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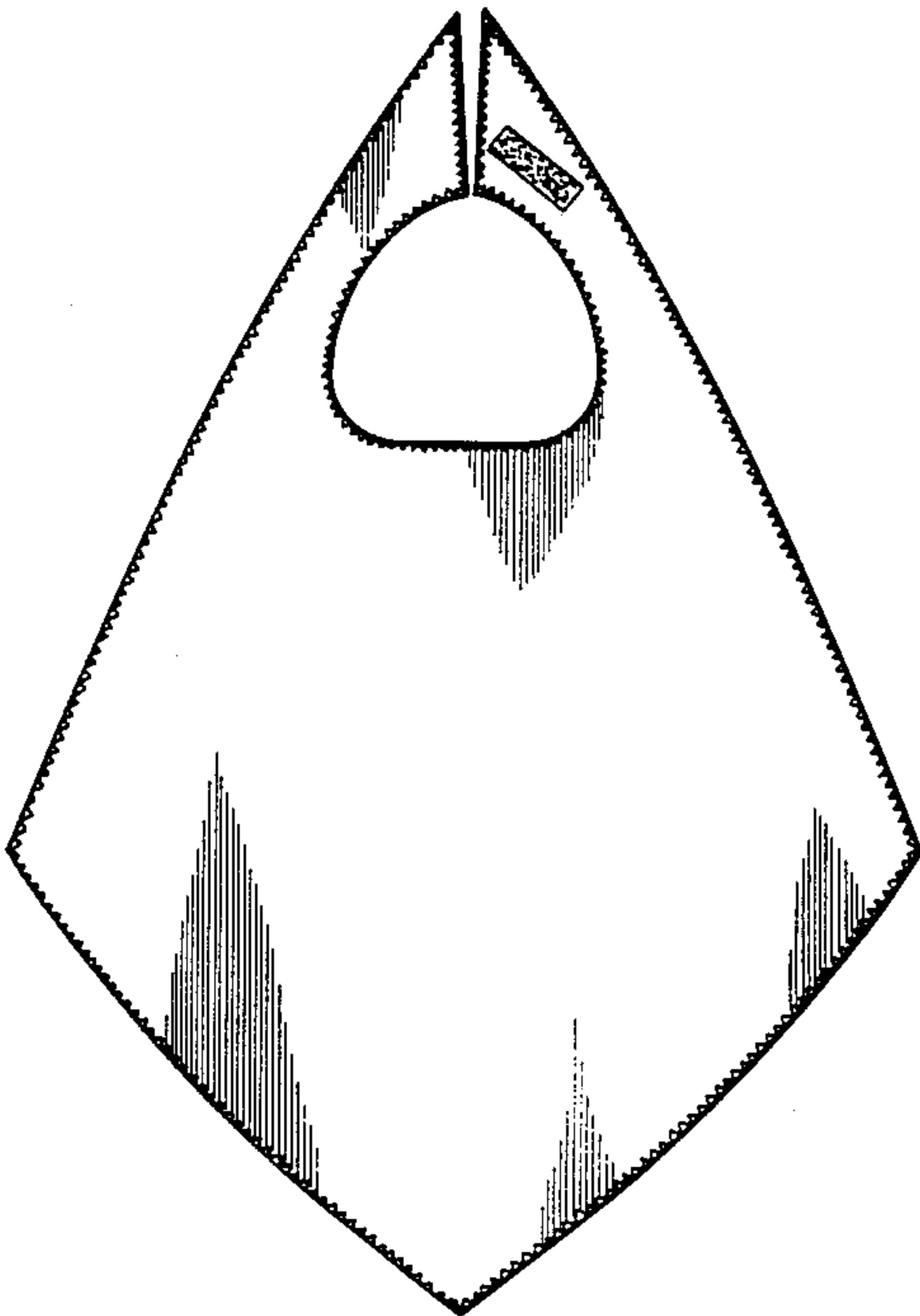

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bib showing my
new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side
opposite being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof, the bib being
shown overlapped as if in use.



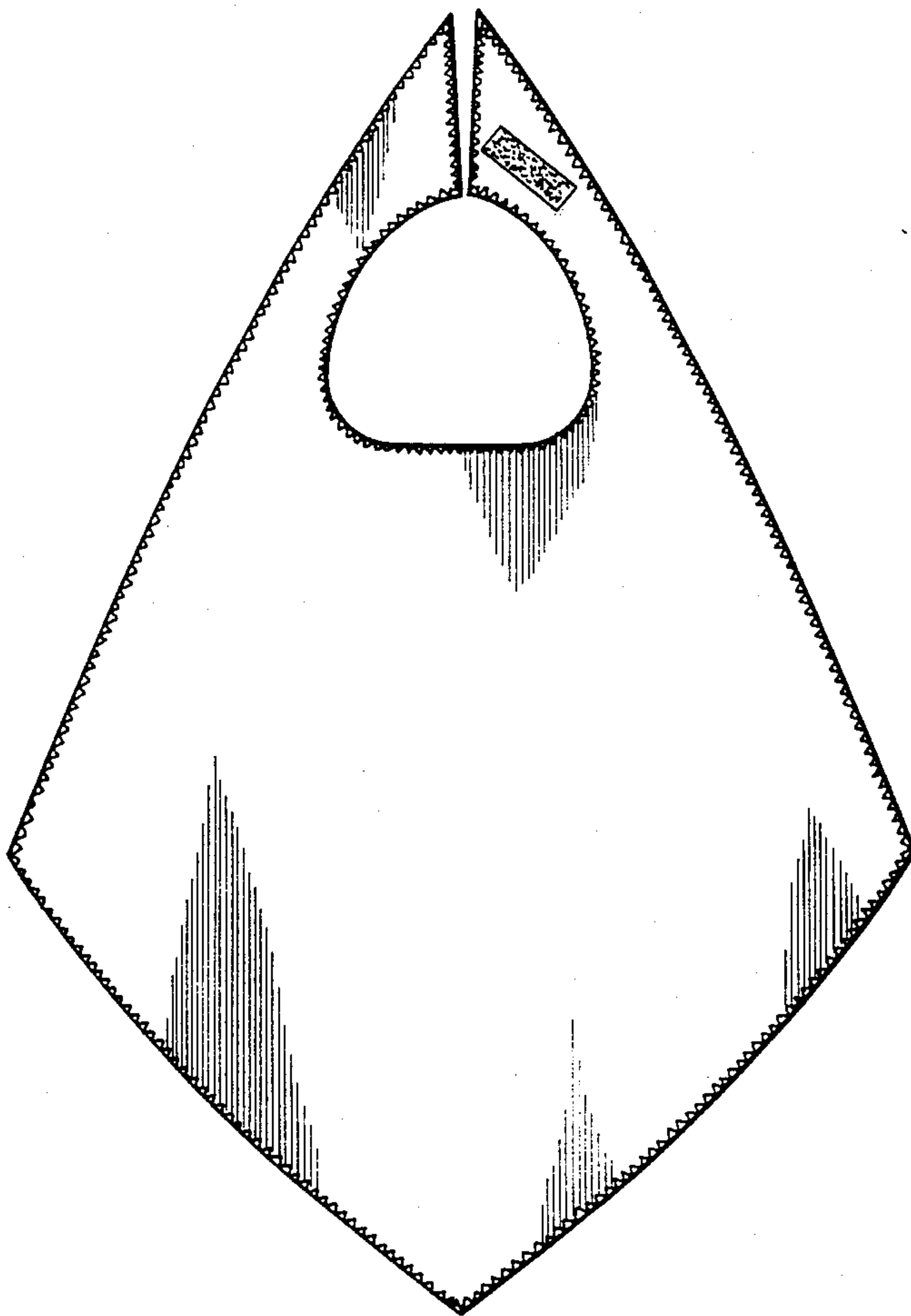

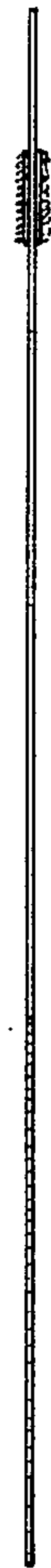
