FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a curio cabinet showing my new design;

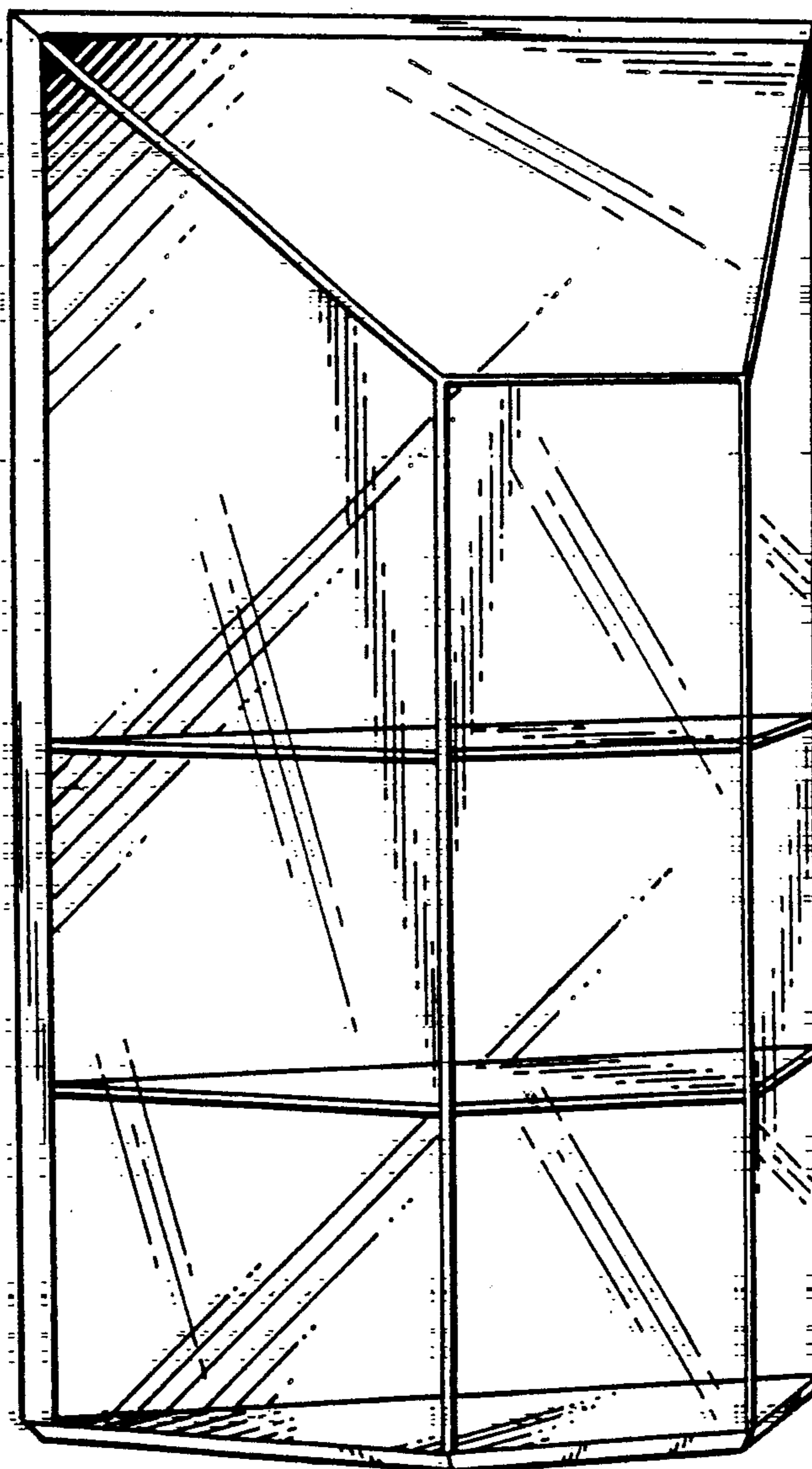
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



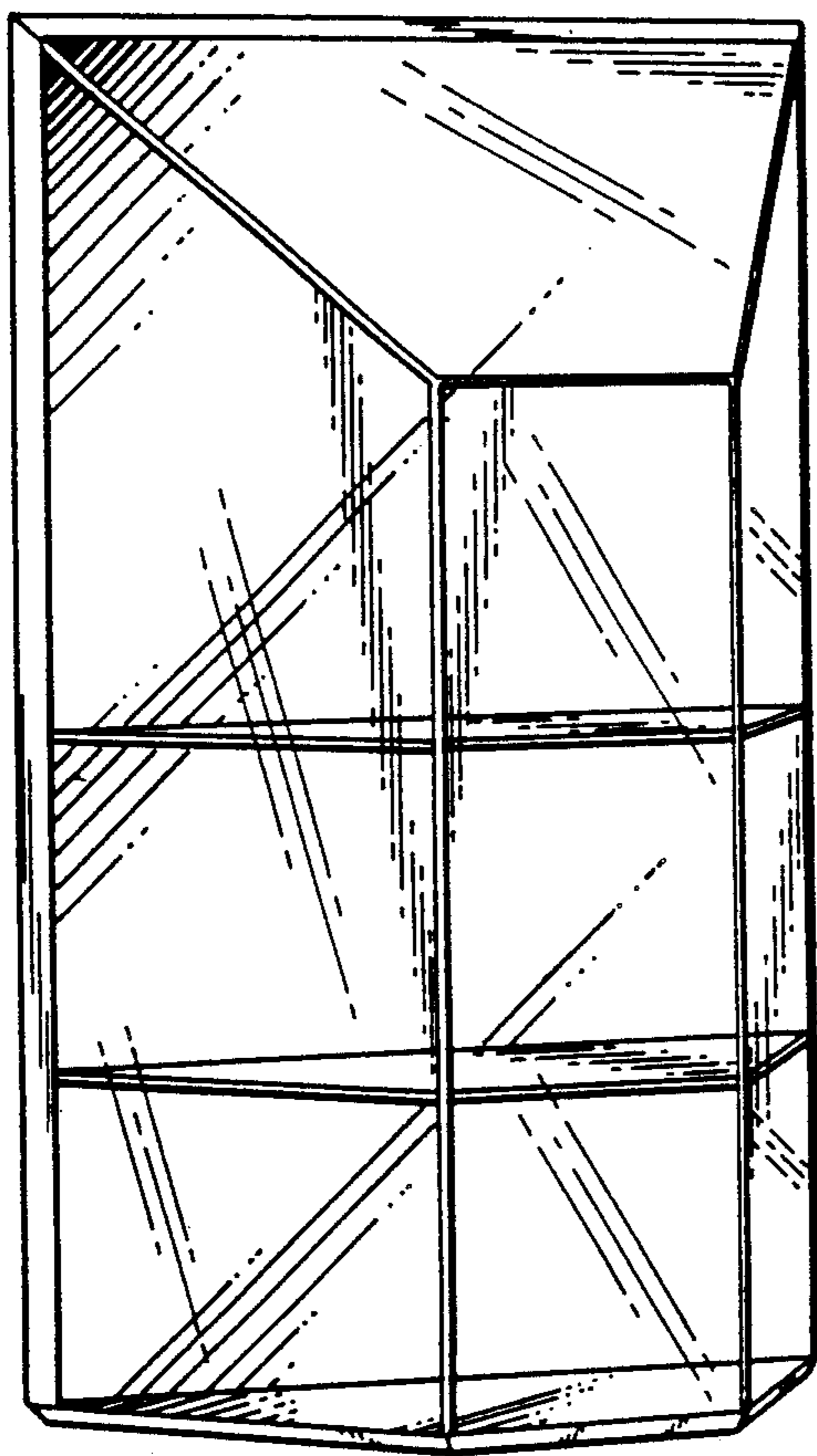

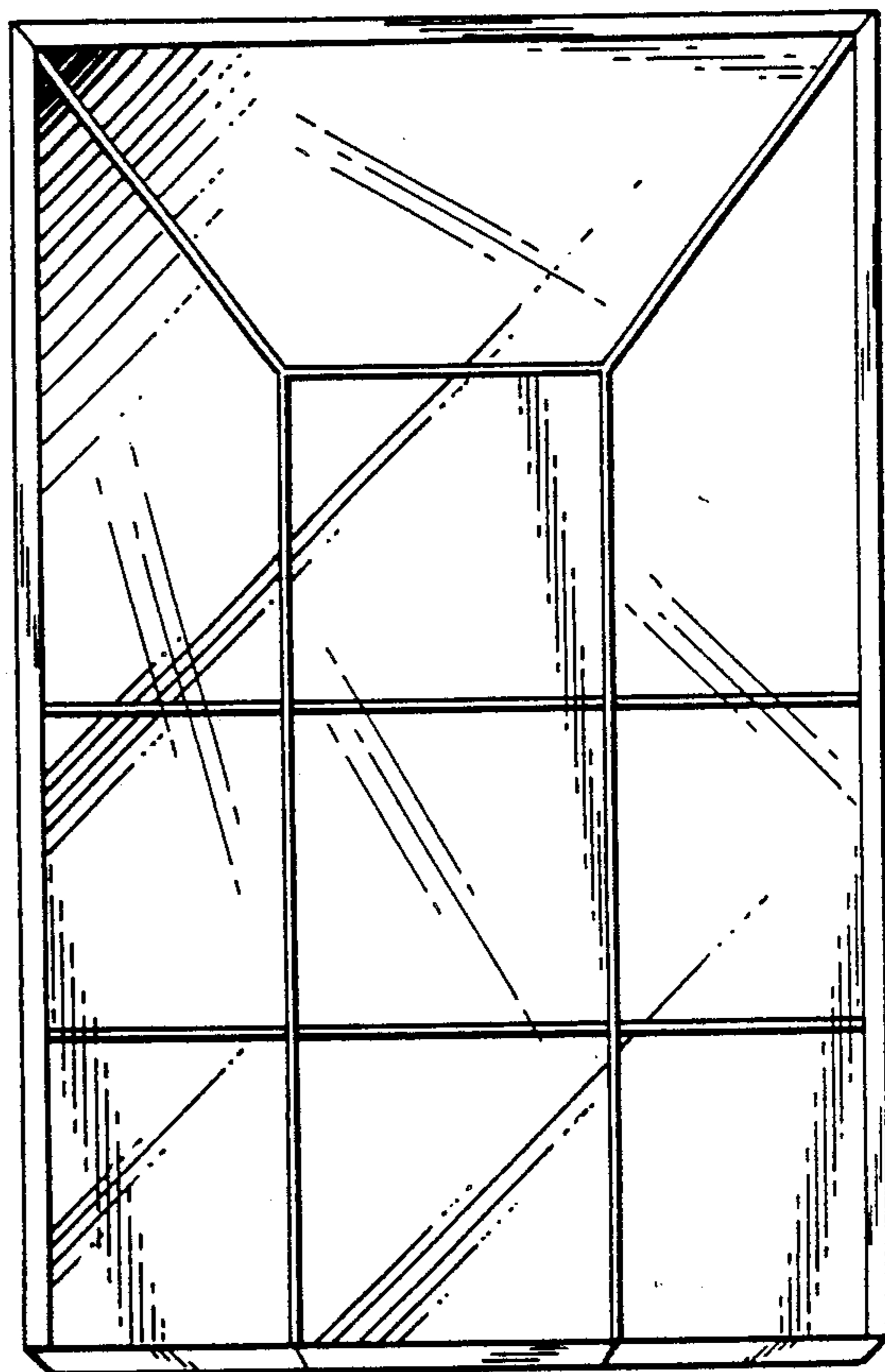

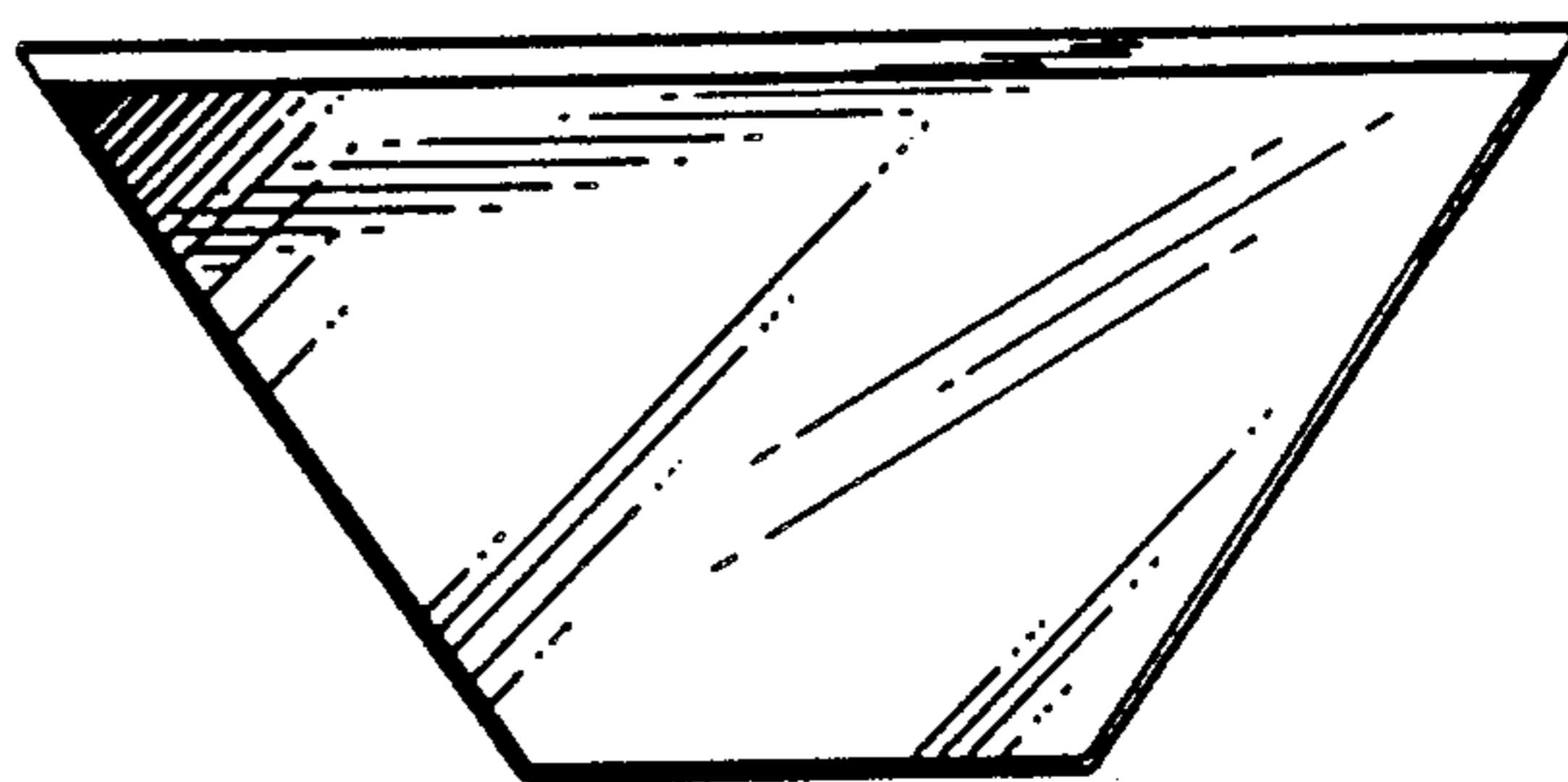

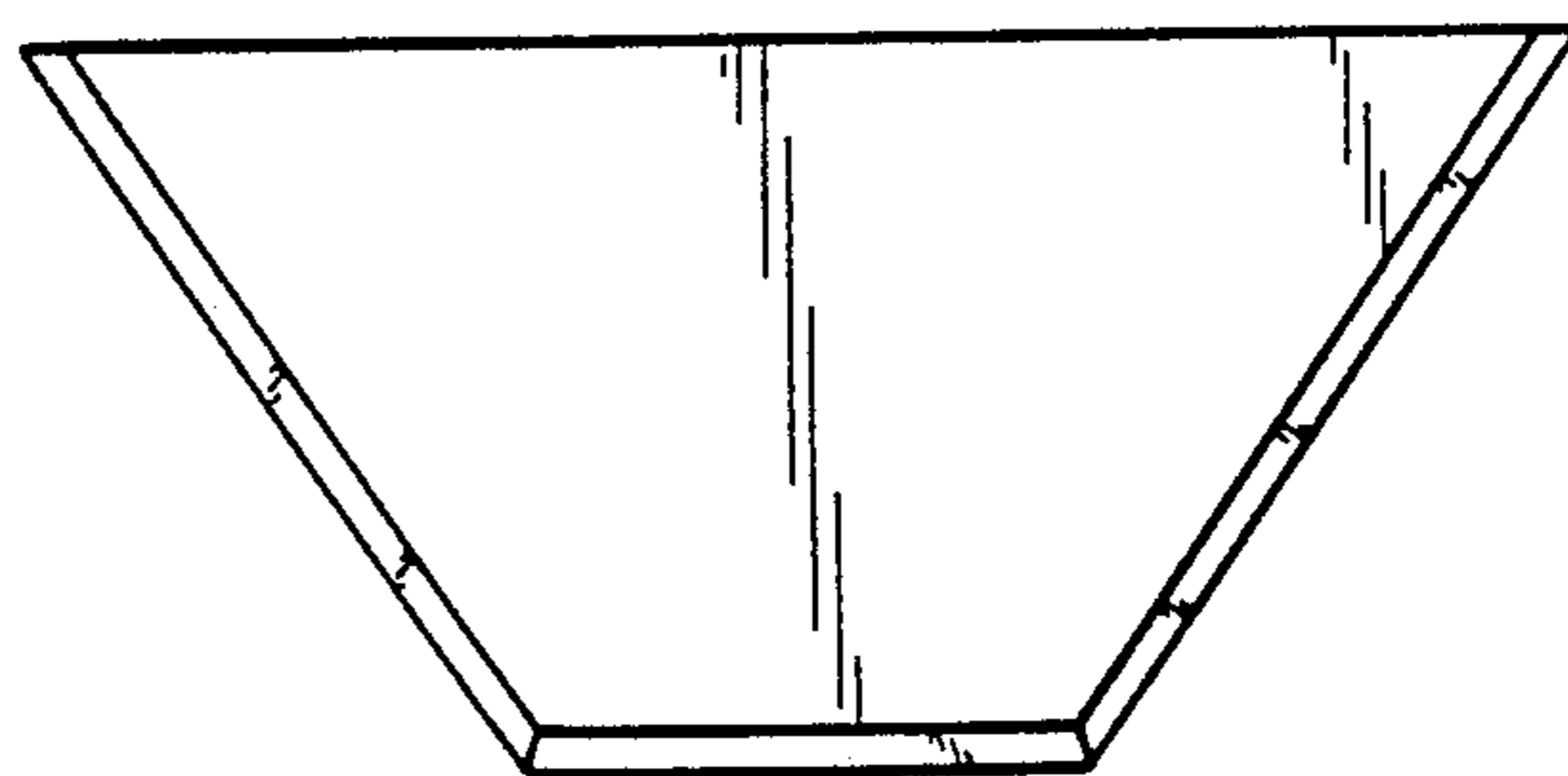

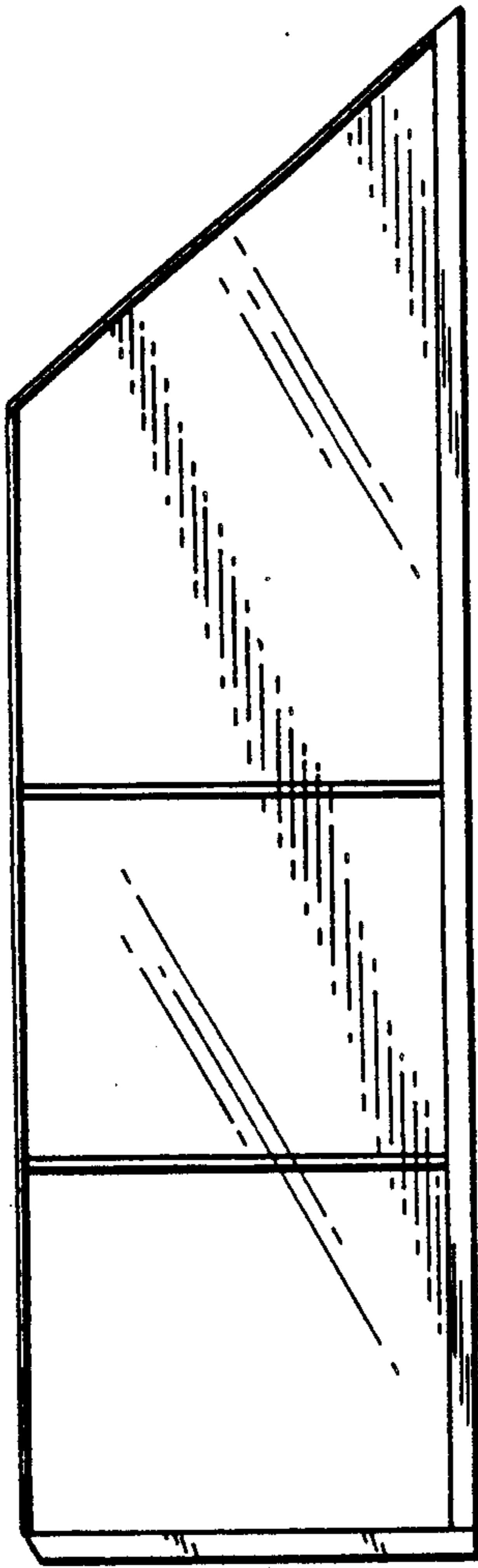

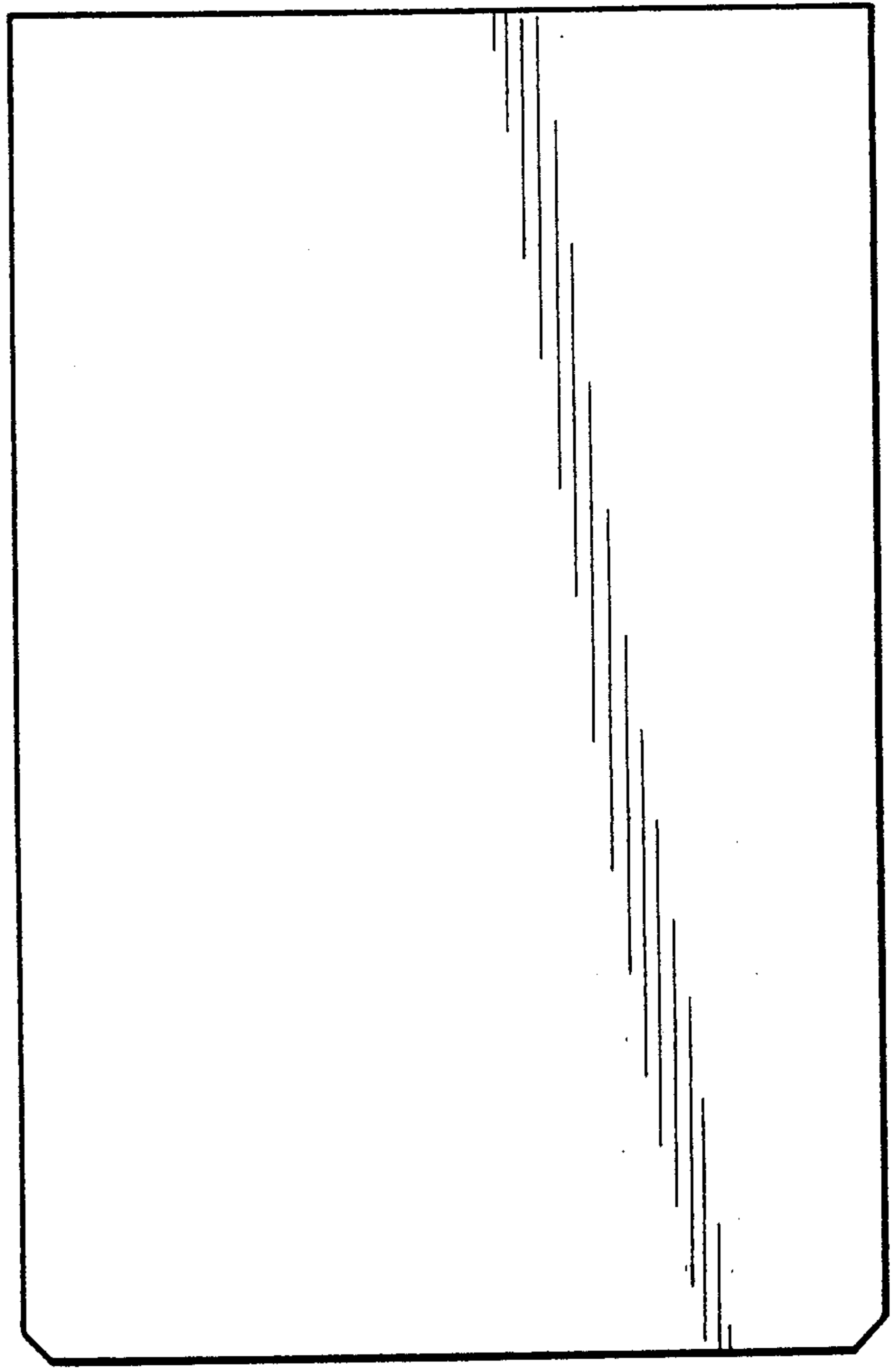
