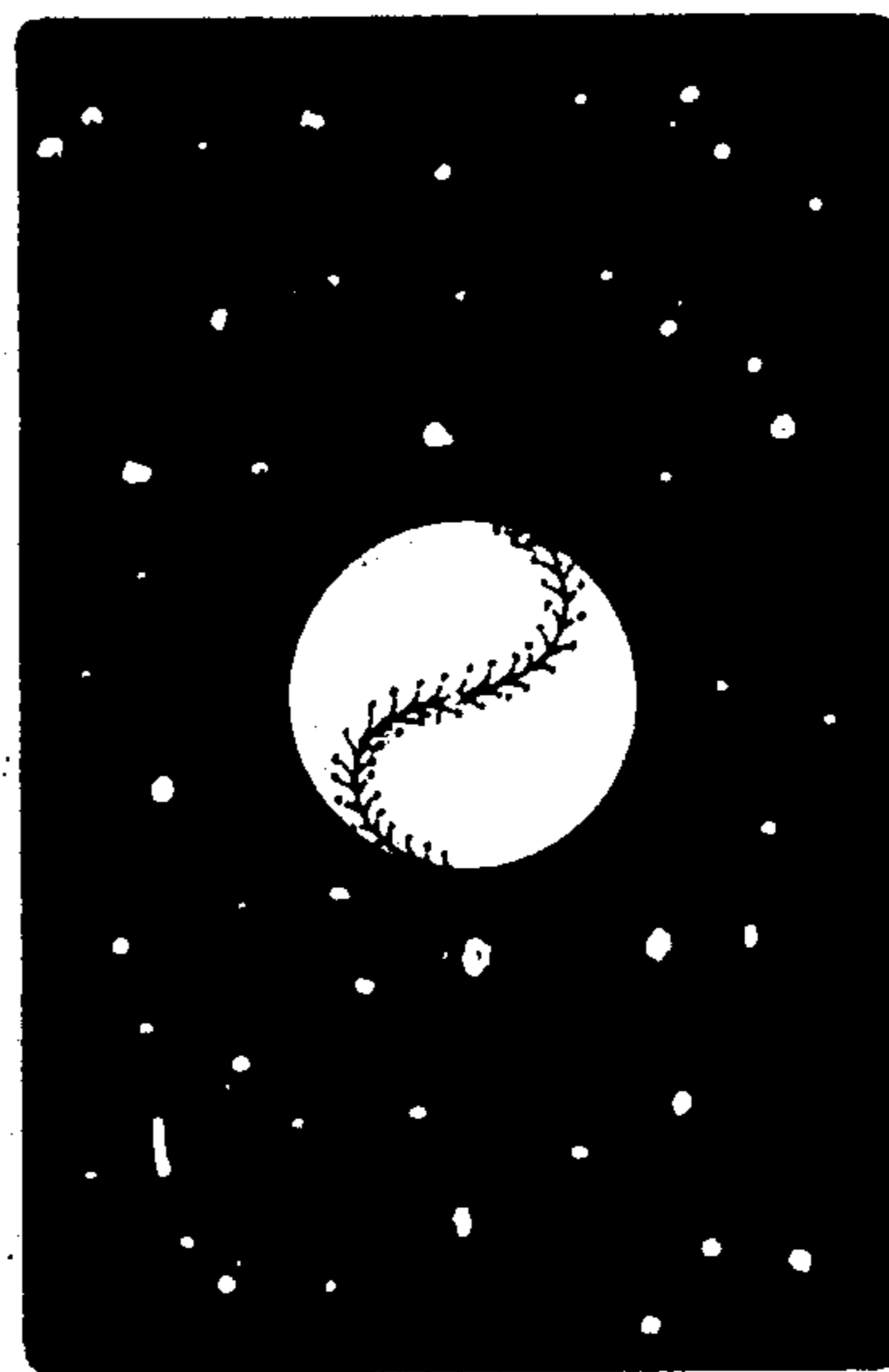
