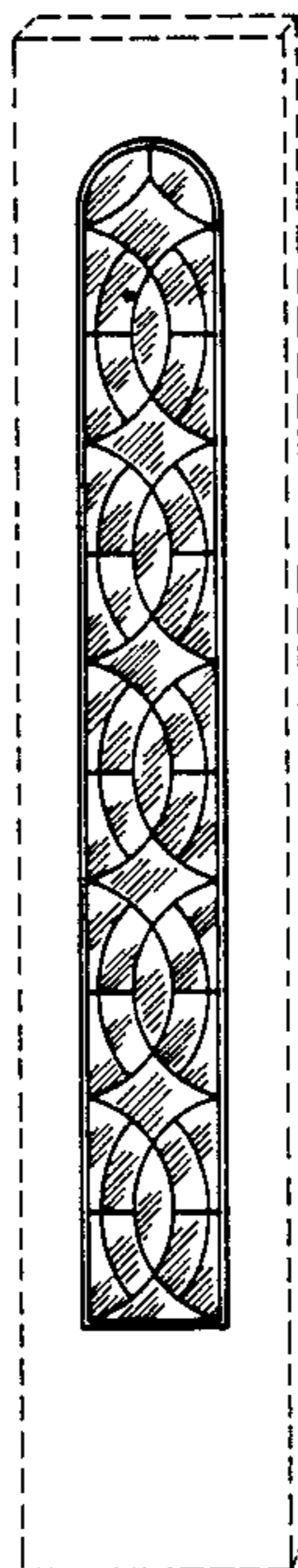

of the front.



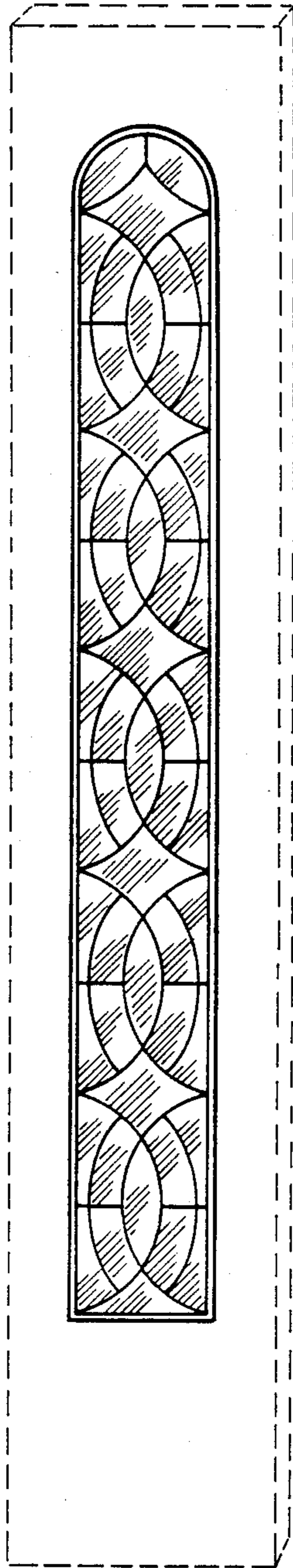
