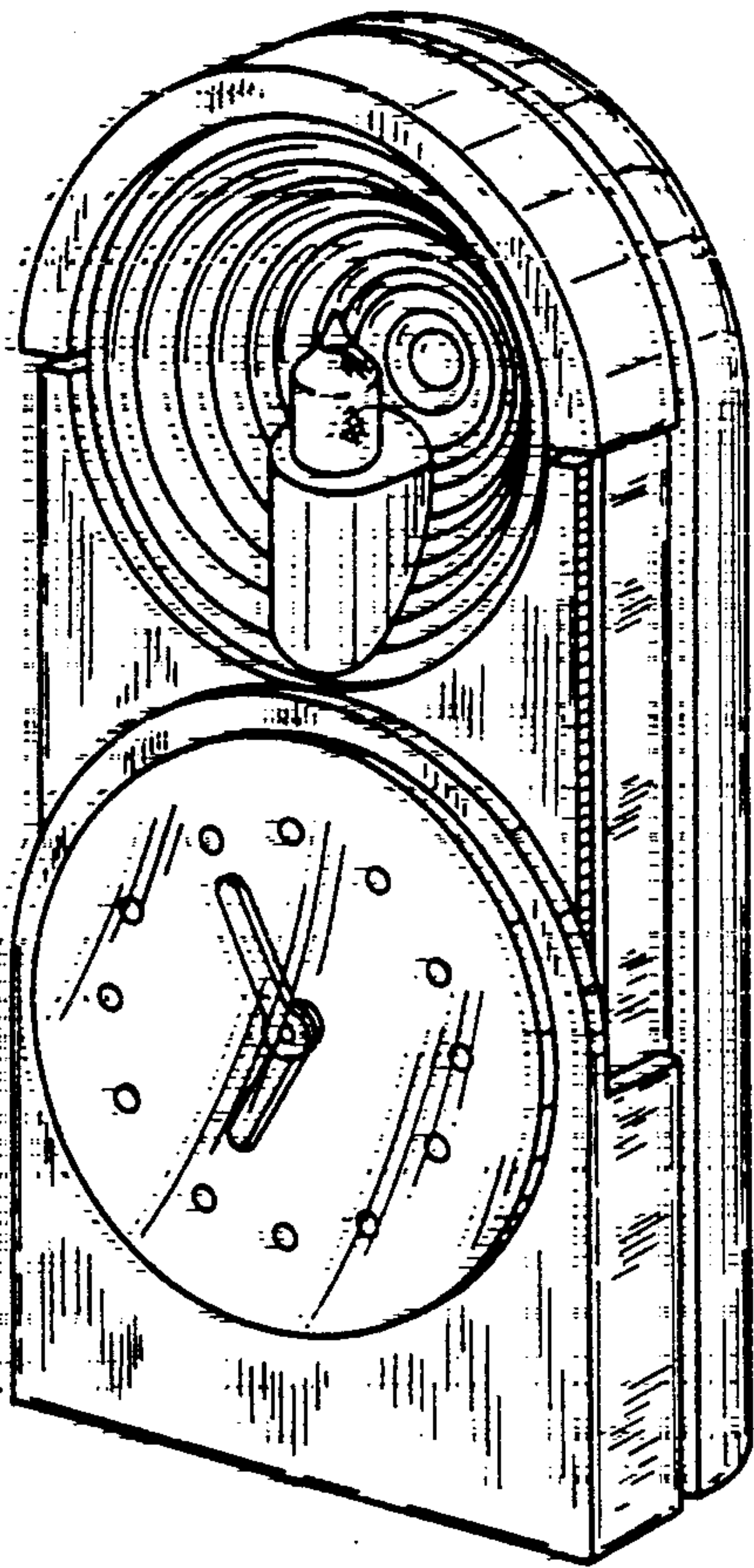

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined flashlight and clock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top right side perspective view of a combined pocket lamp and clock showing my new design, the slide cover containing the clock face in a downward position;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 8 is a front, top right side perspective view thereof, the slide cover containing the clock face in an upward position.



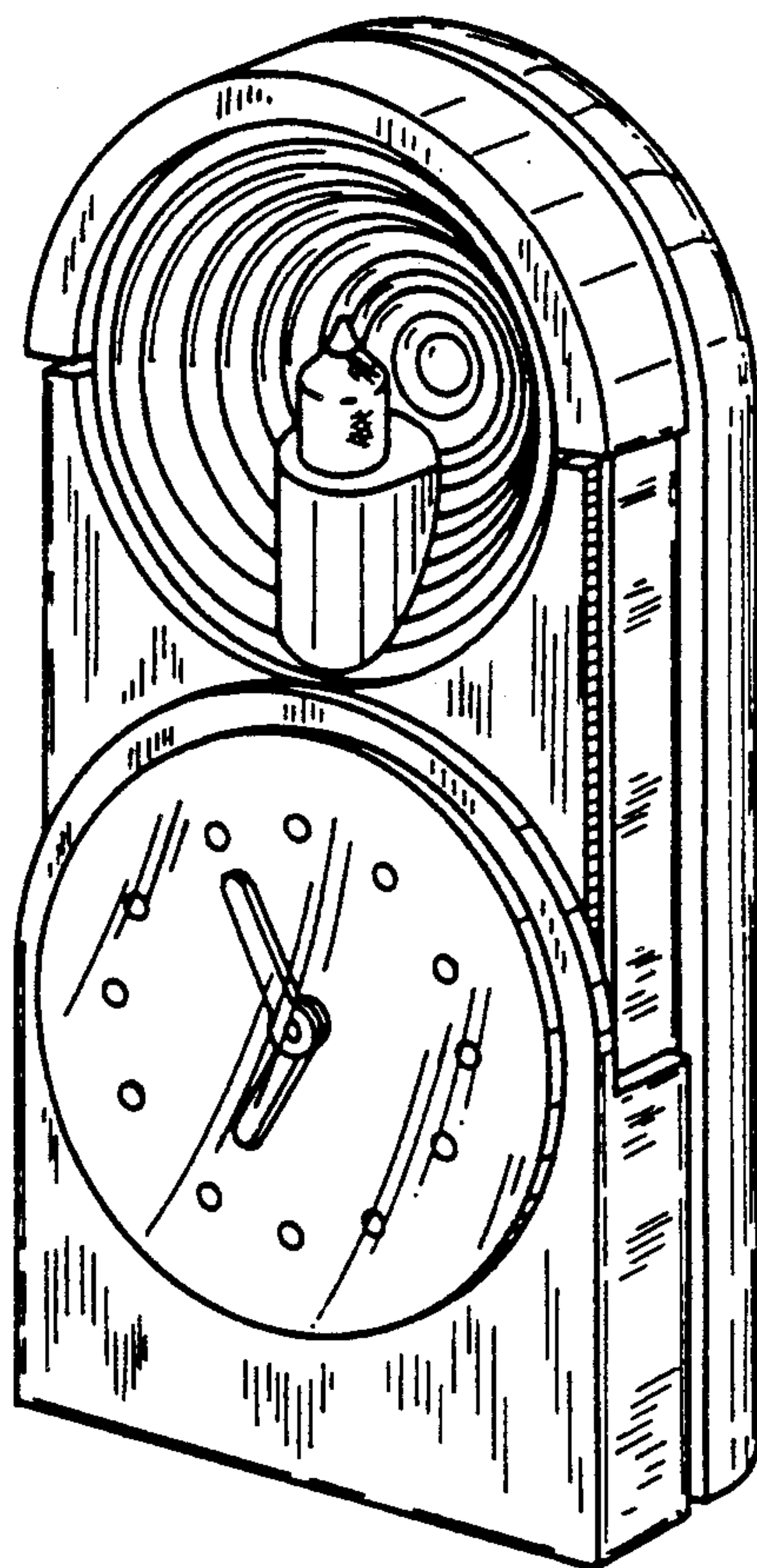

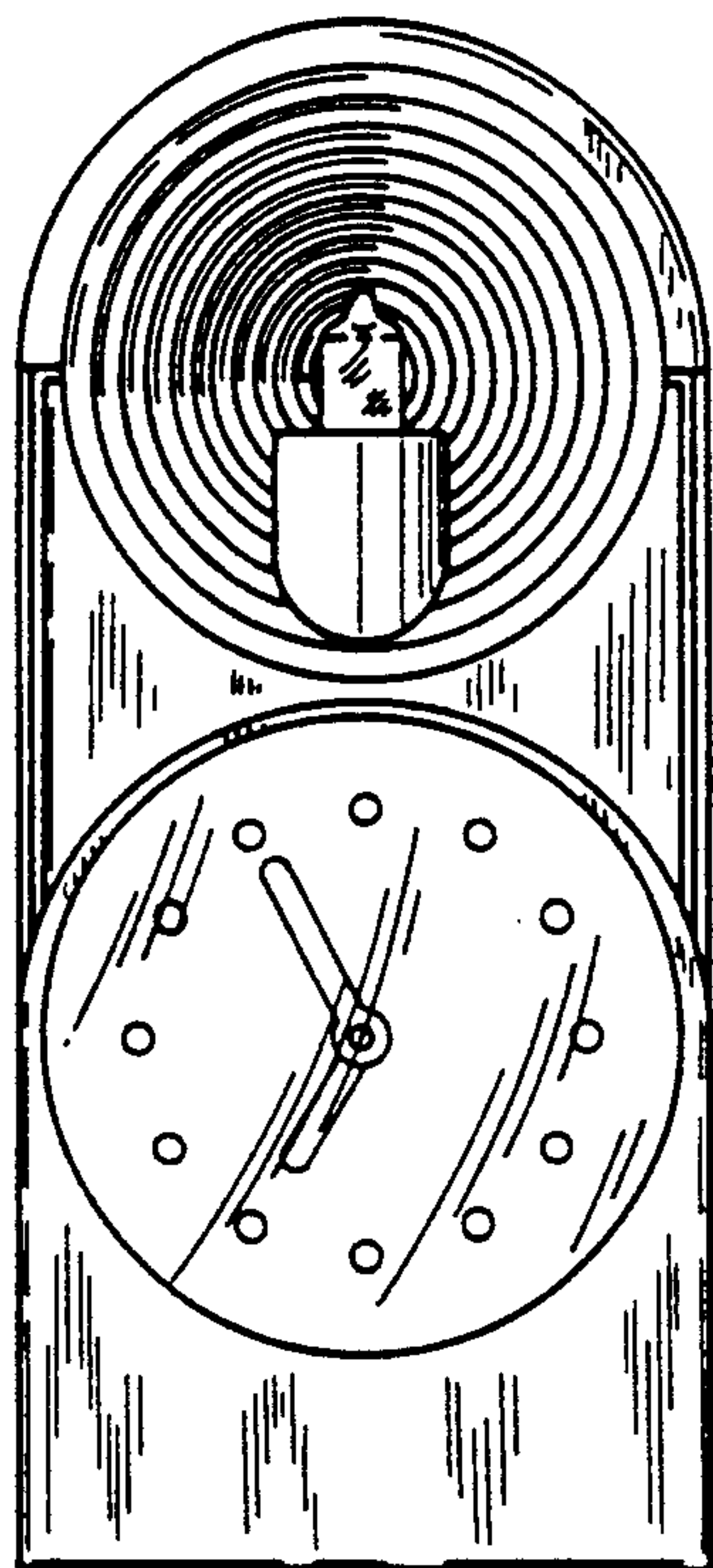

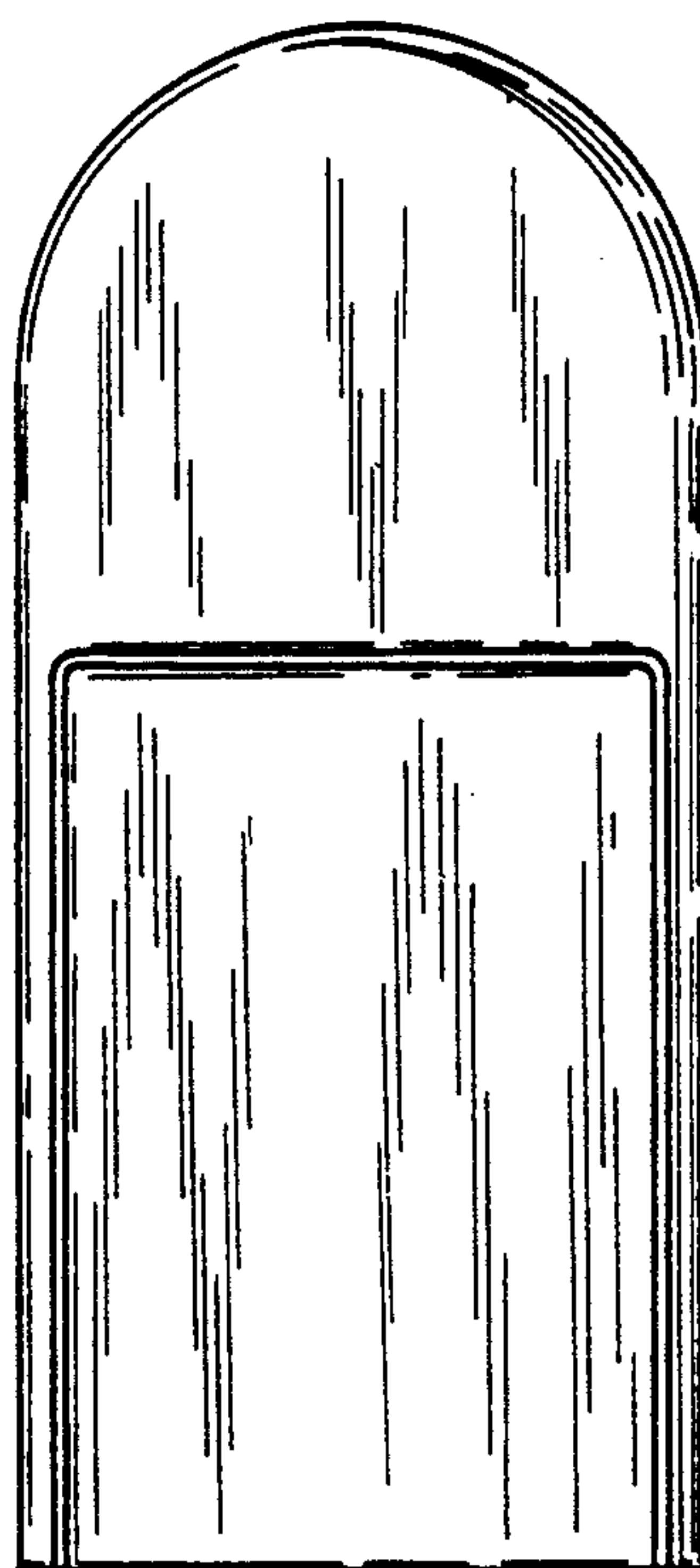

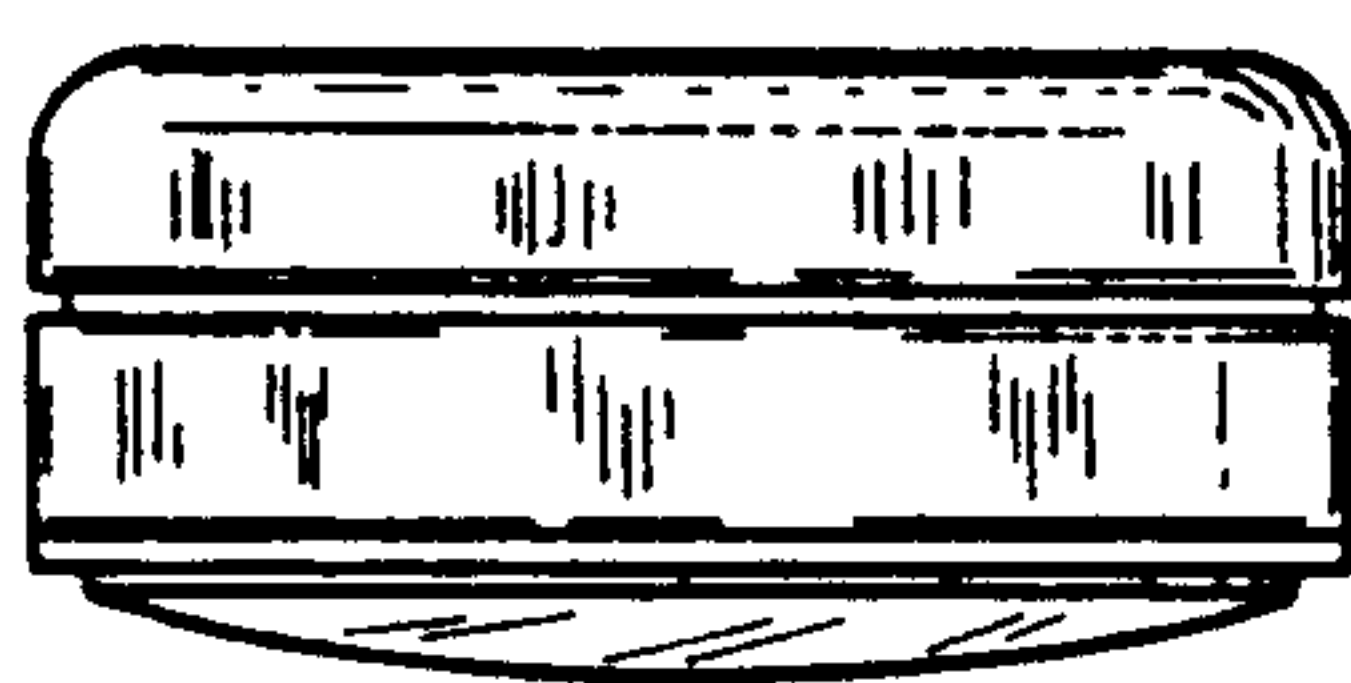
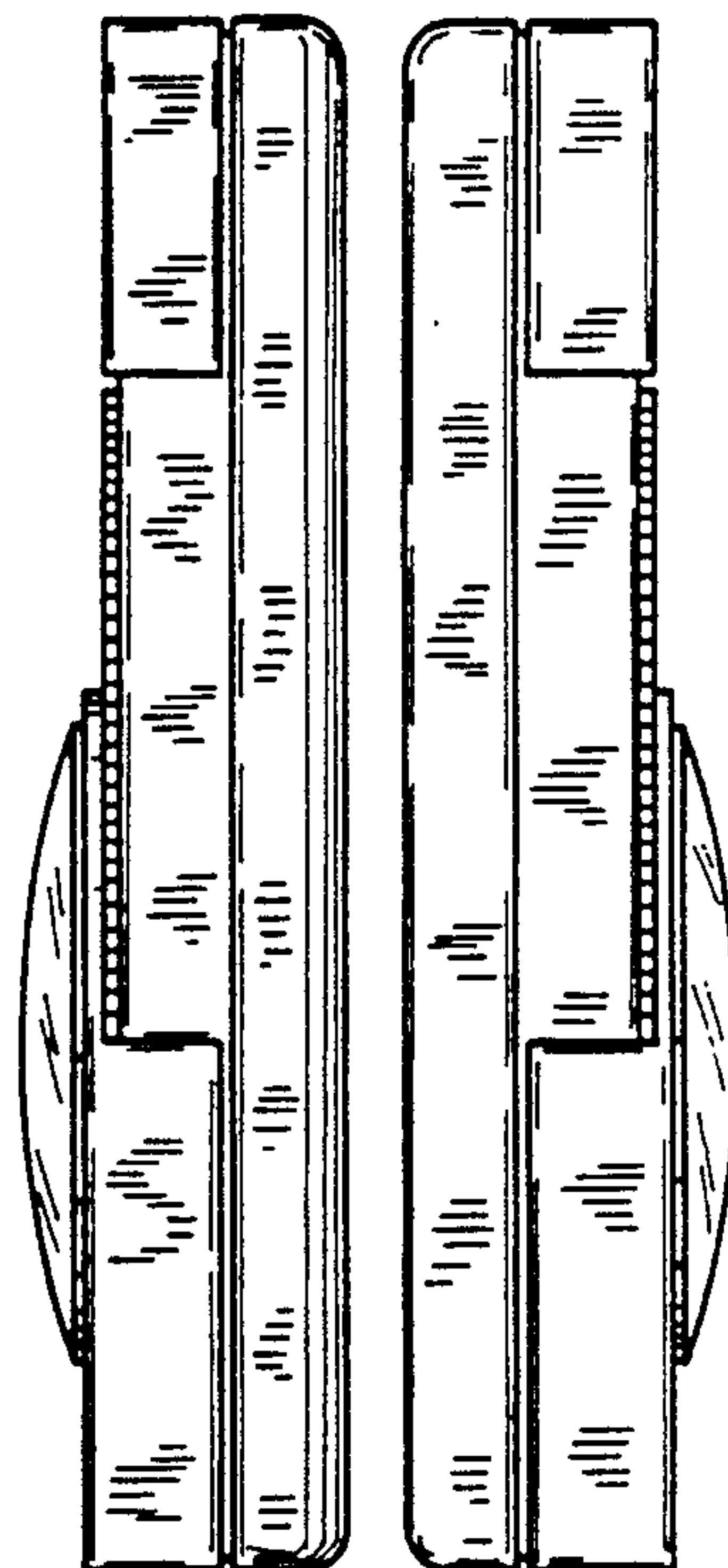

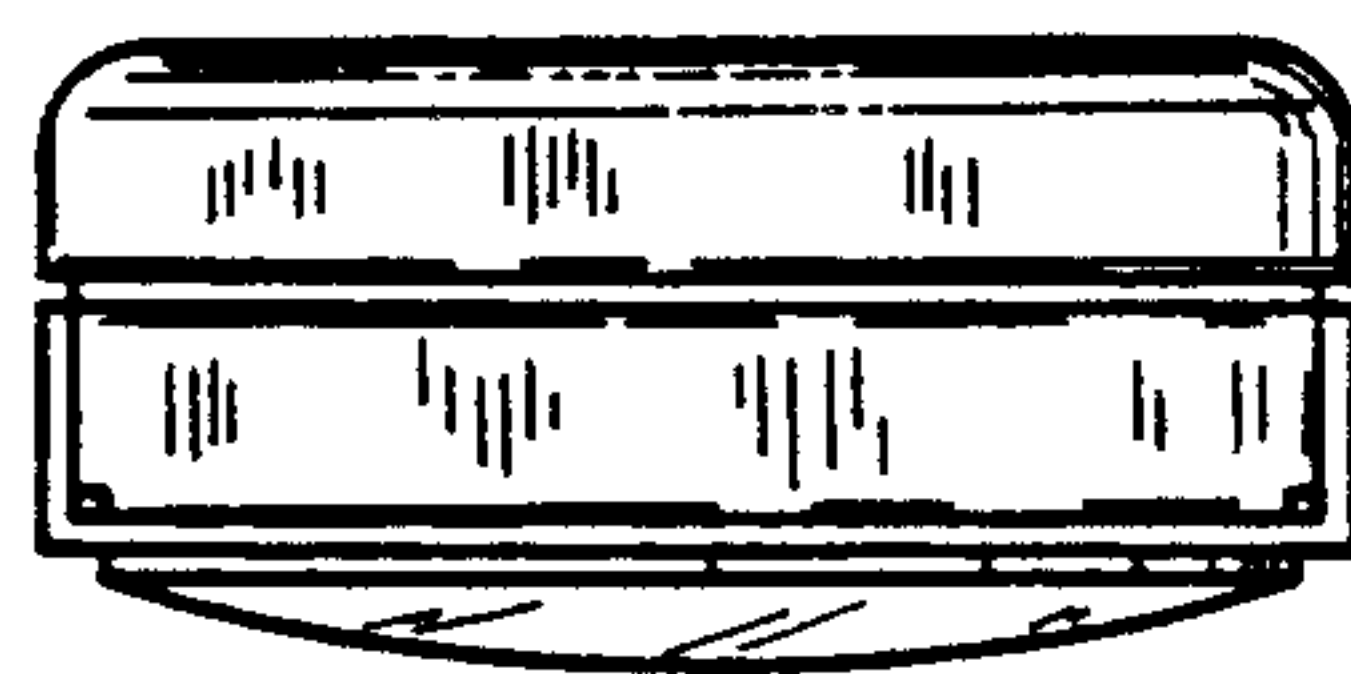

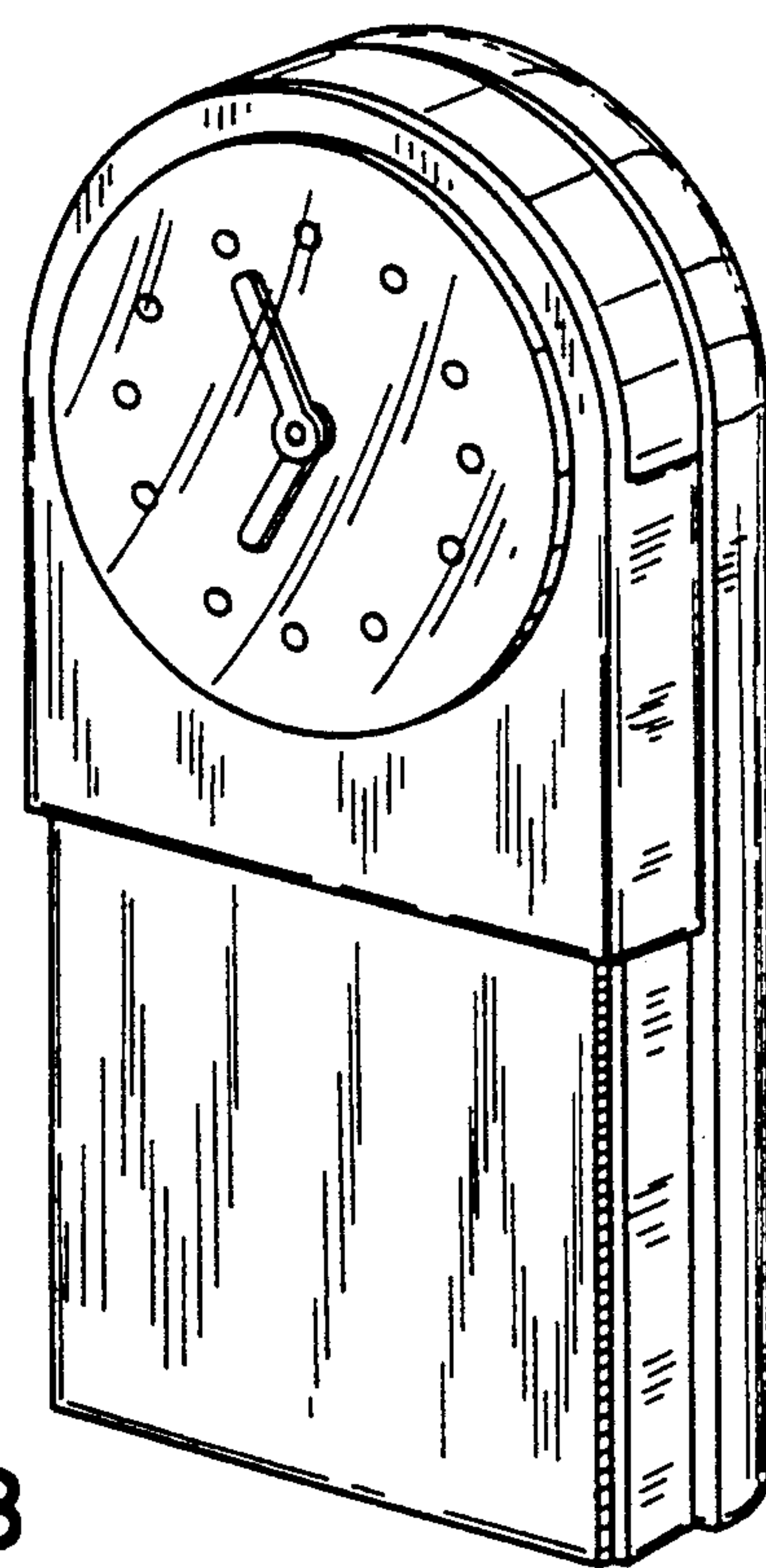
