[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a floor scraper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a floor scraper showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top plan view thereof, the handle being partially shown for ease of illustration only;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 3; and
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
