The ornamental design for an IV dressing, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an IV dressing, showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite view being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 1.

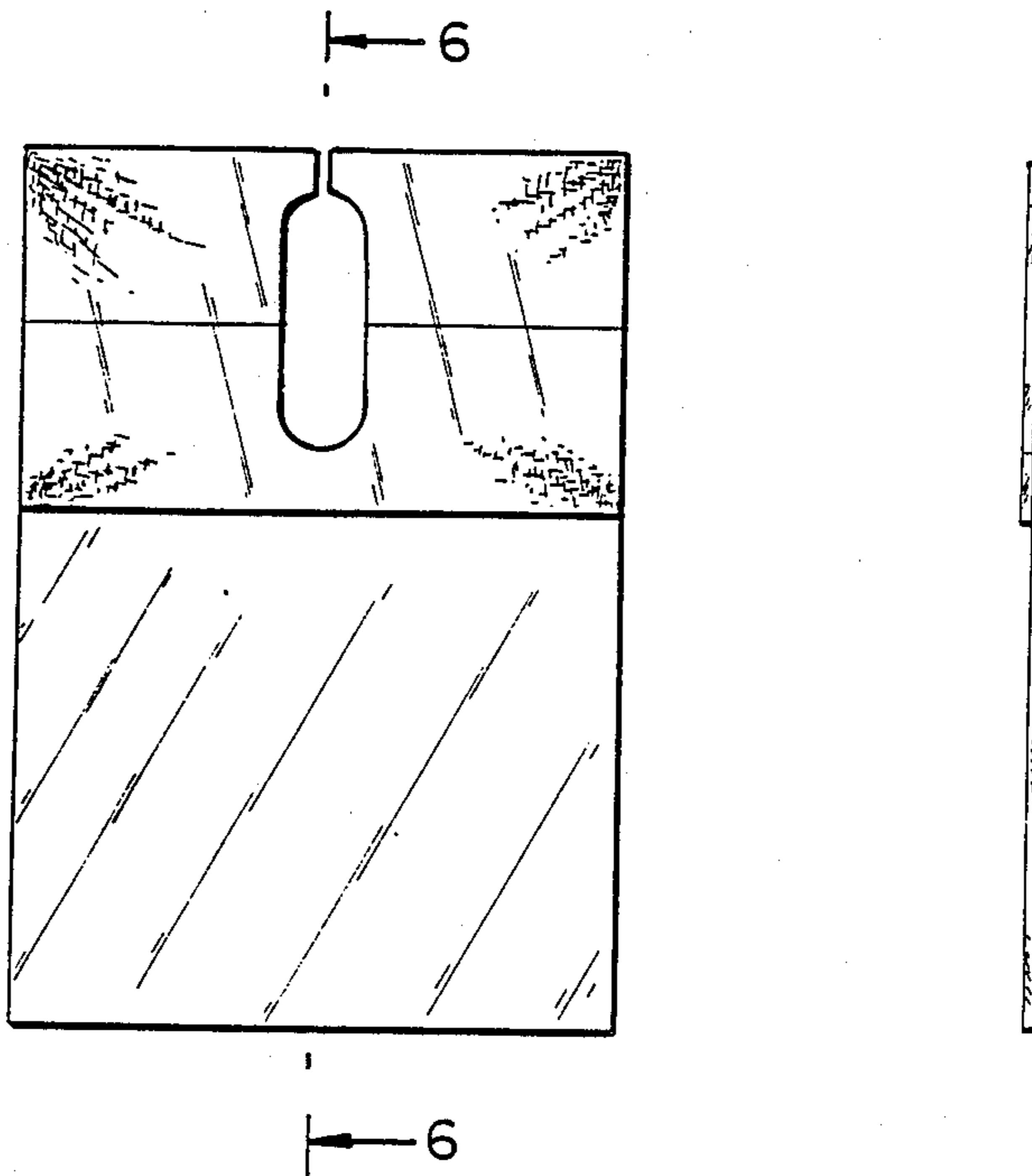

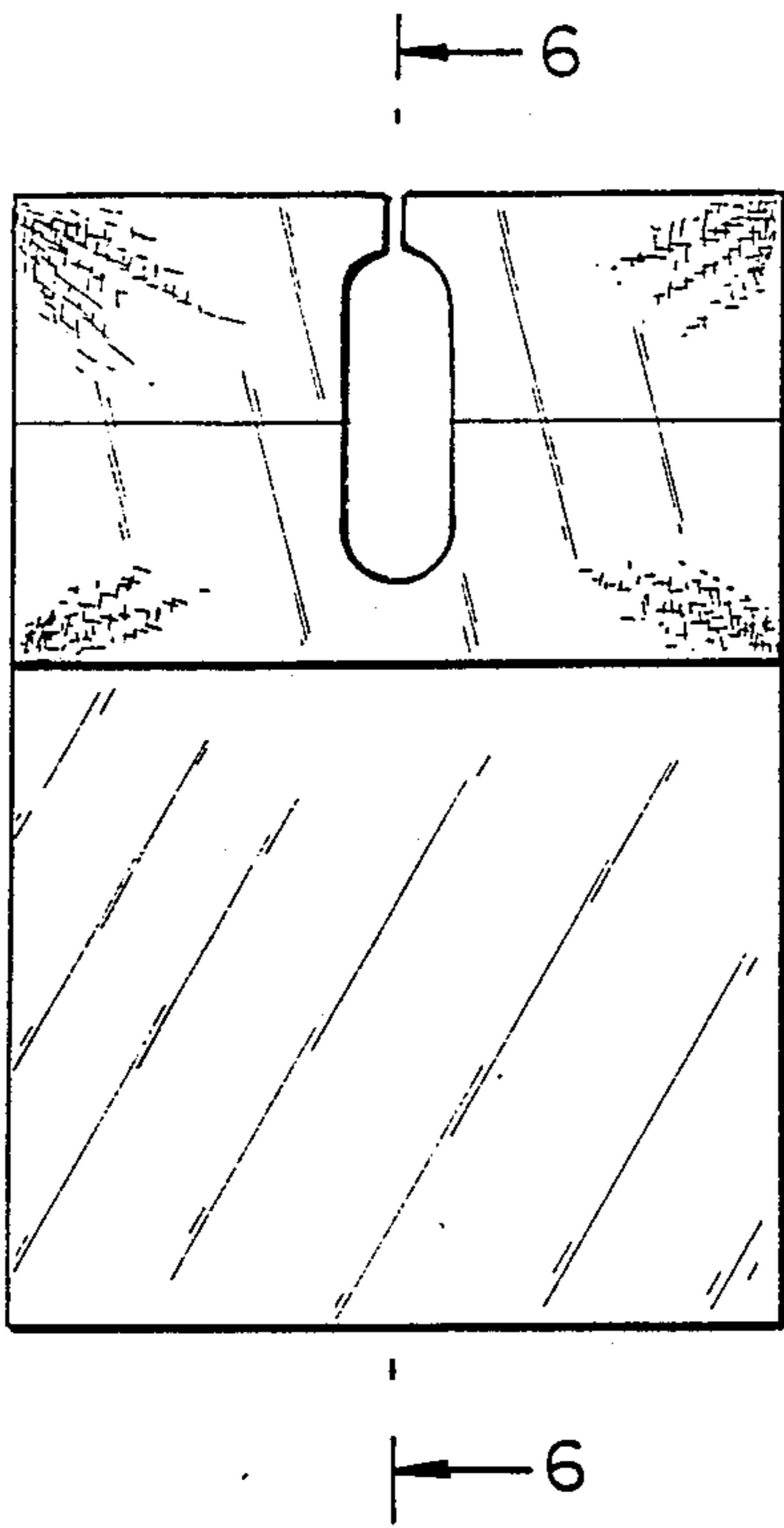

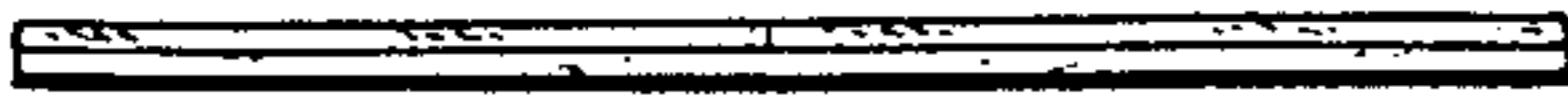
