[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable wireform lamp holder for track lighting fixture having straight sides, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, right side perspective view of an adjustable wireform lamp holder for track lighting fixture showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The lamp and track mount are shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.
