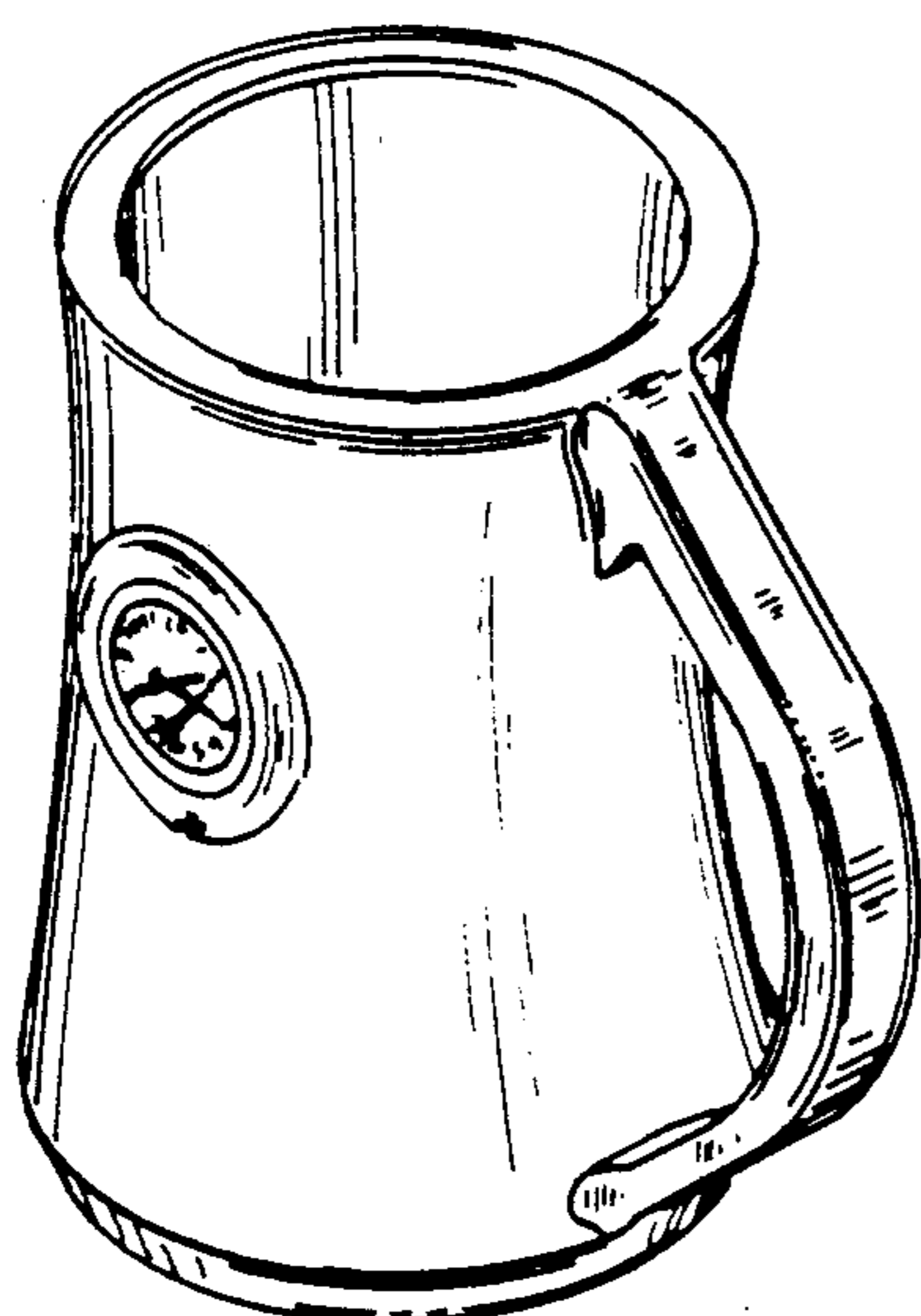

The ornamental design for a combined beverage mug and timepiece, as shown.

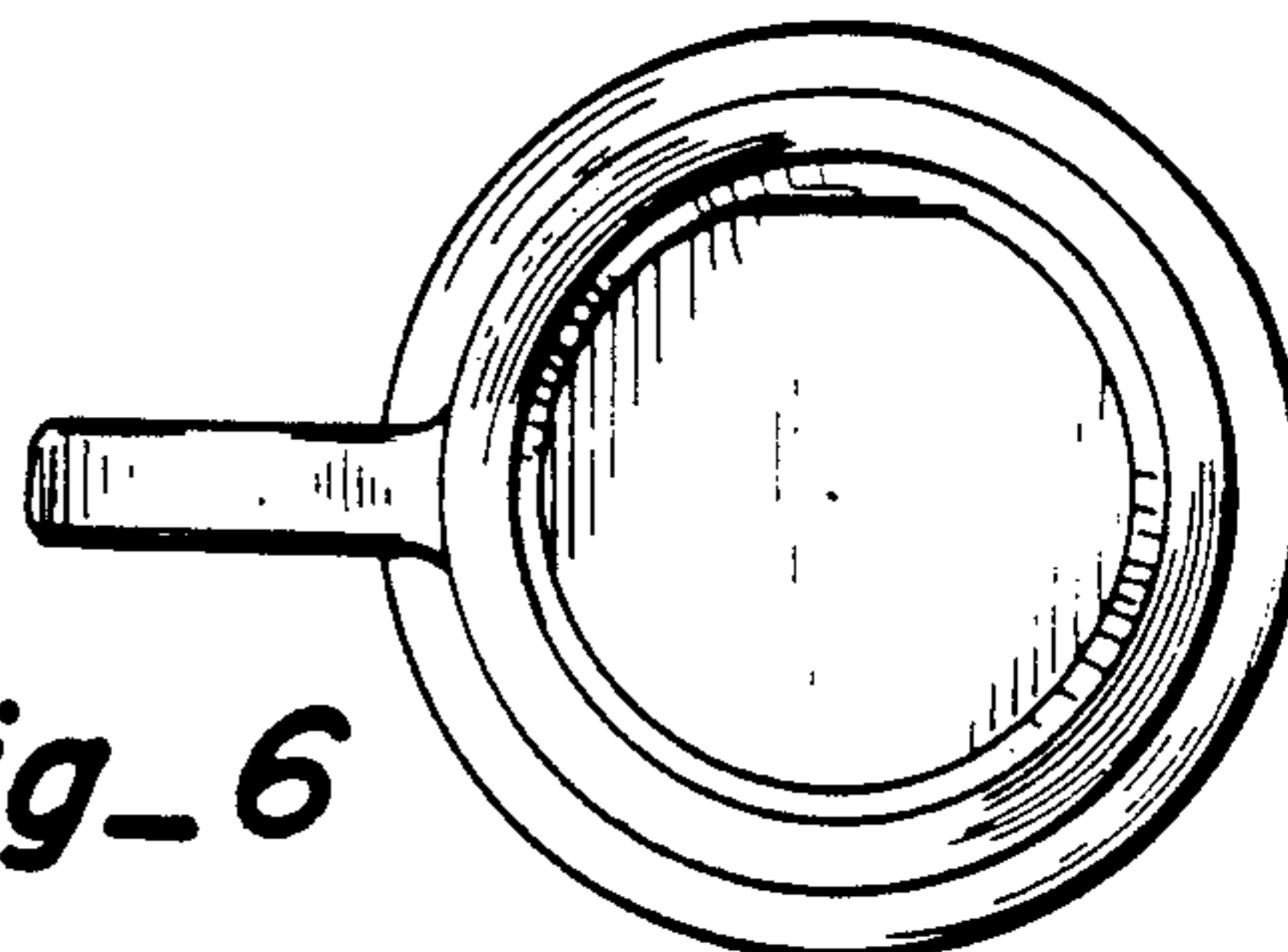
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

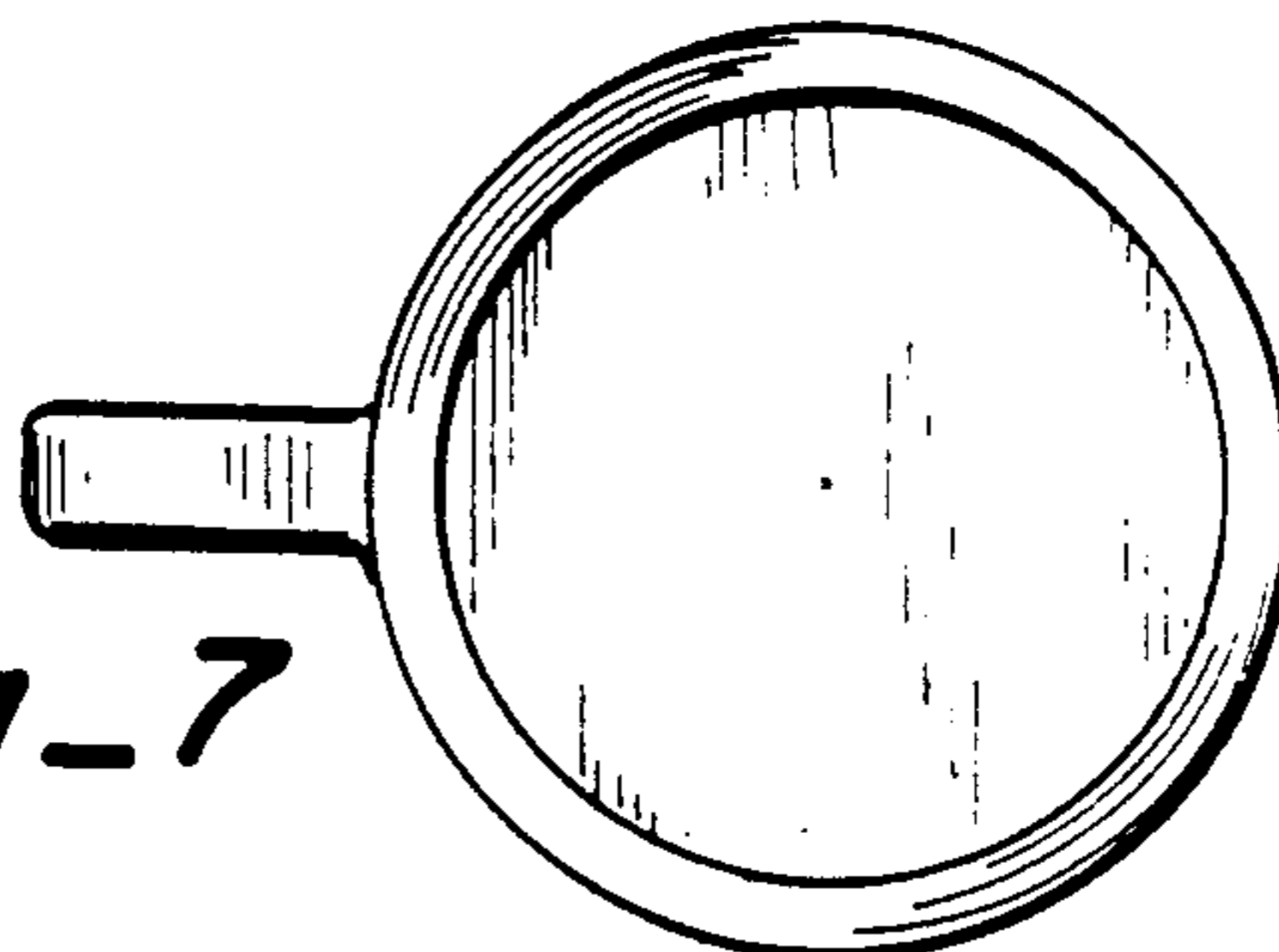




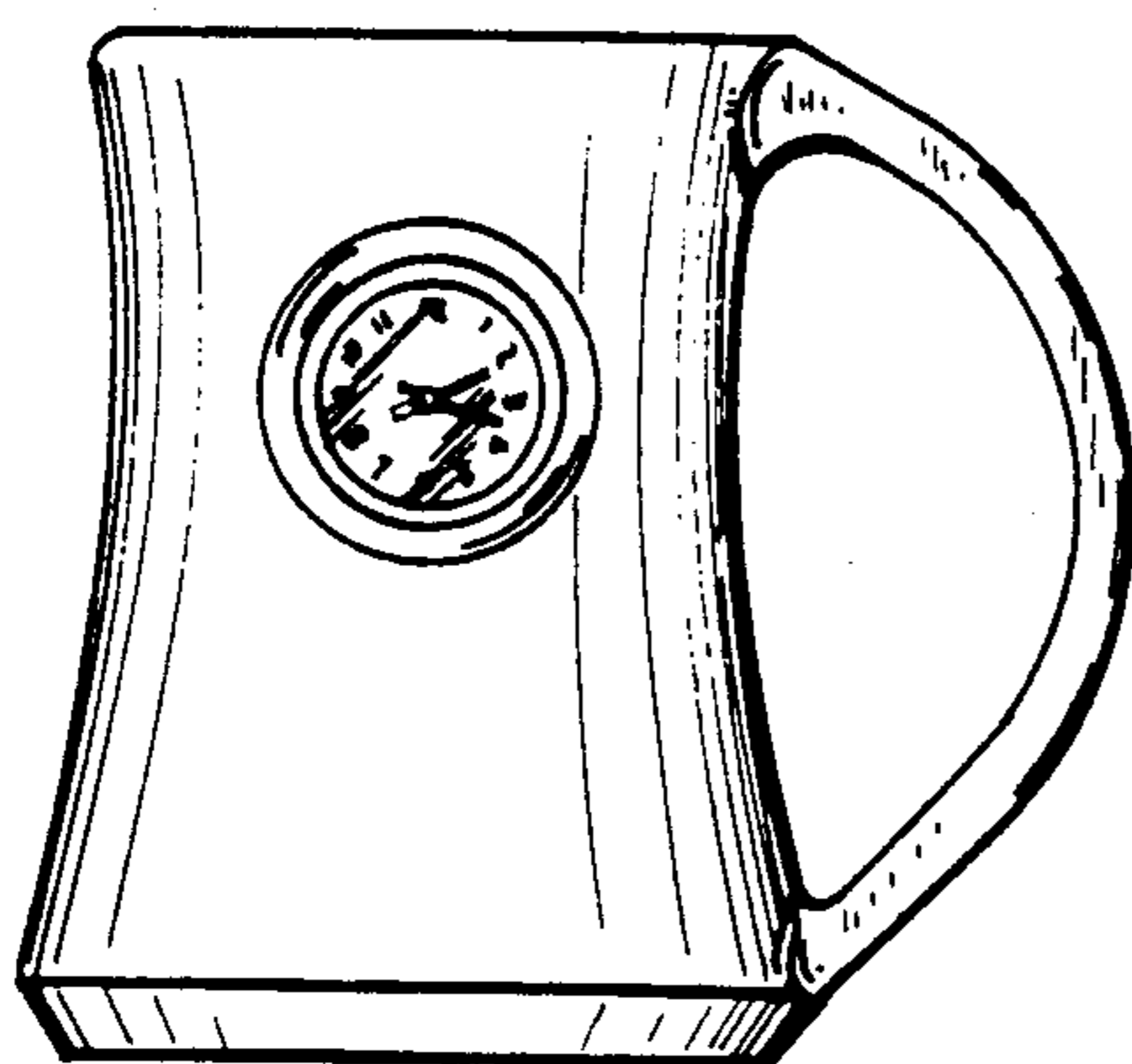

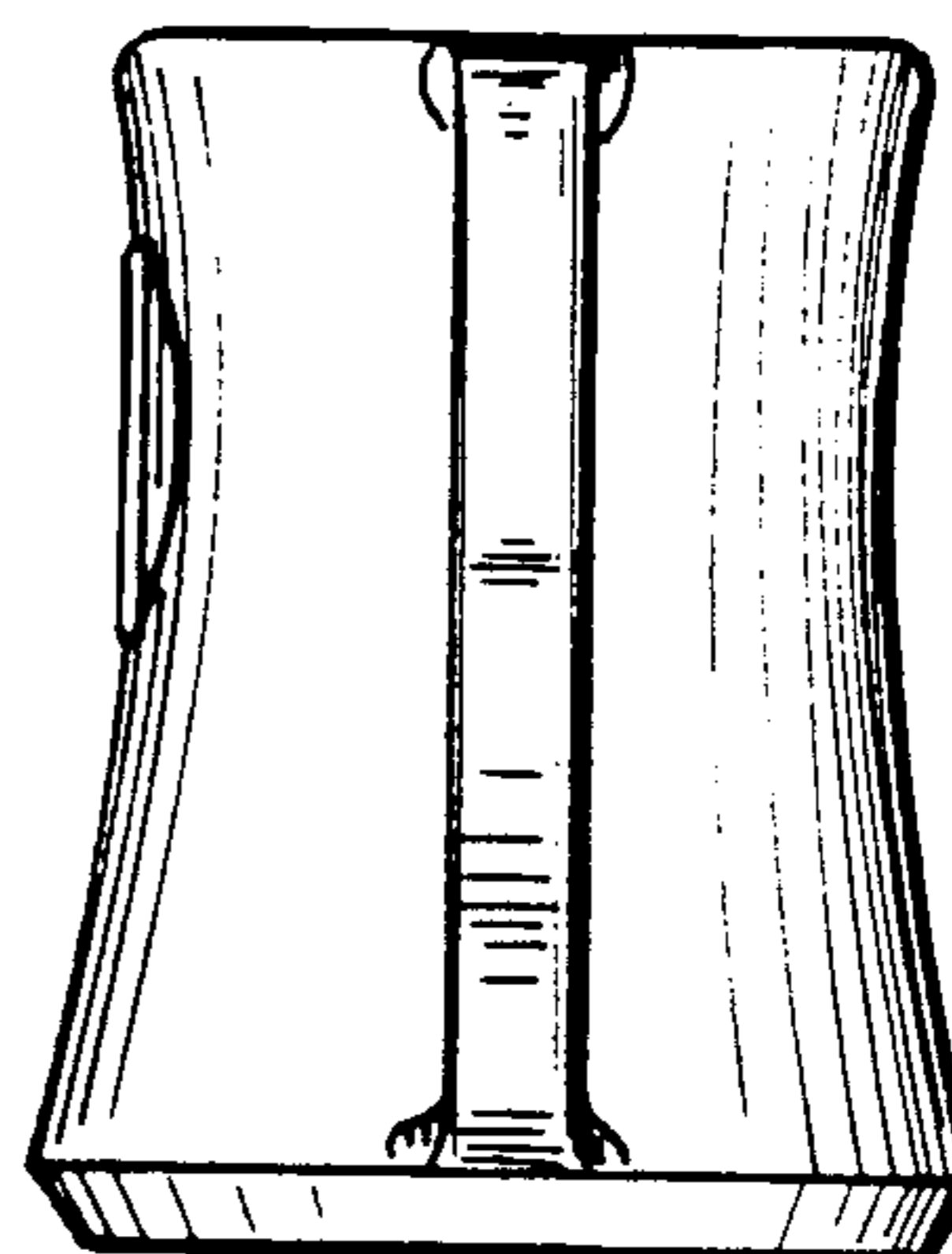

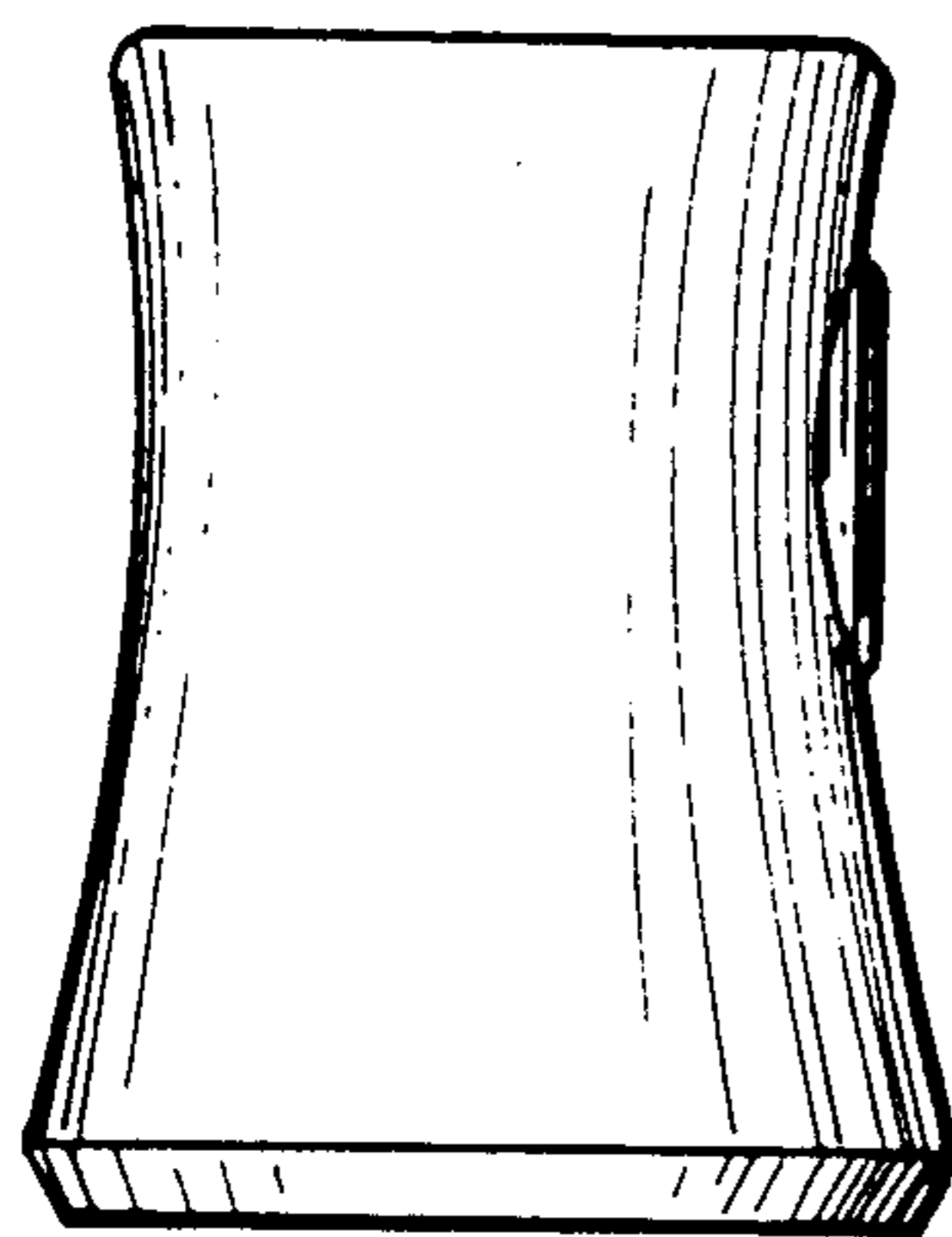

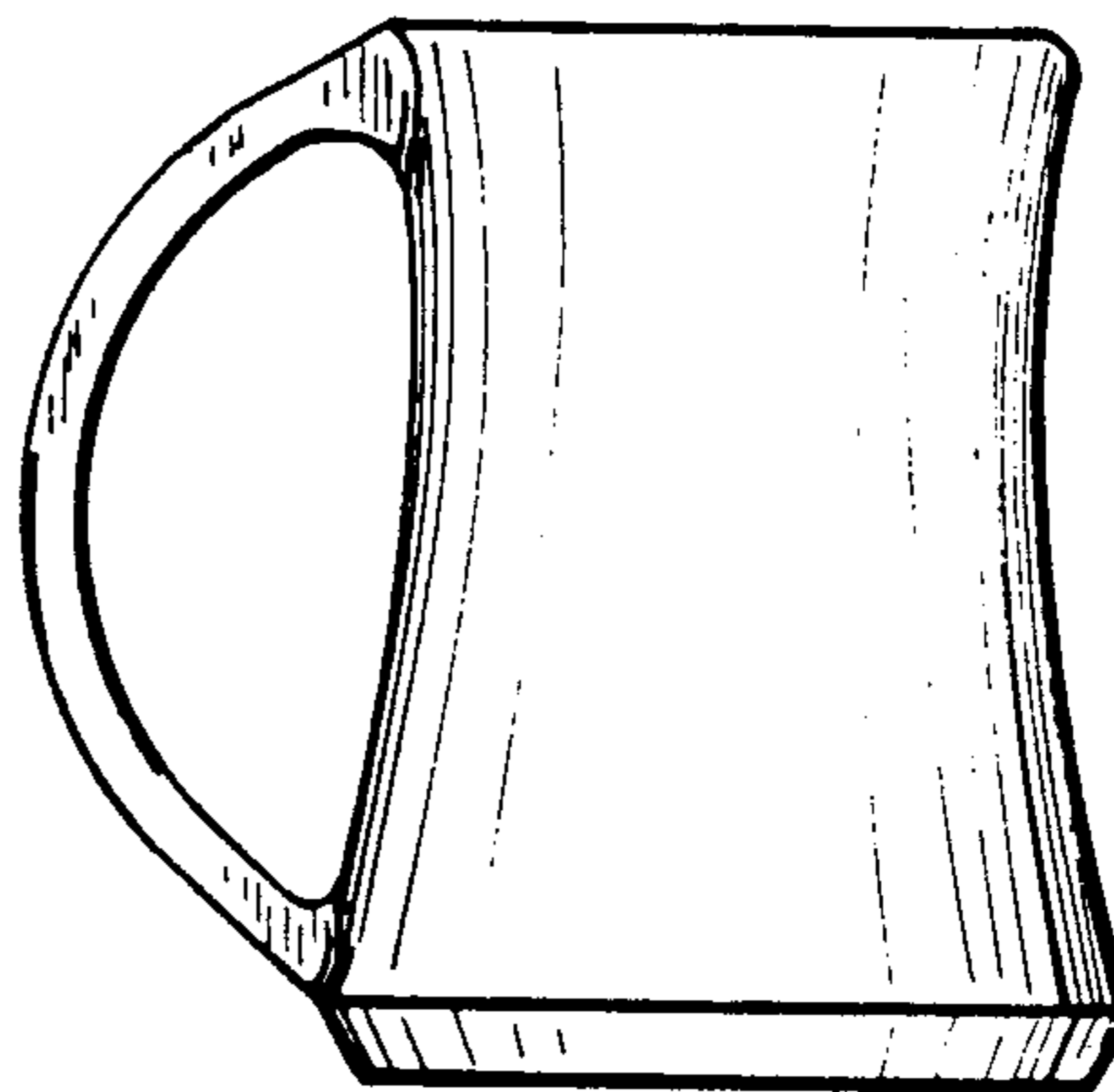
