The ornamental design for a combined courtesy and adjustable reading light for vehicles, as shown and described.

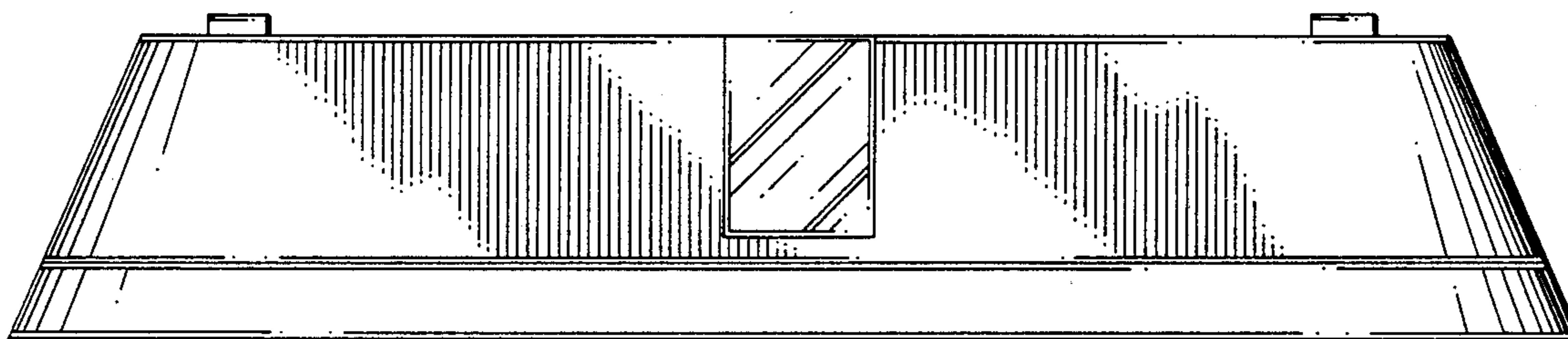
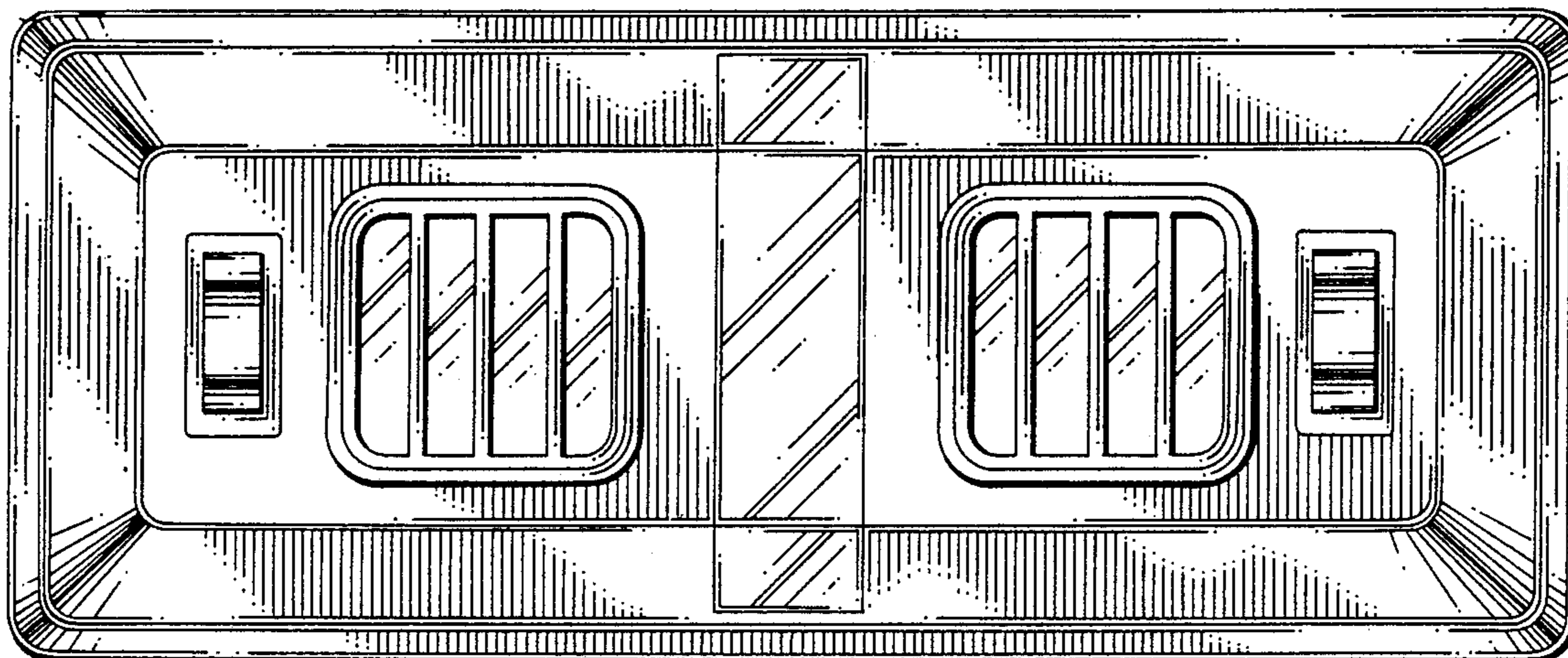
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a combined courtesy and adjustable reading light for vehicles showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view the opposite end being a mirror image.



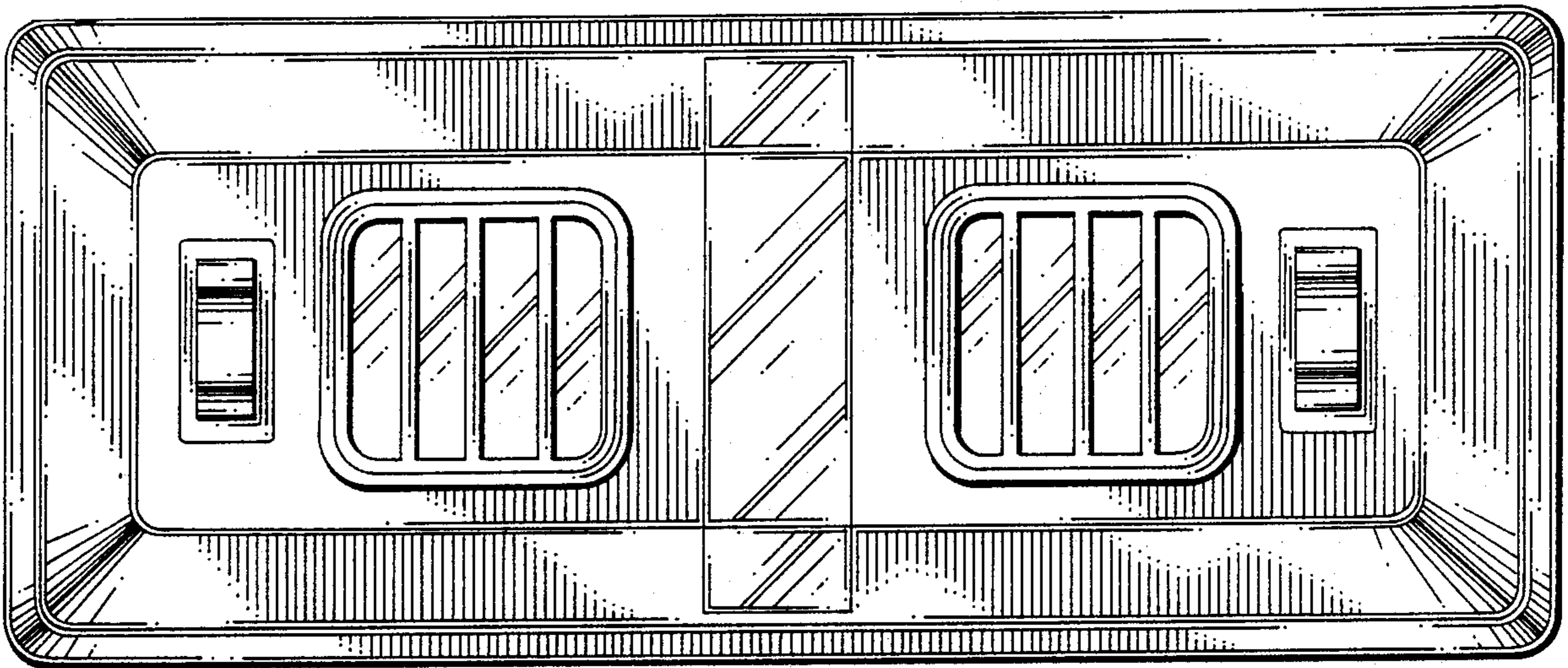

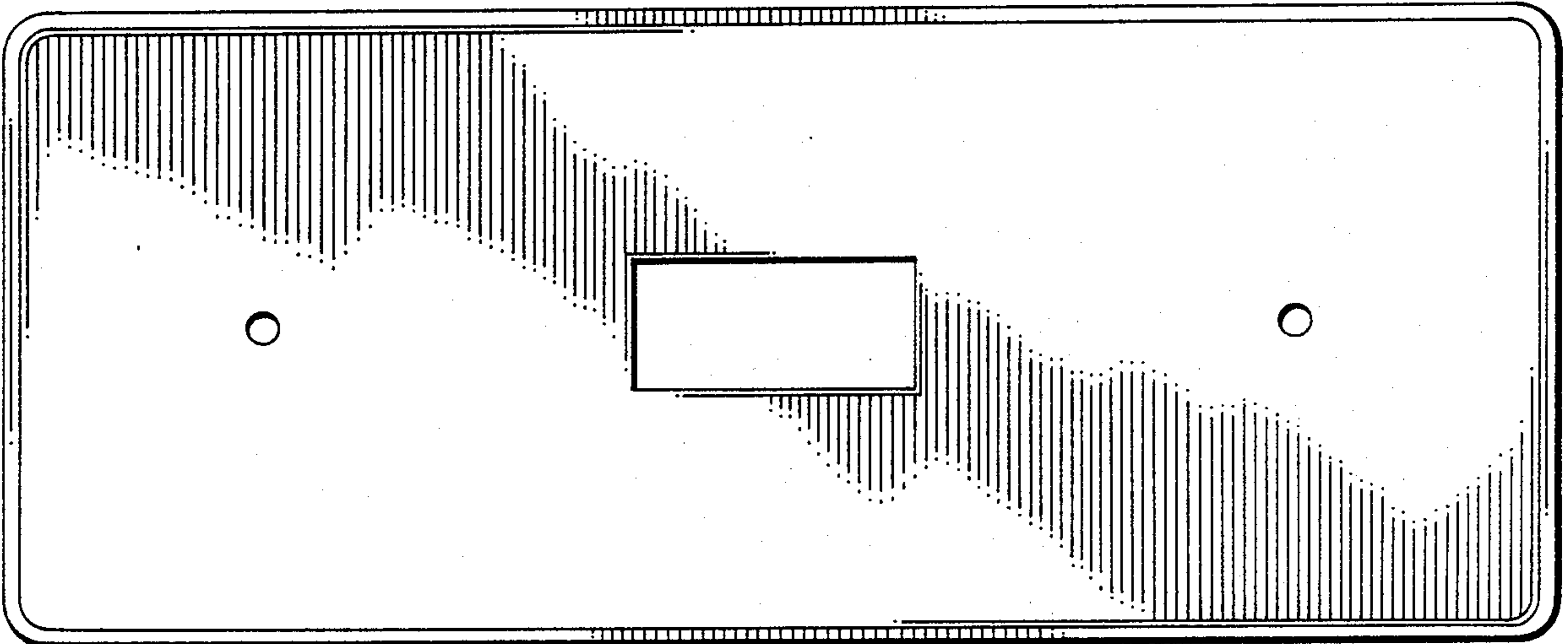

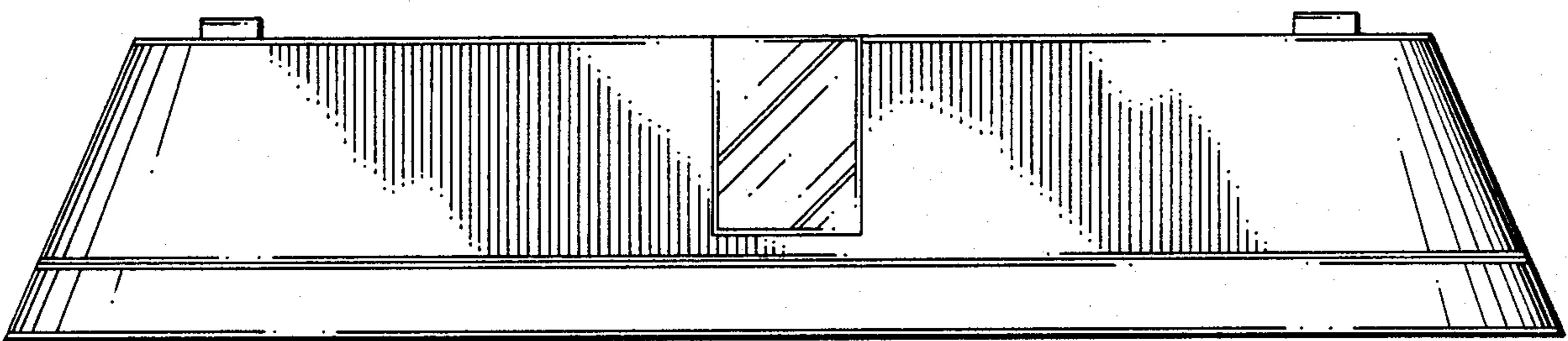
