[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a protective garment for pets, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of a protective garment for pets showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line representation of a dog in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

It is to be understood that the straps in FIGS. 2, 3, 5 and 7 are broken away to indicate indeterminate length.

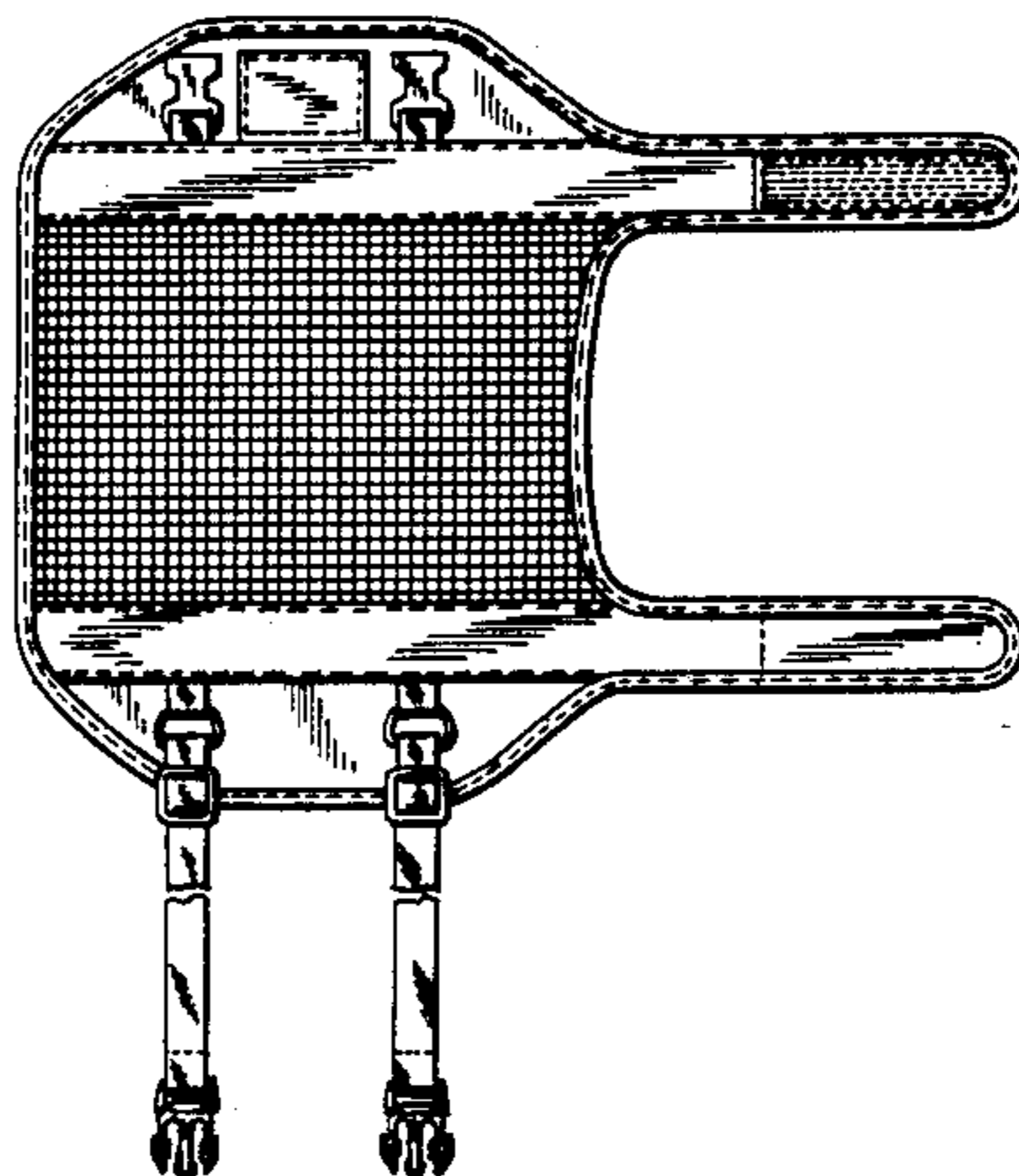
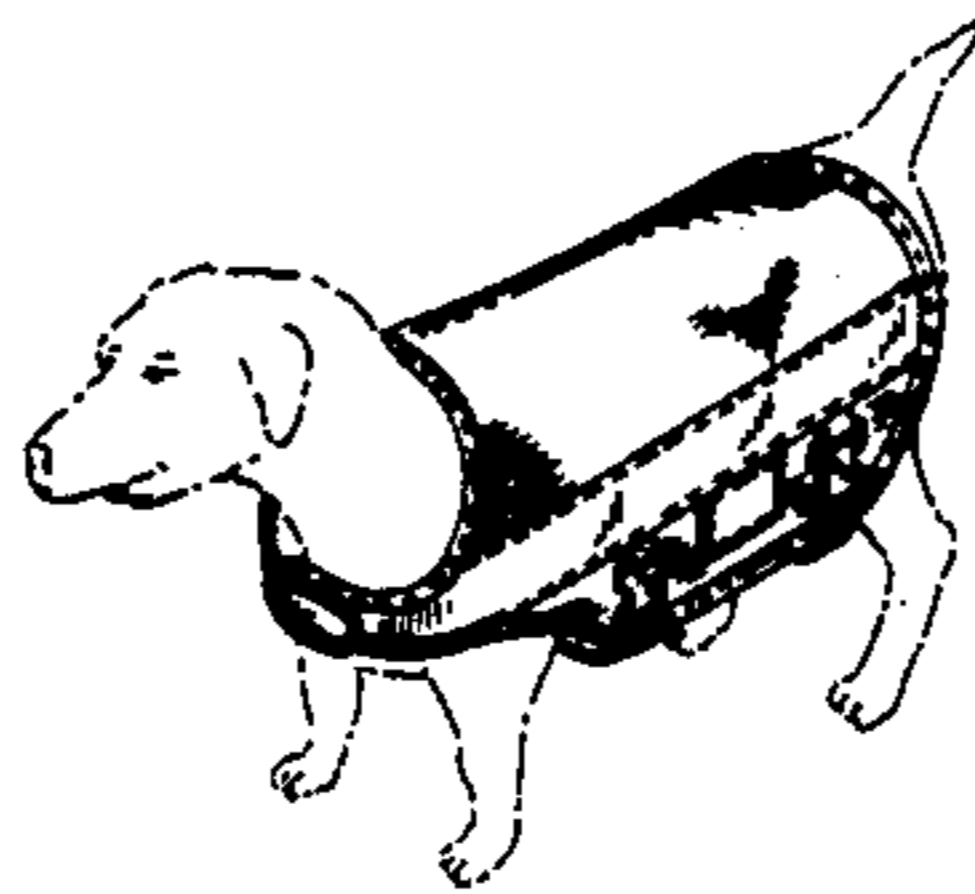

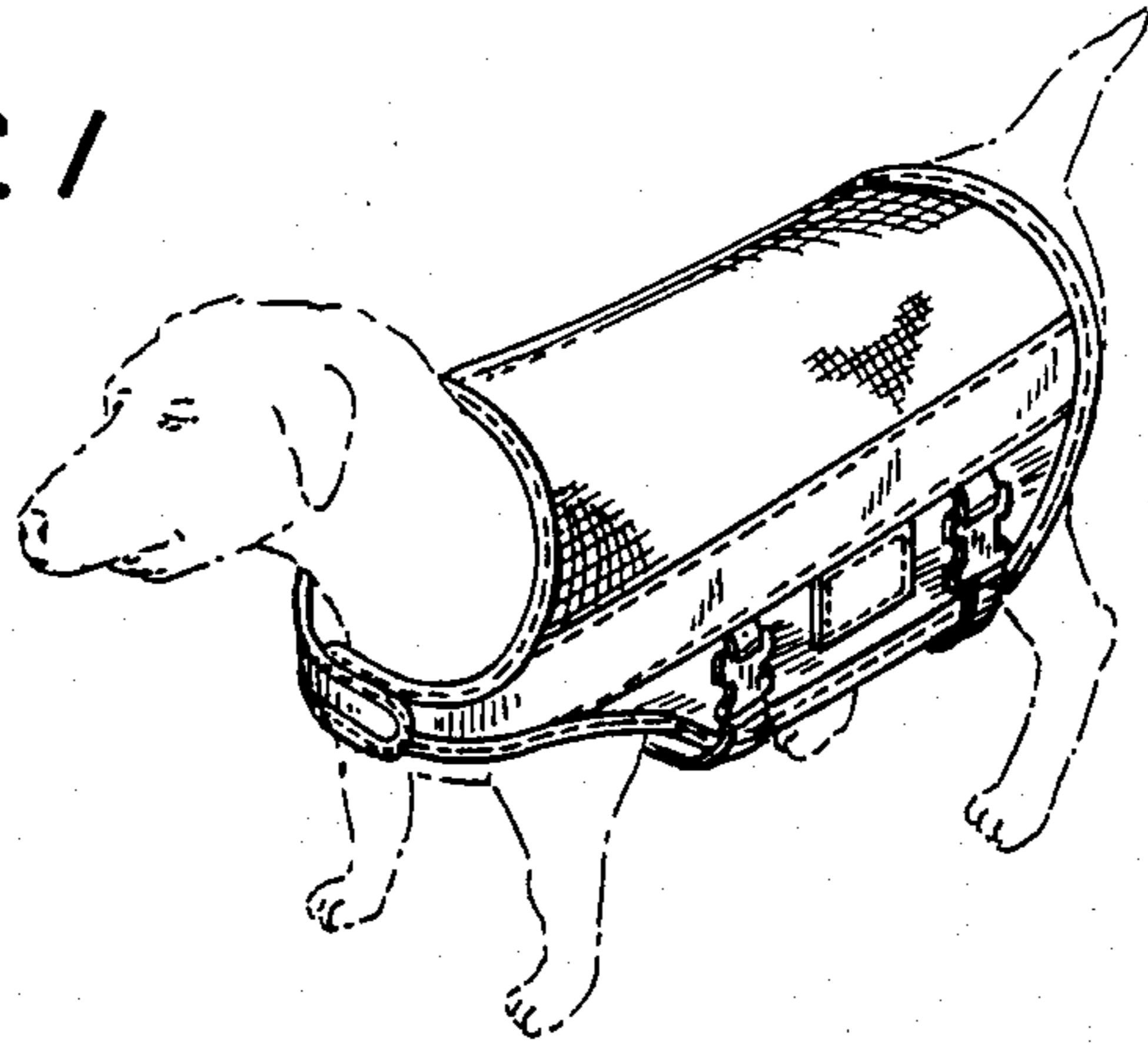

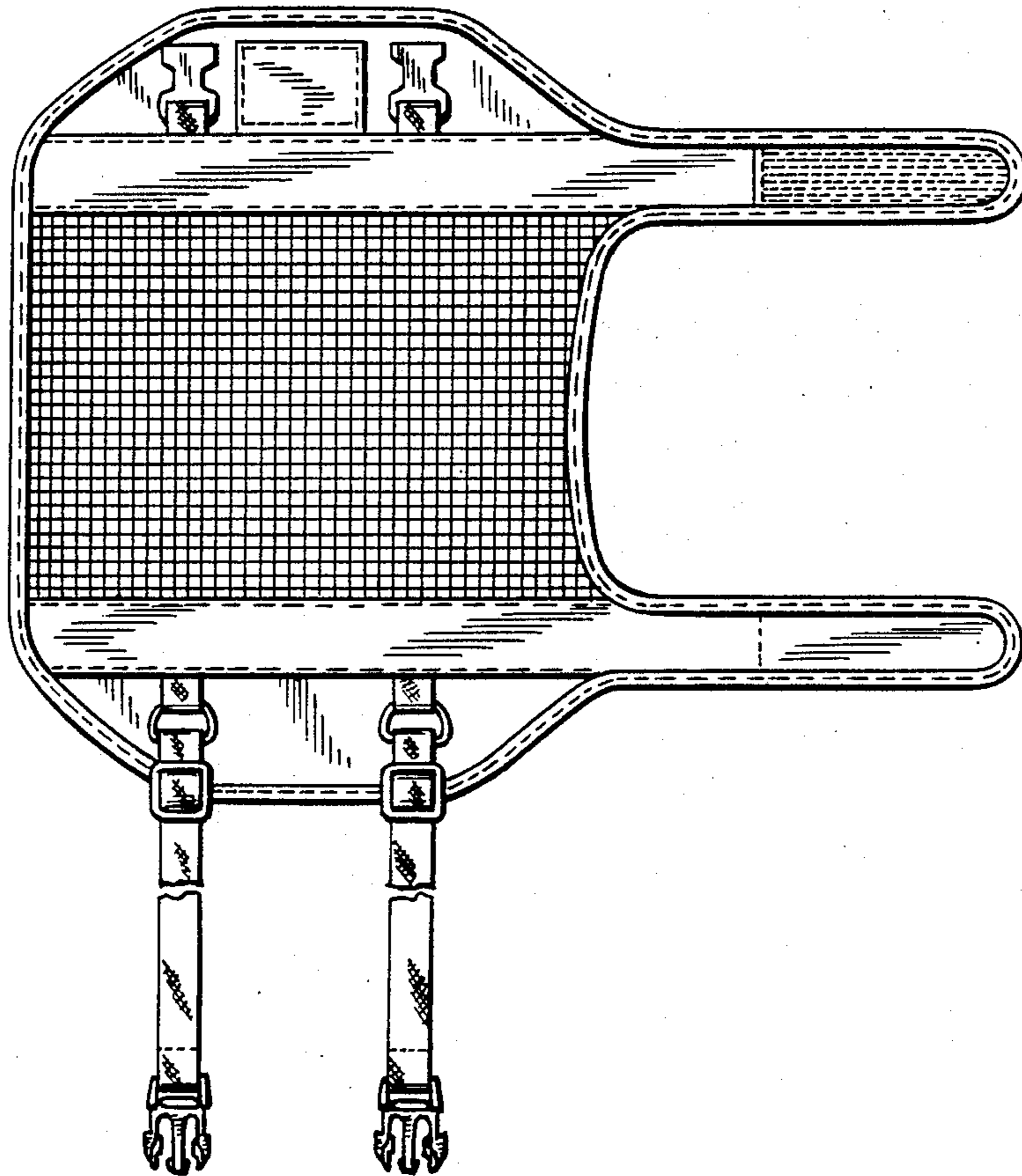

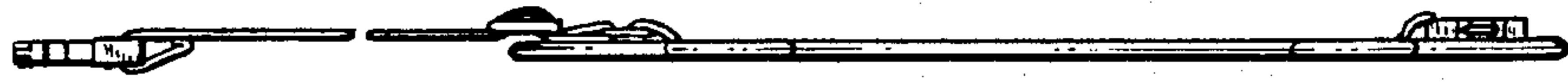

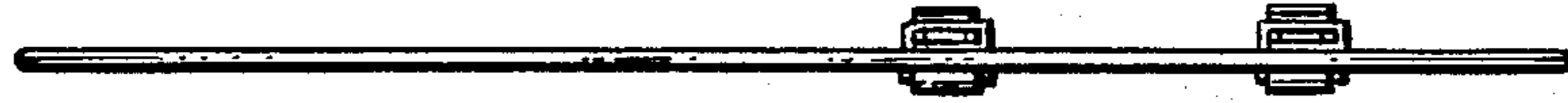

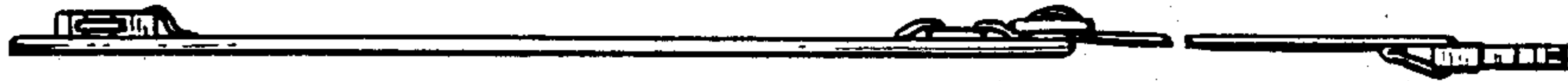

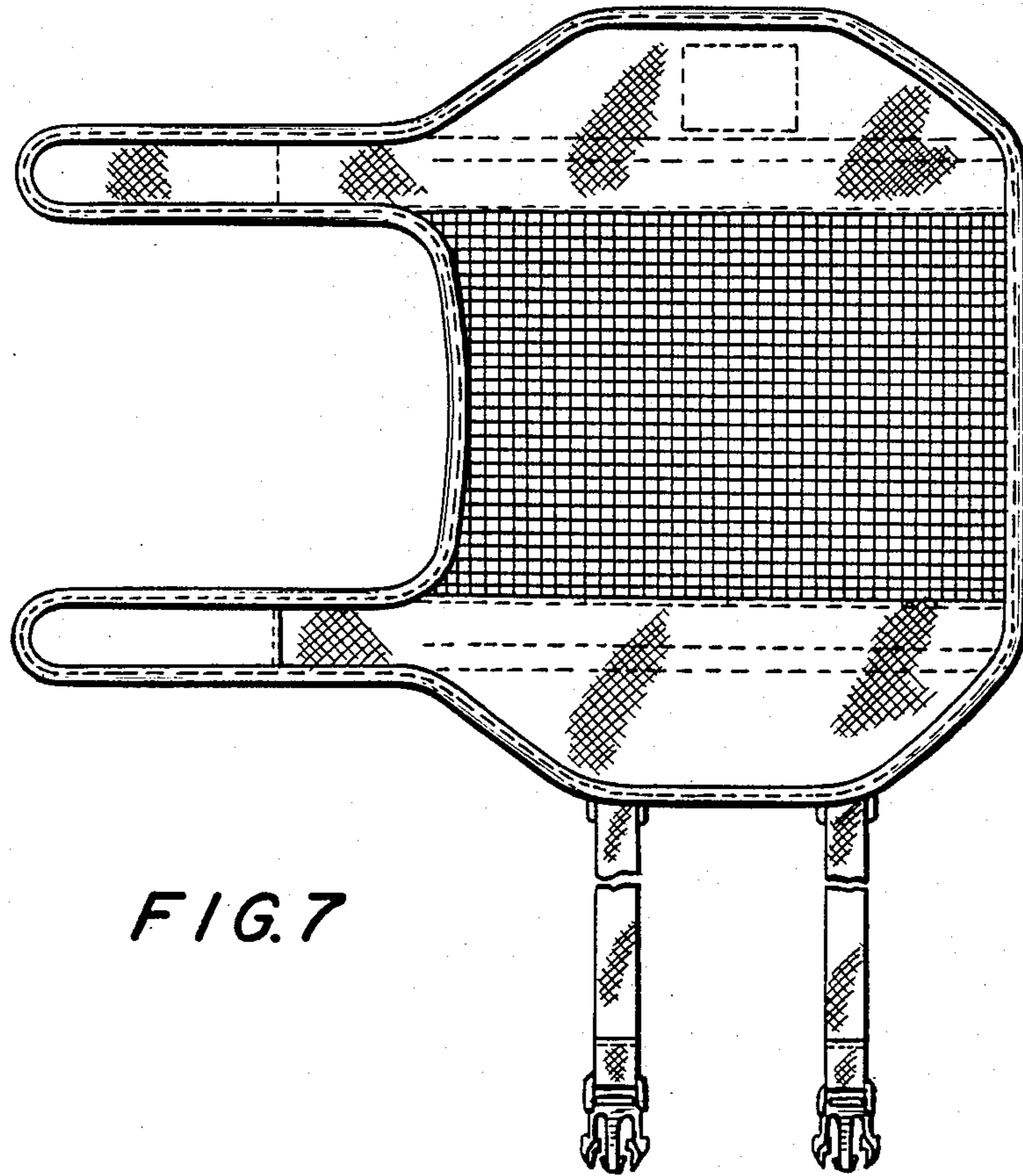
