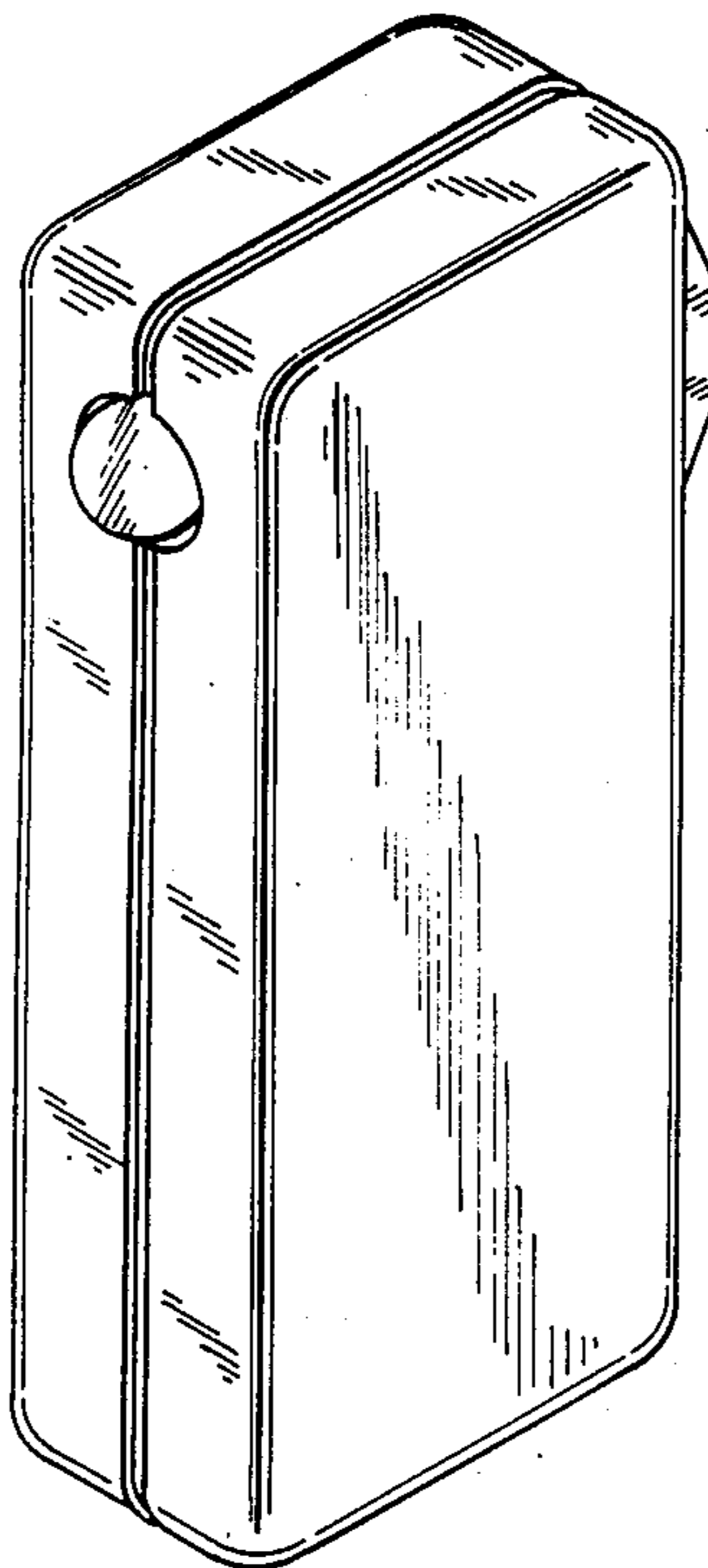

The ornamental design for a flashlight for handbags or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

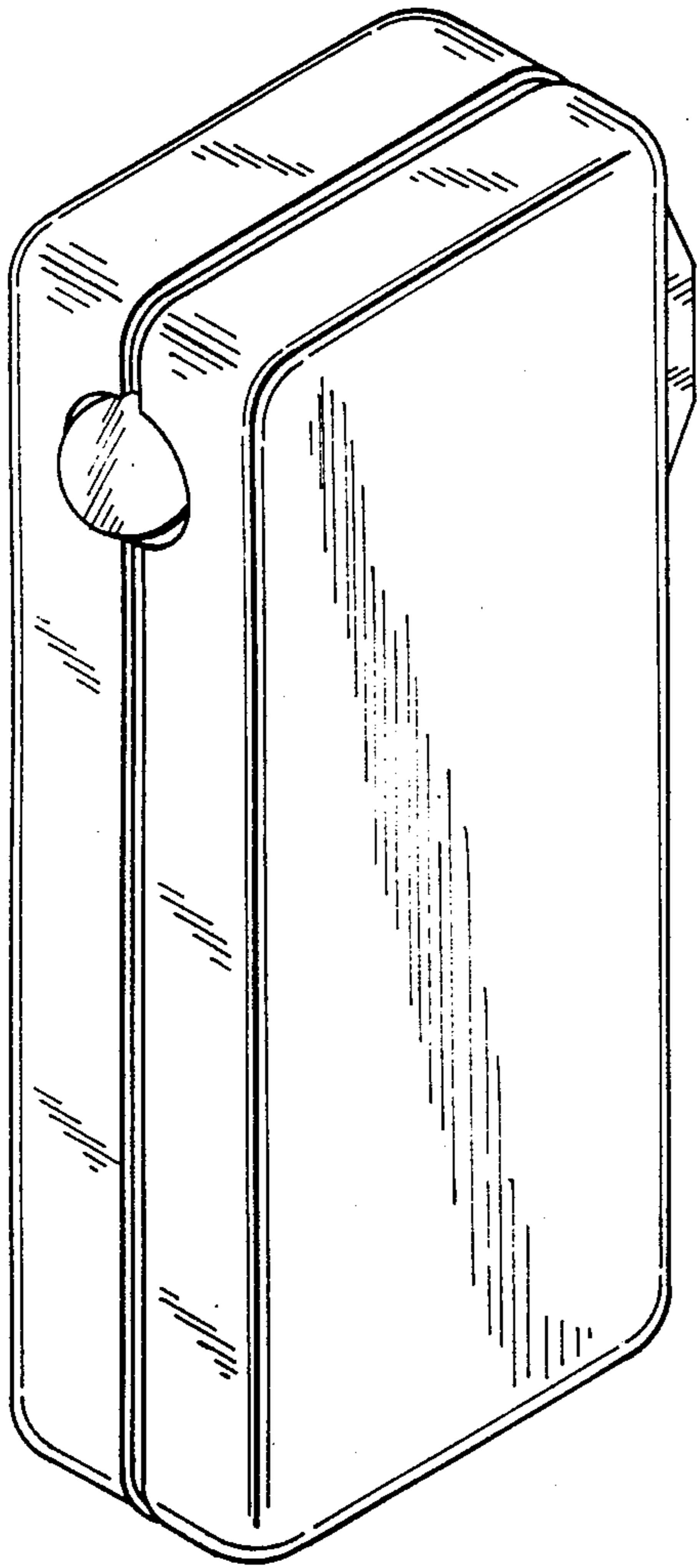

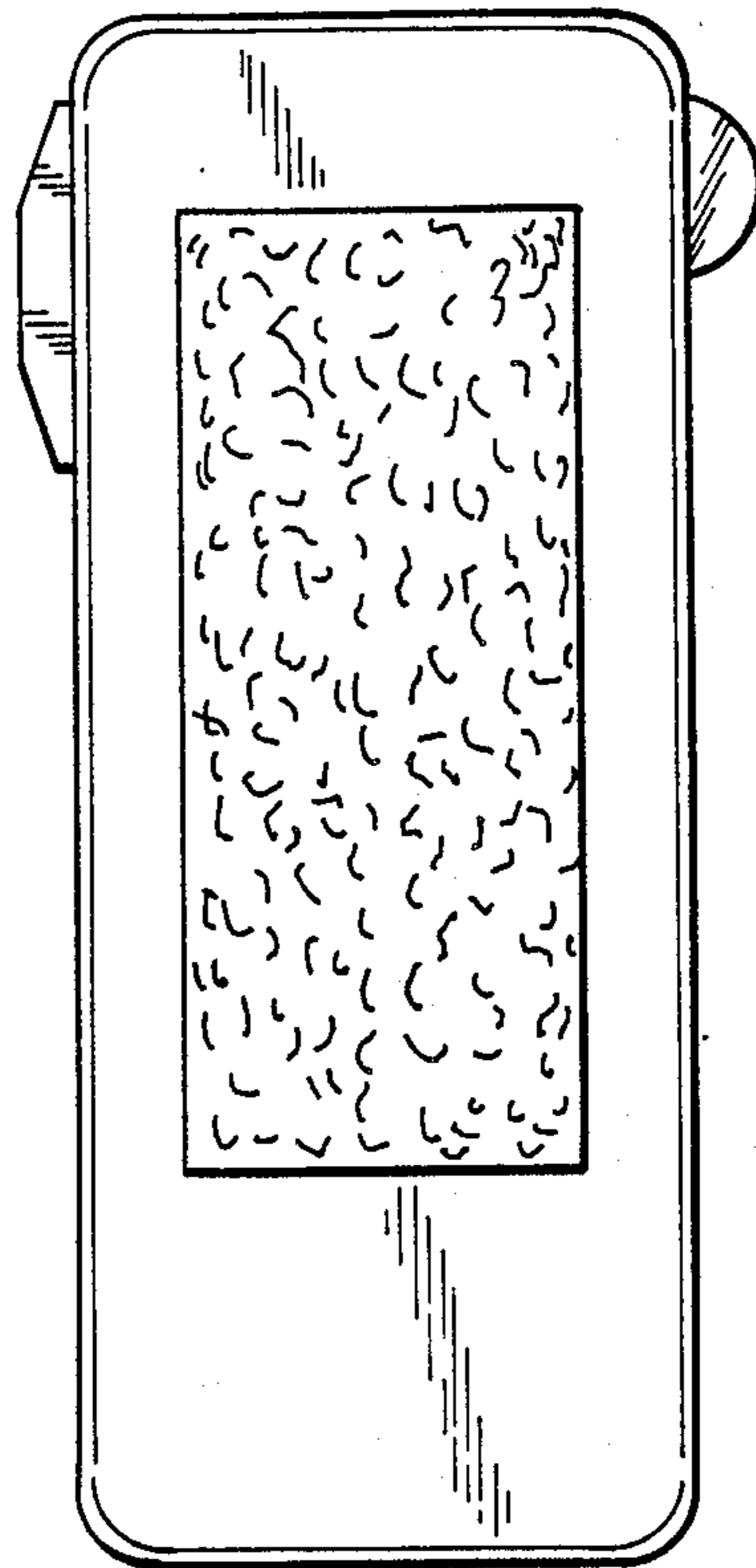

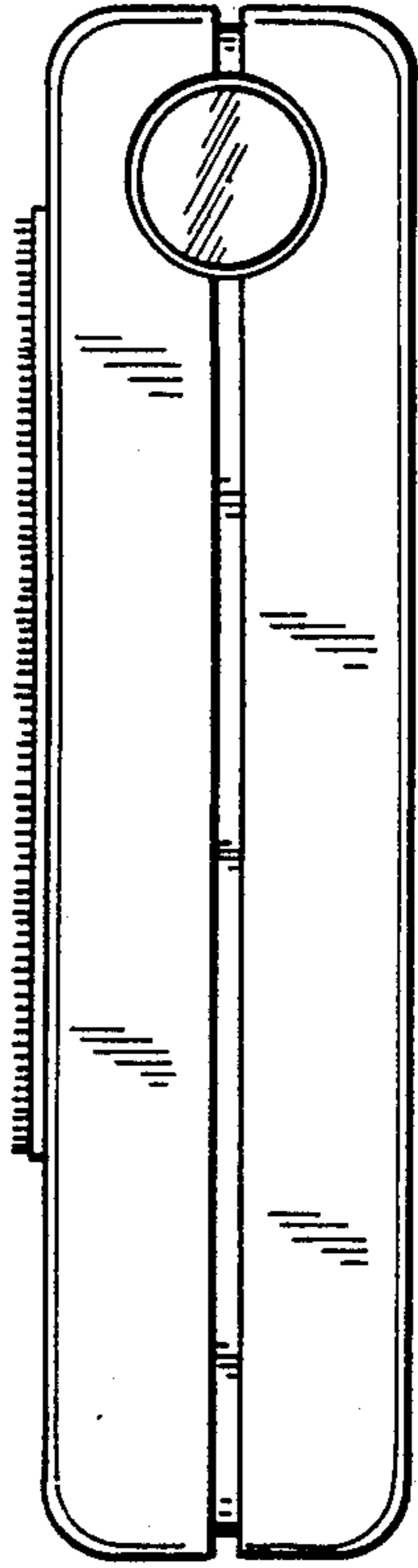

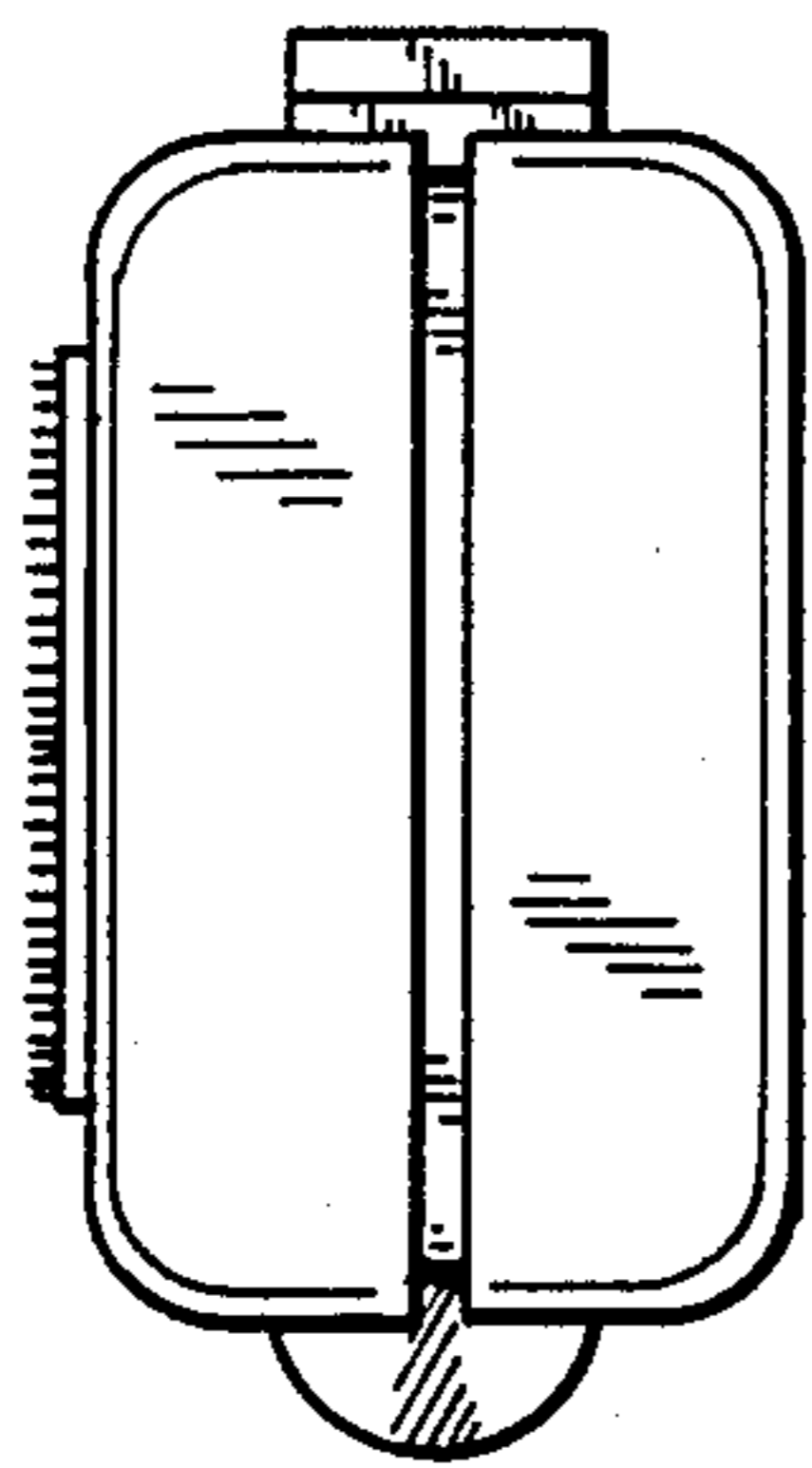
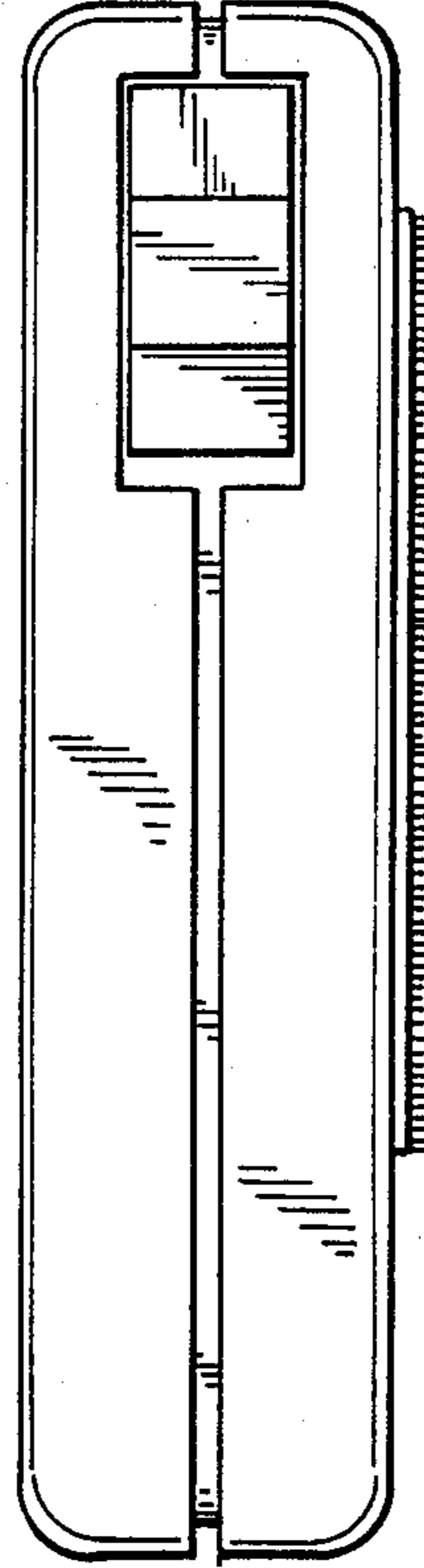

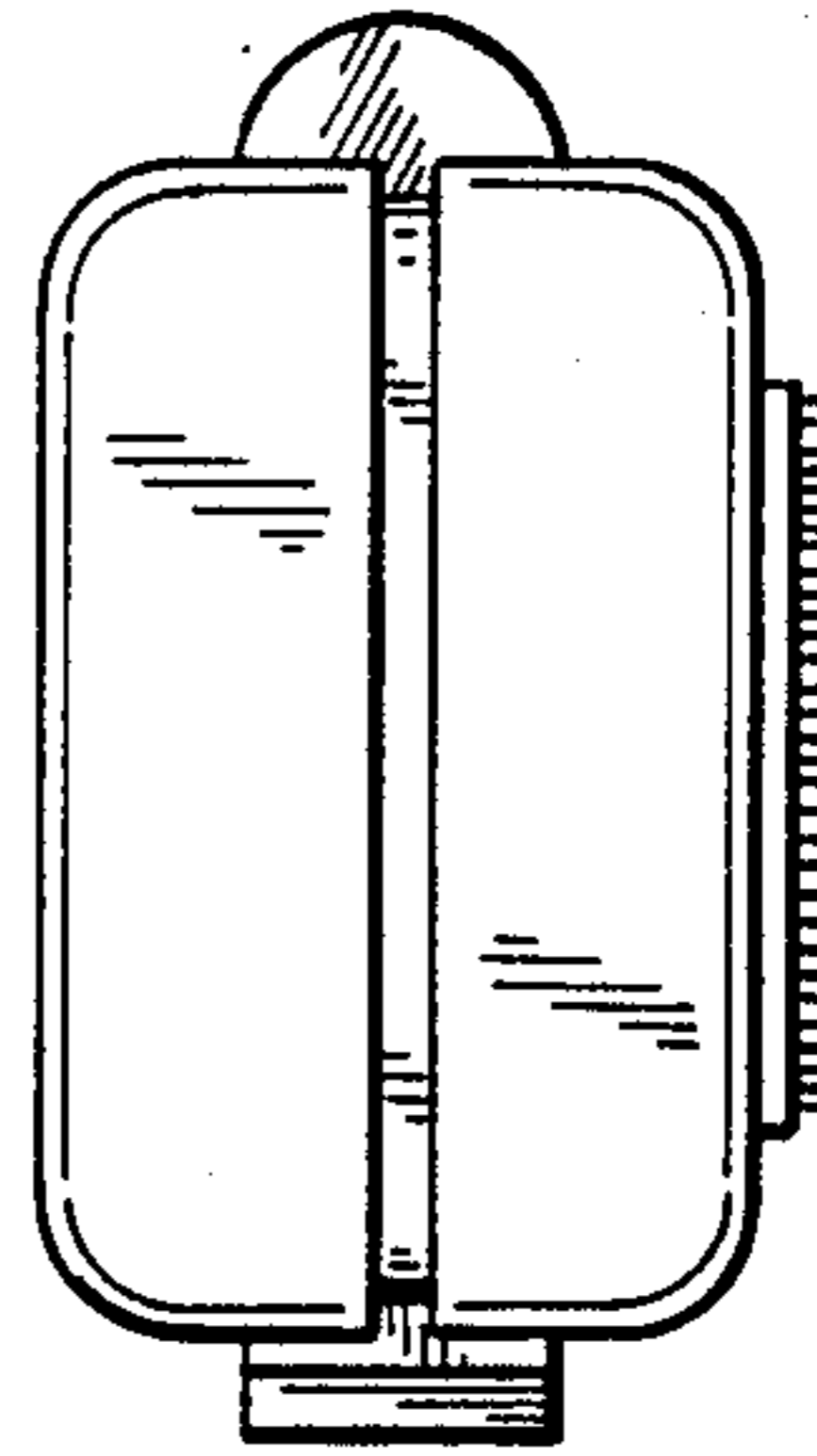
