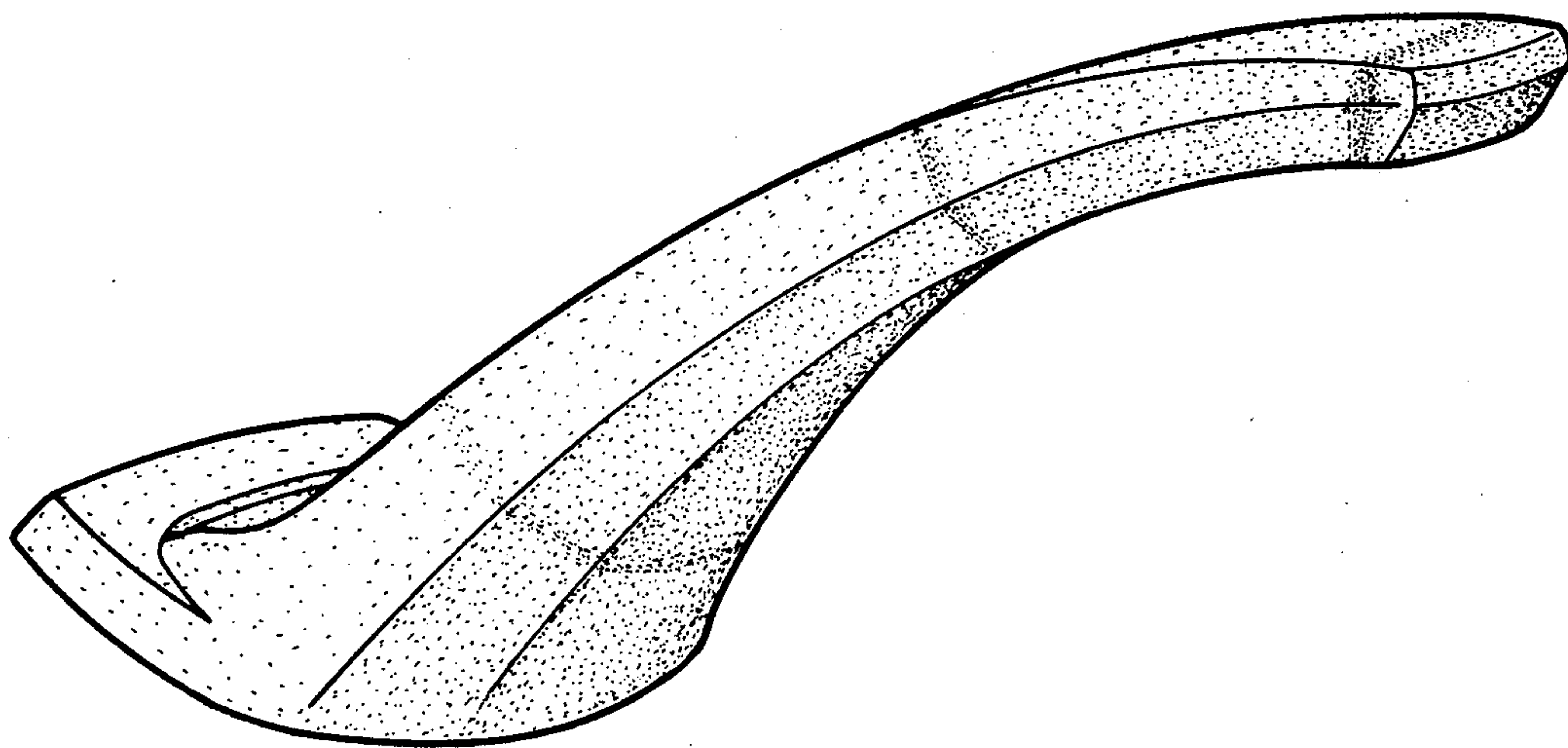

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a spout, showing our new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



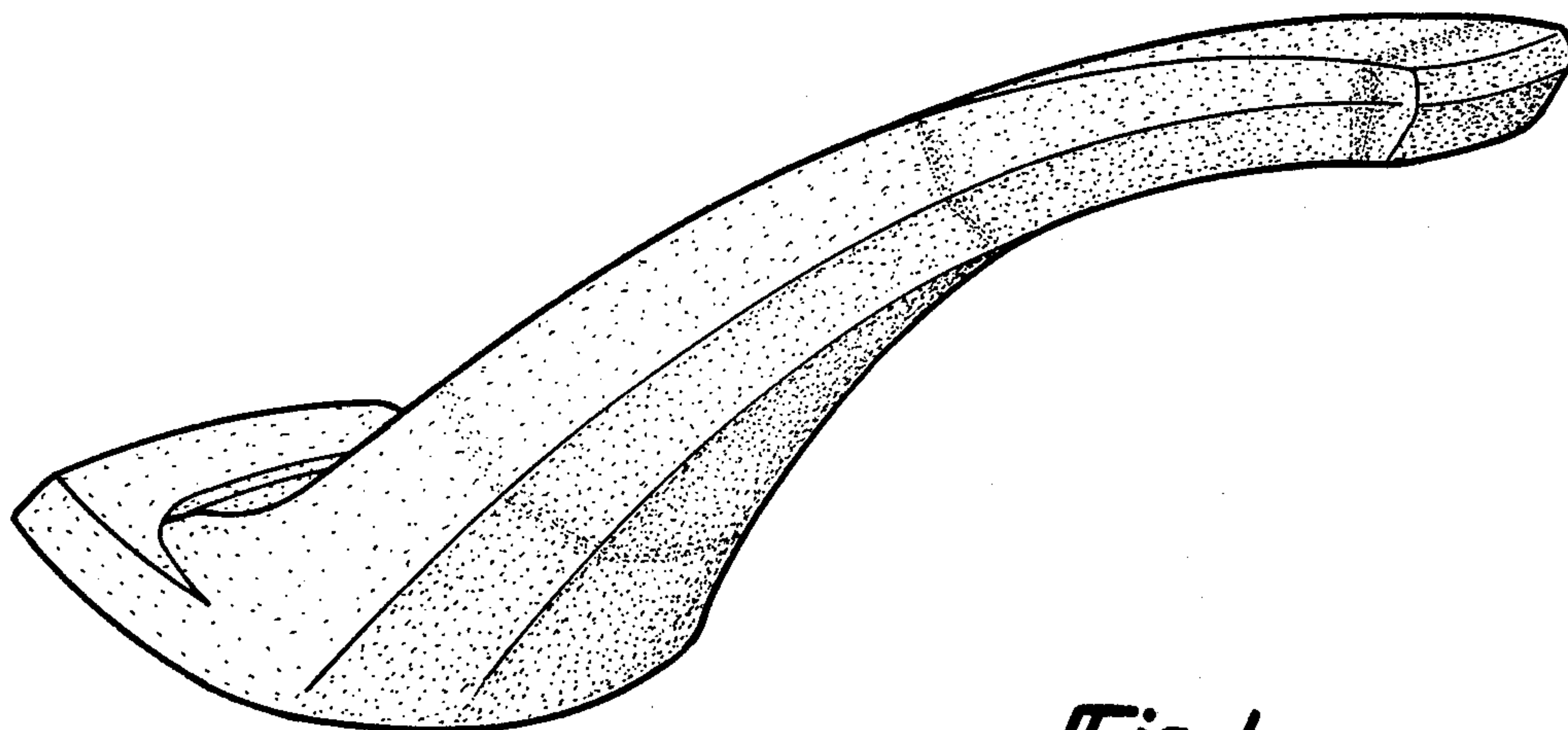

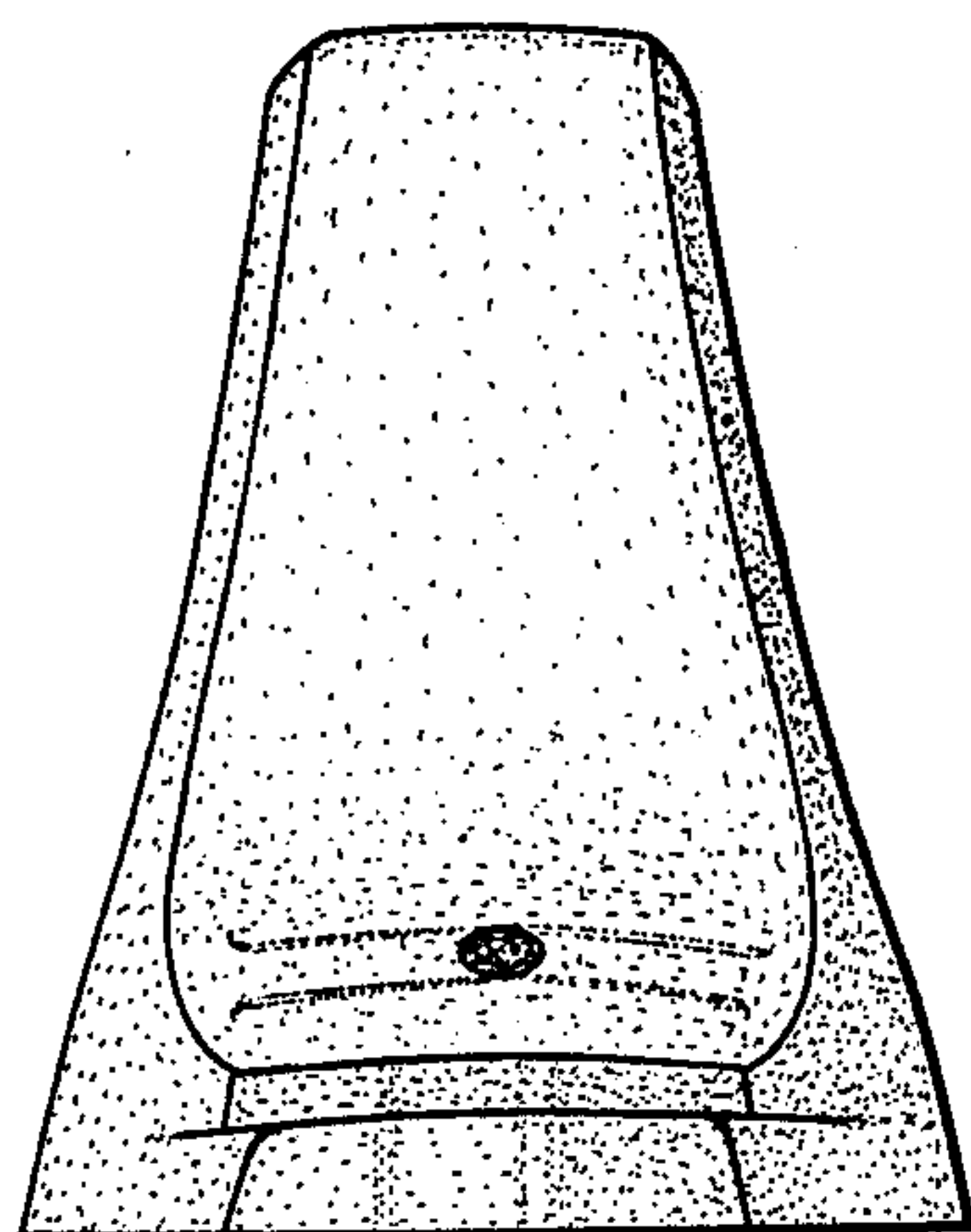

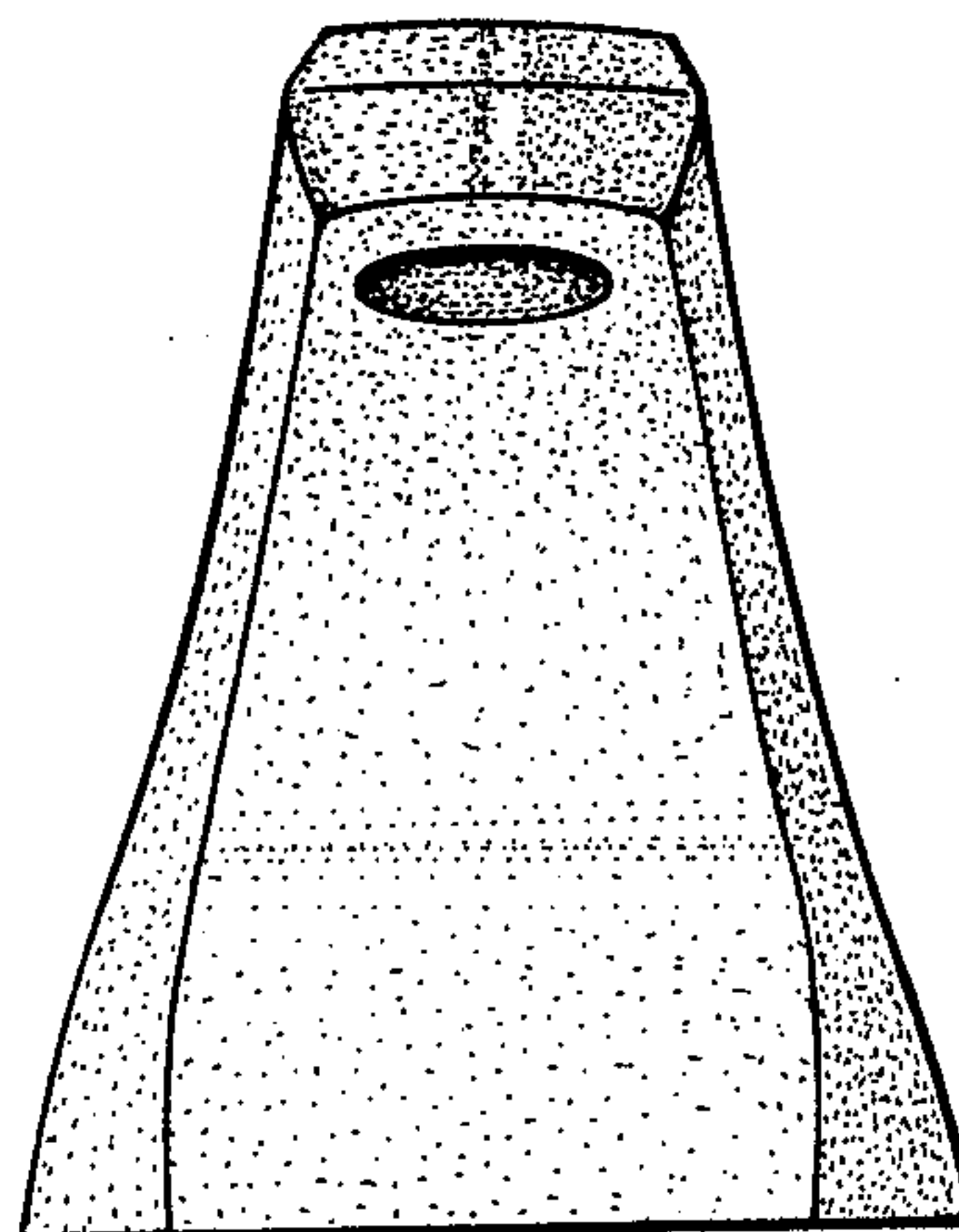

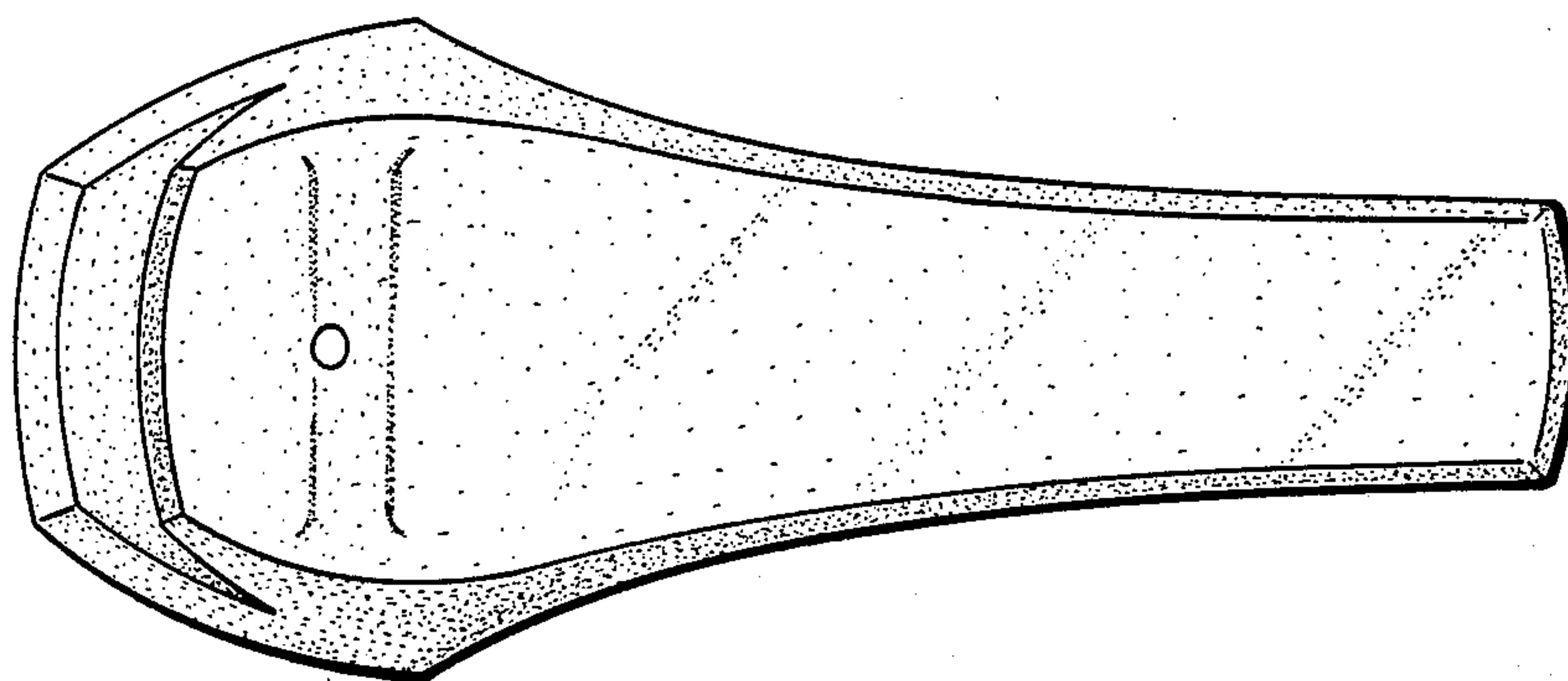

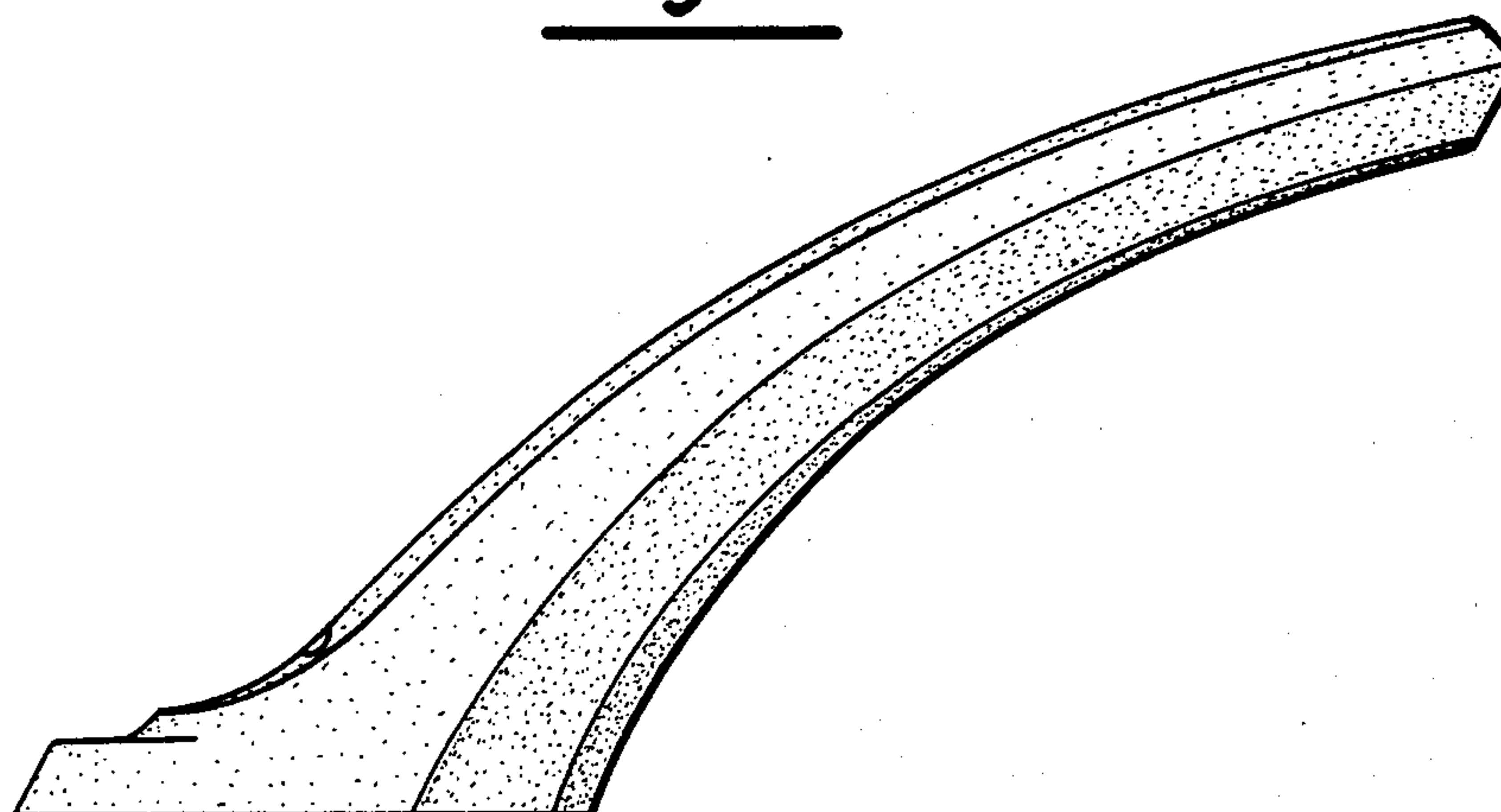

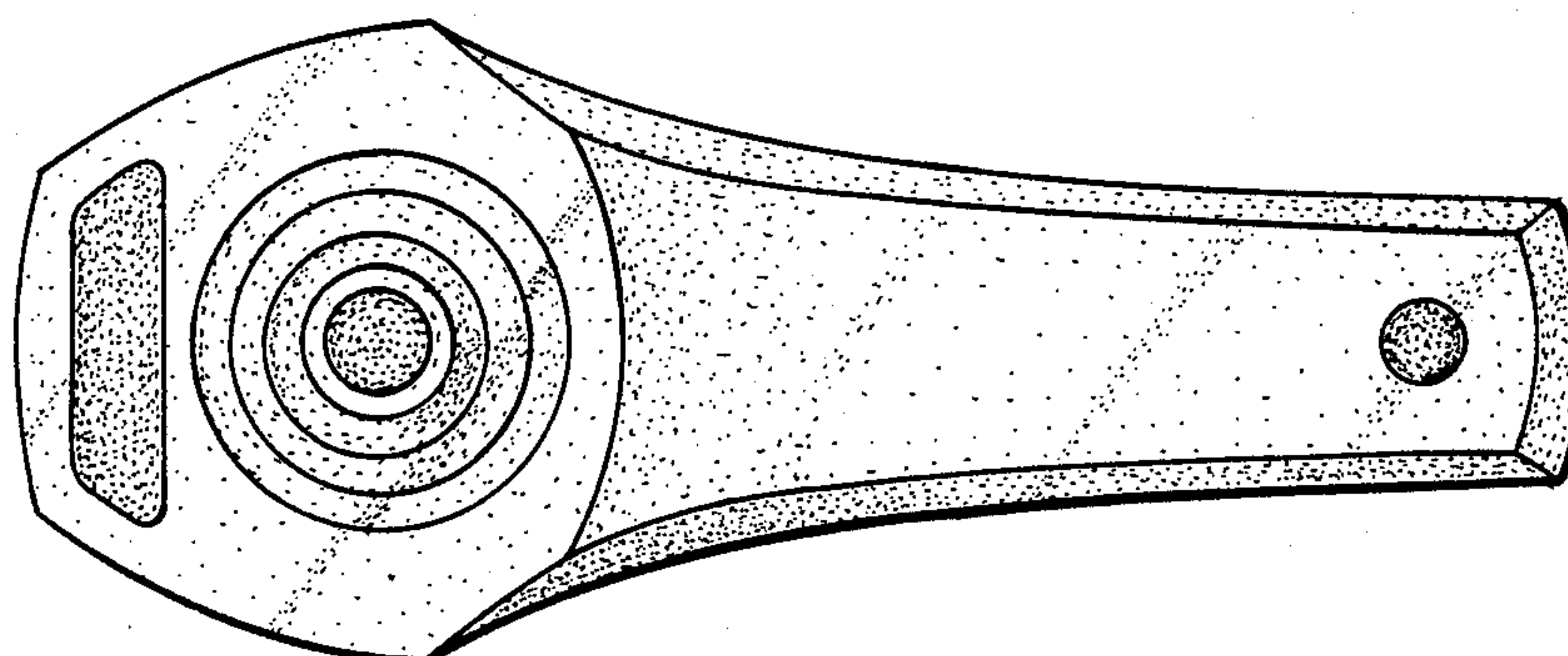
