FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

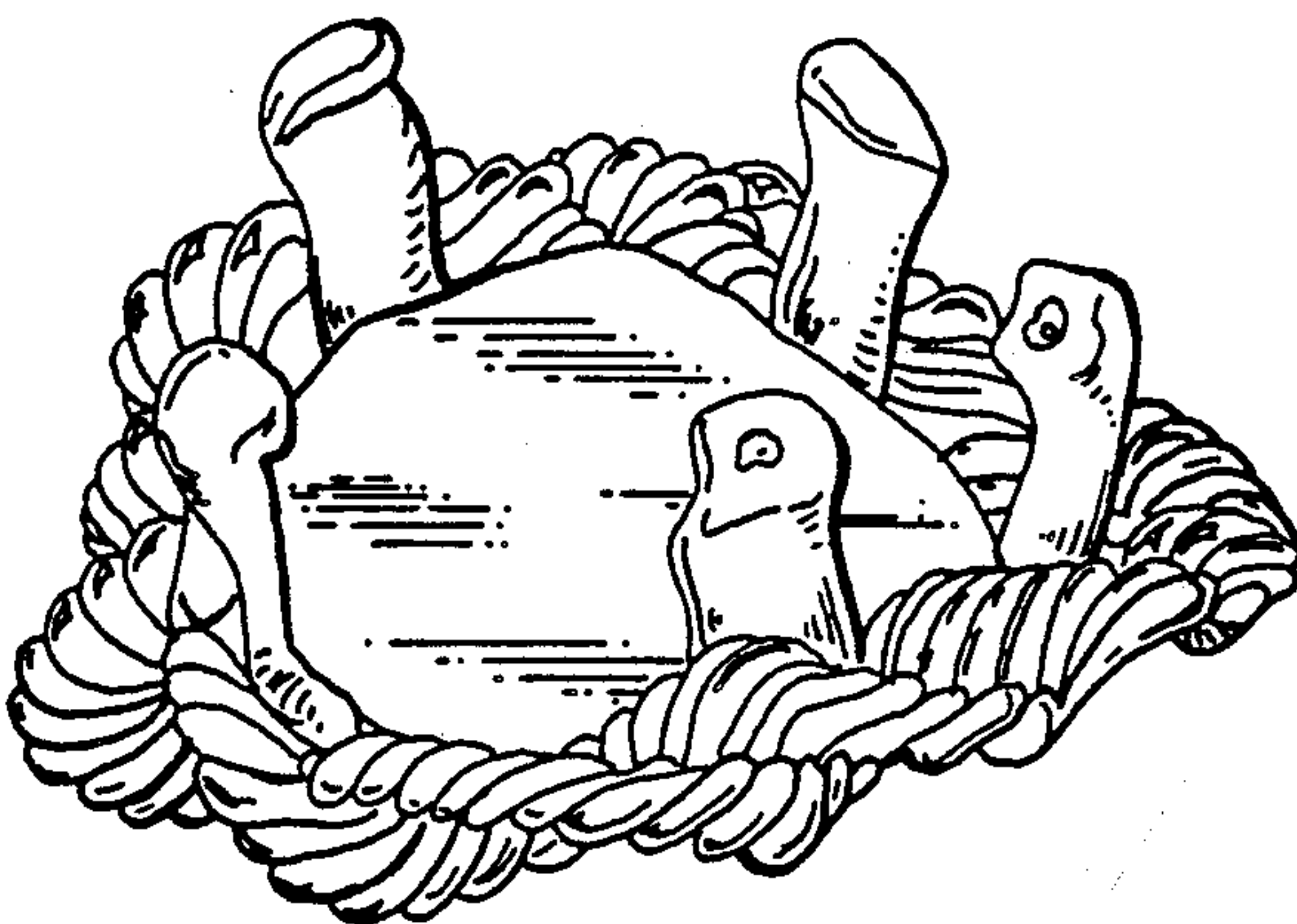
FIG. 5 is a perspective view of the setting unobscured

the claimed design.



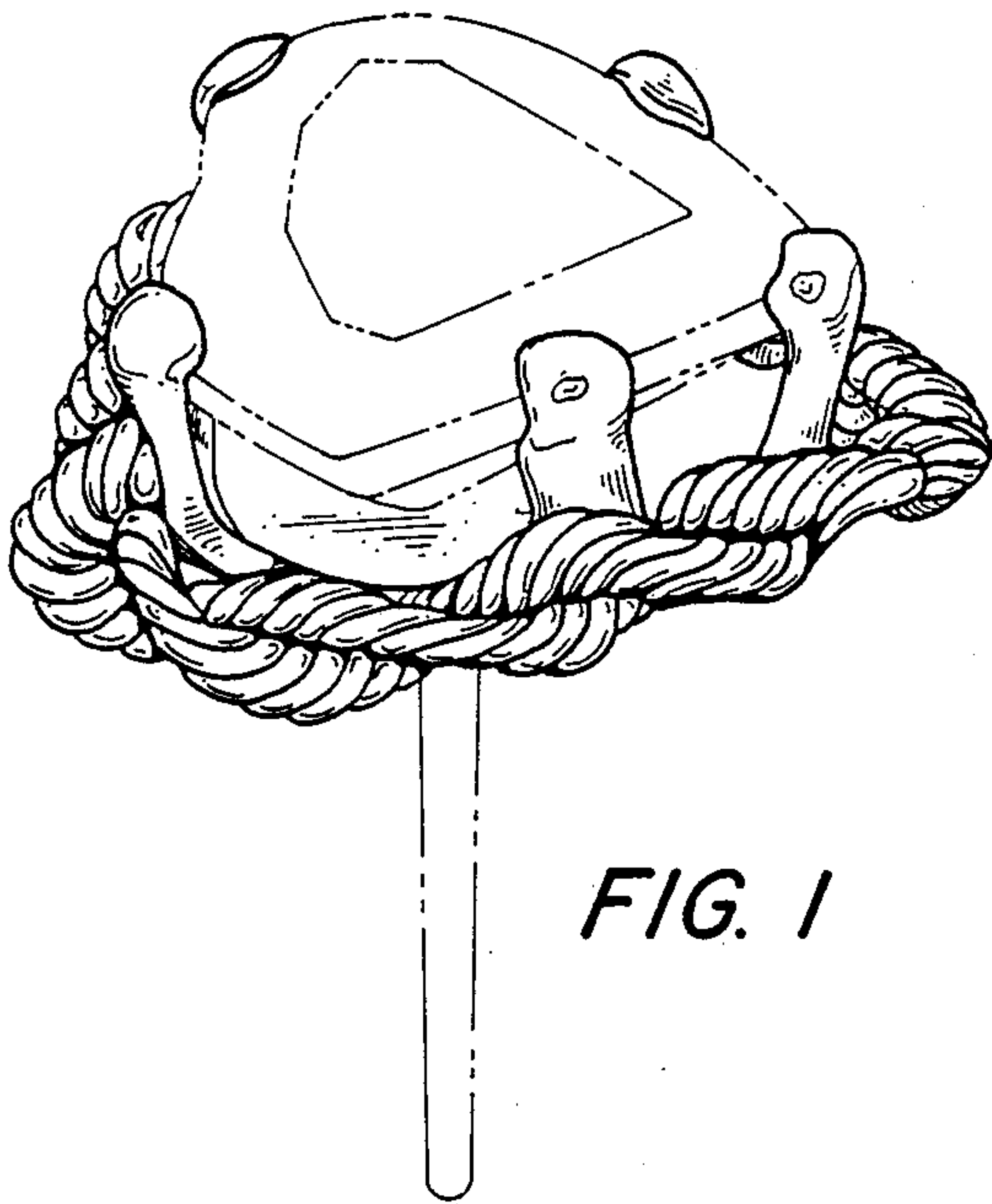

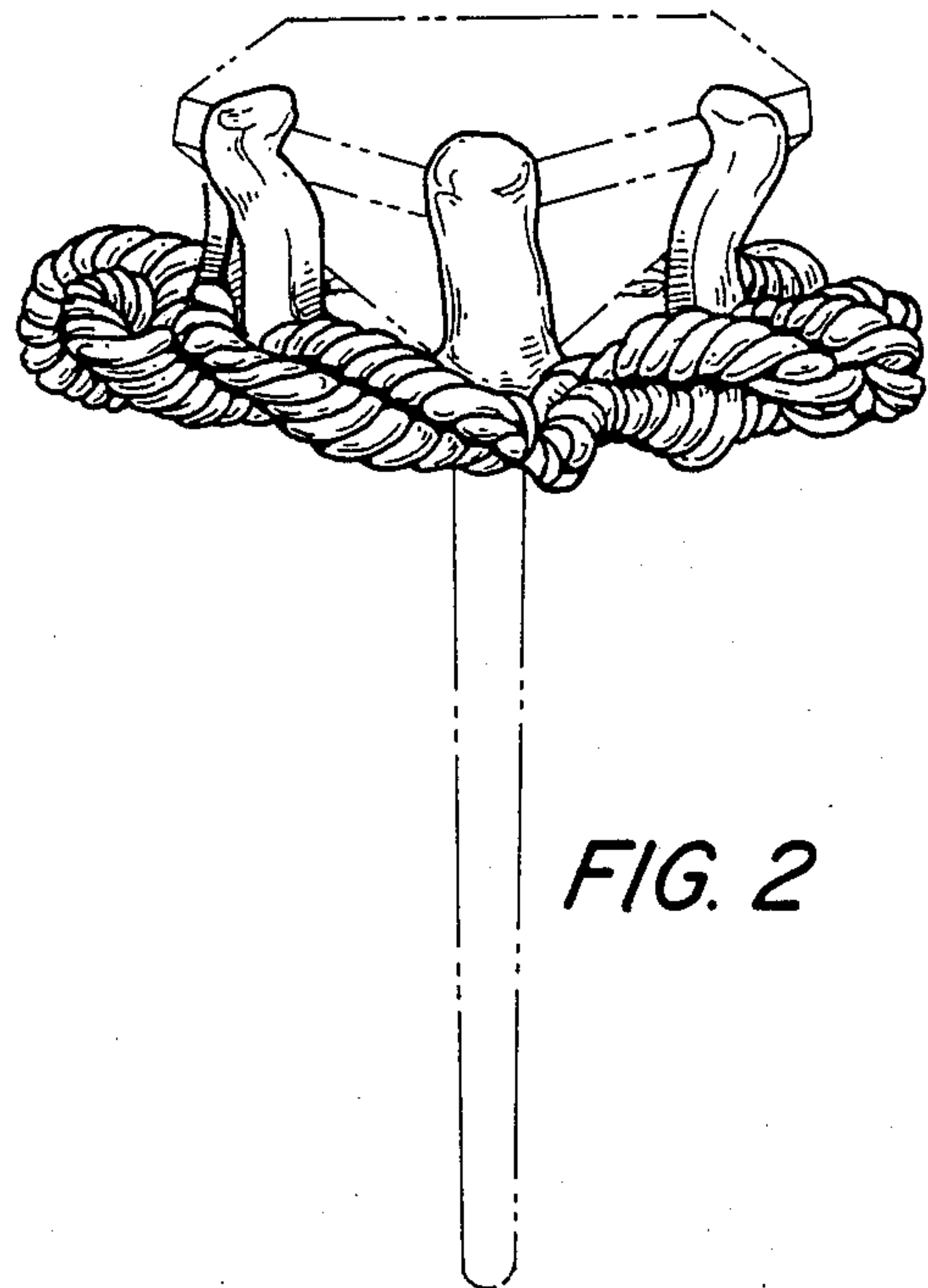

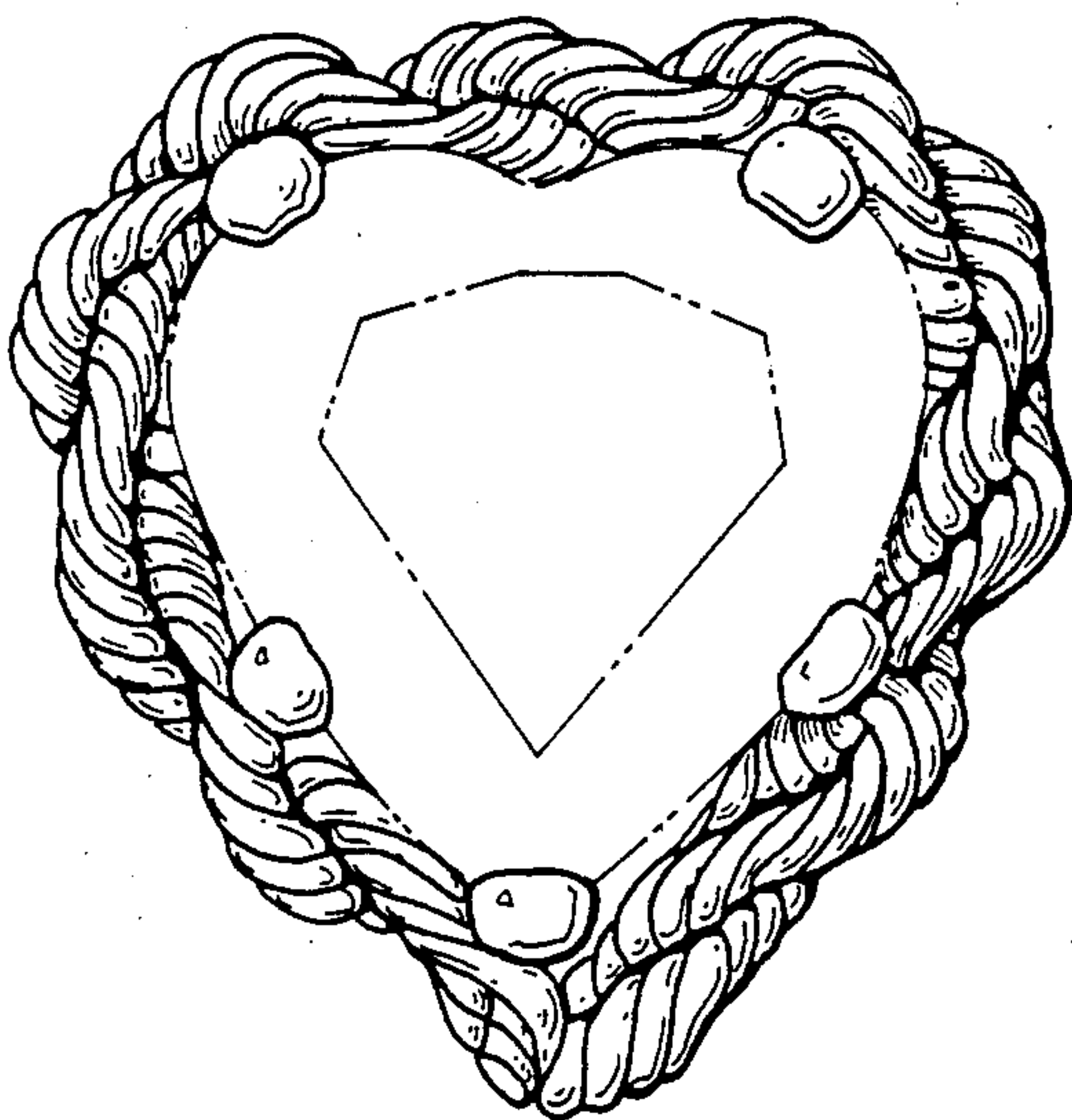

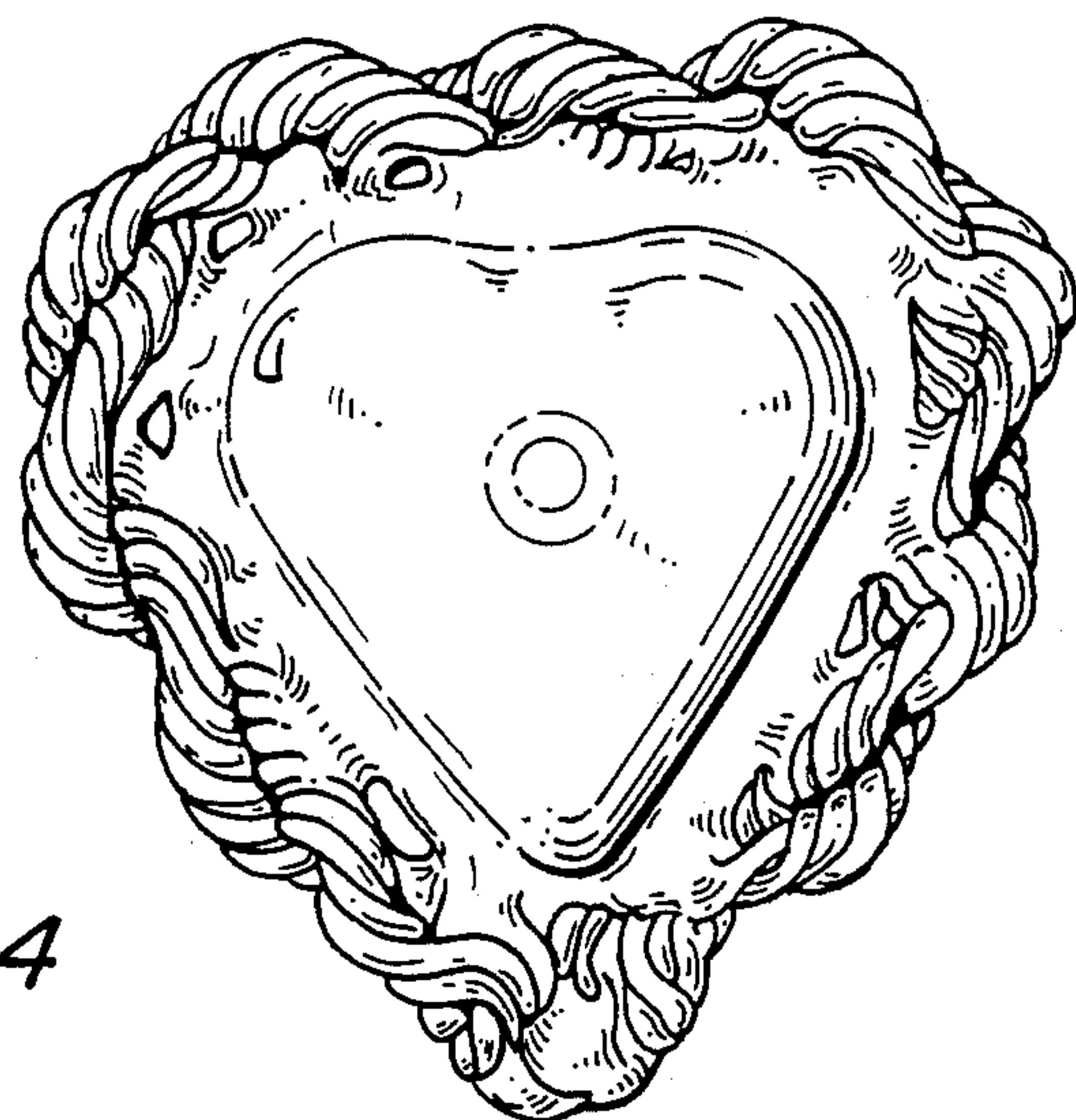

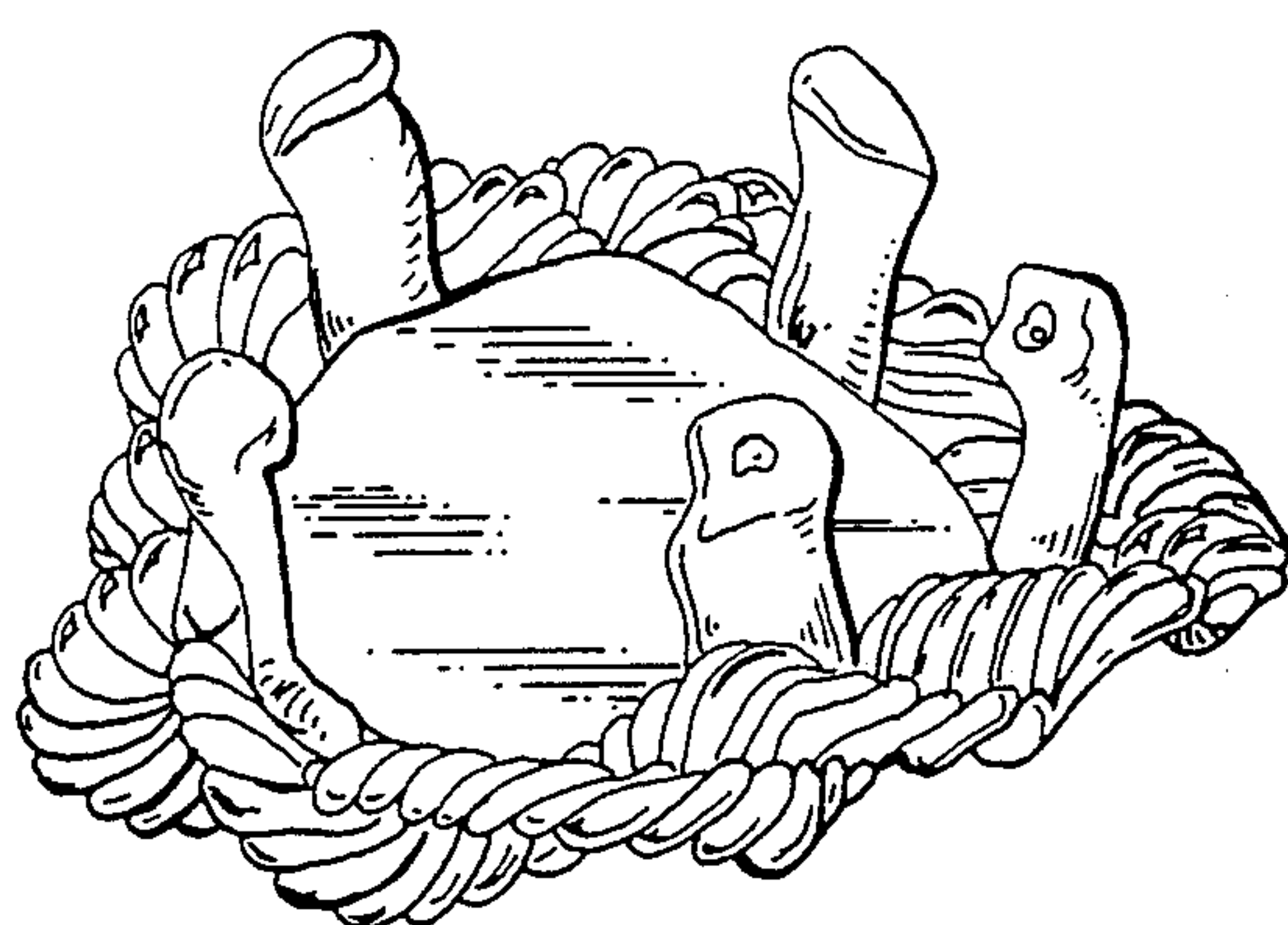

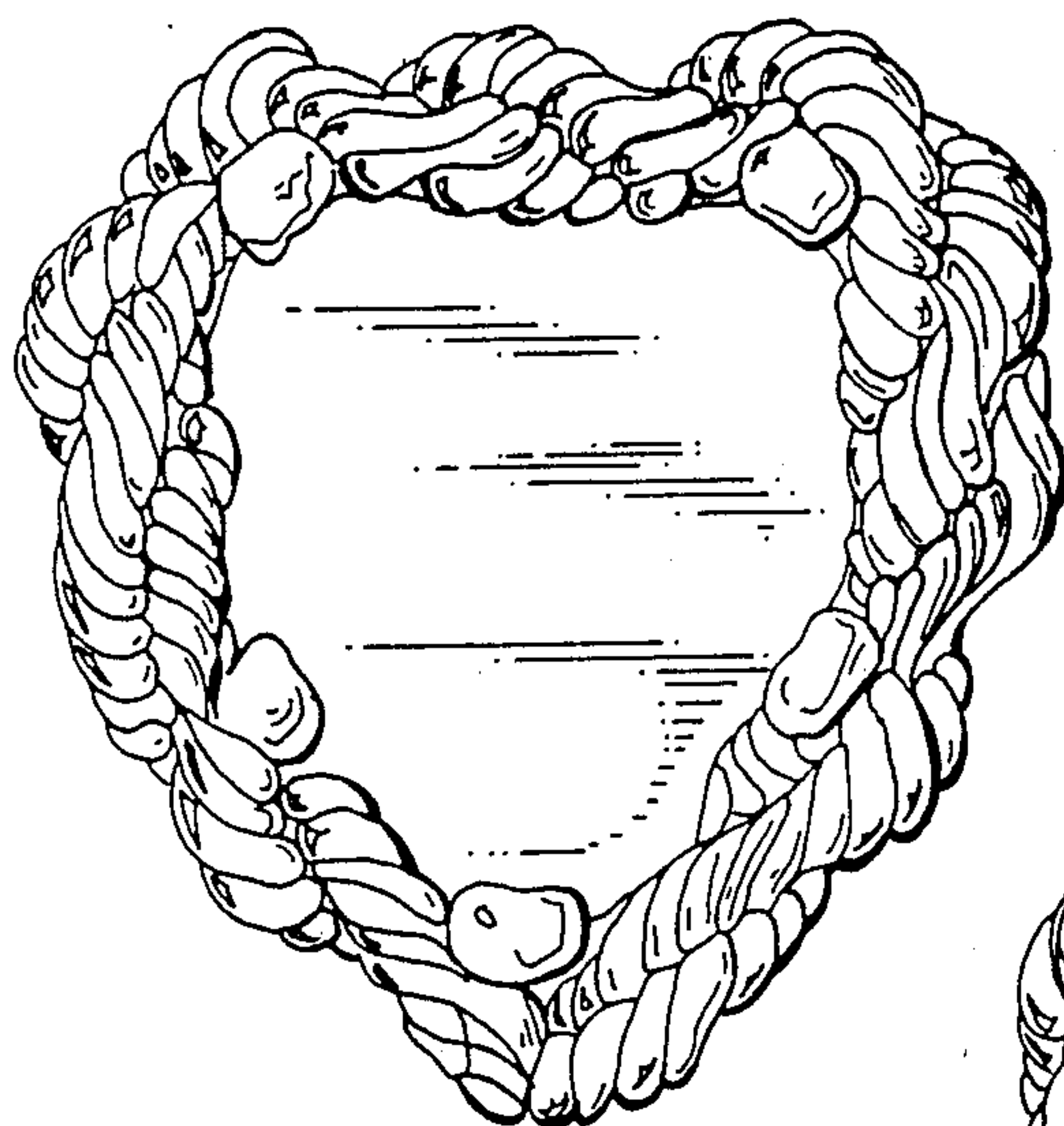
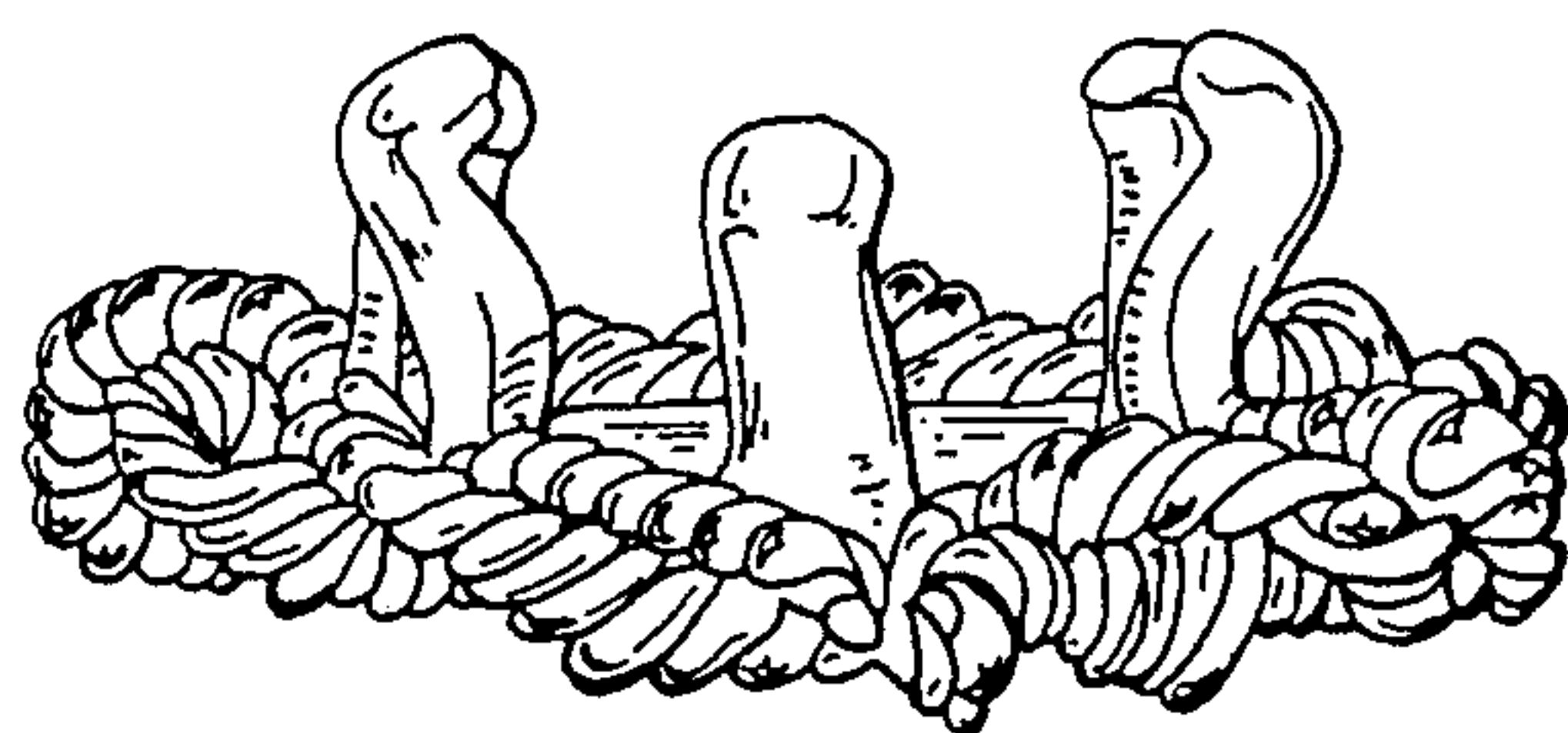
