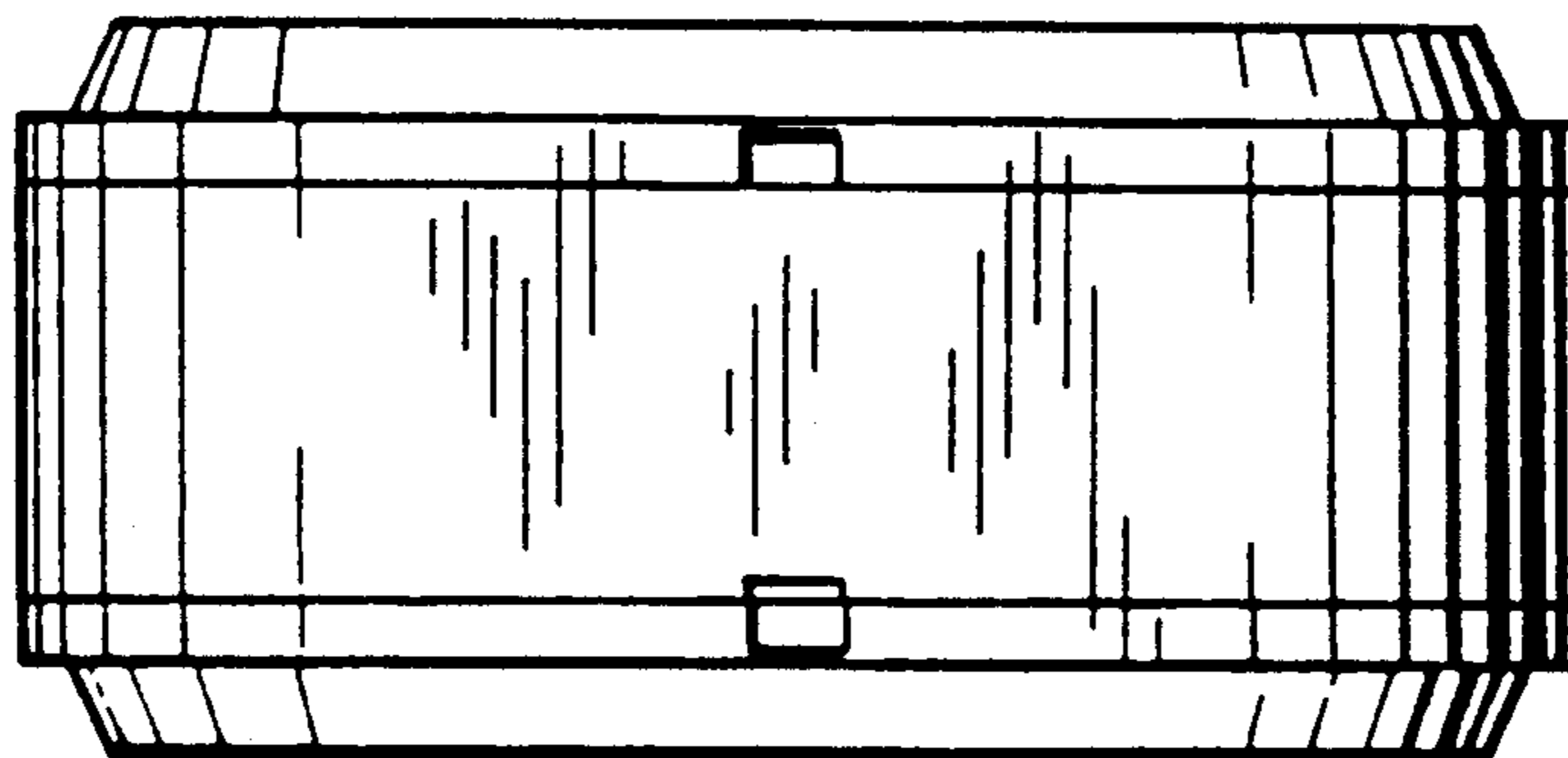
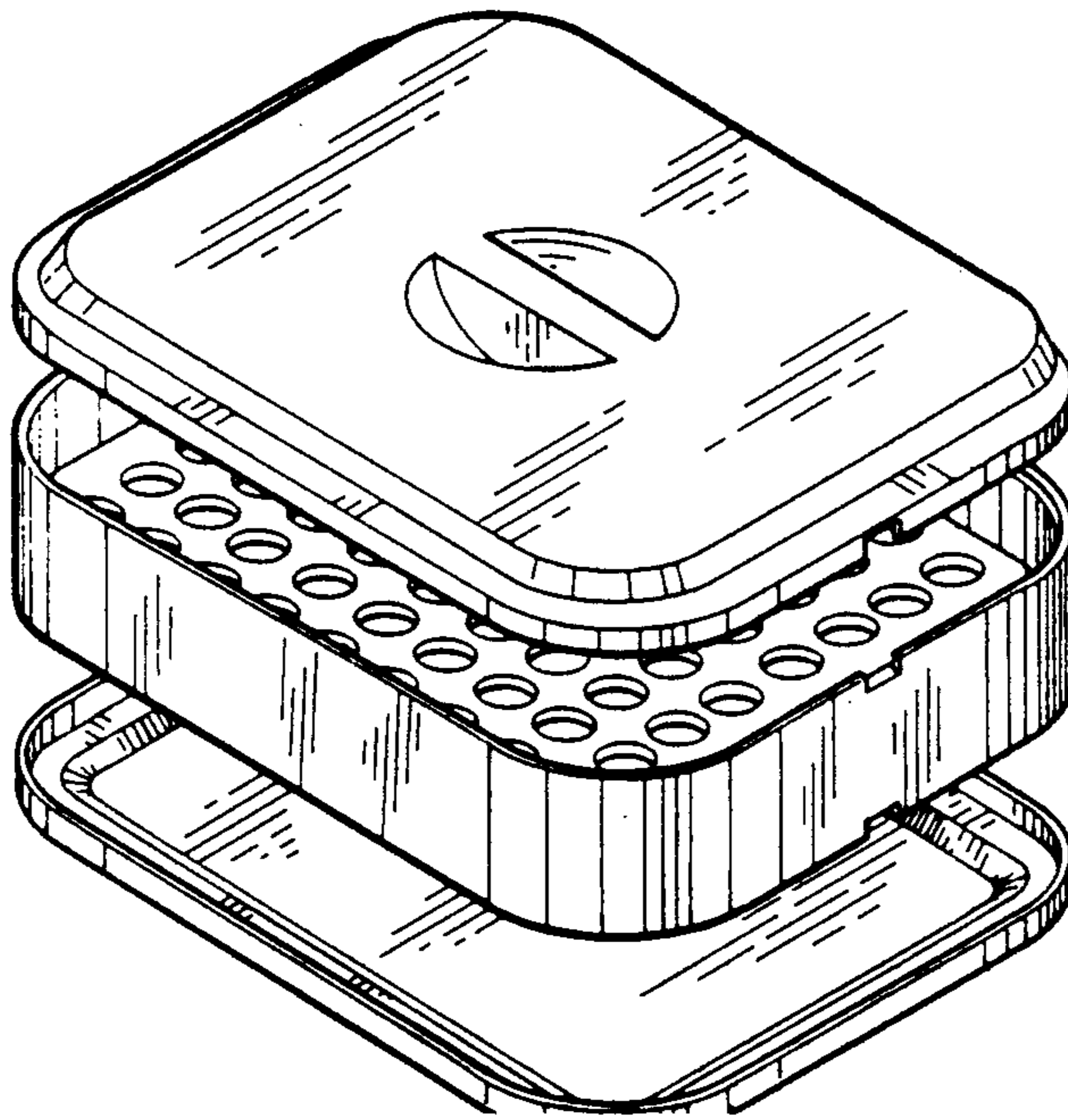

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a microwave oven cooking container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an exploded perspective view of a microwave oven cooking container, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a left end elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is an exploded perspective view of an alternate embodiment of a microwave oven cooking container, showing my new design; FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the alternate embodiment illustrated in FIG. 6; FIG. 8 is a front or rear elevational view of the alternate embodiment illustrated in FIG. 6; and FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the alternate embodiment illustrated in FIG. 6; and FIG. 10 is a right or left side elevational view of the alternate embodiment illustrated in FIG. 6.



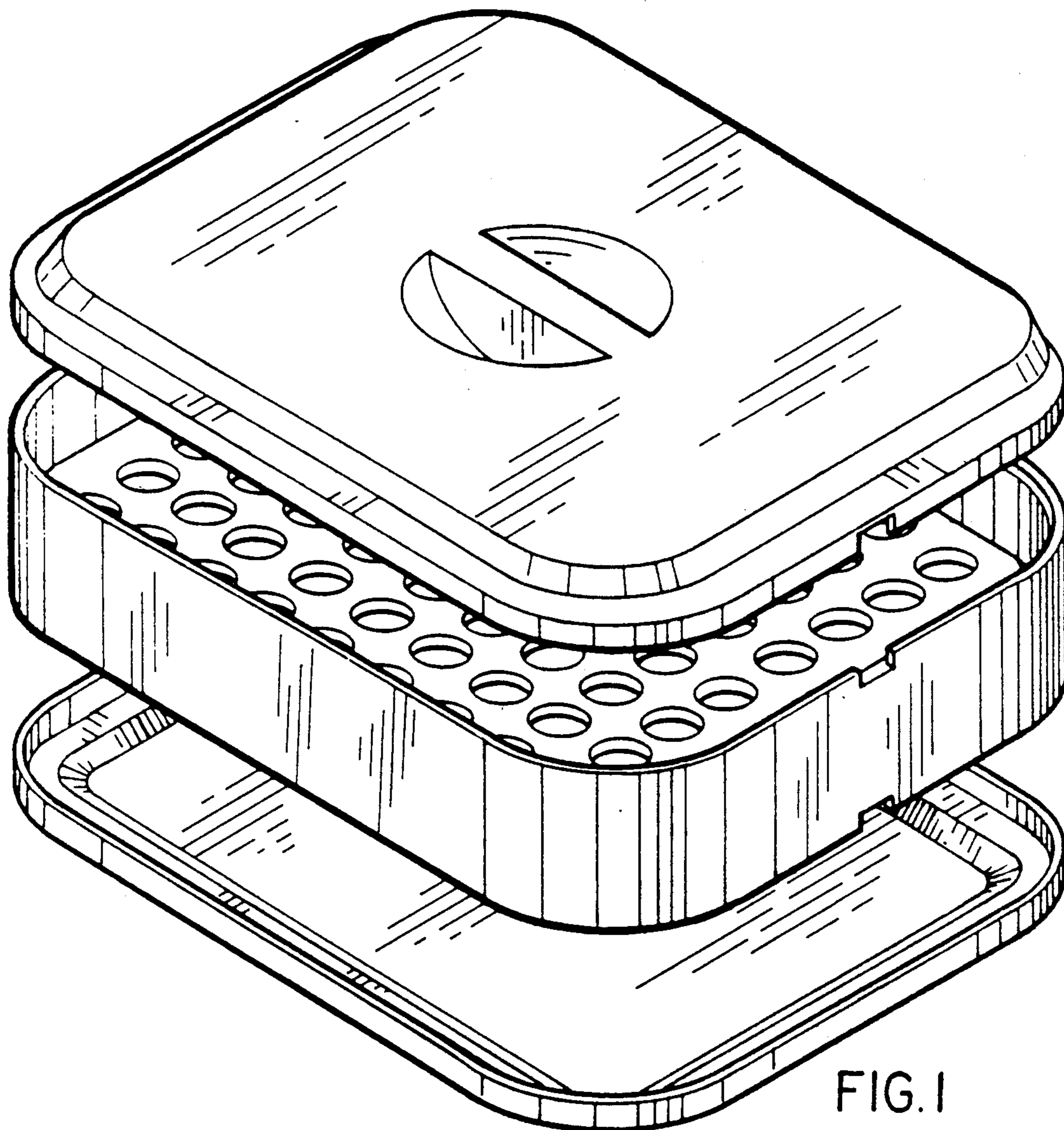

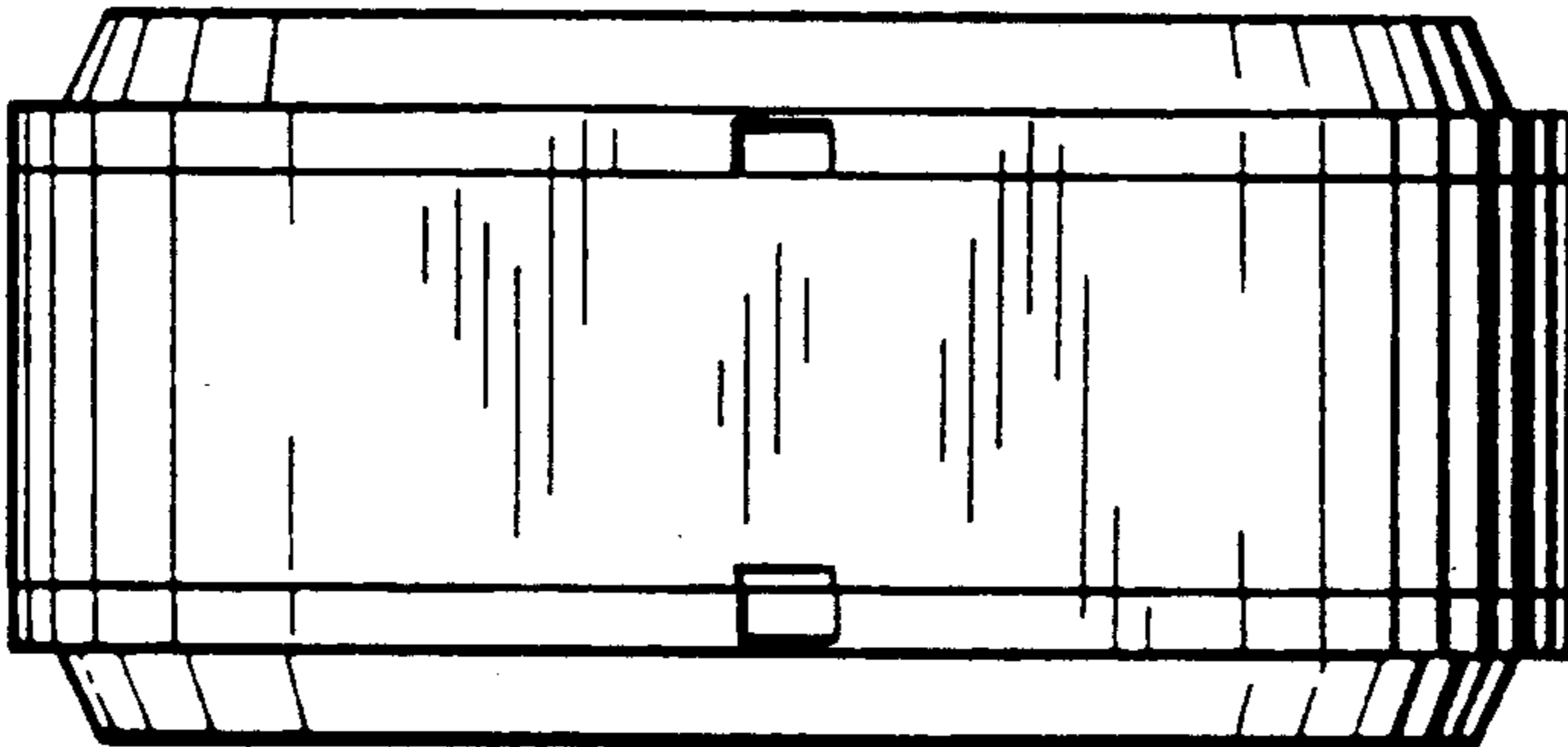

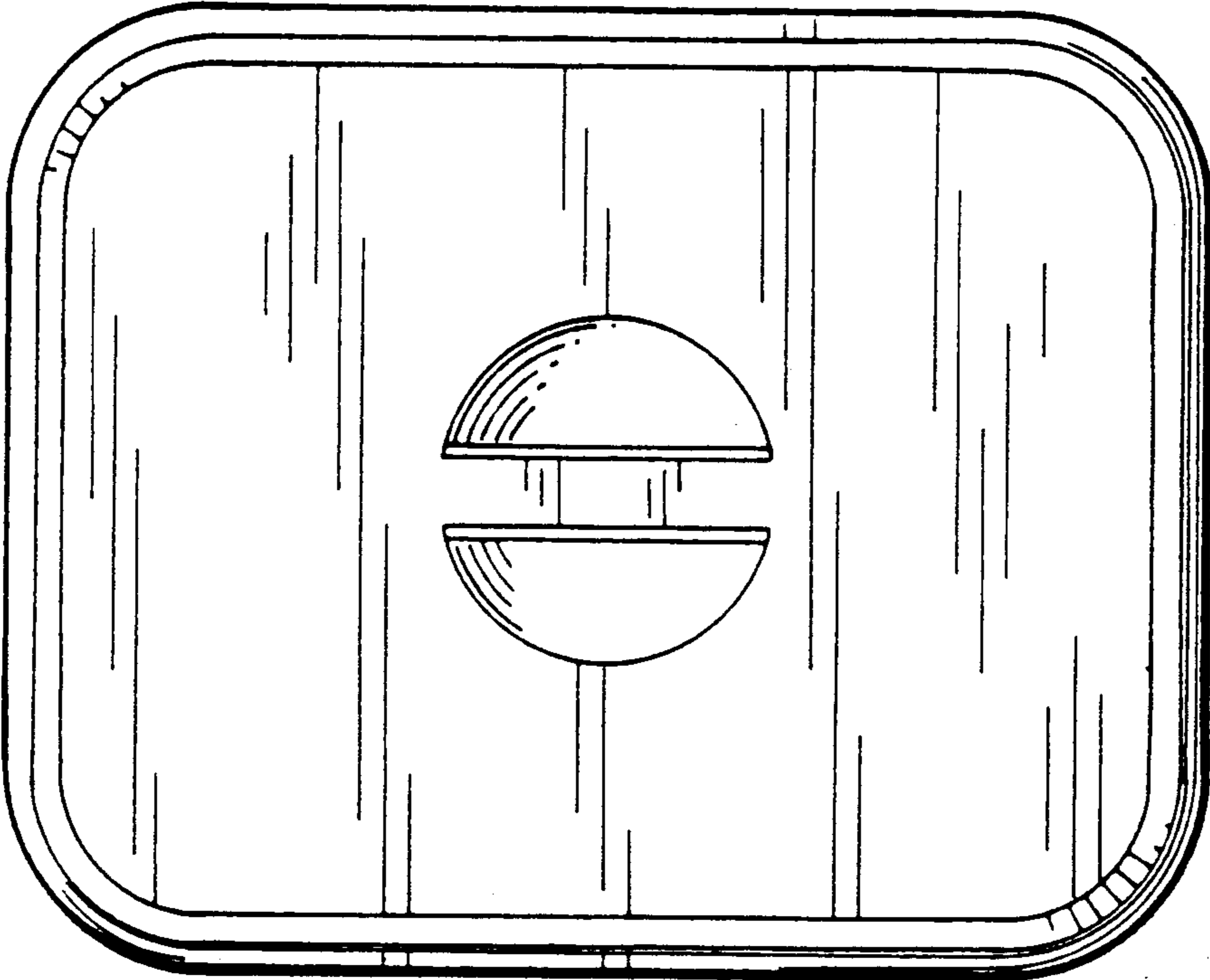

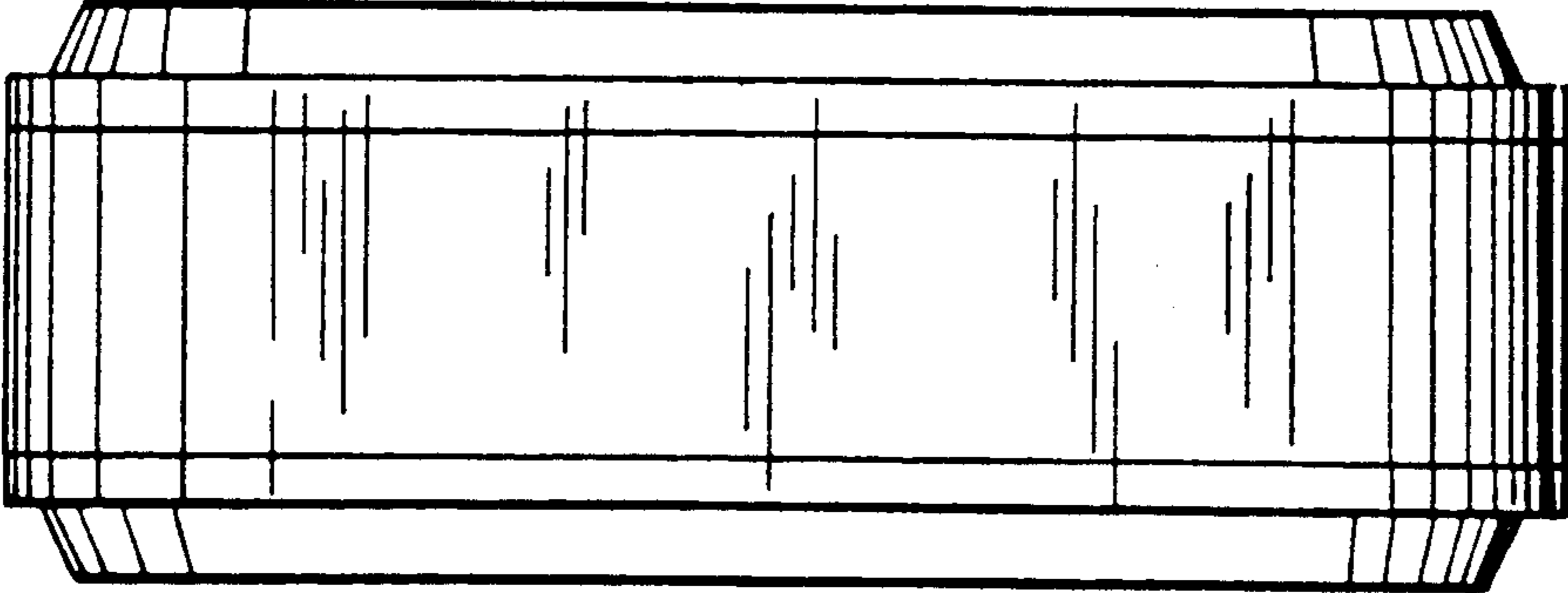

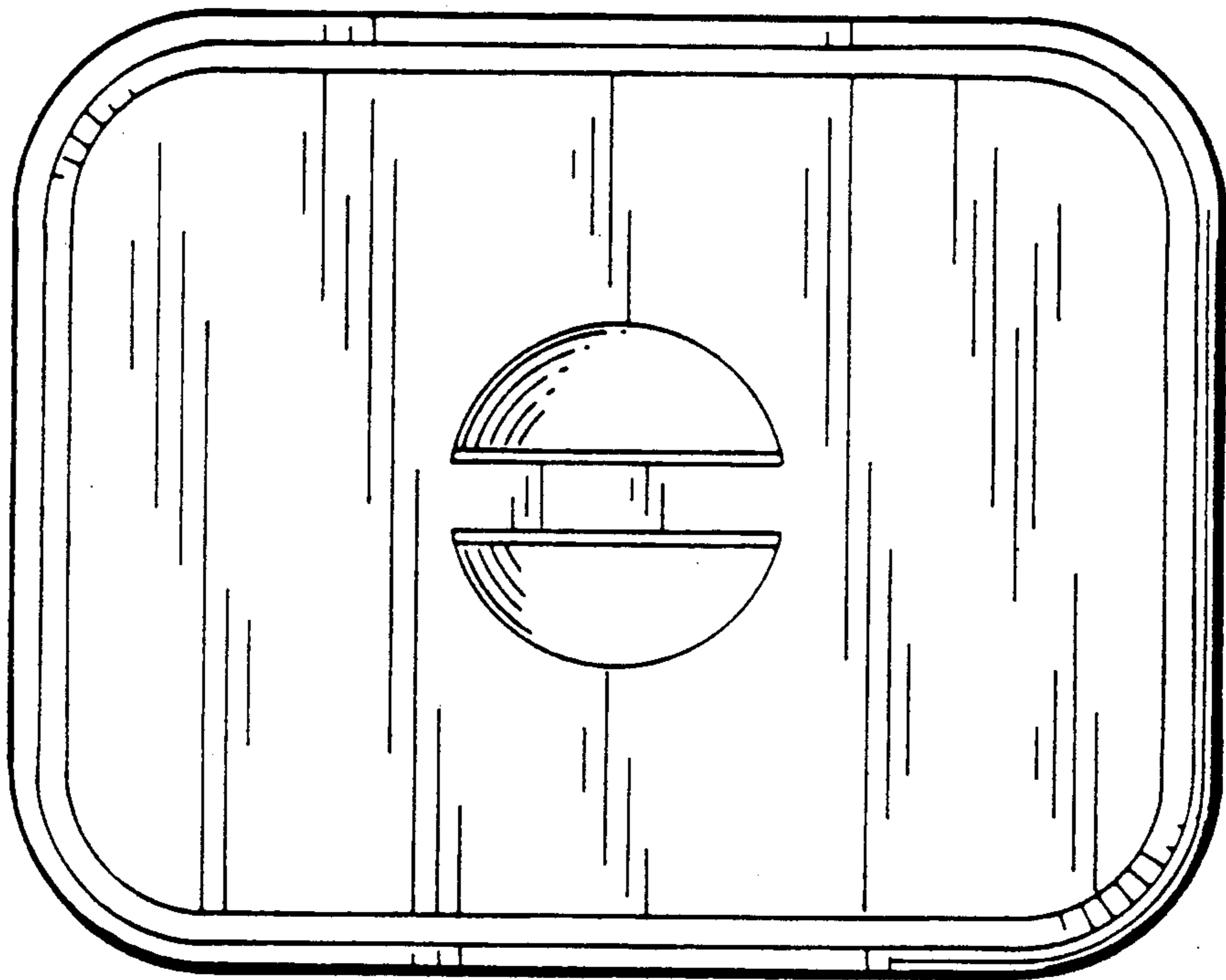

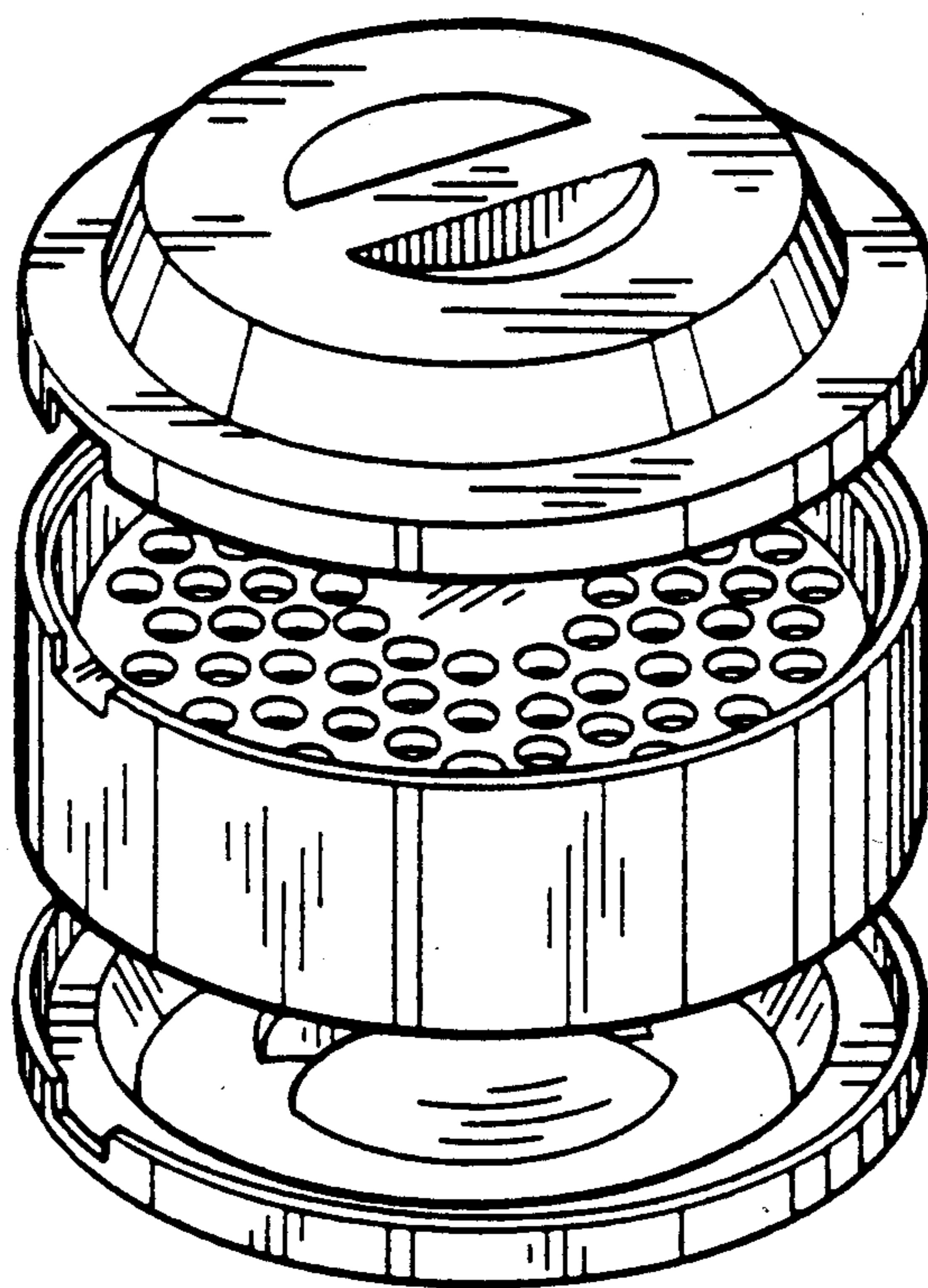

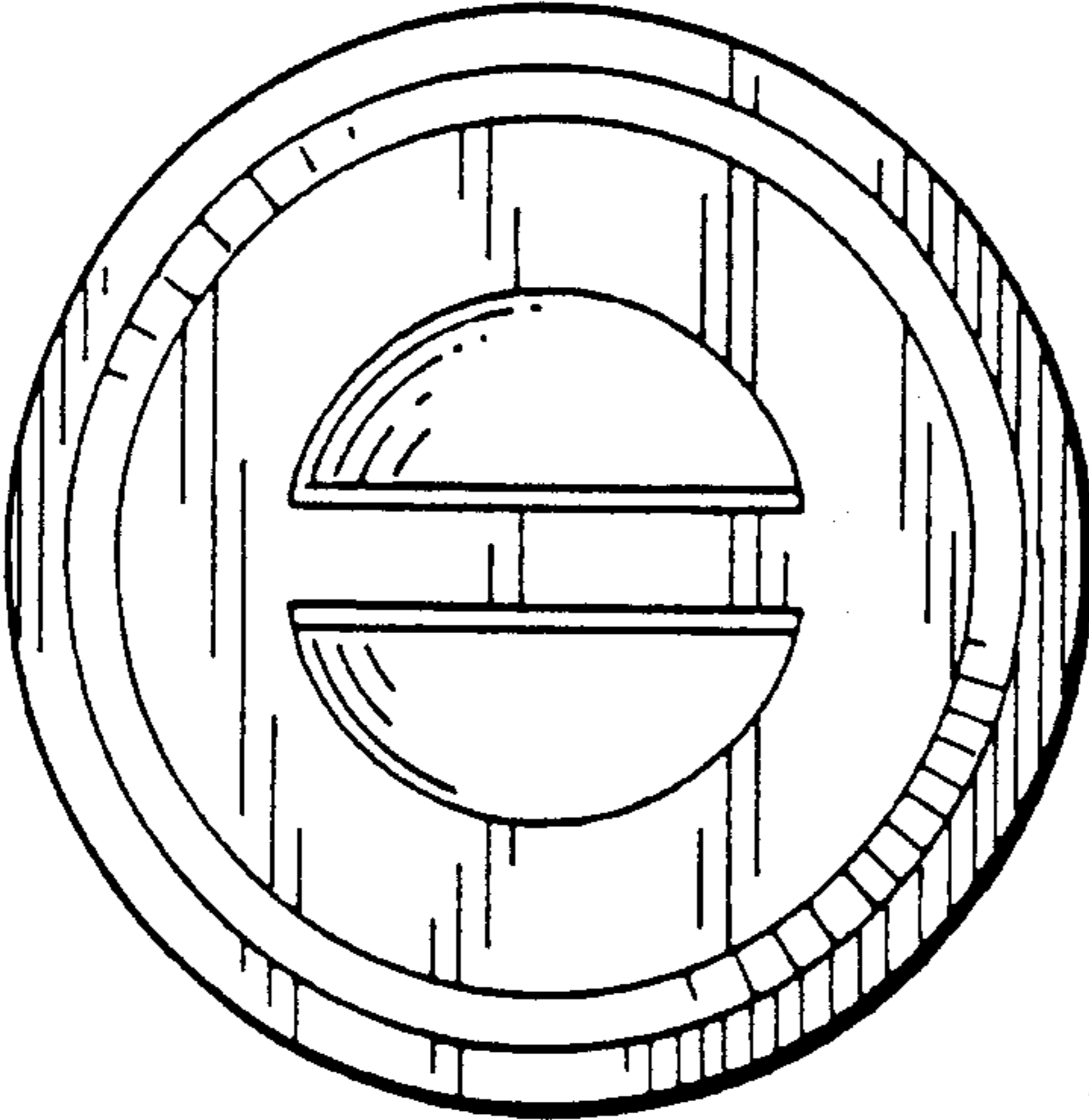

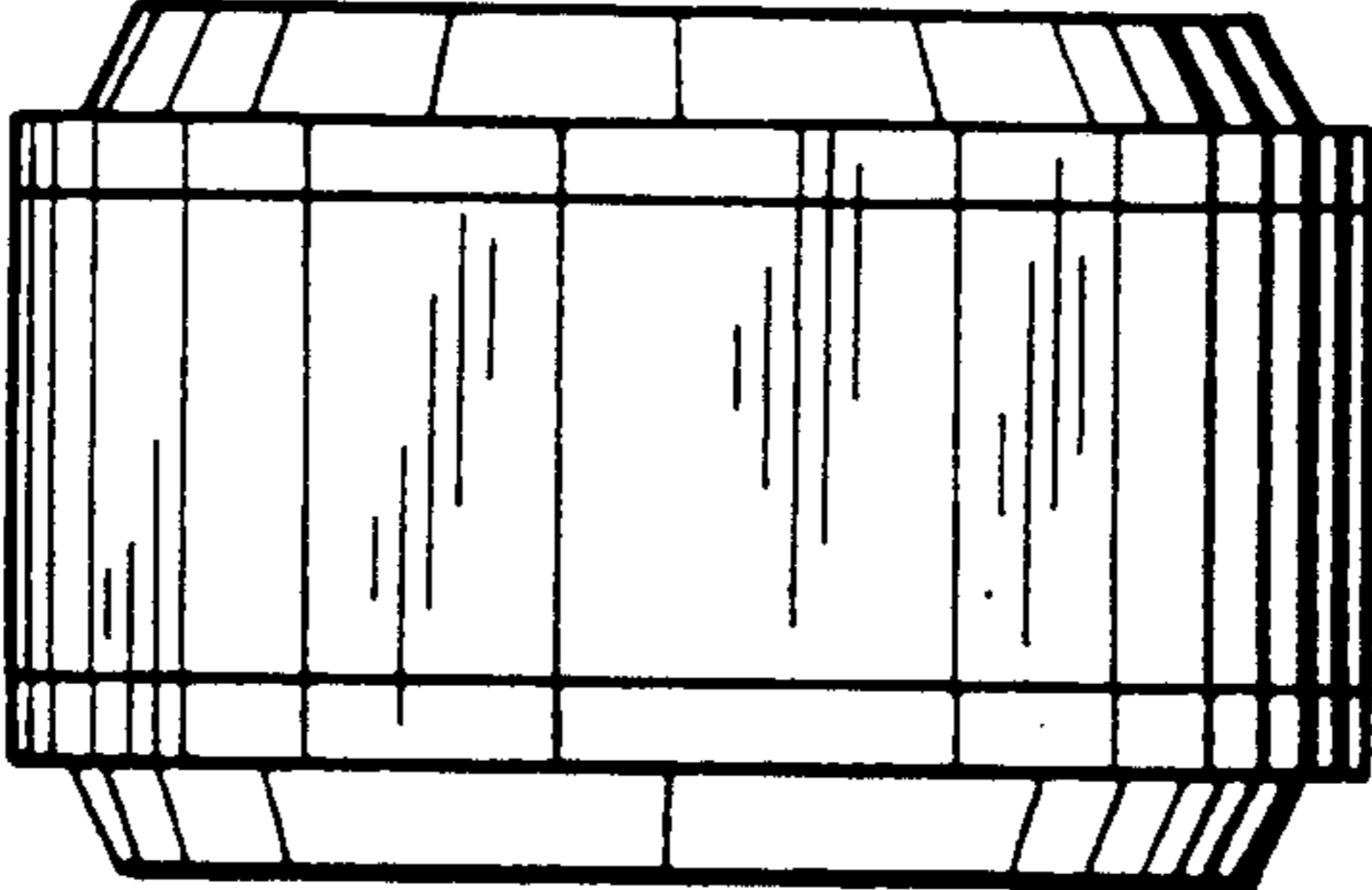

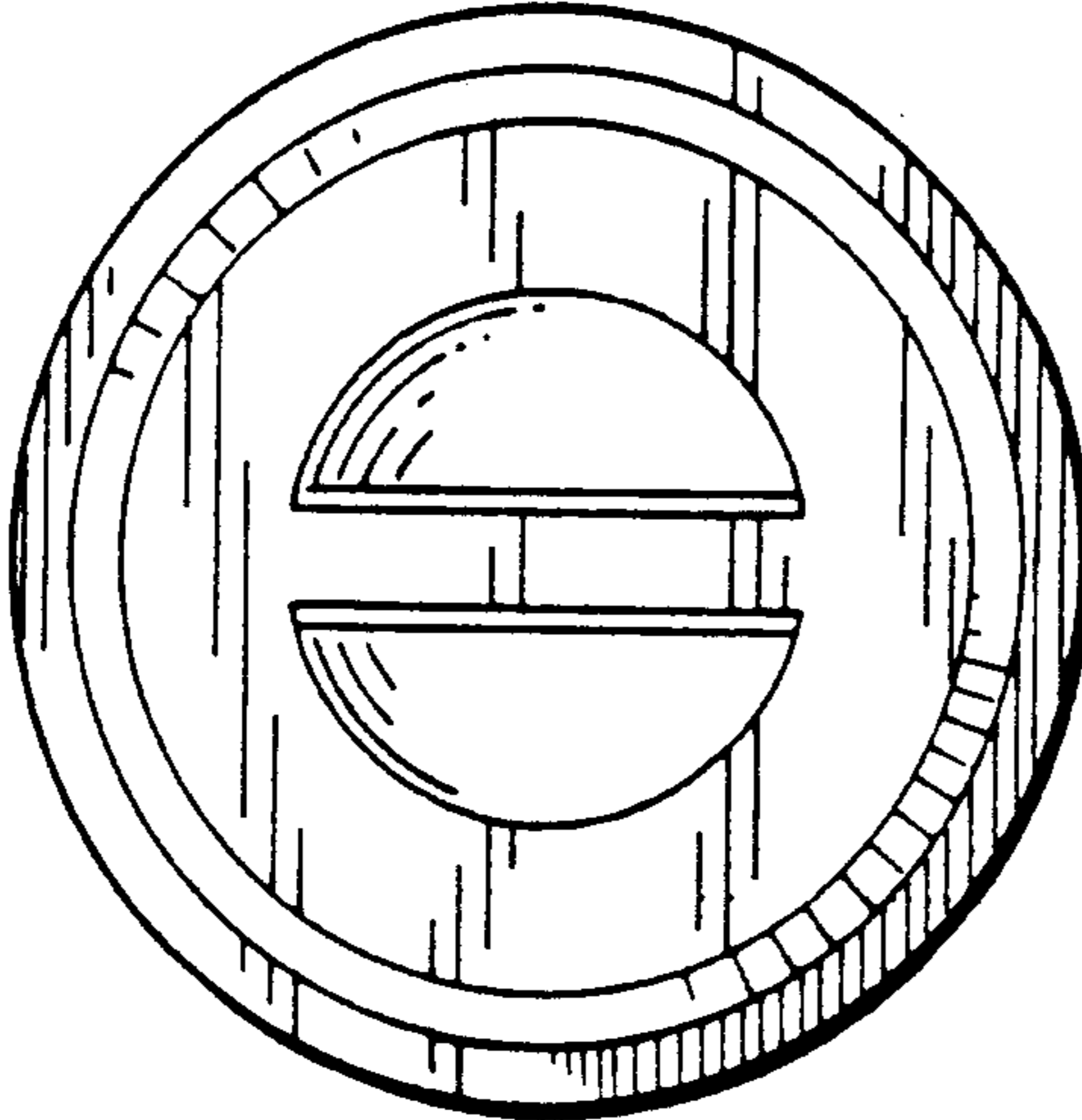

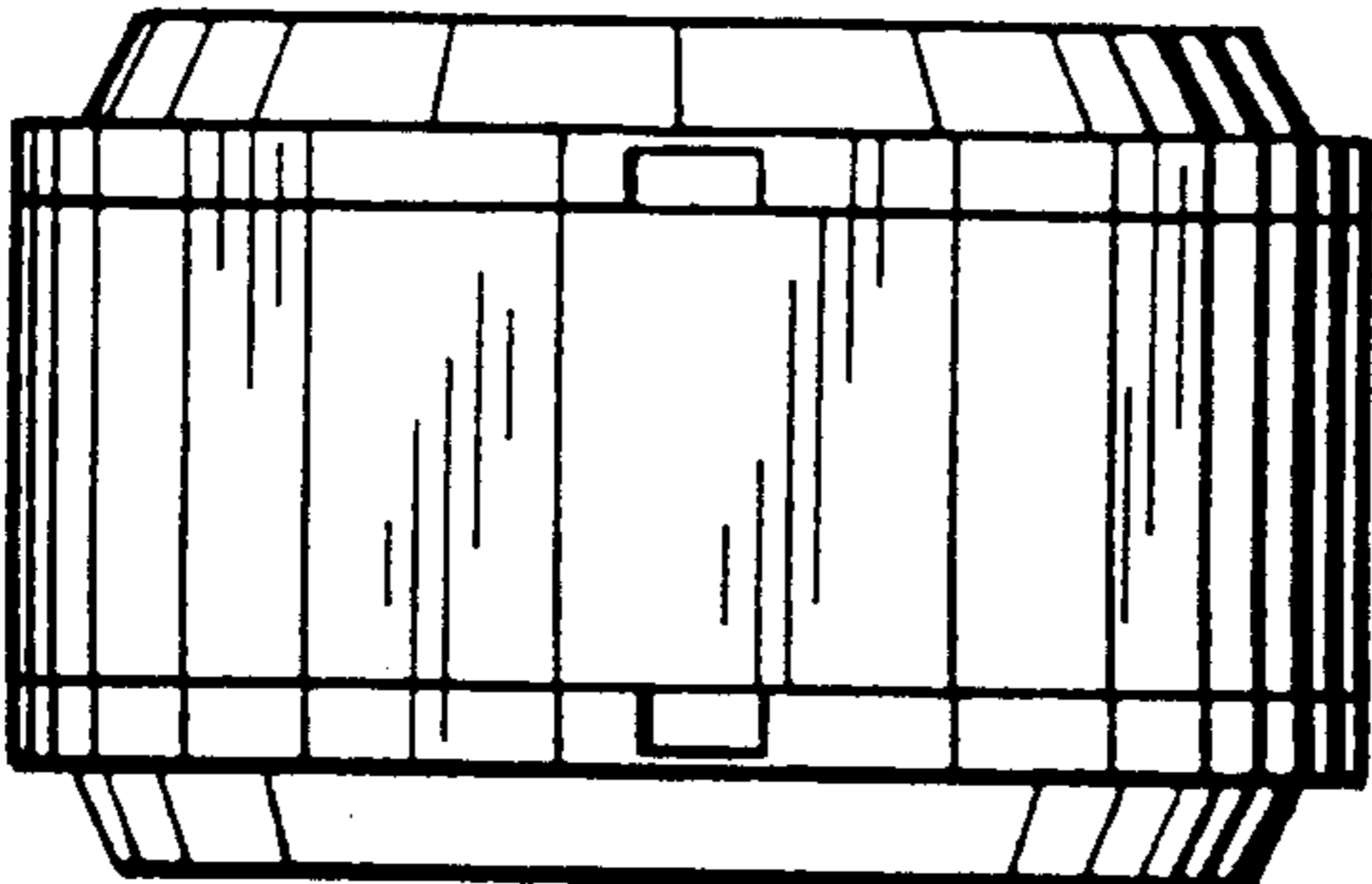
