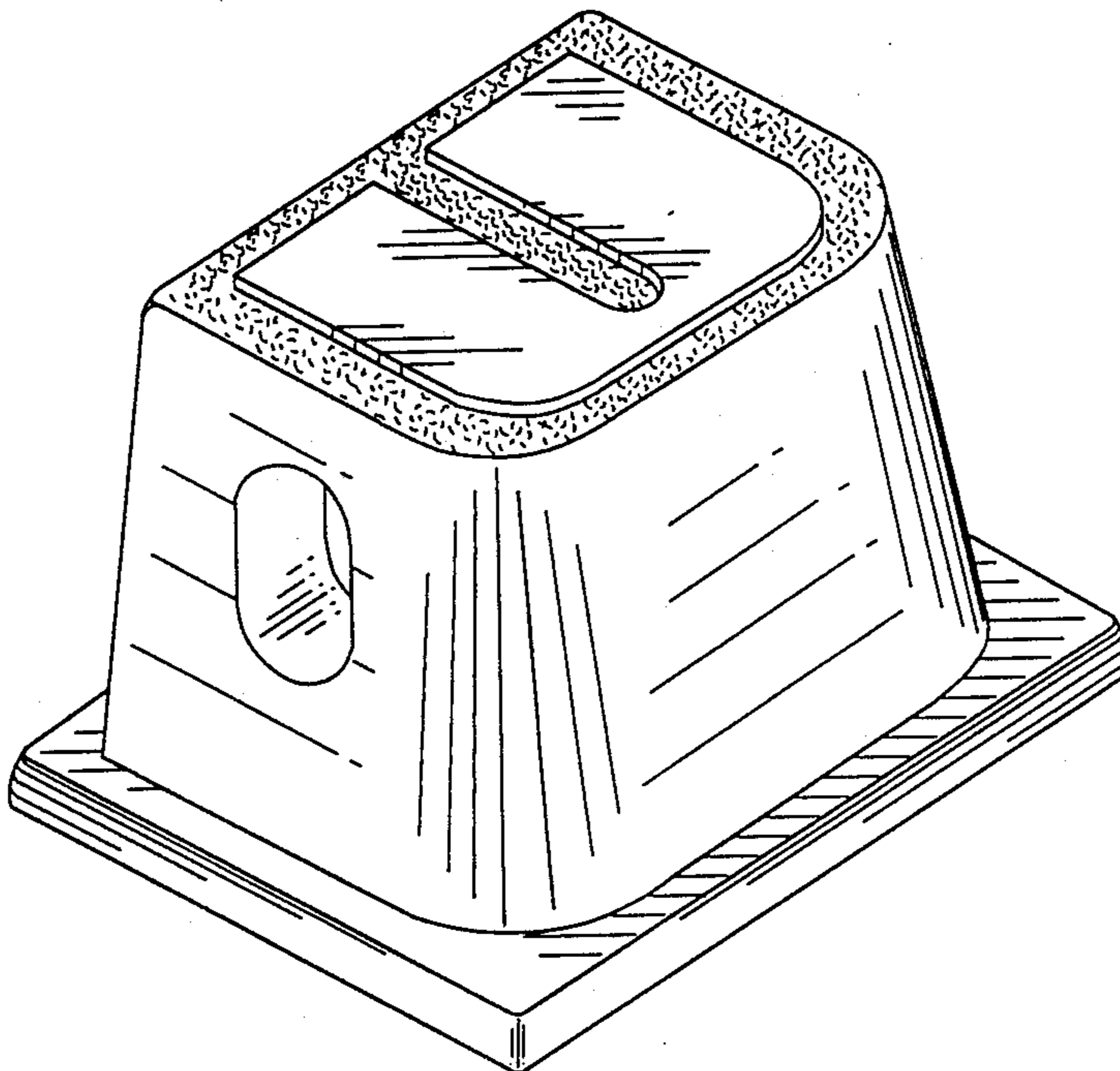

DESCRIPTION

 FIG. 8 is a bottom, rear perspective view thereof.



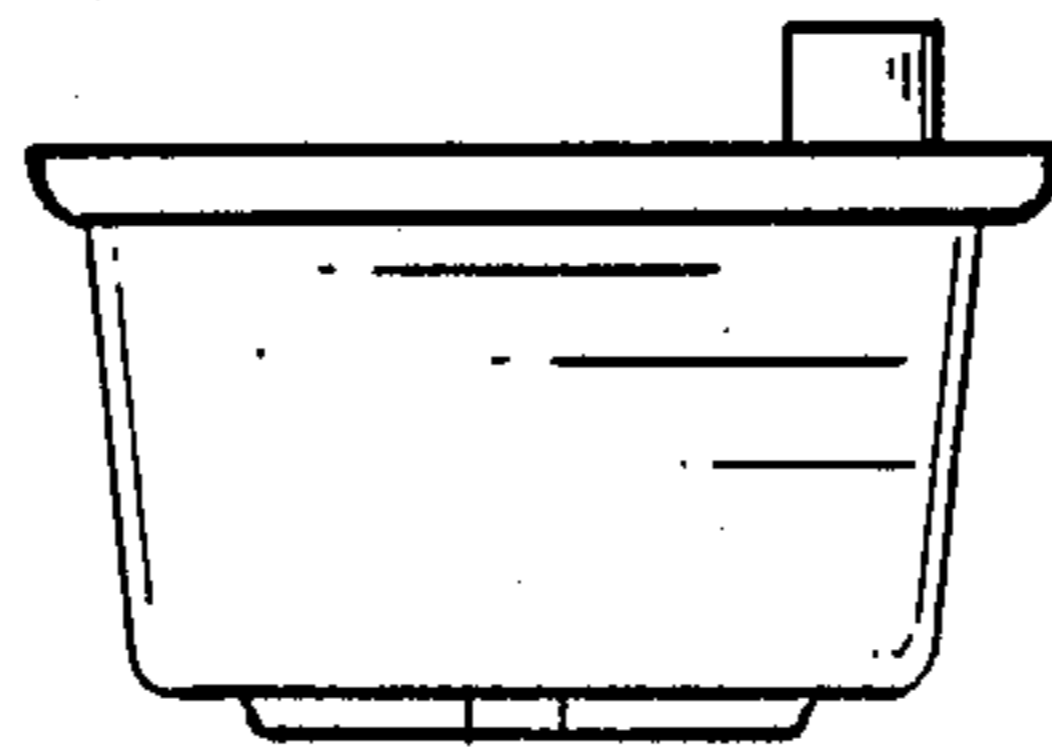

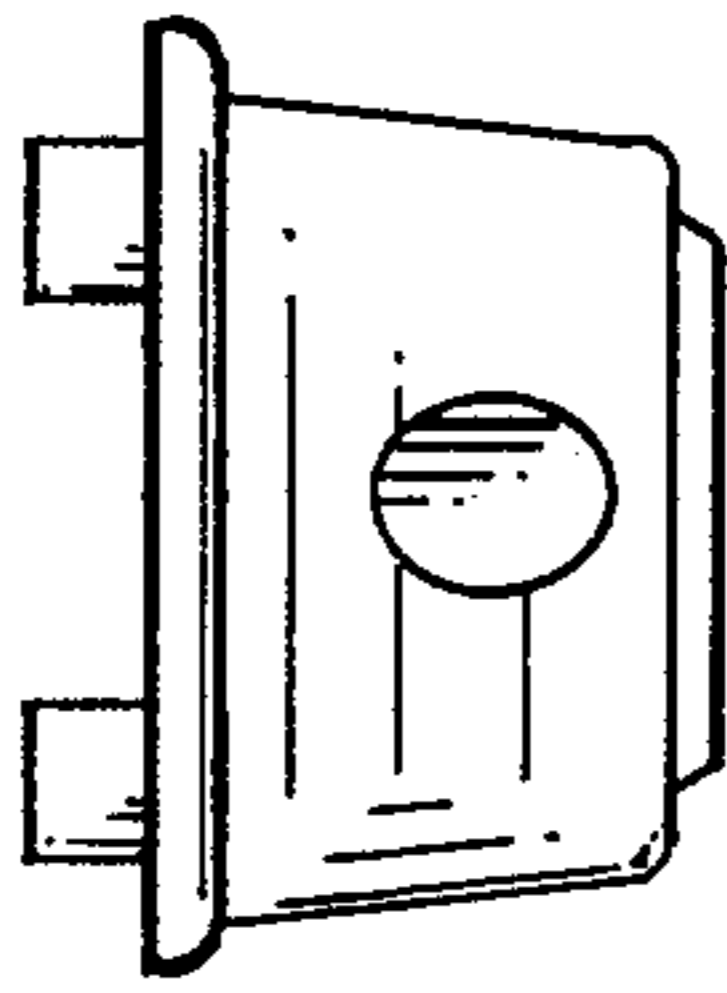

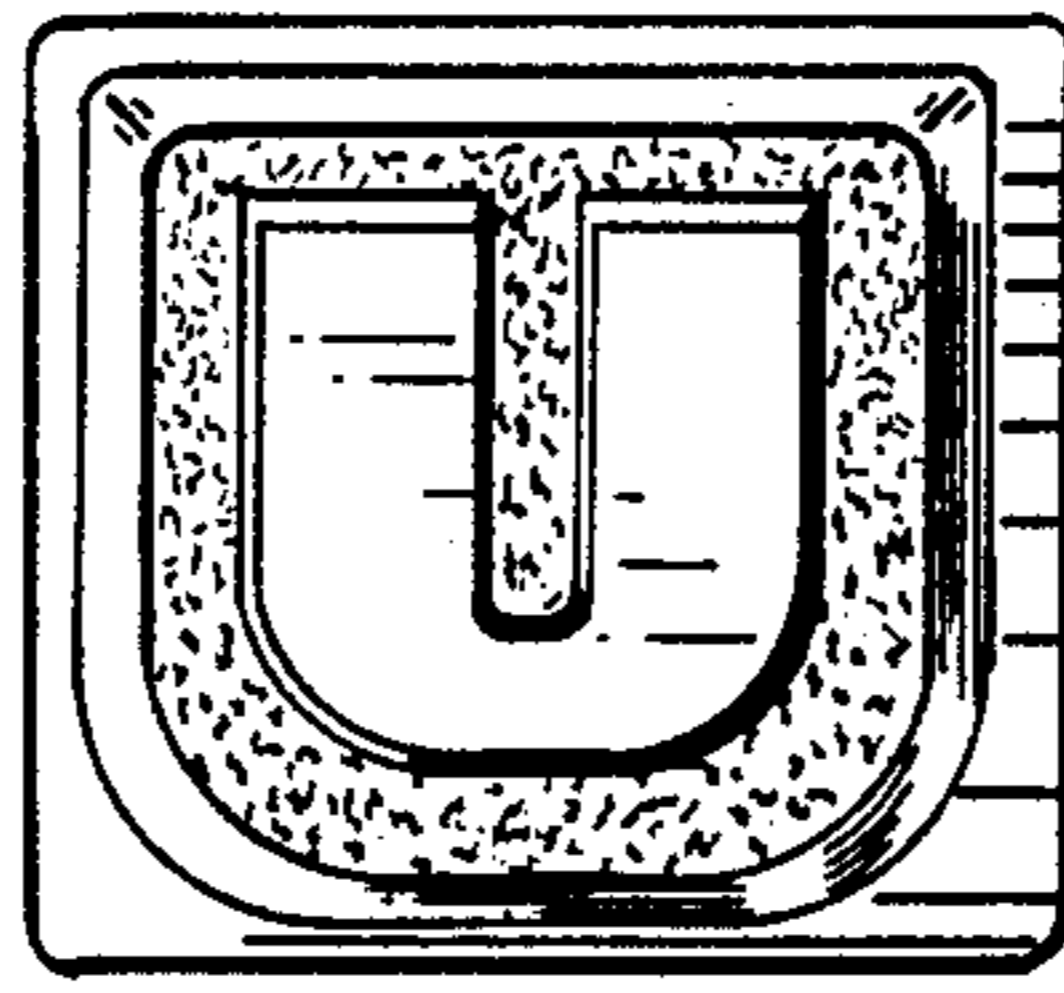

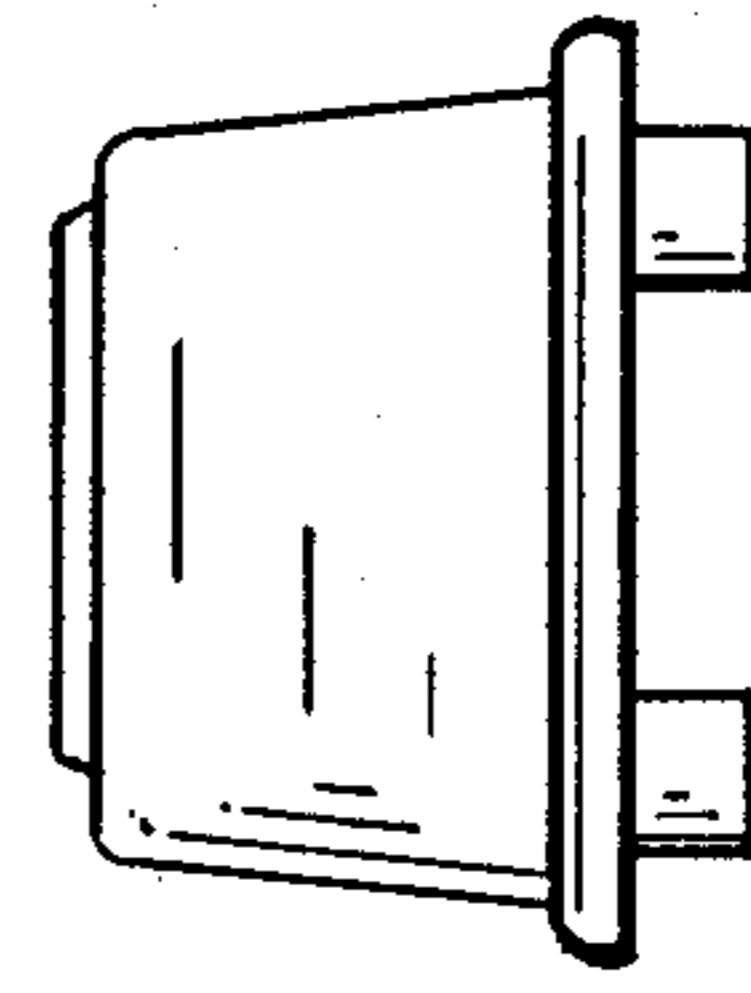

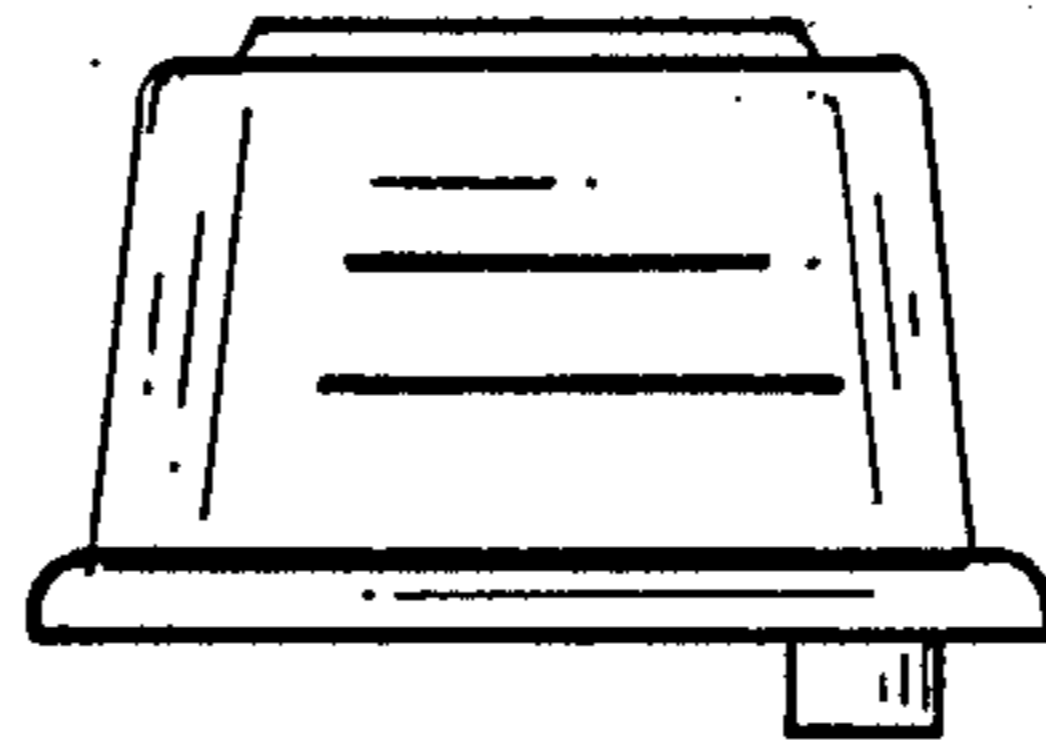

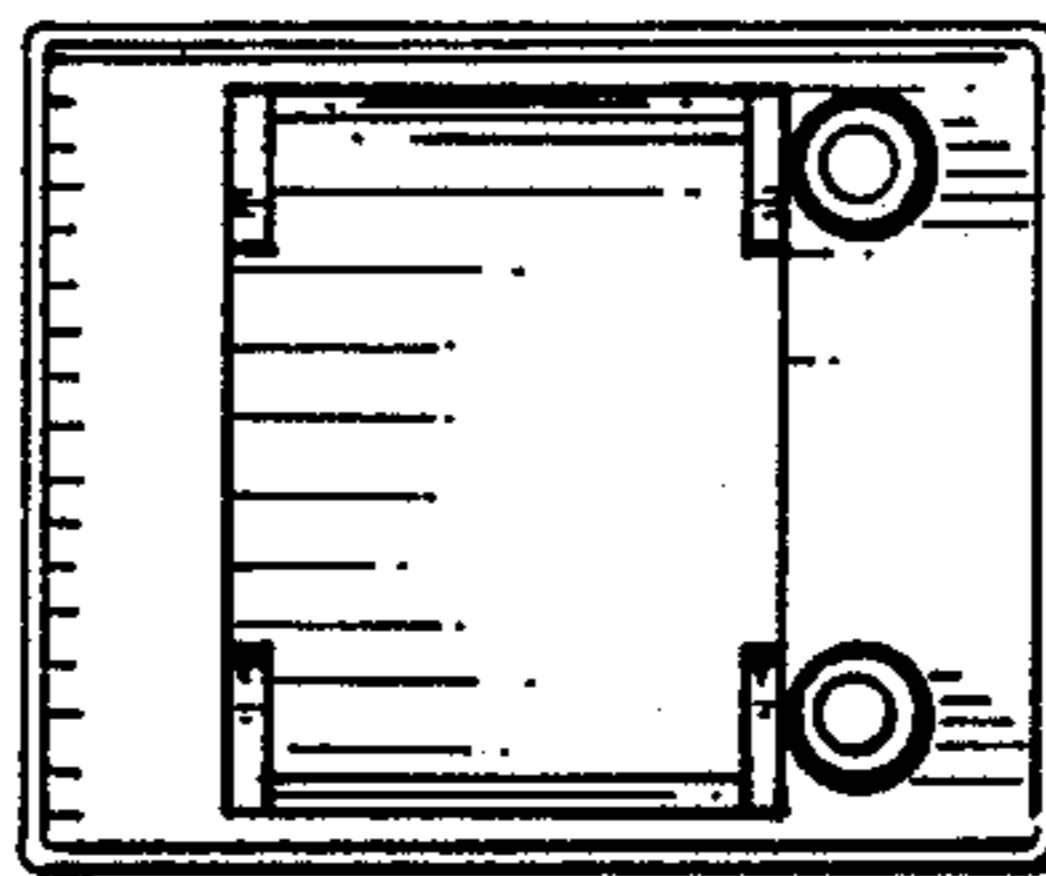

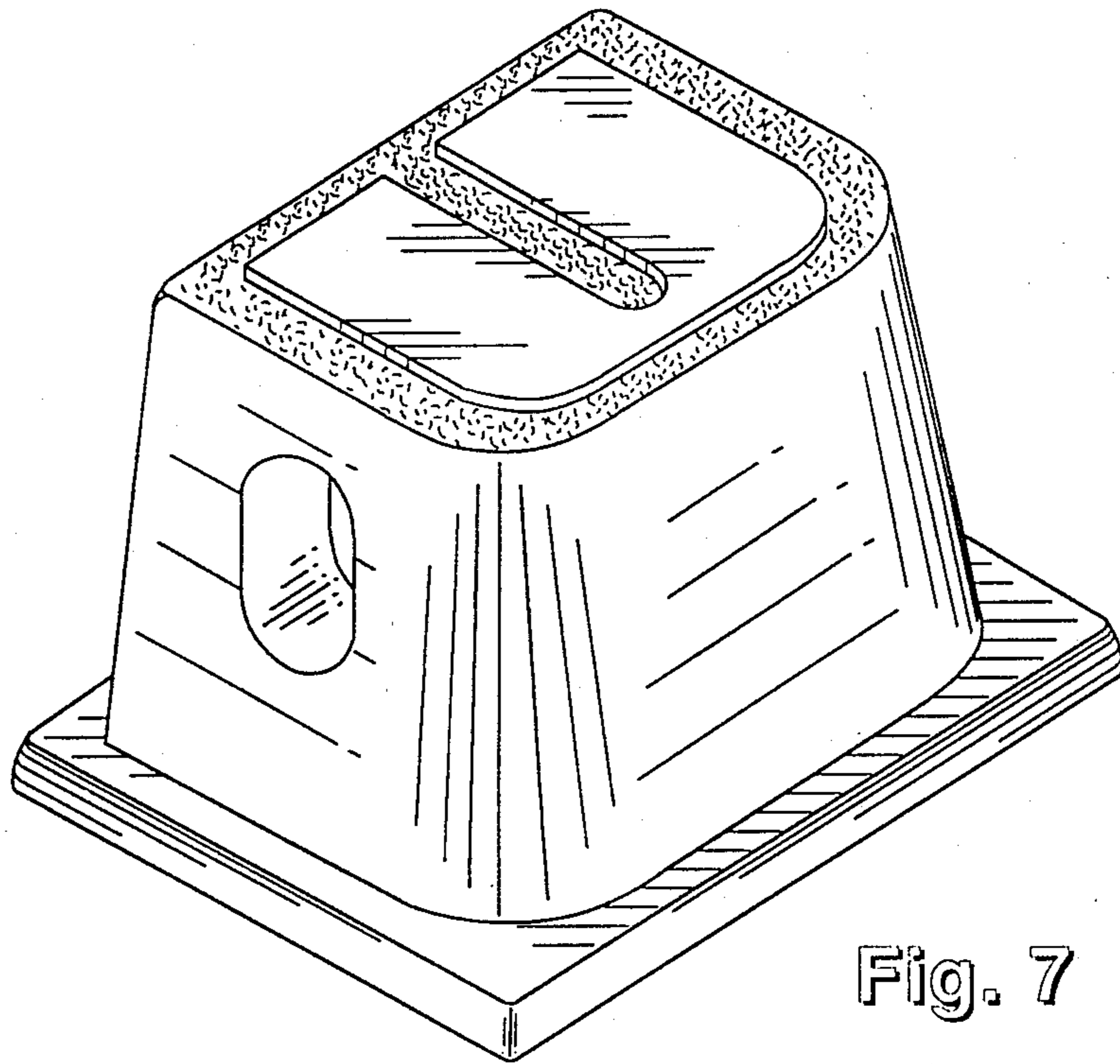

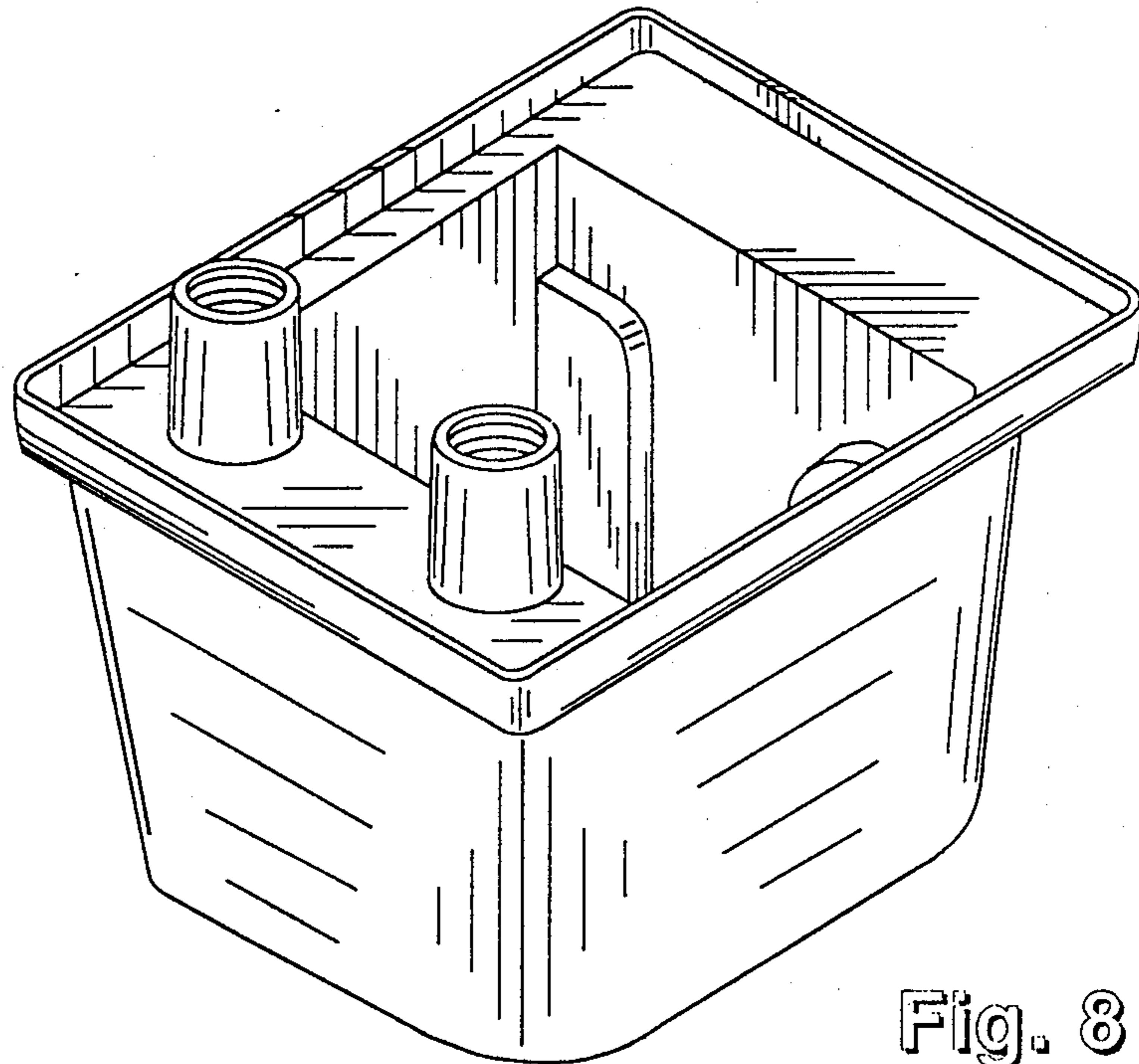
