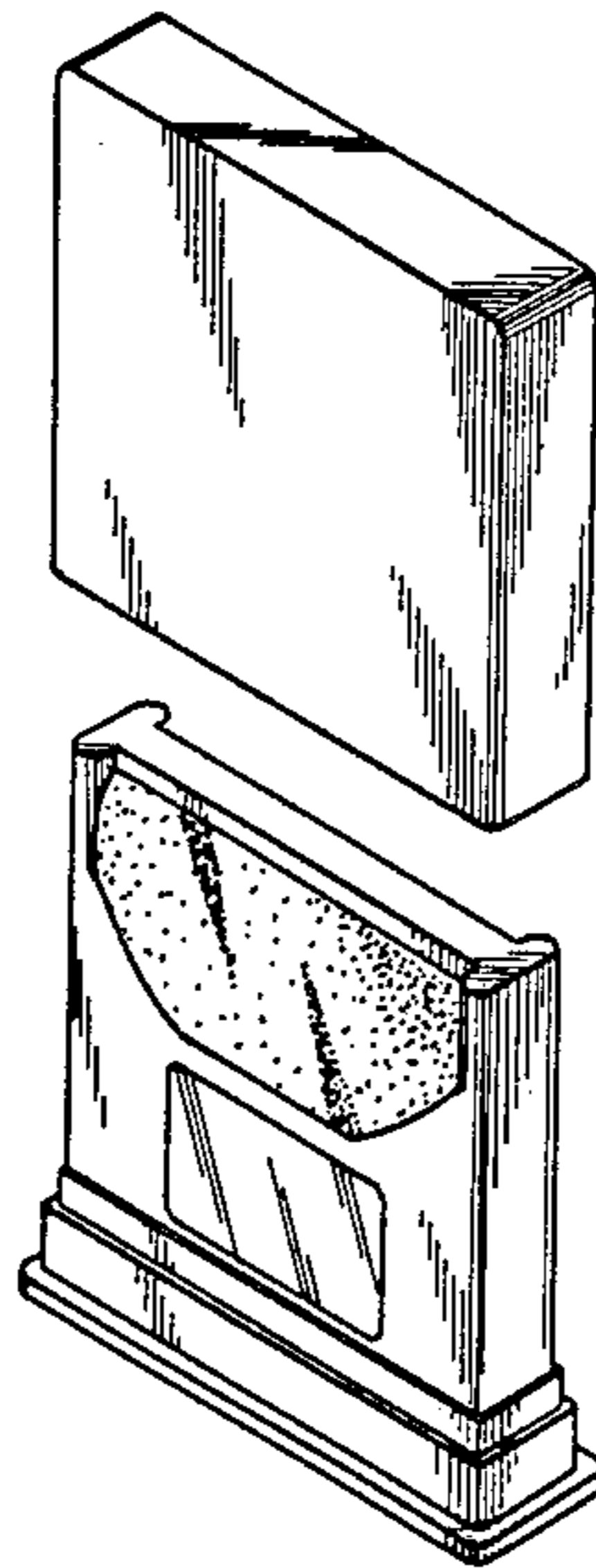

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lipstick case, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a lipstick case showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown;  
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof; the side opposite being a mirror image of the side shown;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is an exploded perspective view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the cover element of the design, shown separately for clarity of illustration;  
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the base portion, shown separately for clarity of illustration;  
FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof; and  
FIG. 11 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown.



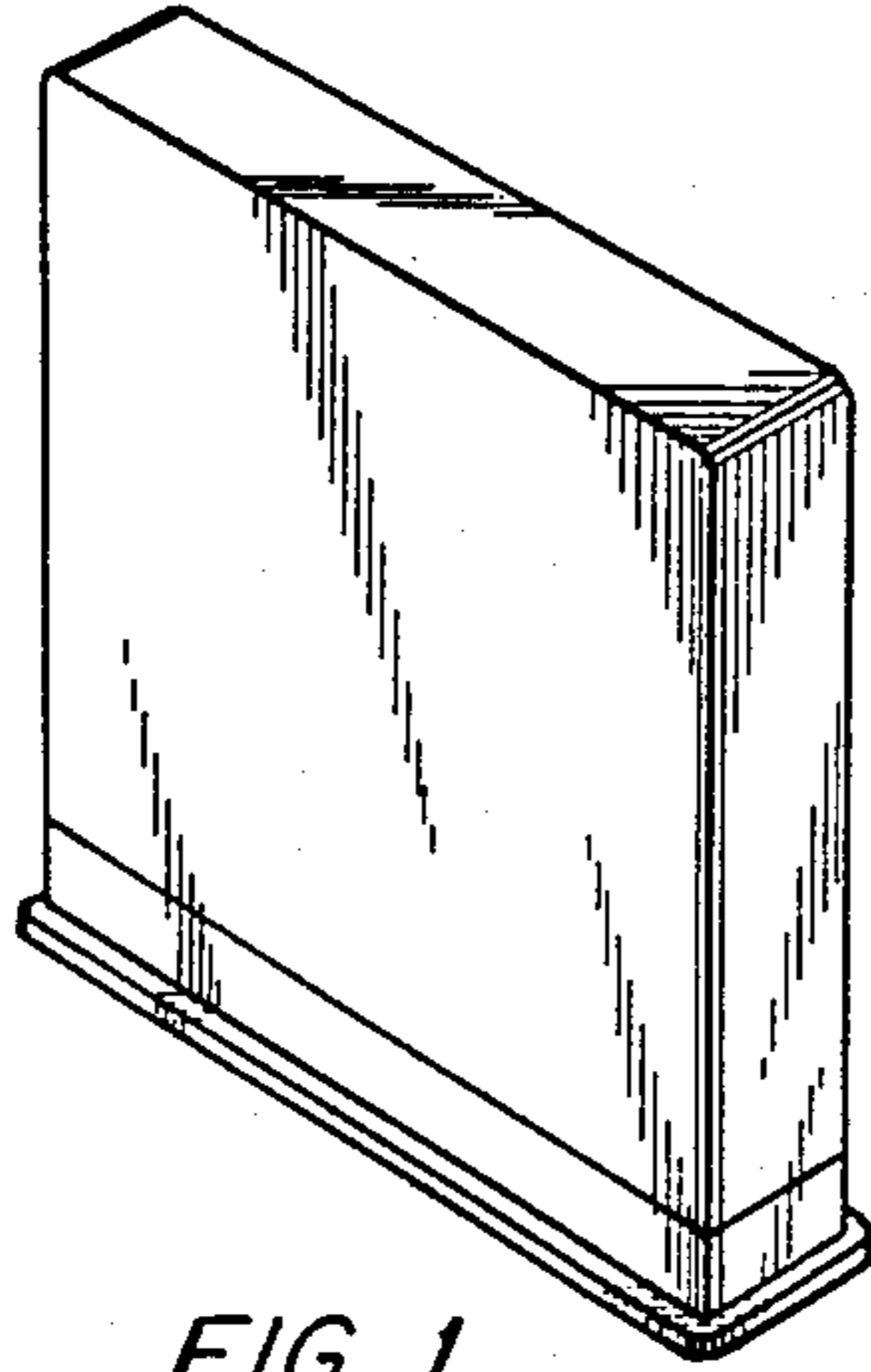

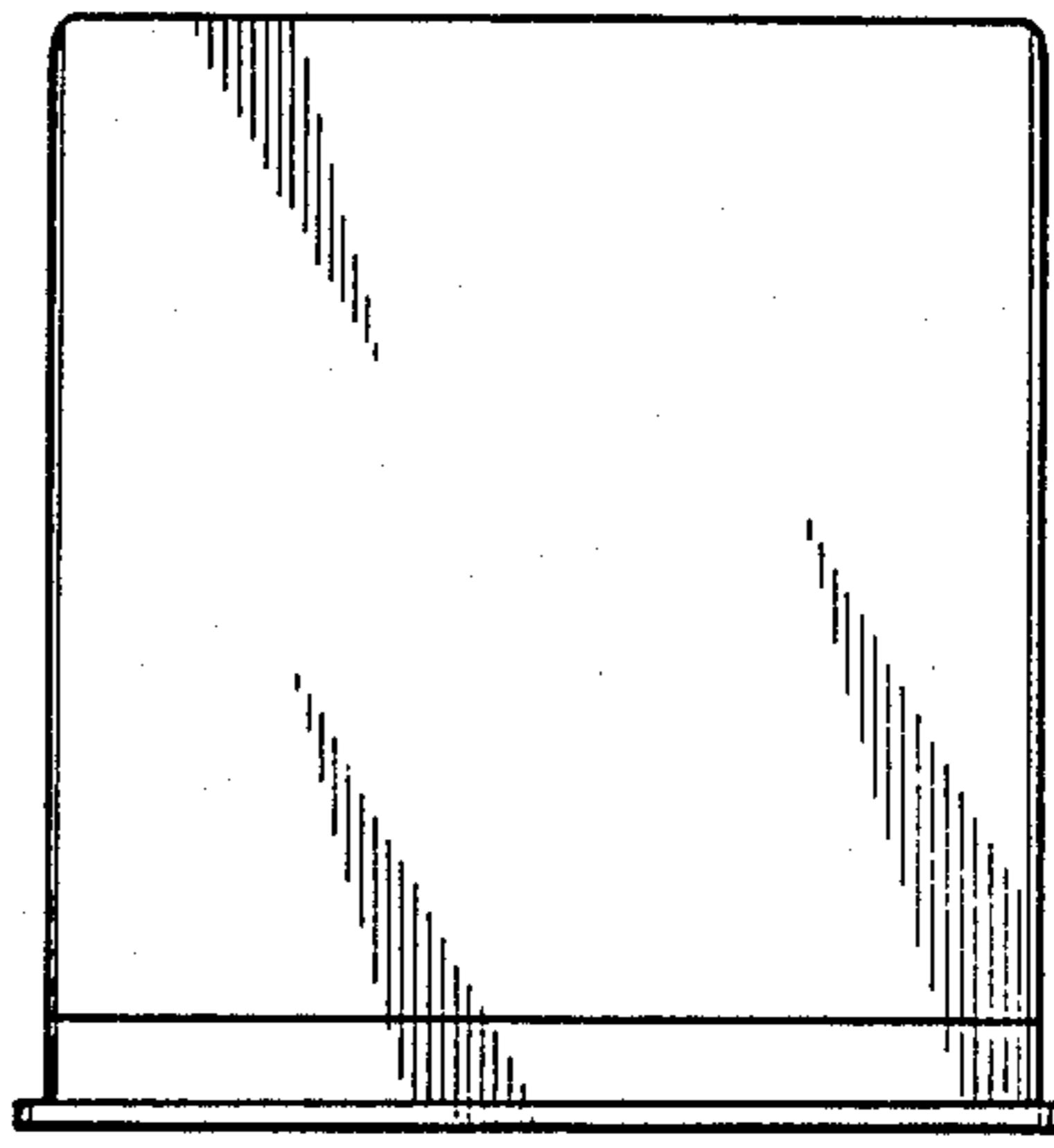

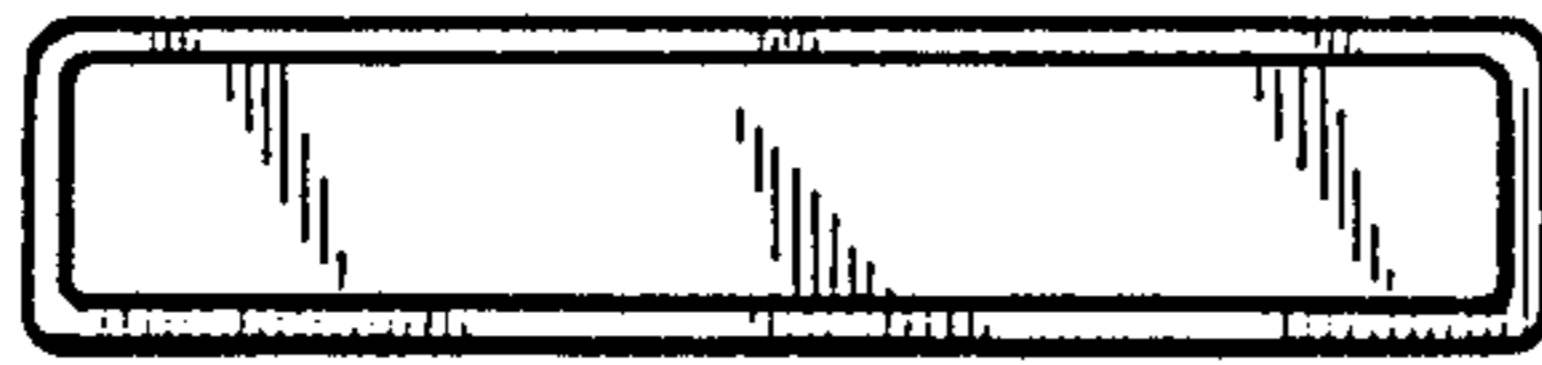

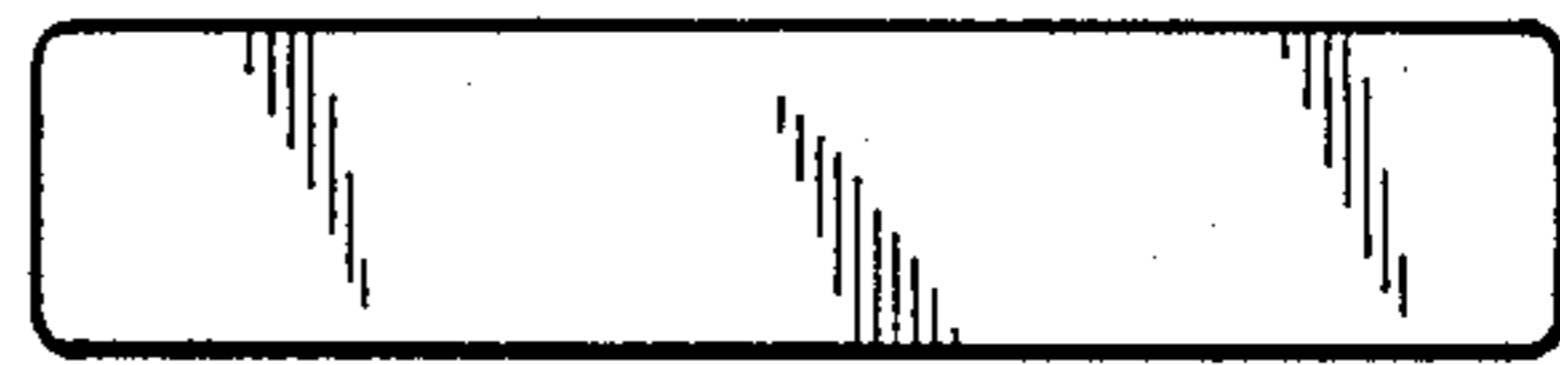

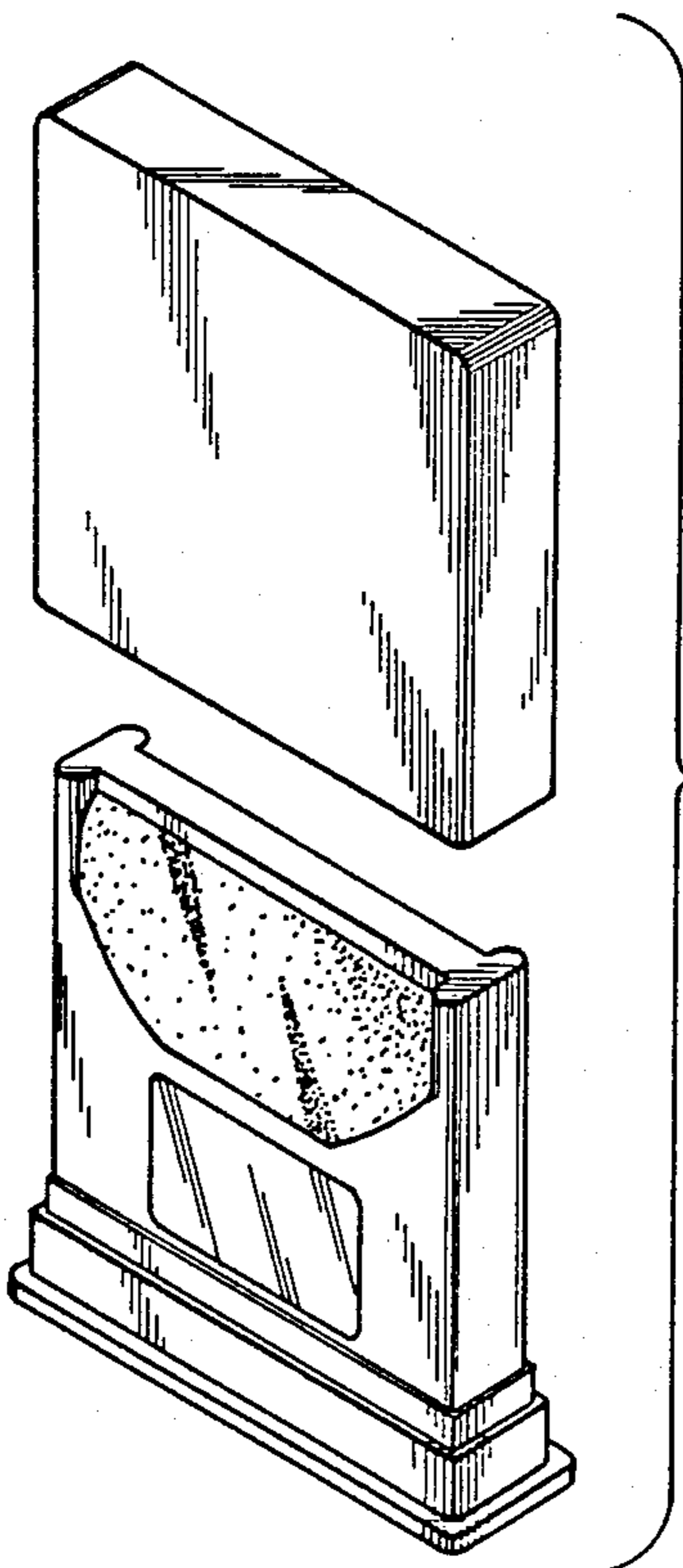

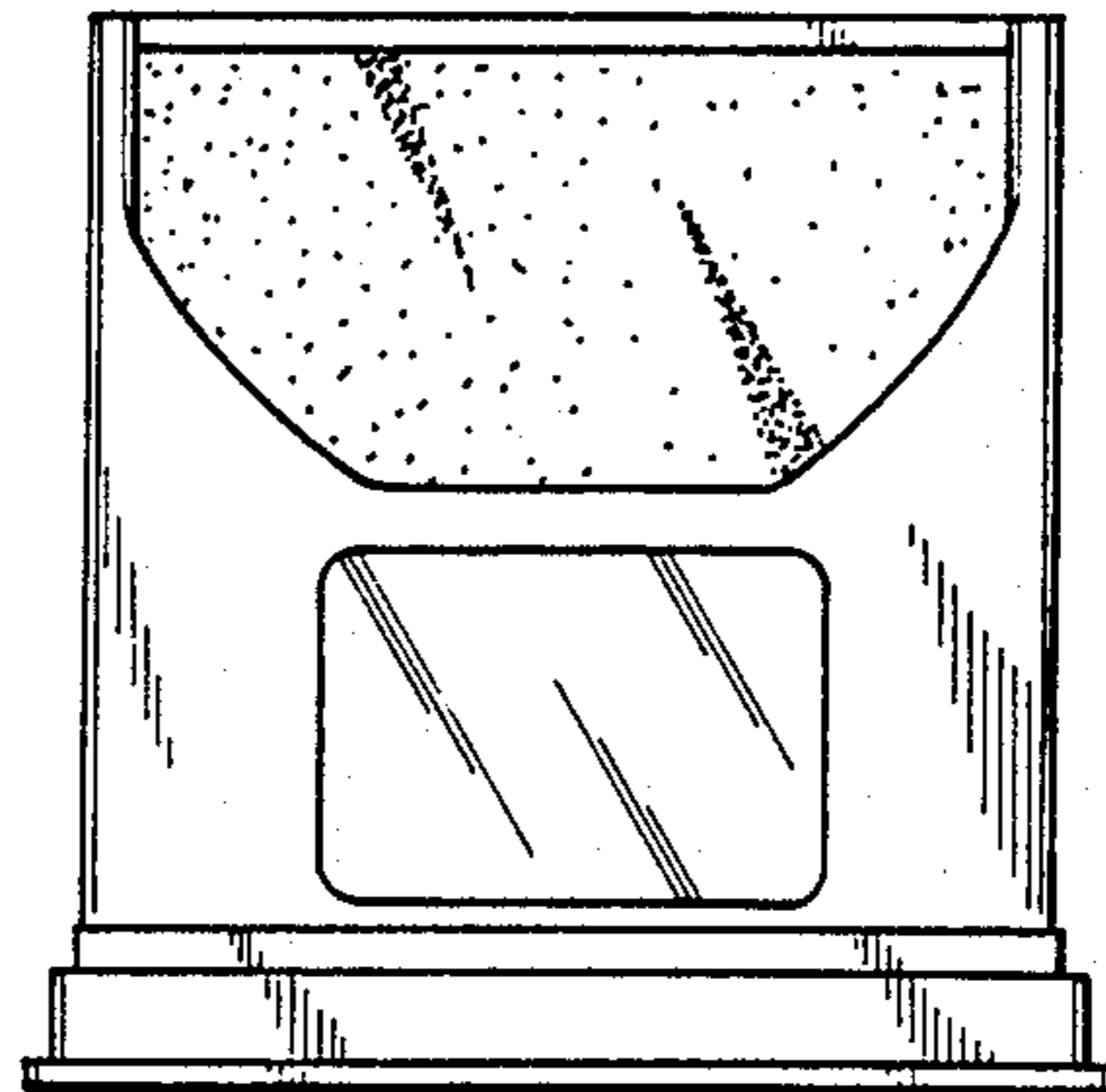

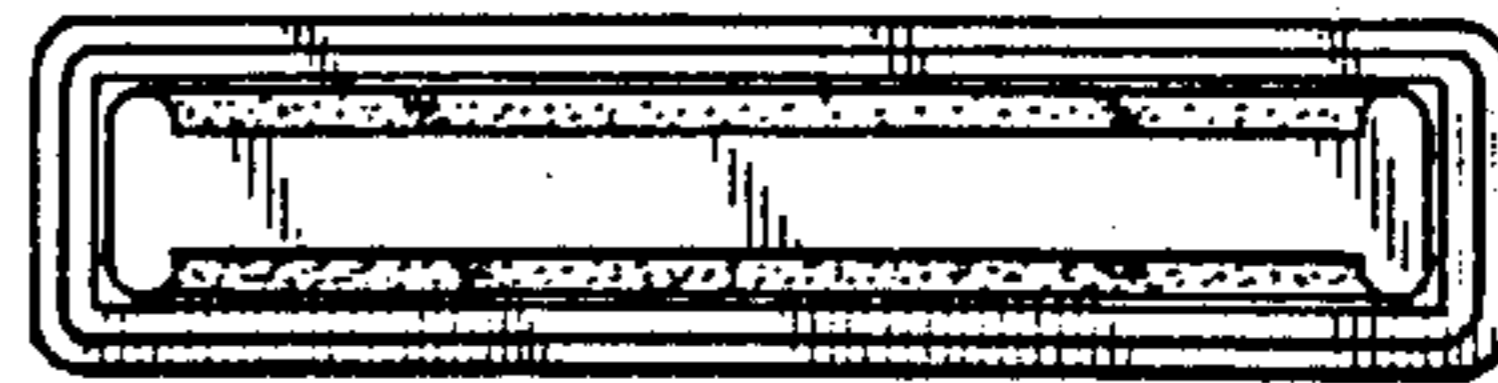

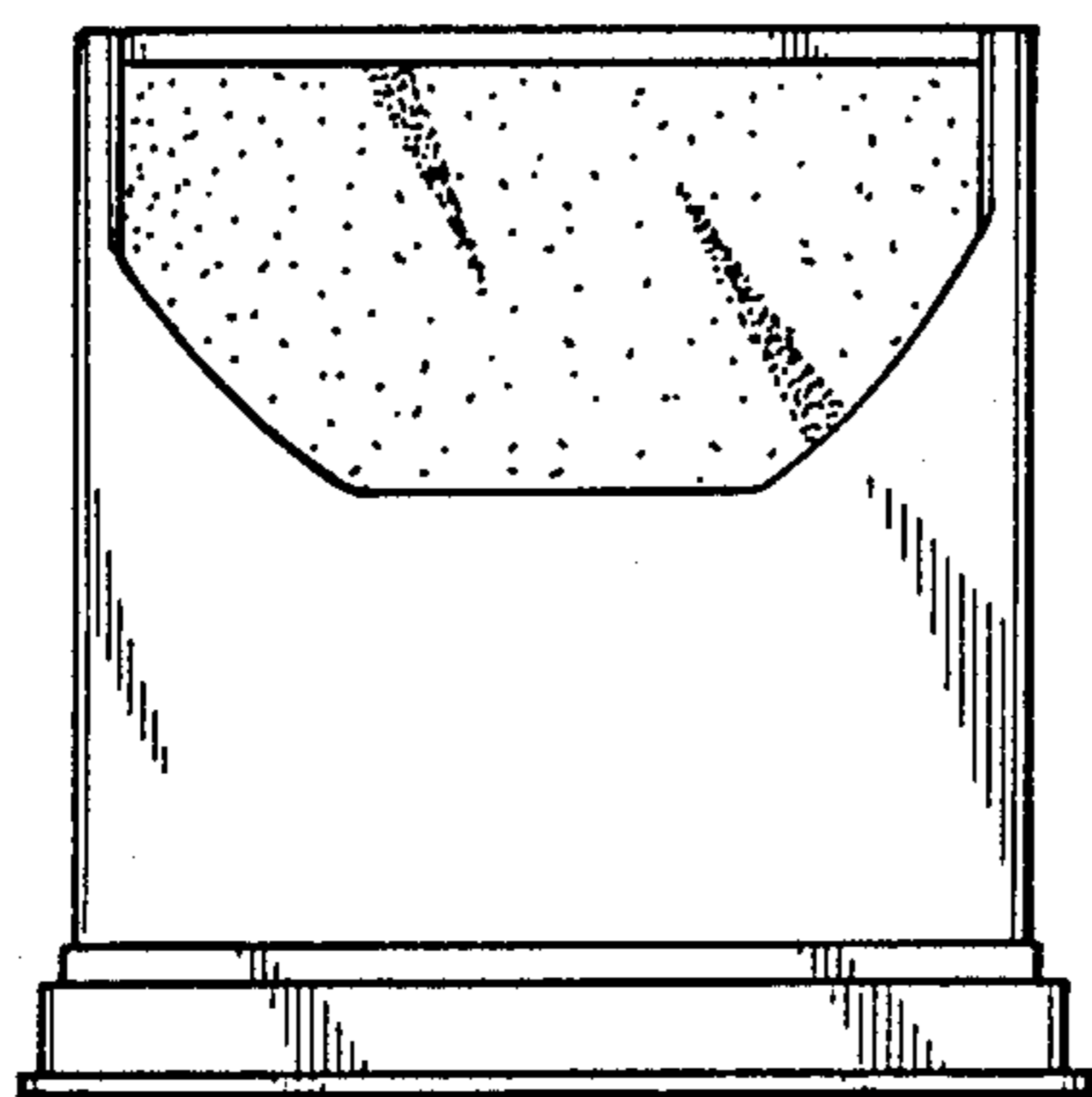

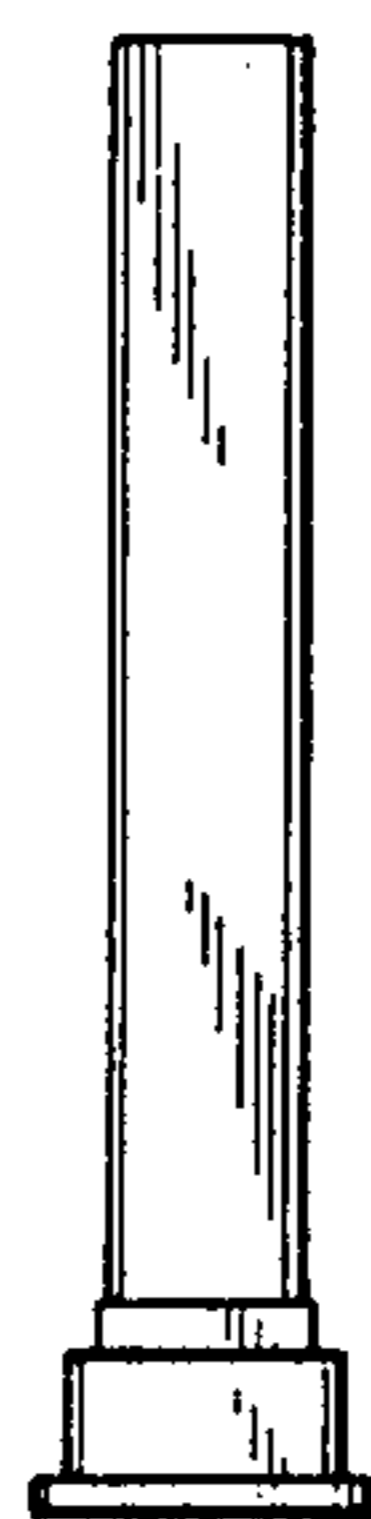
