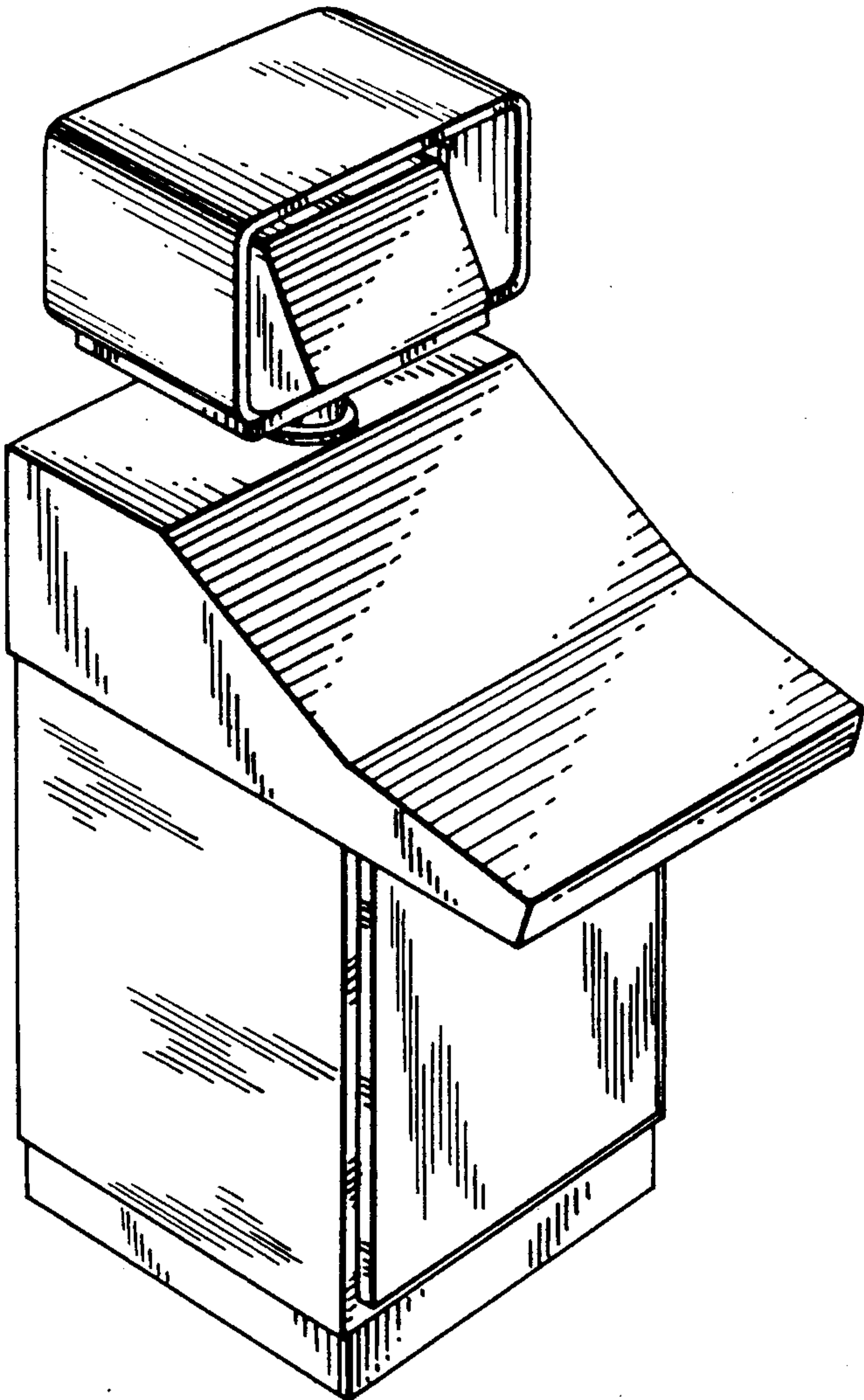

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a control console for the operation of machinery, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a control console for the operation of machinery showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view thereof.



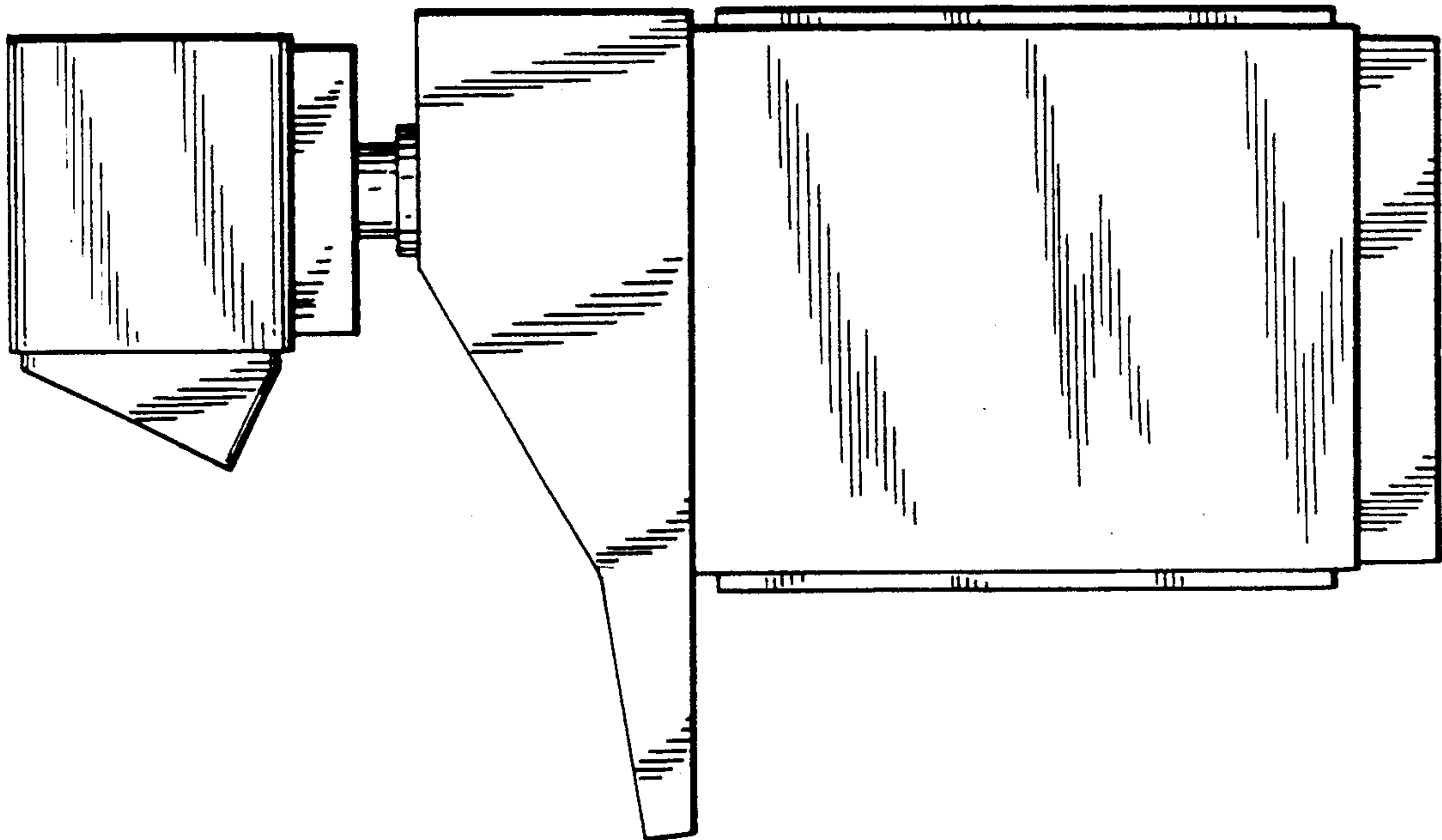

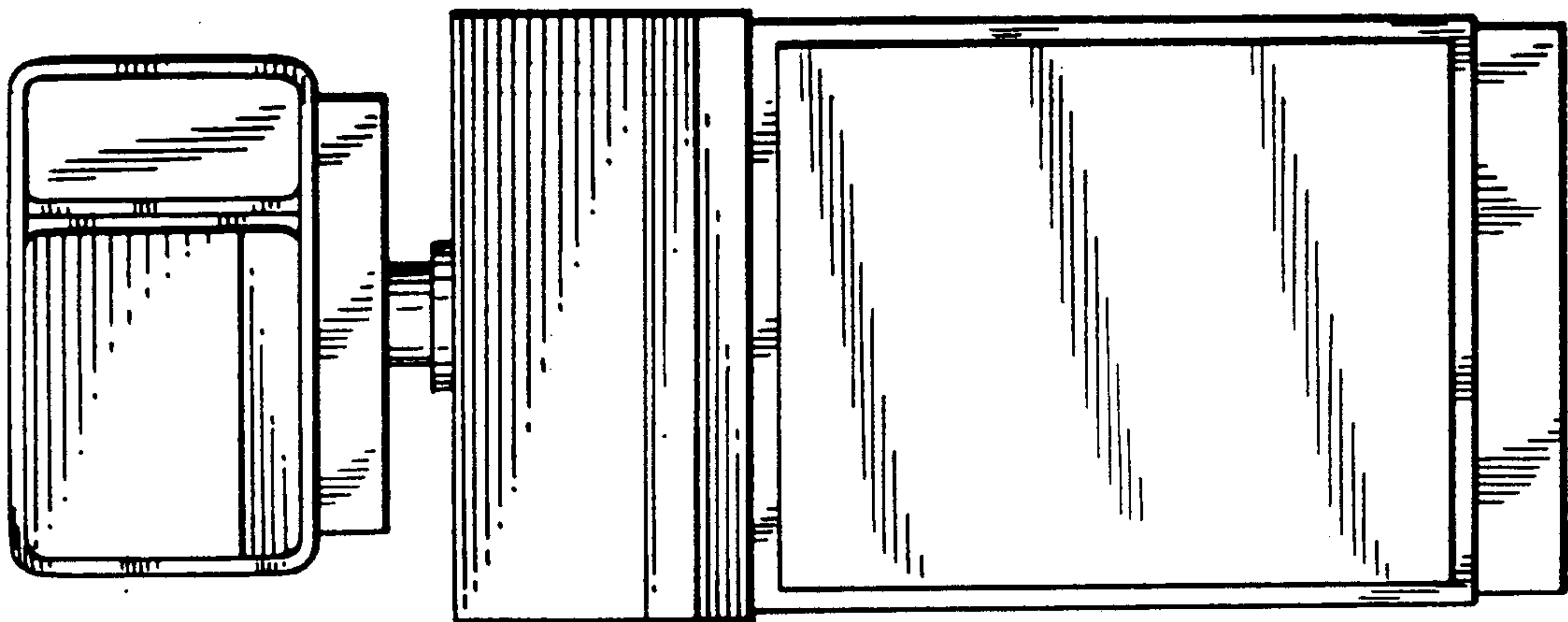

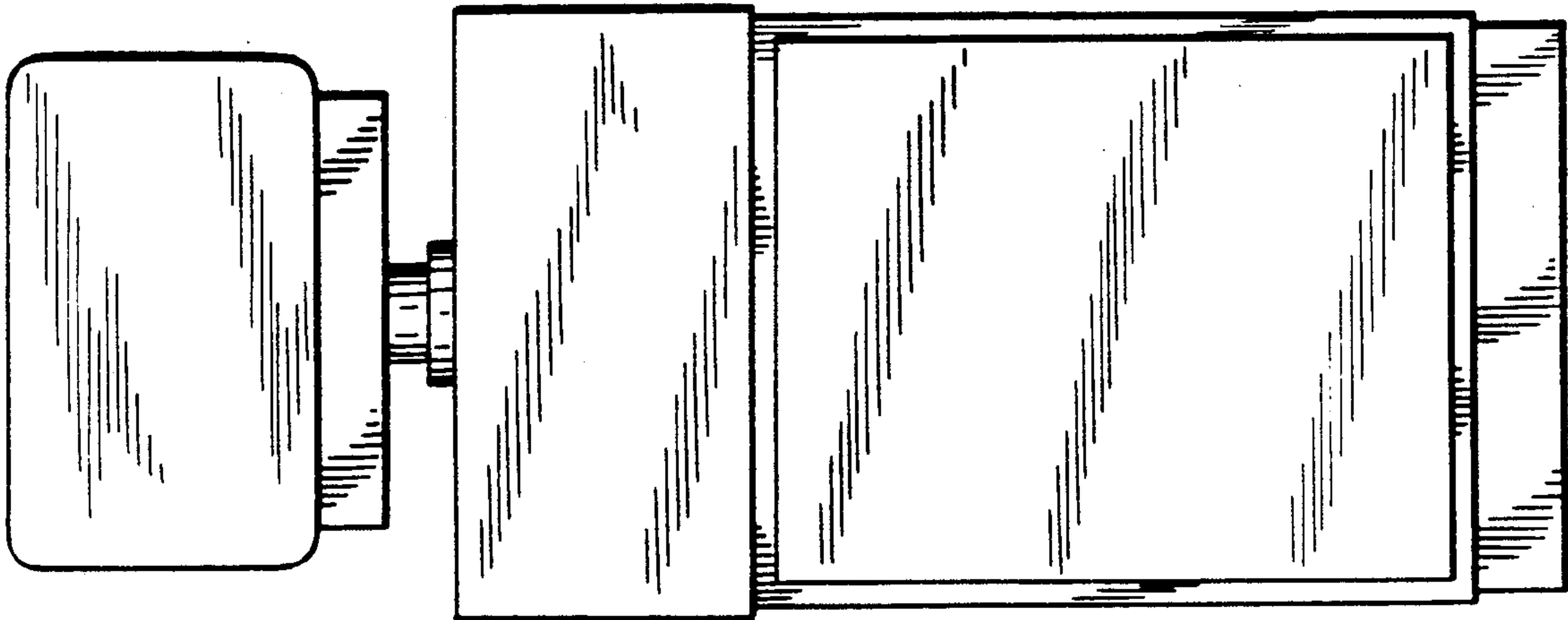

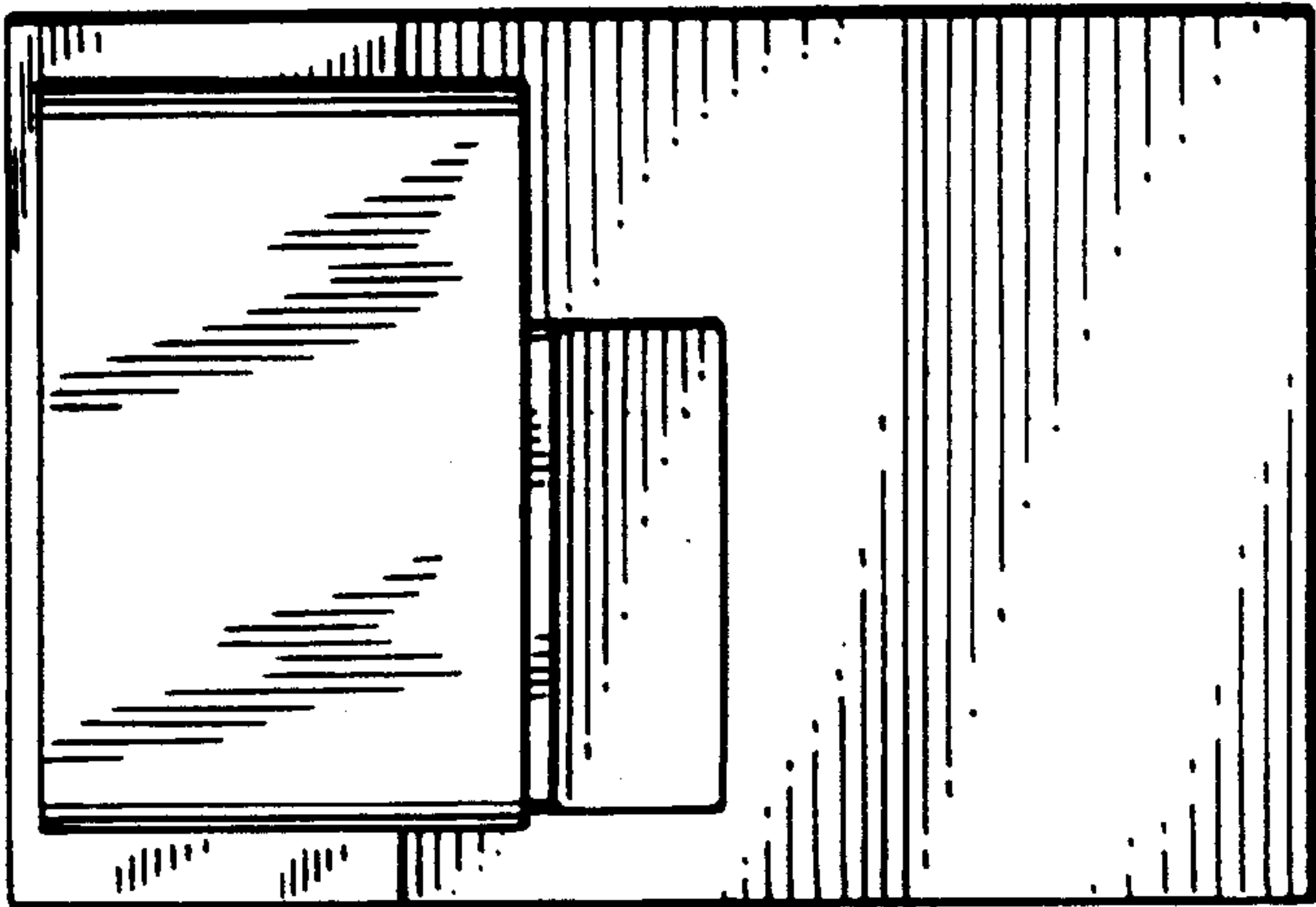

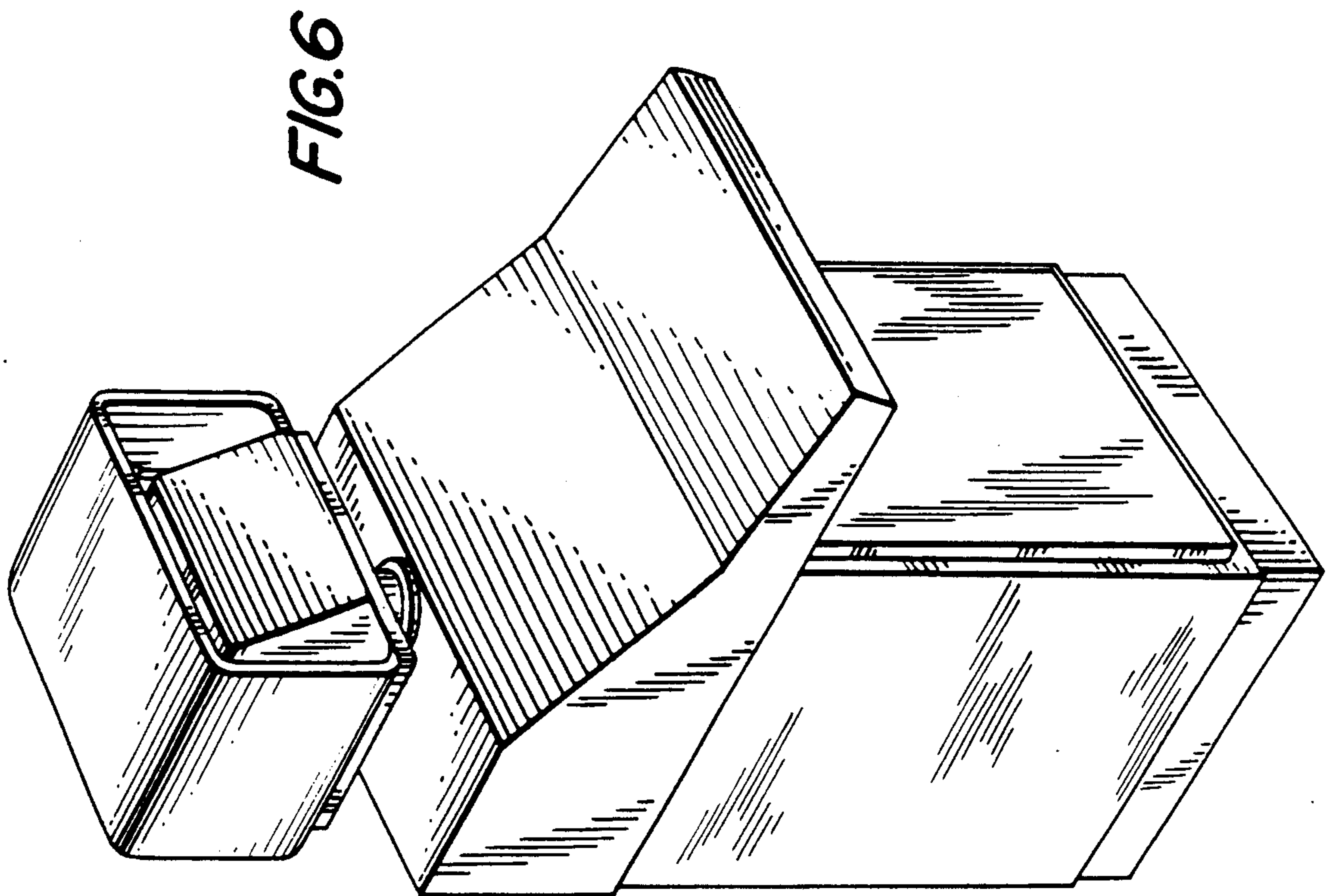
