FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

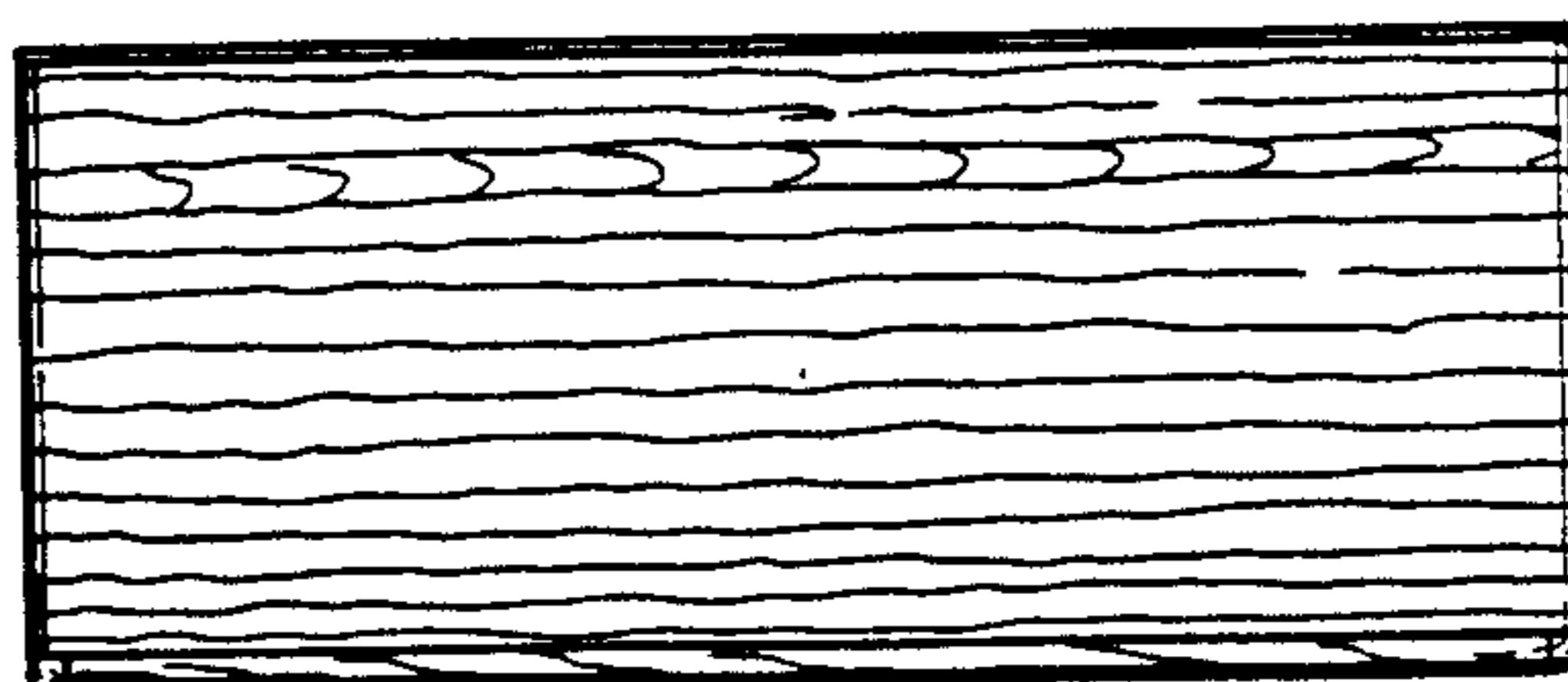
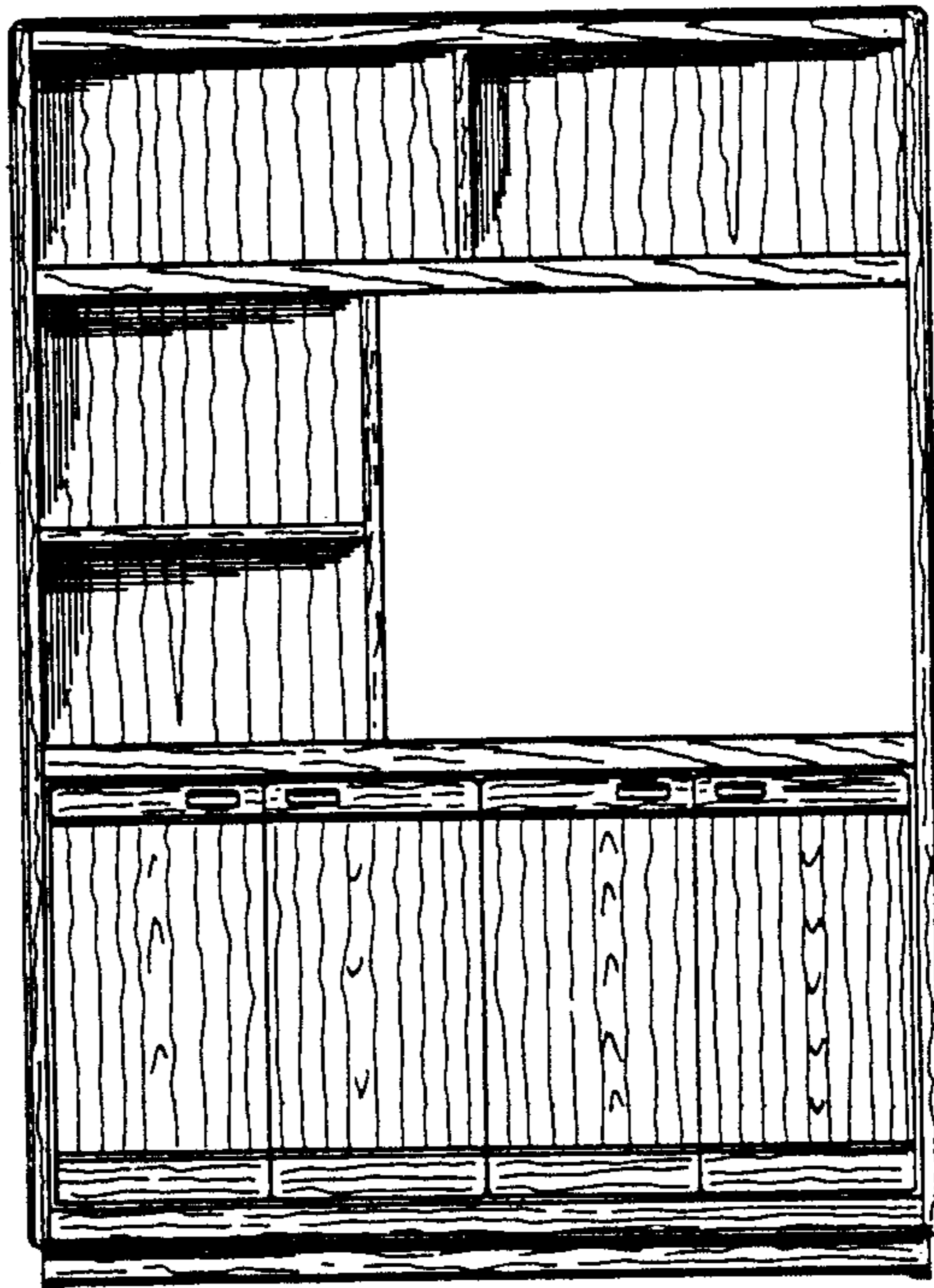
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

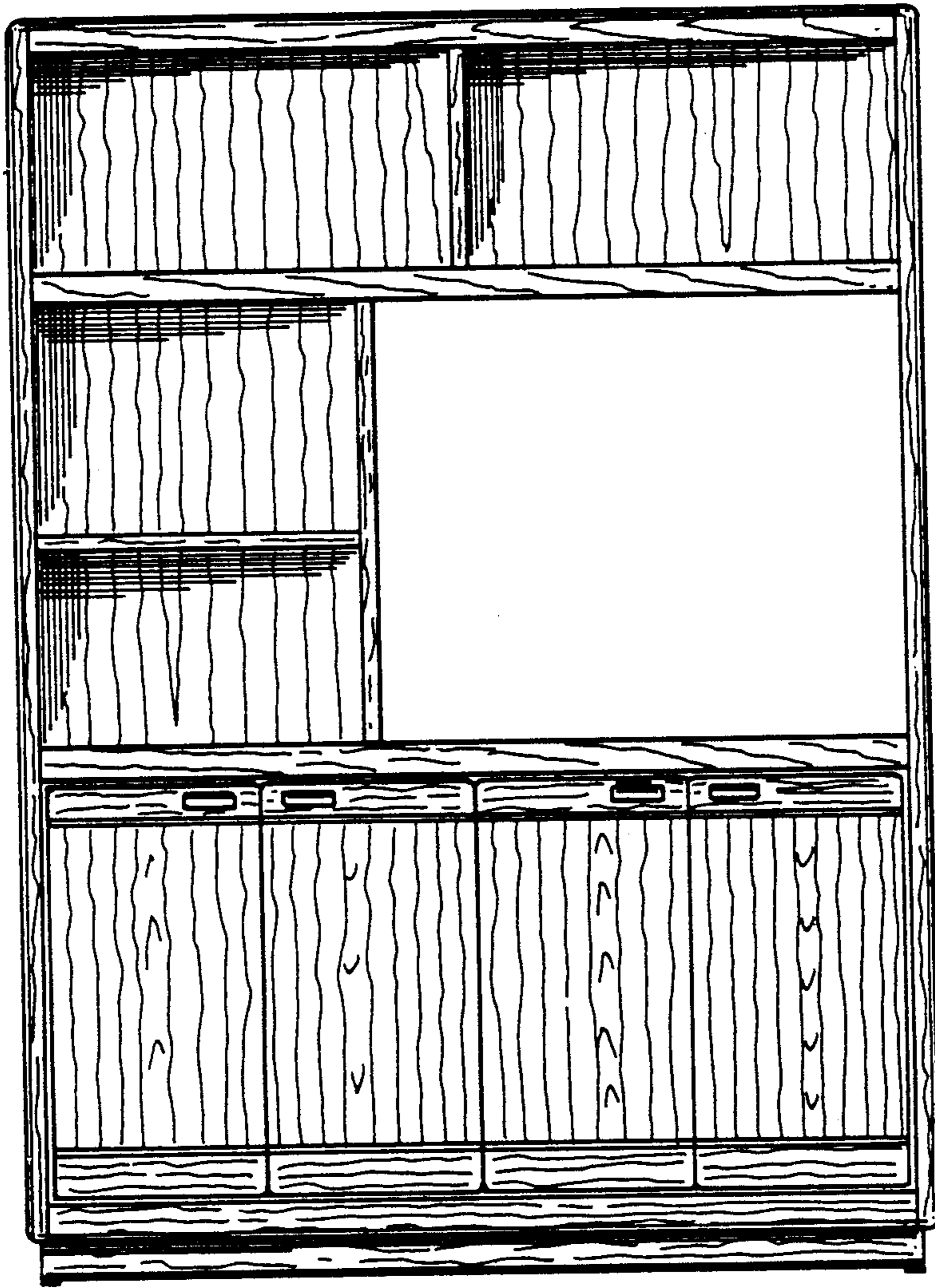

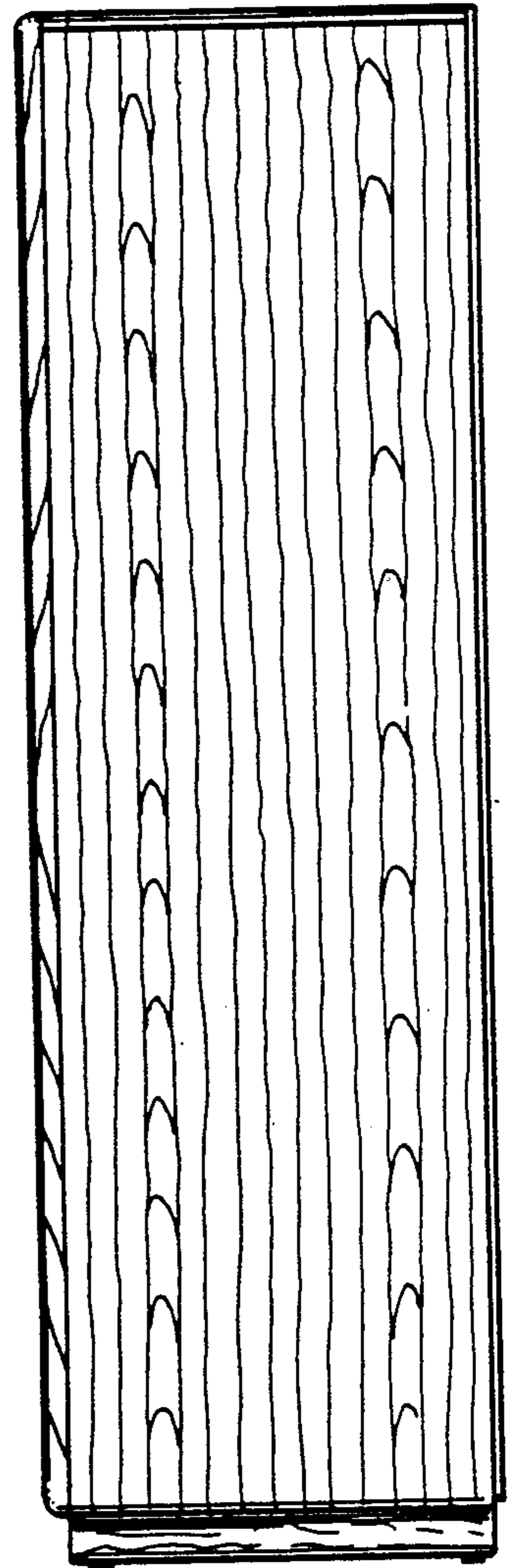

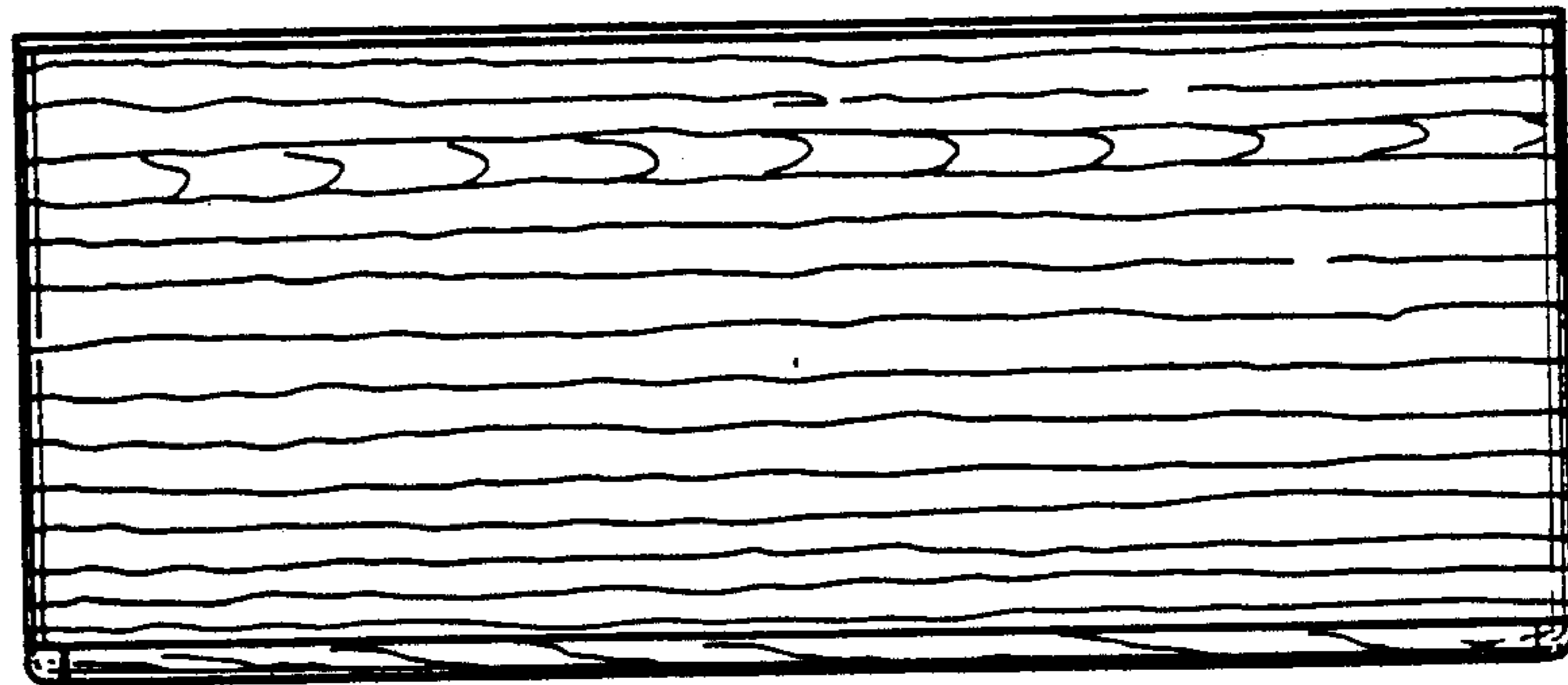

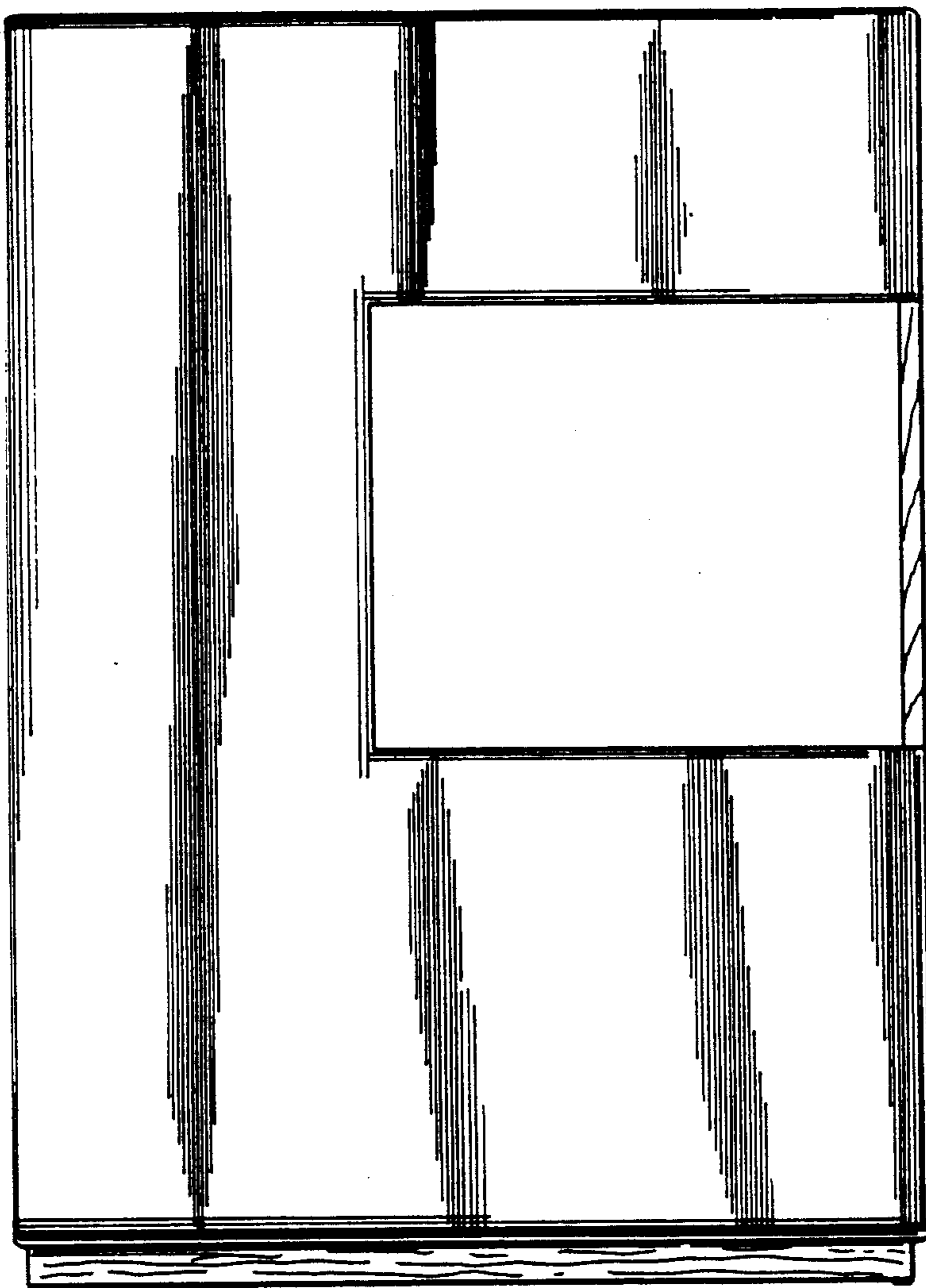

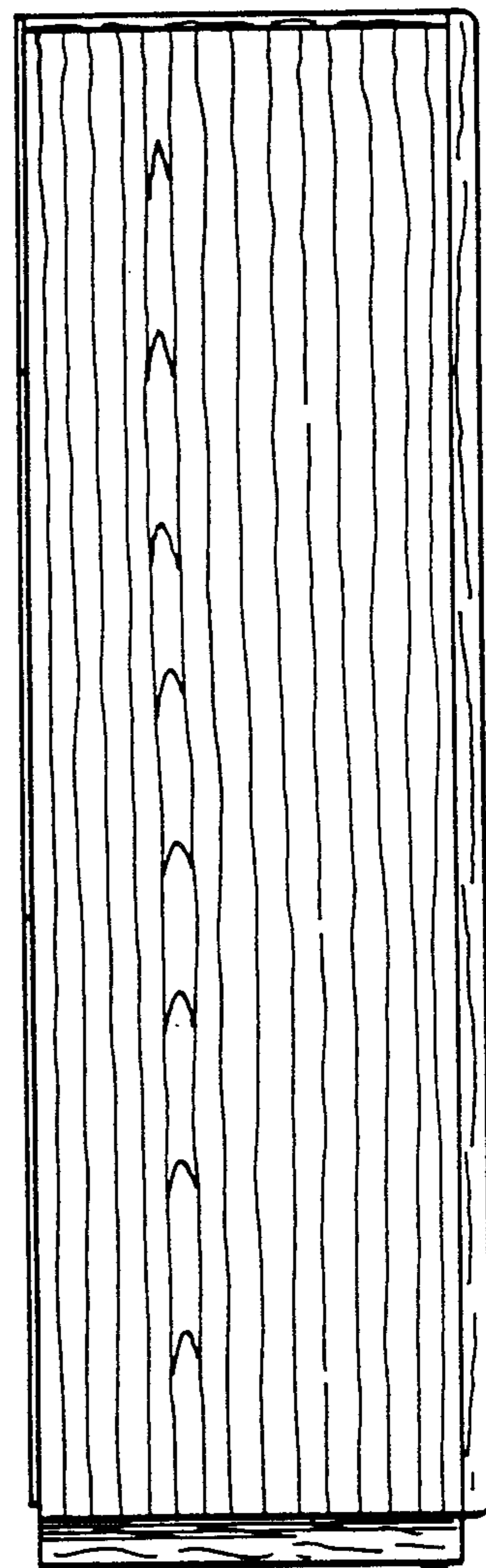

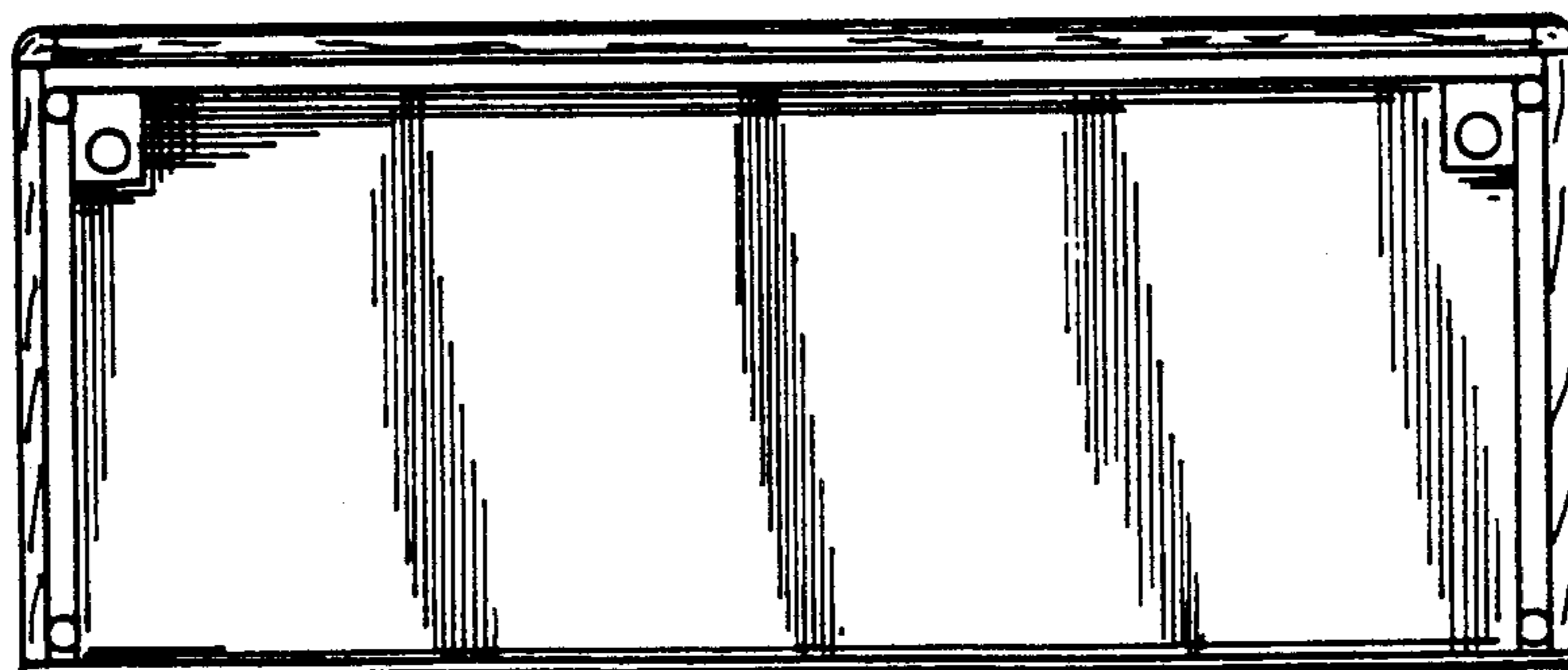
