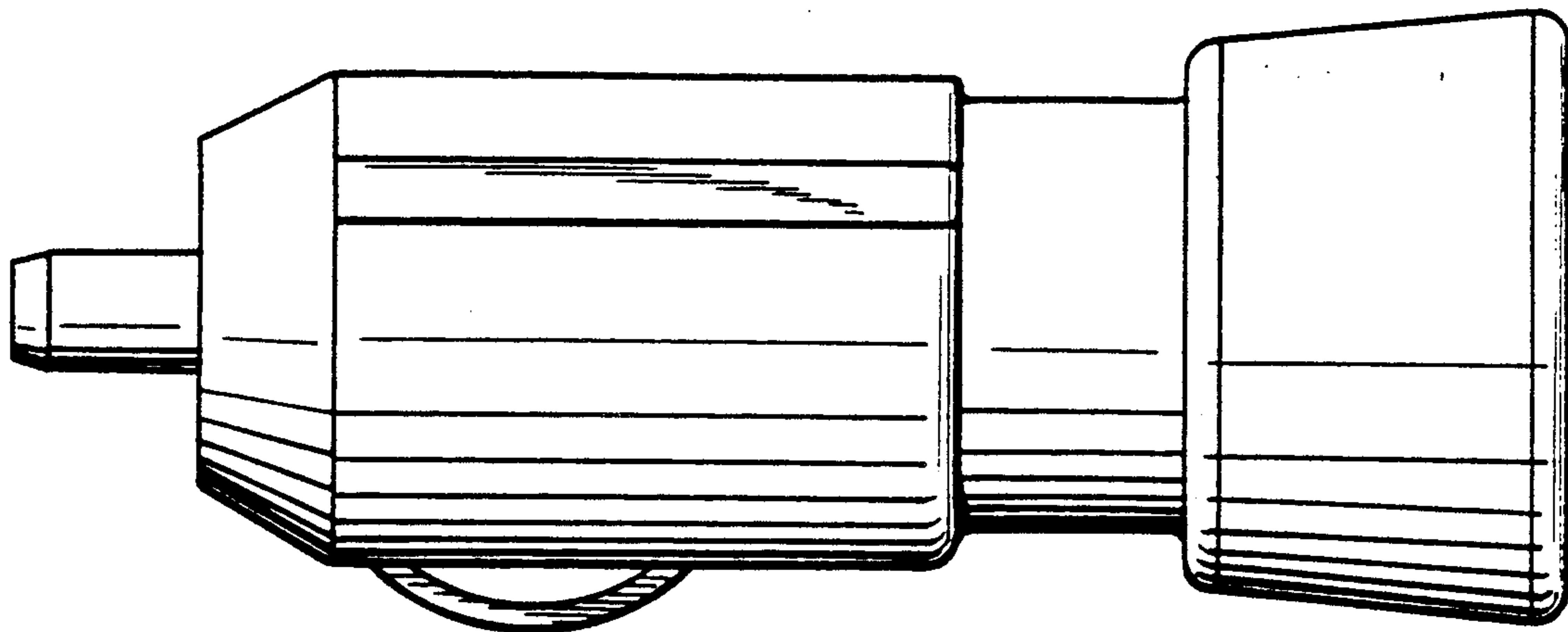

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an electrical adaptor plug for vehicle lighter socket for a police radar warning receiver, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of an electrical adapter plug for vehicle lighter socket for a police radar warning receiver showing my new design, the right side being a mirror image of that shown; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.



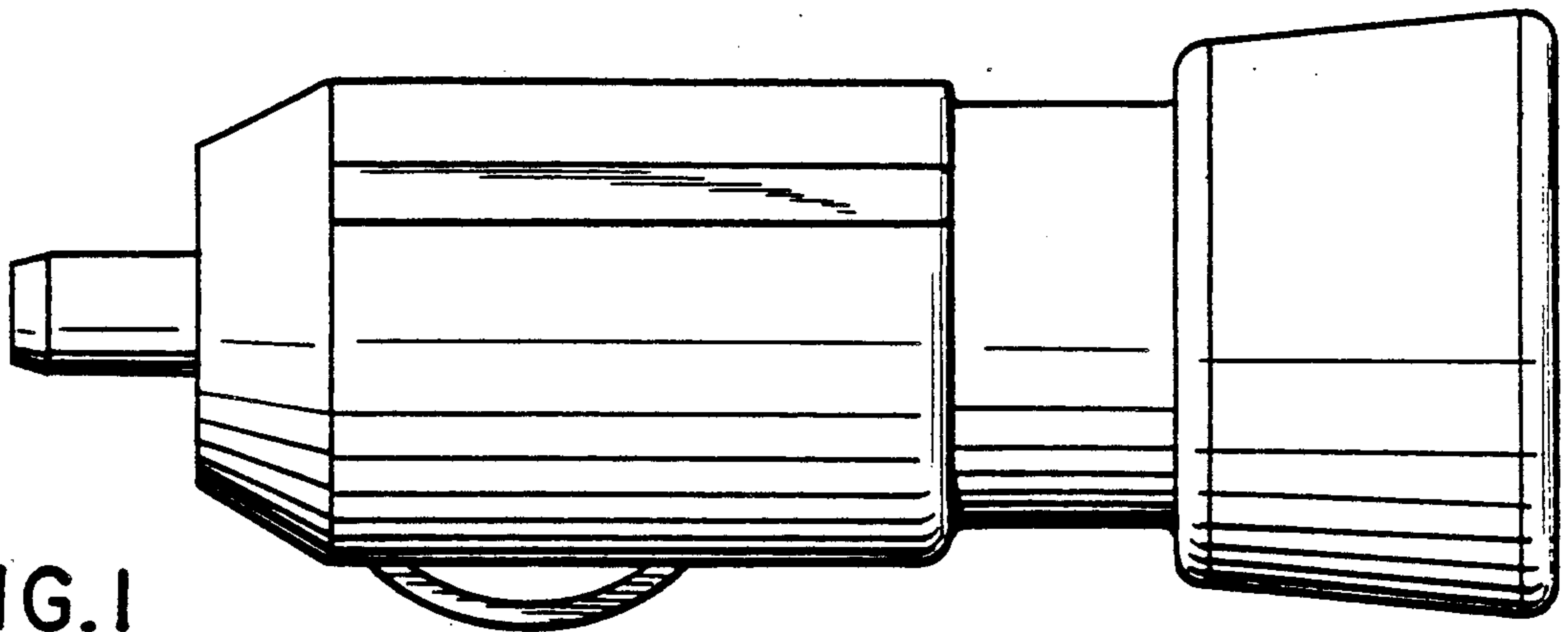
