The ornamental design for integral holder for both paint cover and brush, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIGS. 1 and 2 are respectively right and left side elevational views, of an integral holder for both paint and can brush showing my new design;

FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively front and rear elevational views thereof.

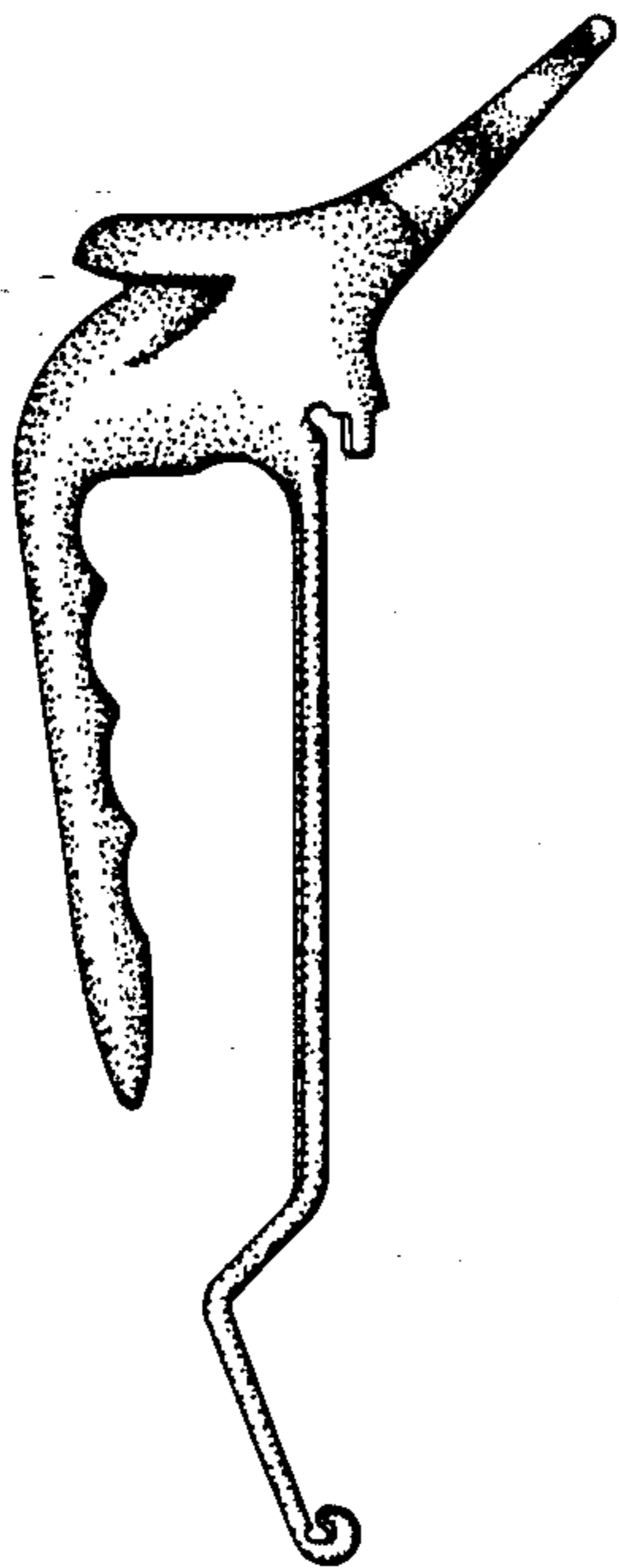

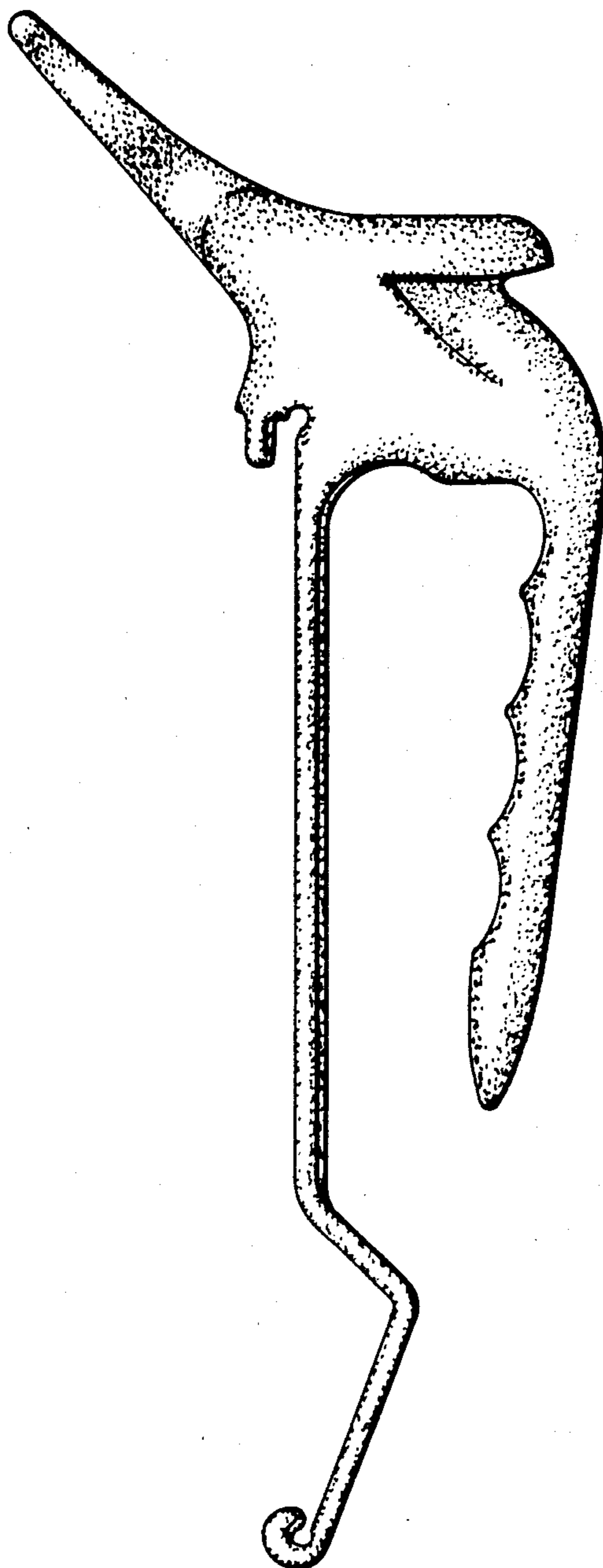
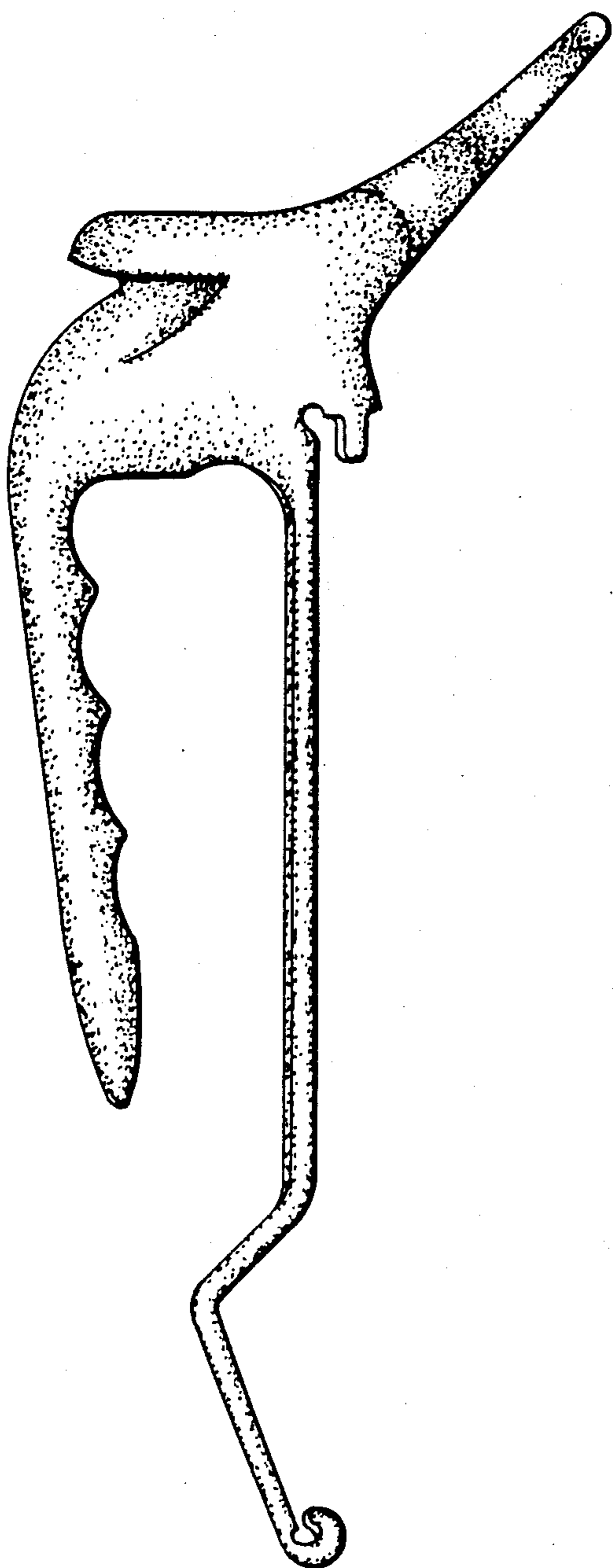

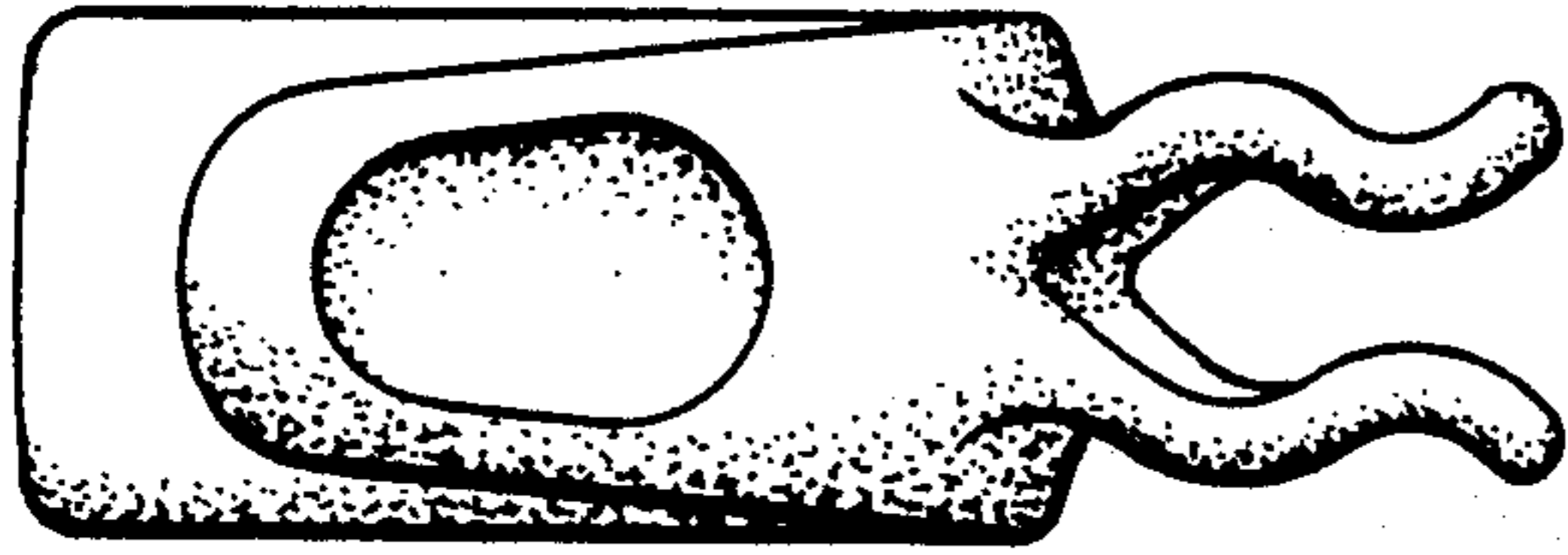

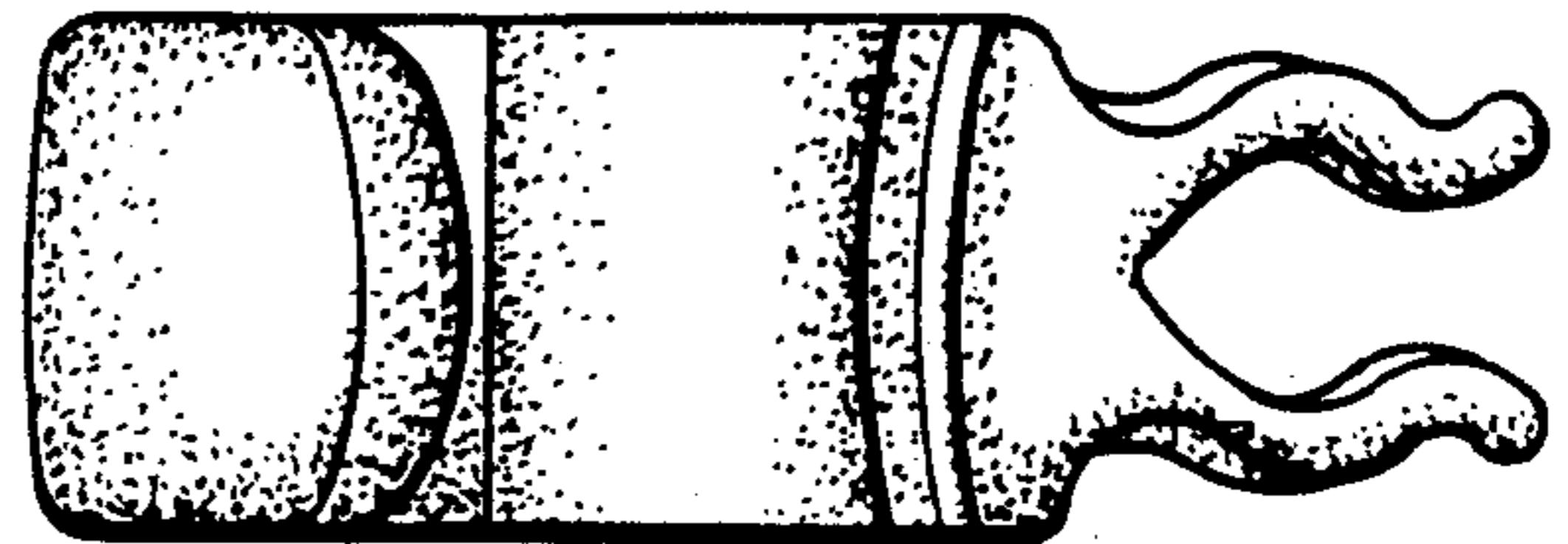

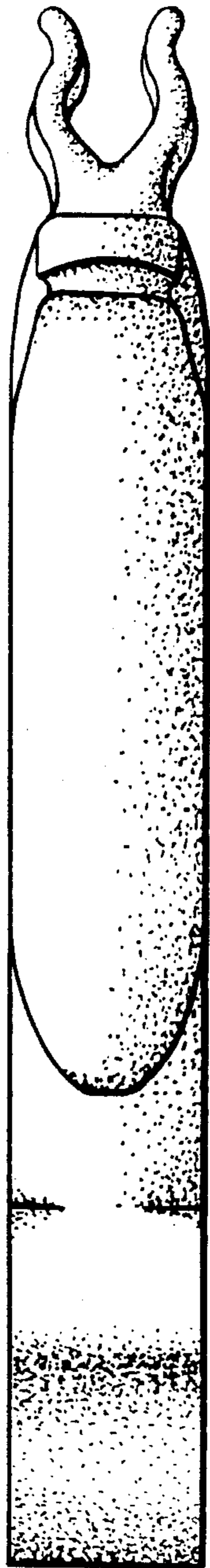
