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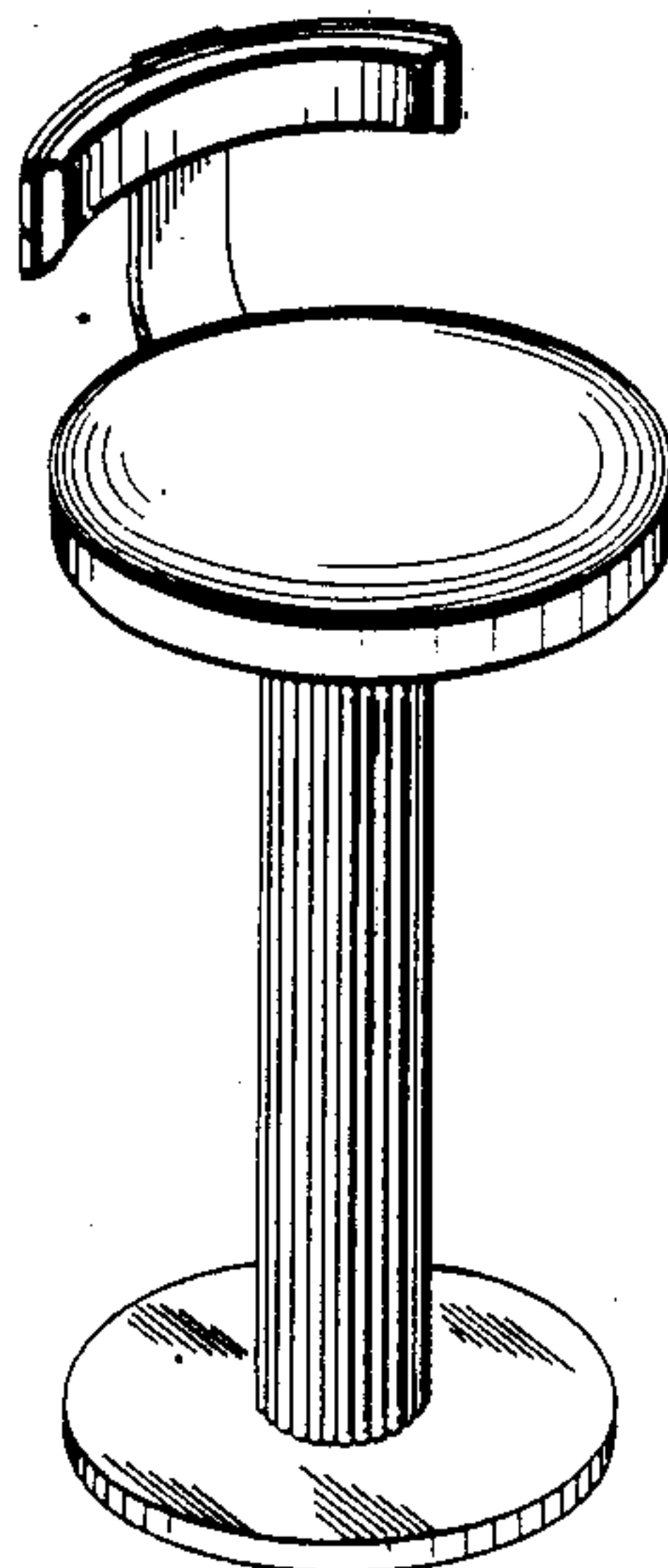

FIG. 5 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment, showing my new design.



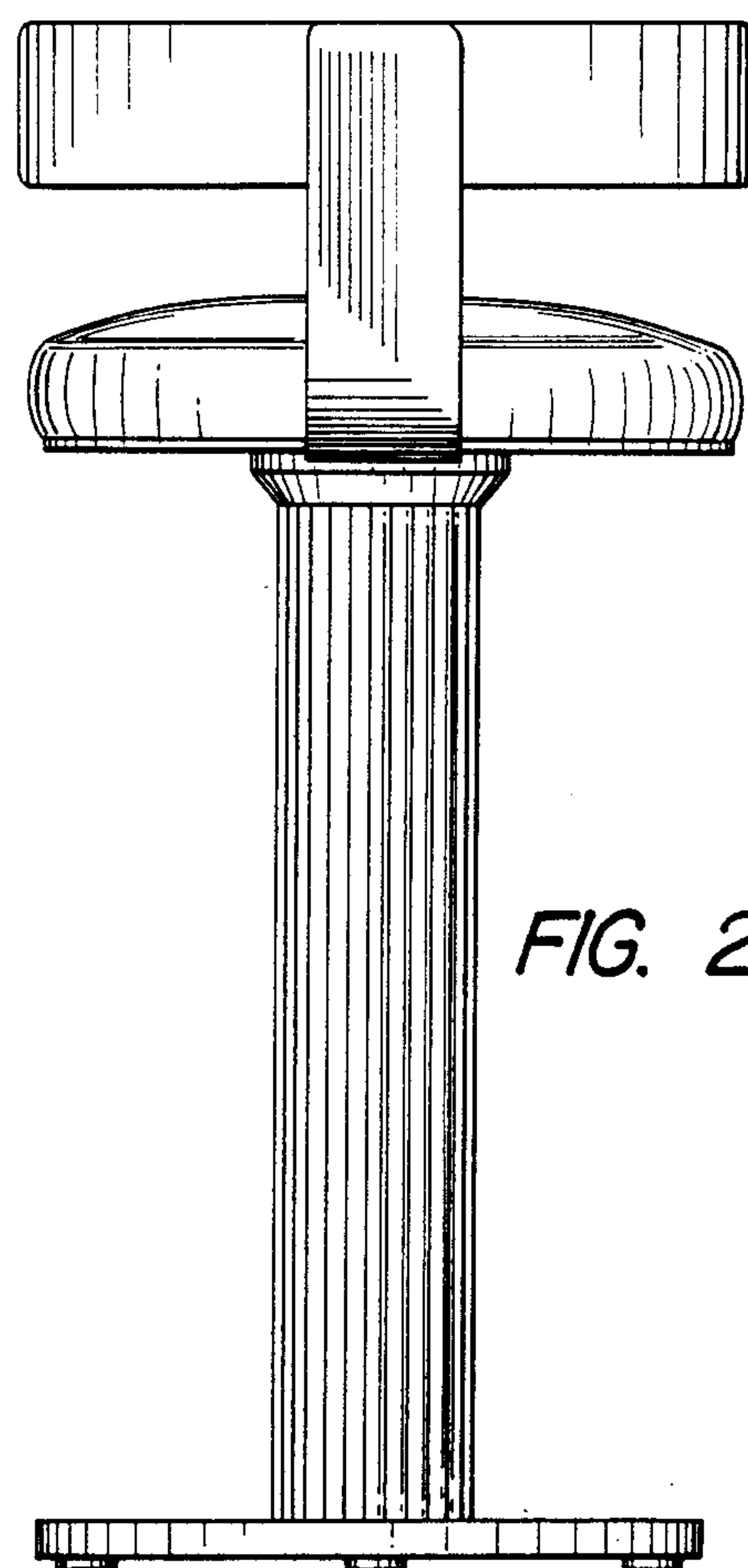
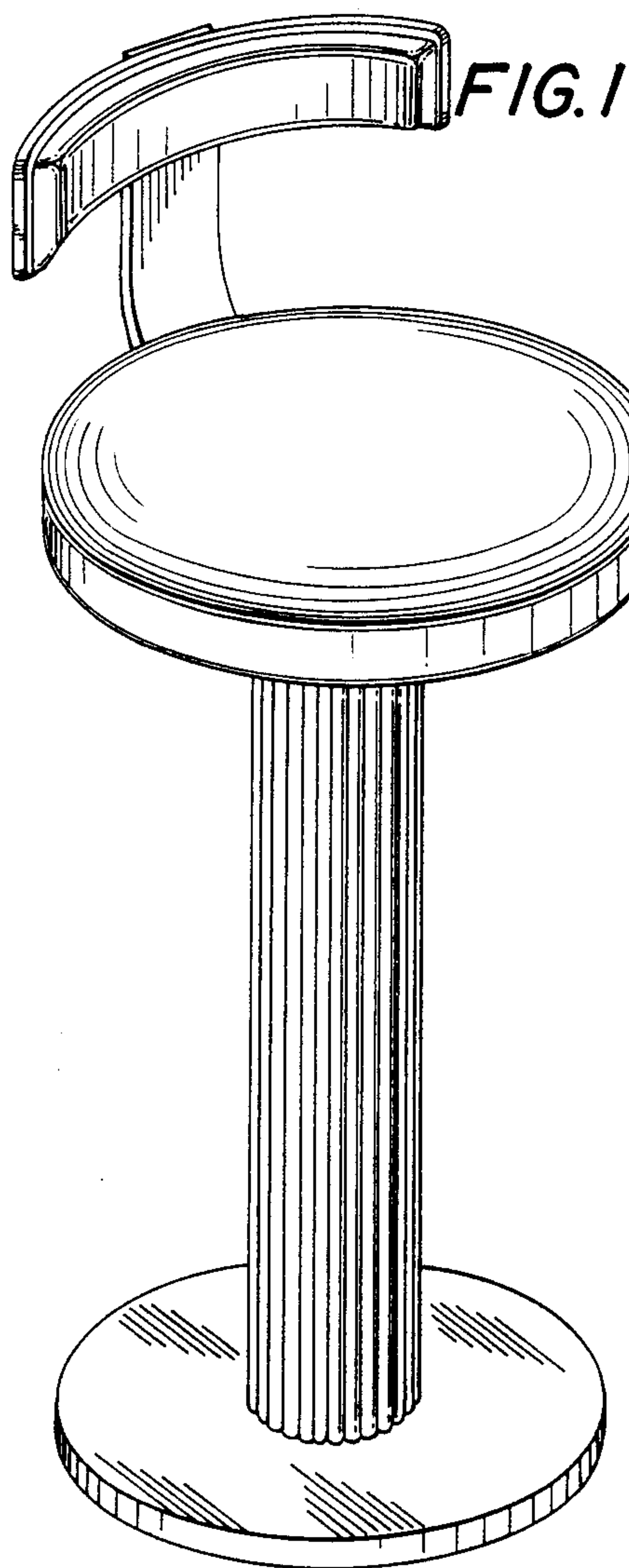

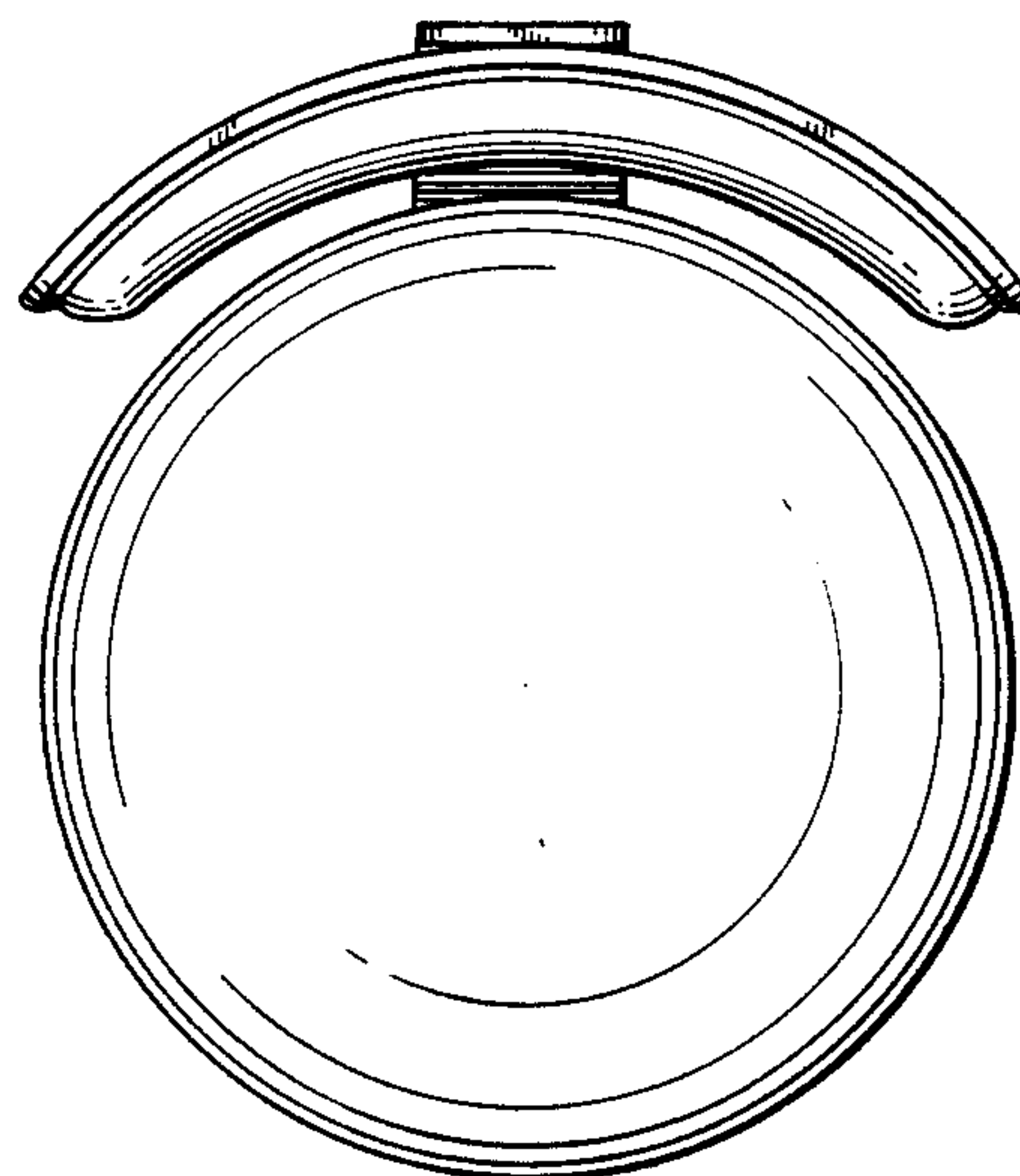

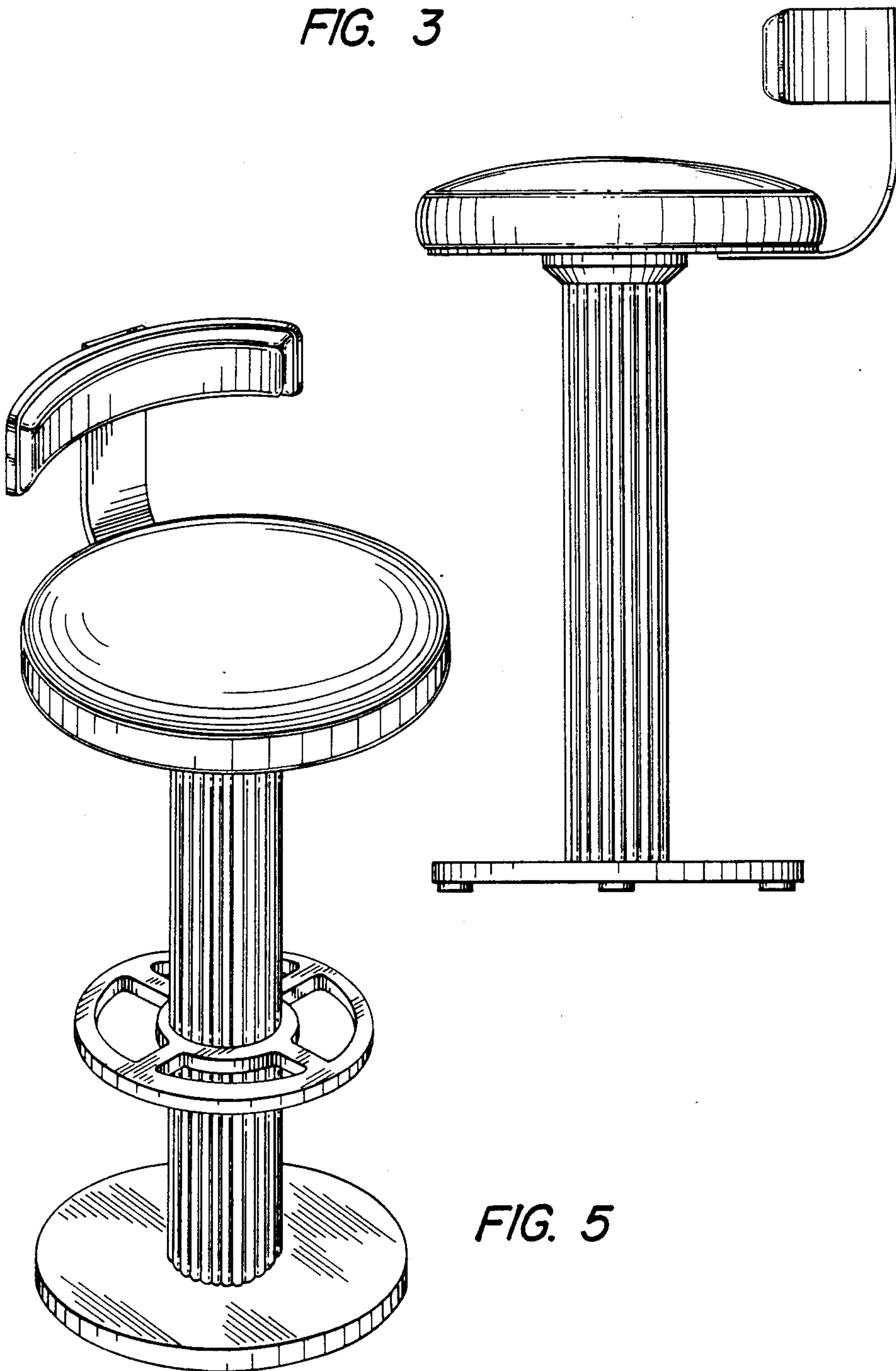
