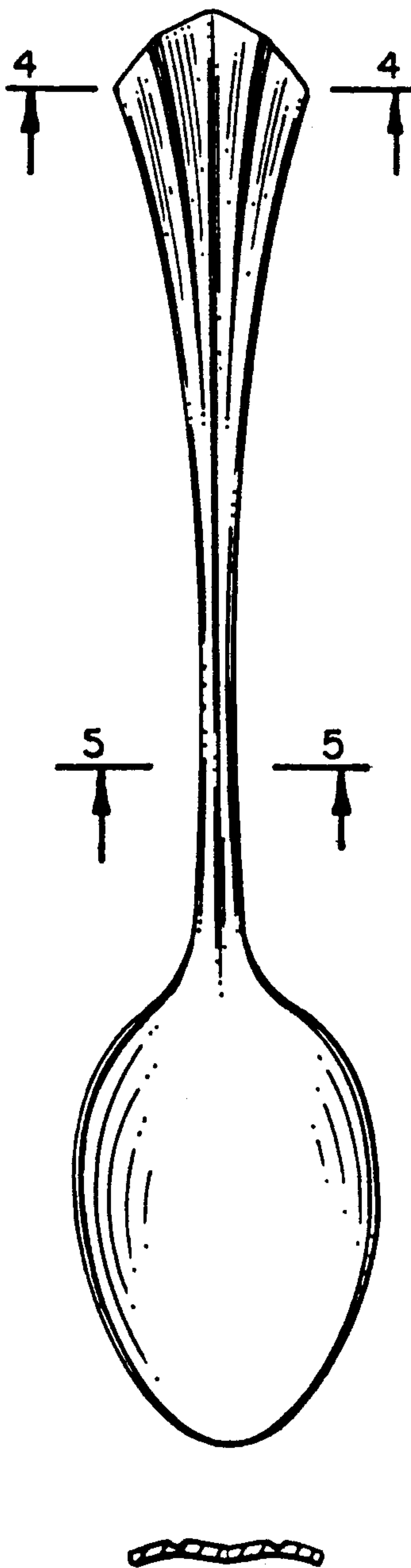
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spoon showing my new design;

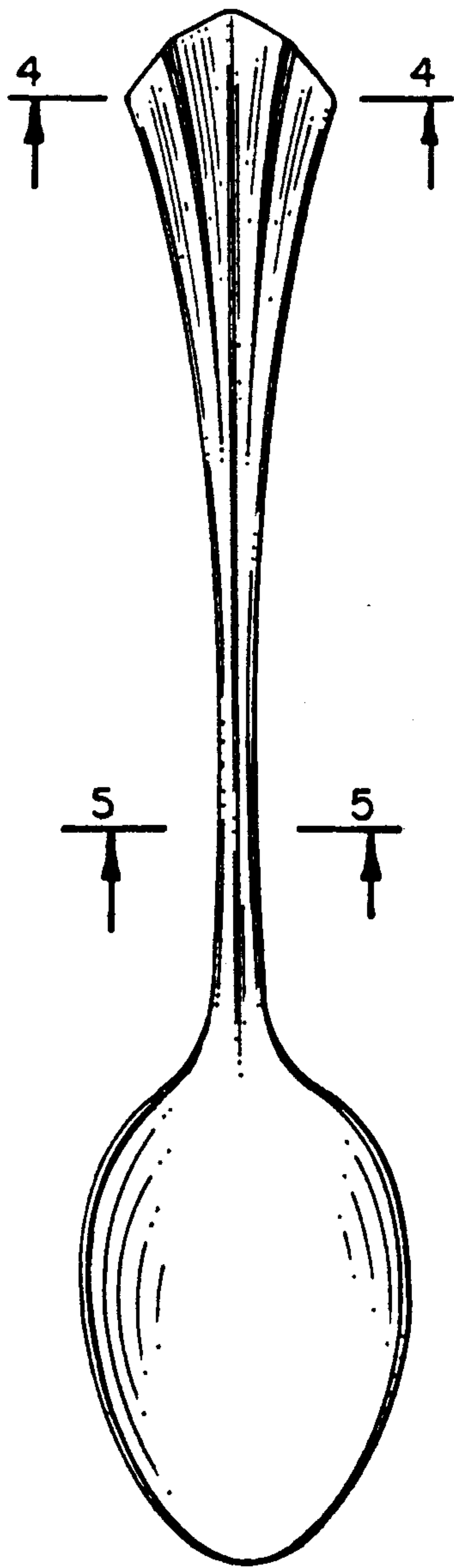

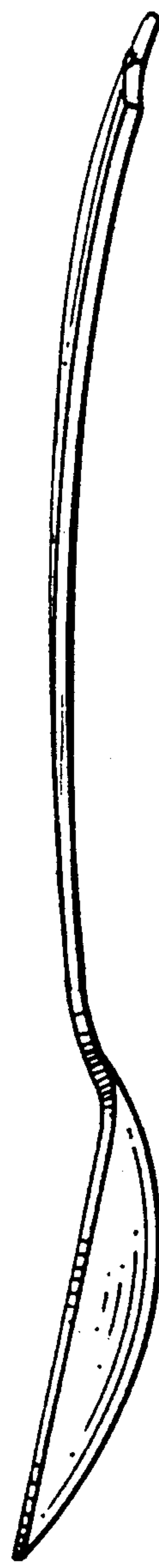

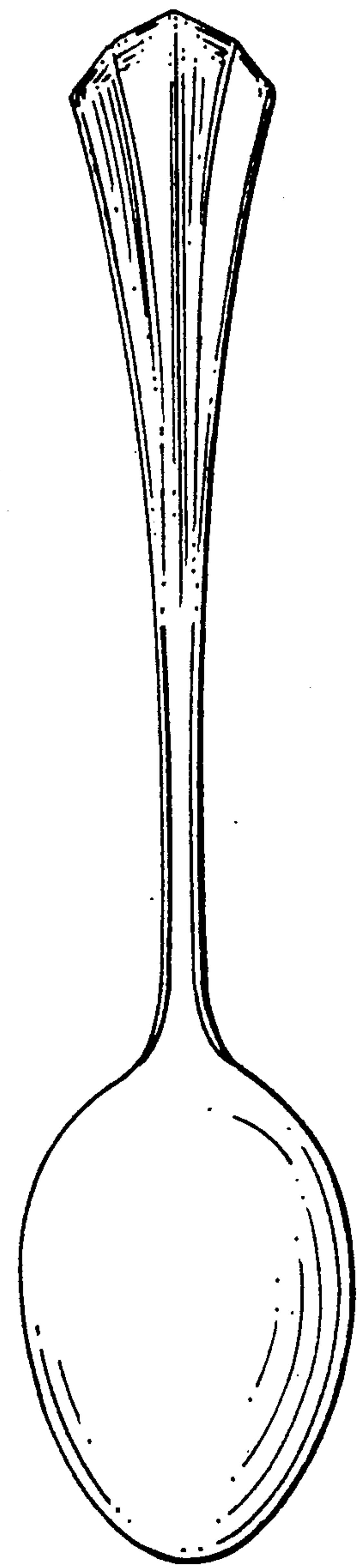
