FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a video cabinet or similar article showing our new design;

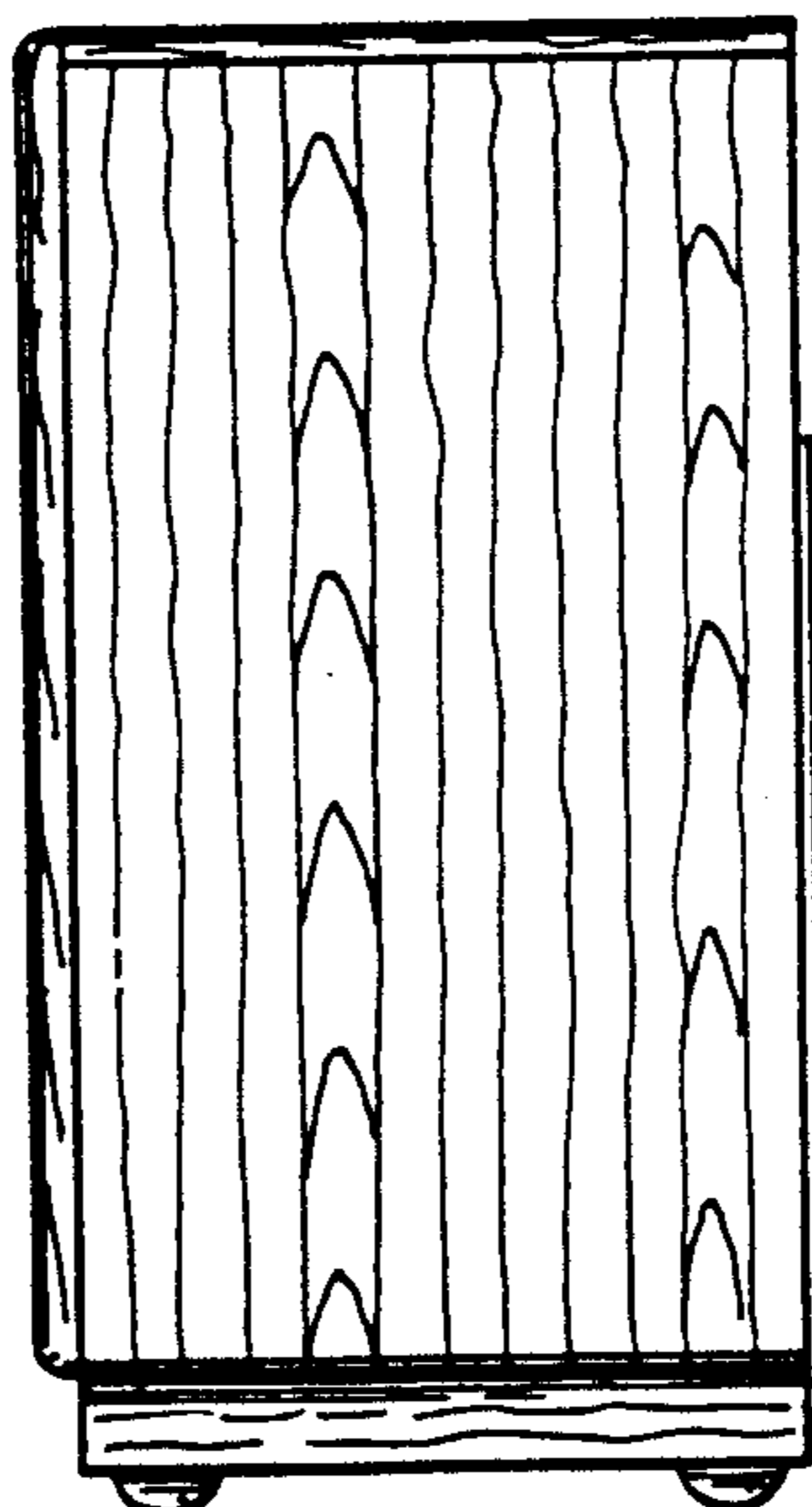
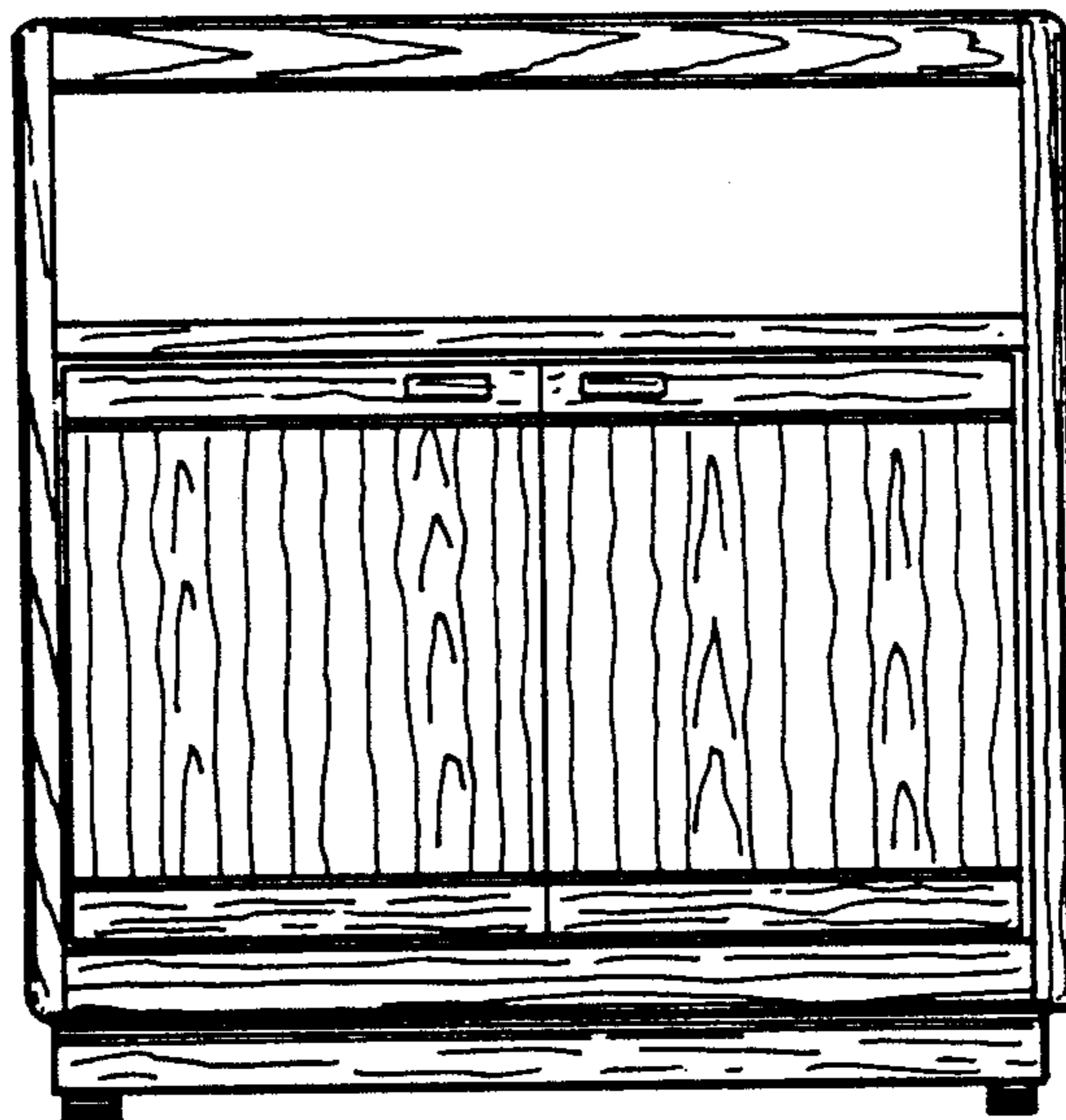
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof.



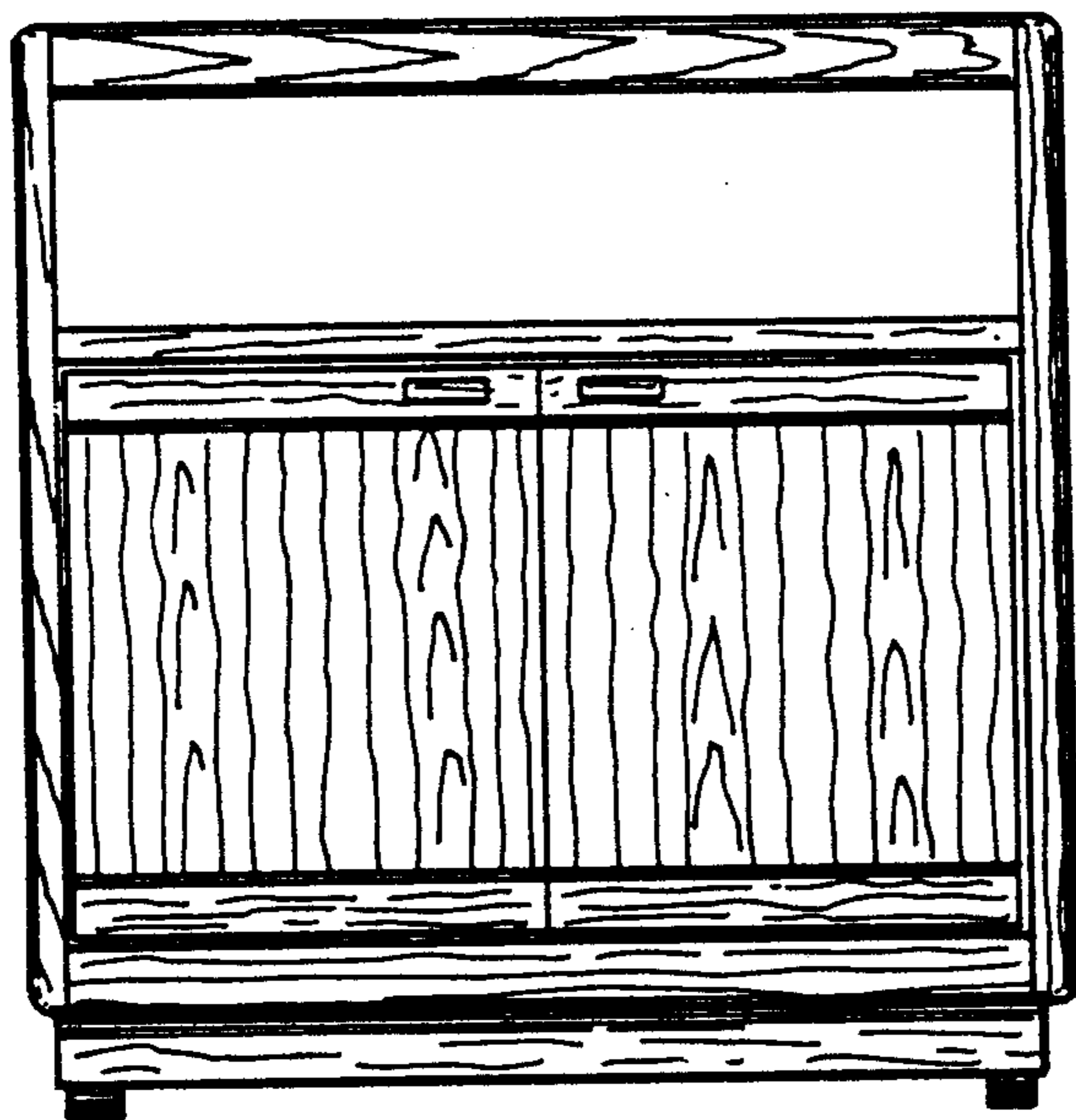

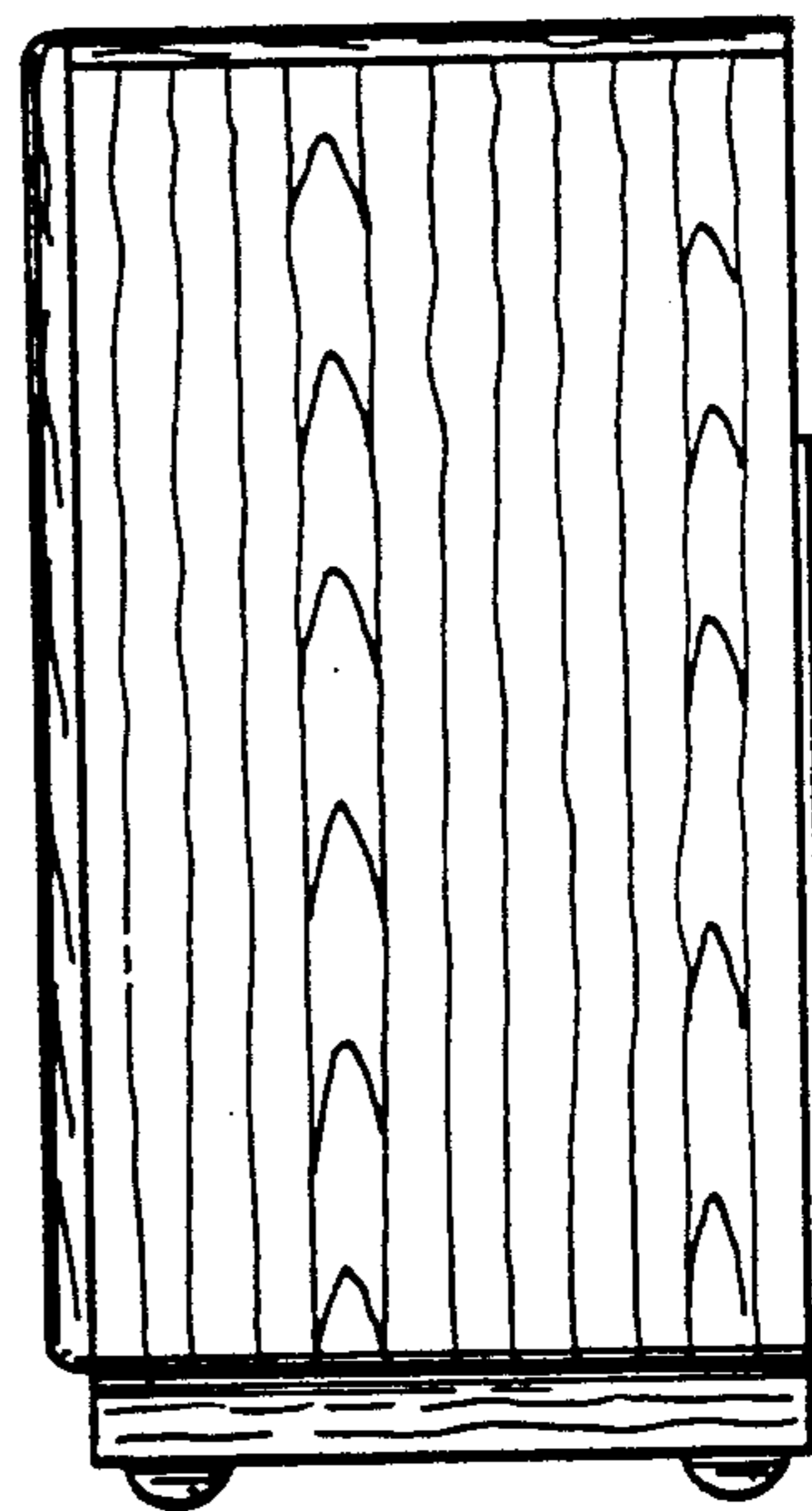

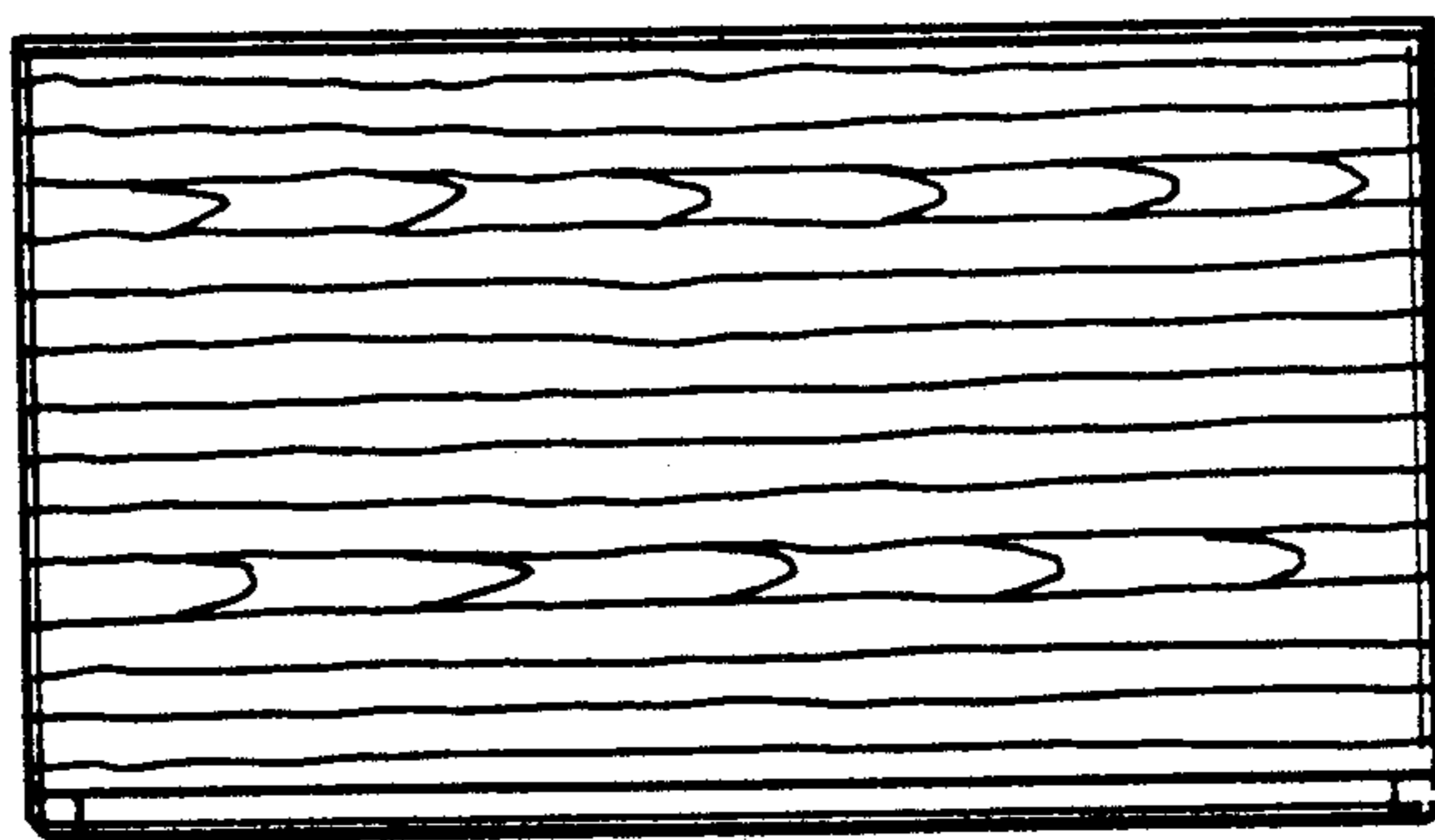

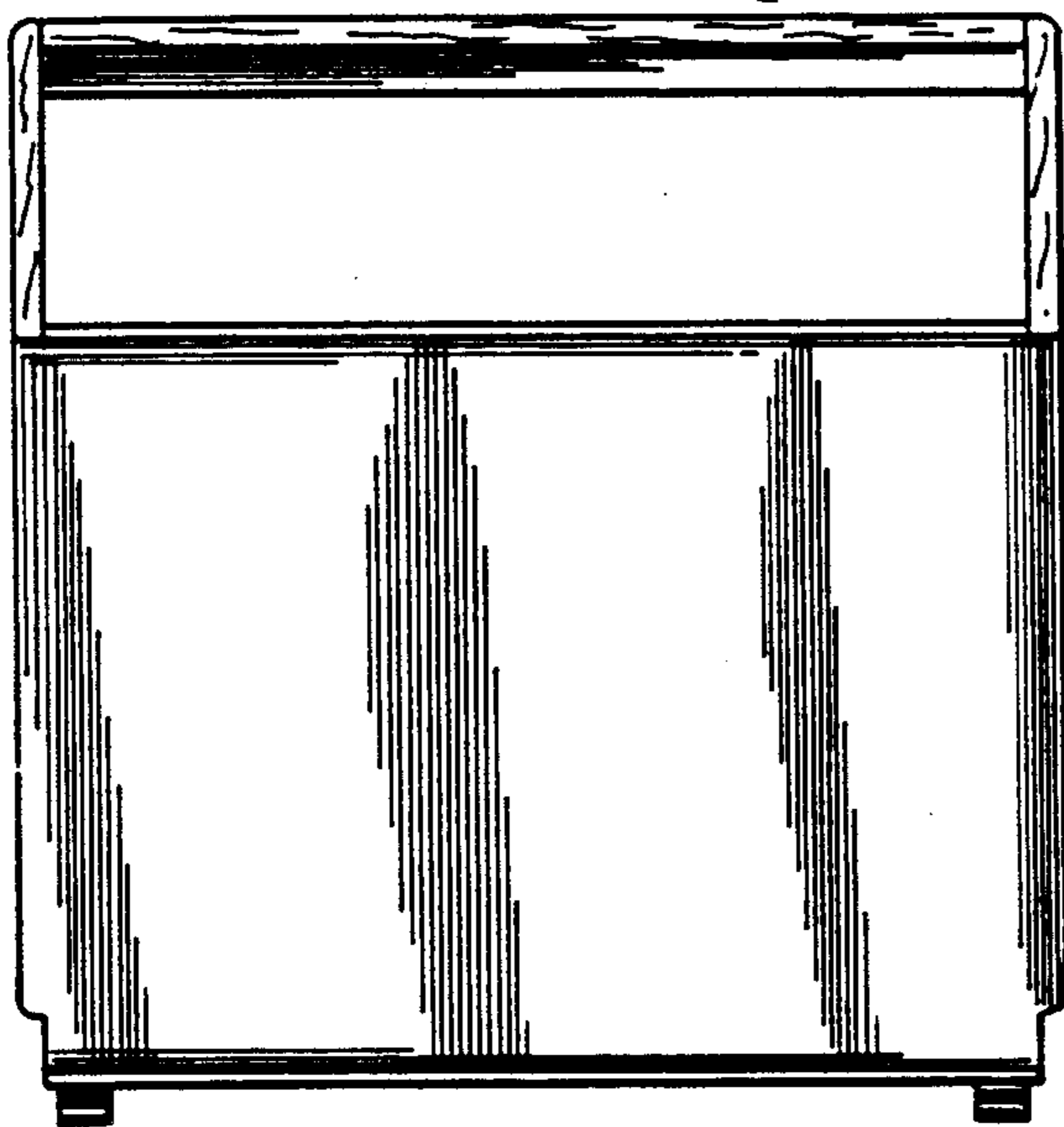

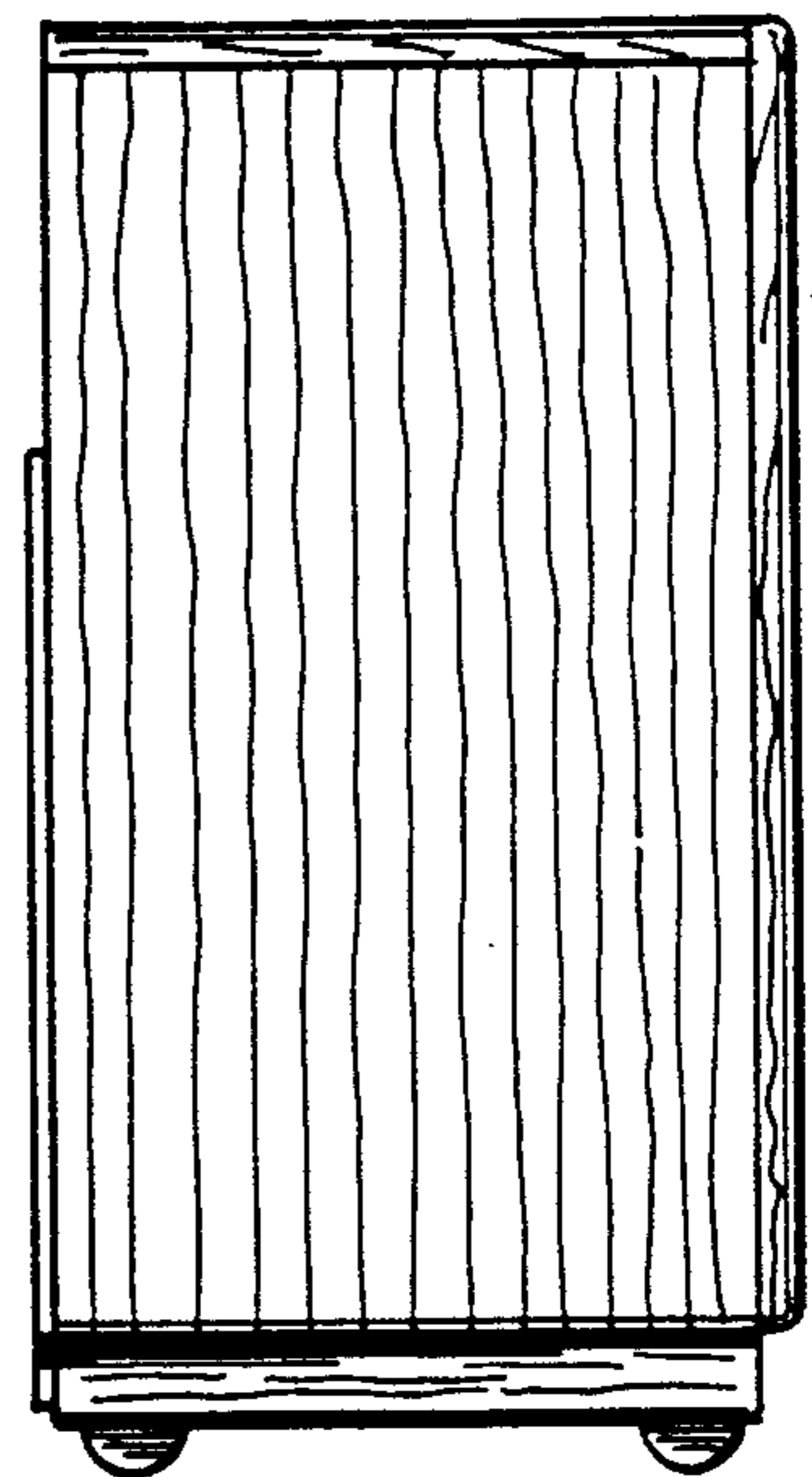

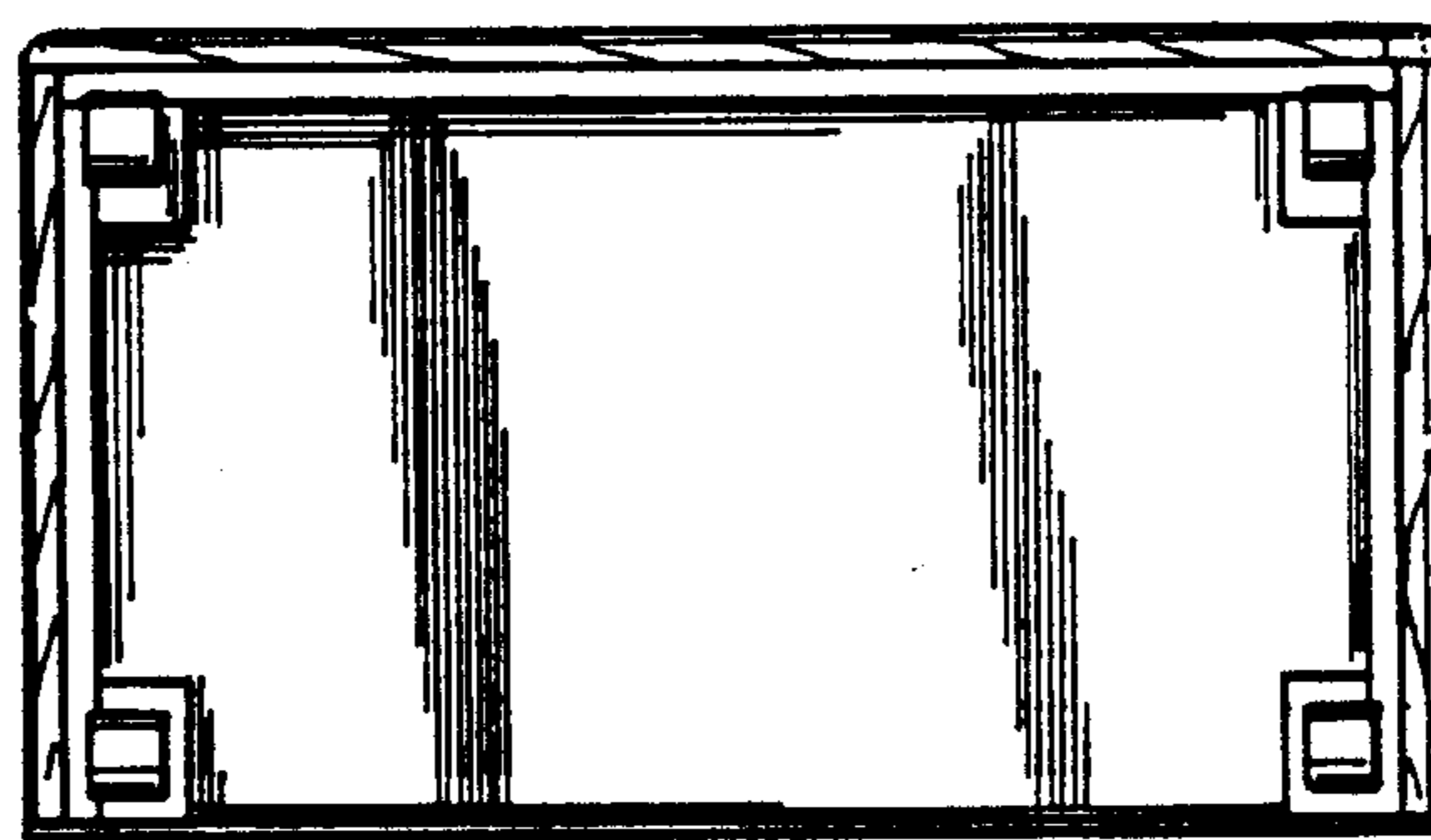
