FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof rotated 90 degrees from FIG. 1, and

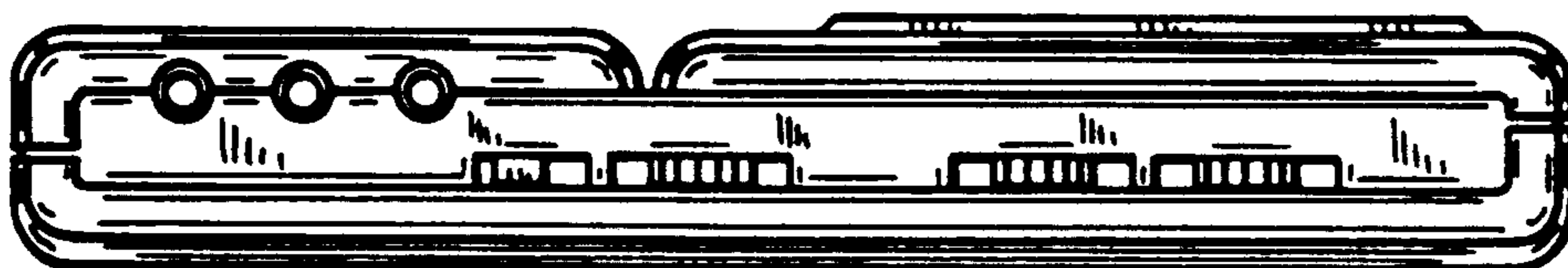
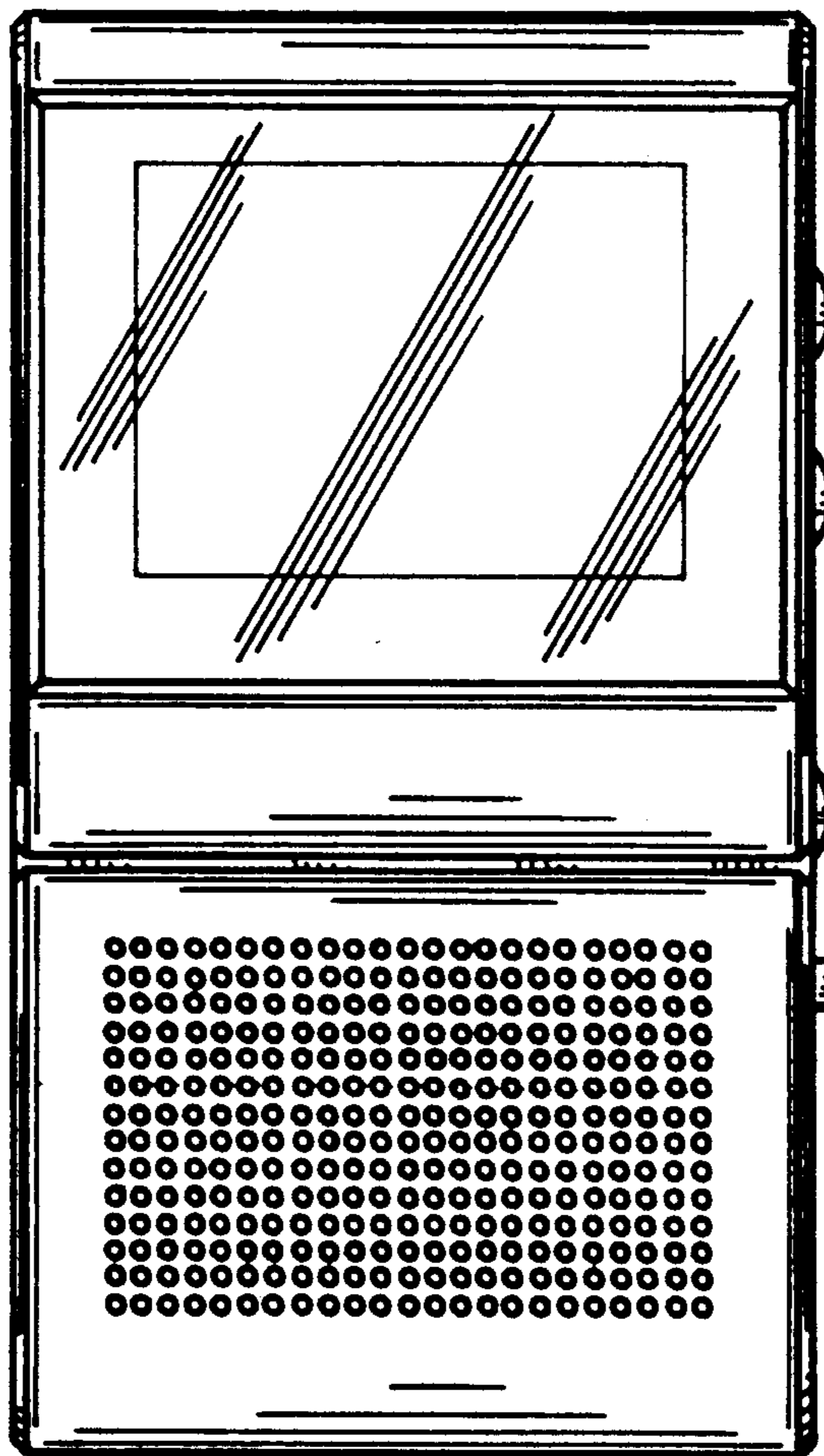
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof rotated 90 degrees from FIG. 1.

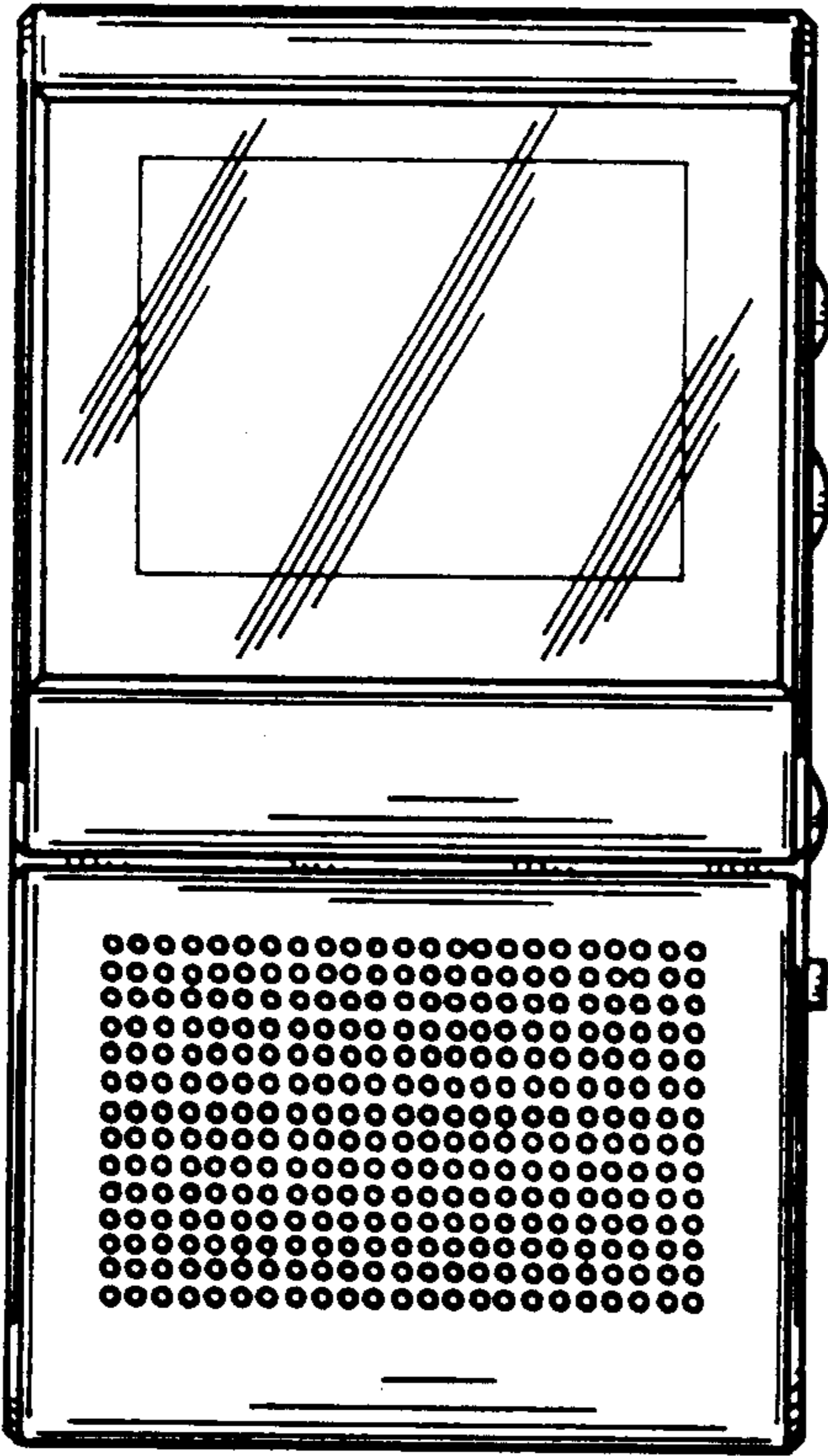

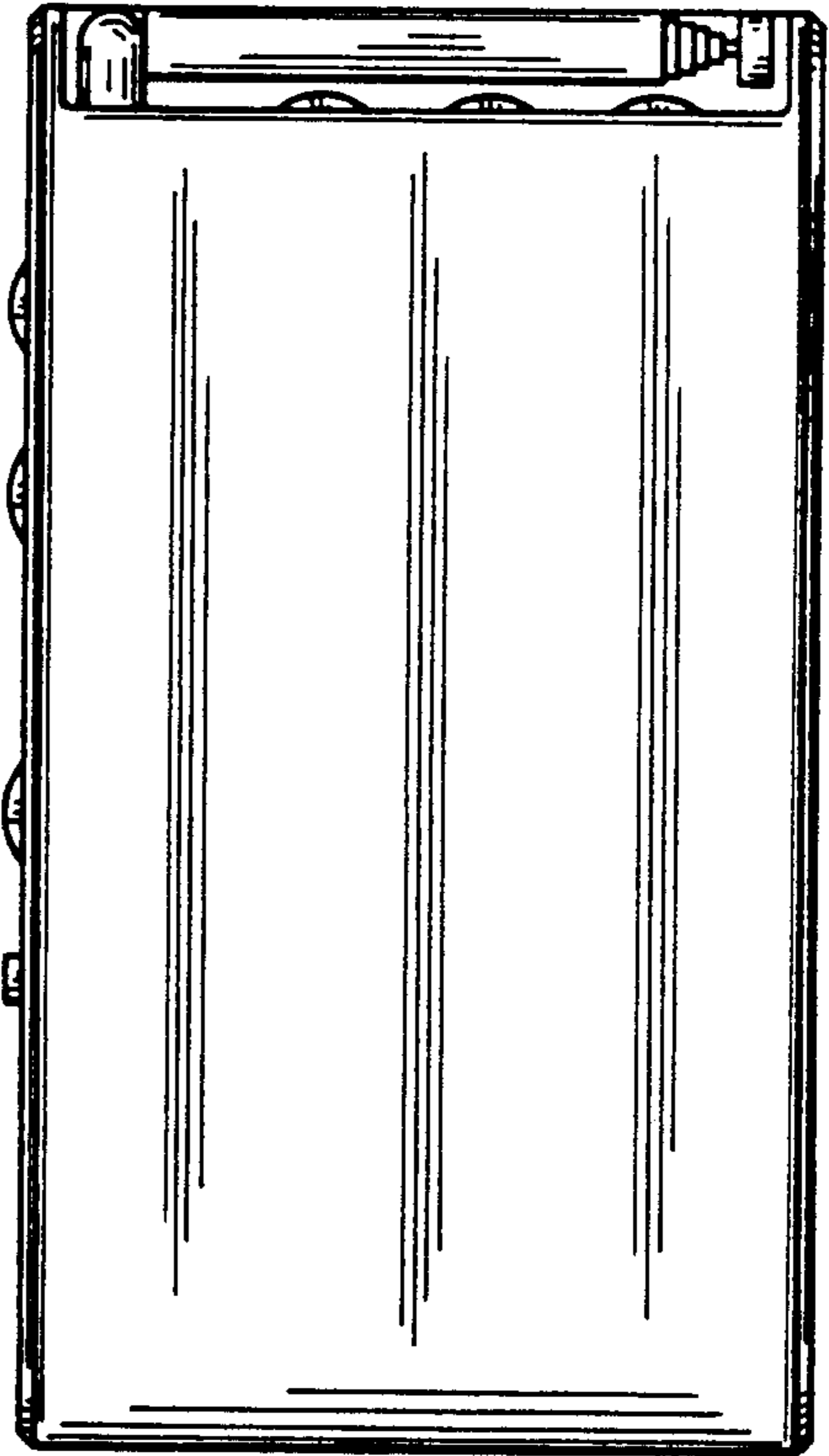

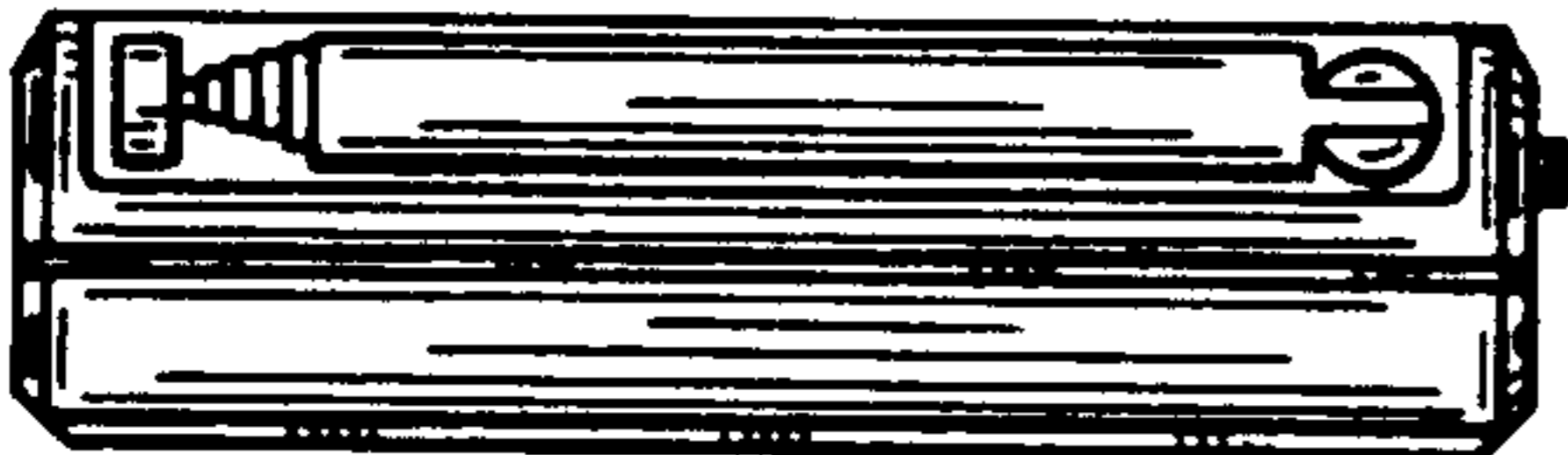




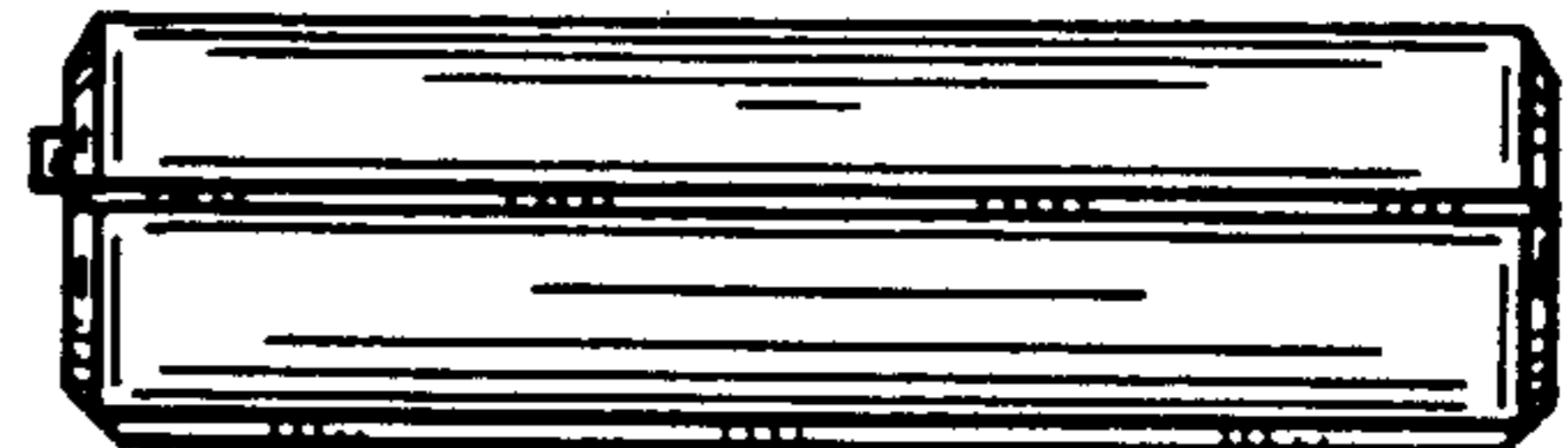

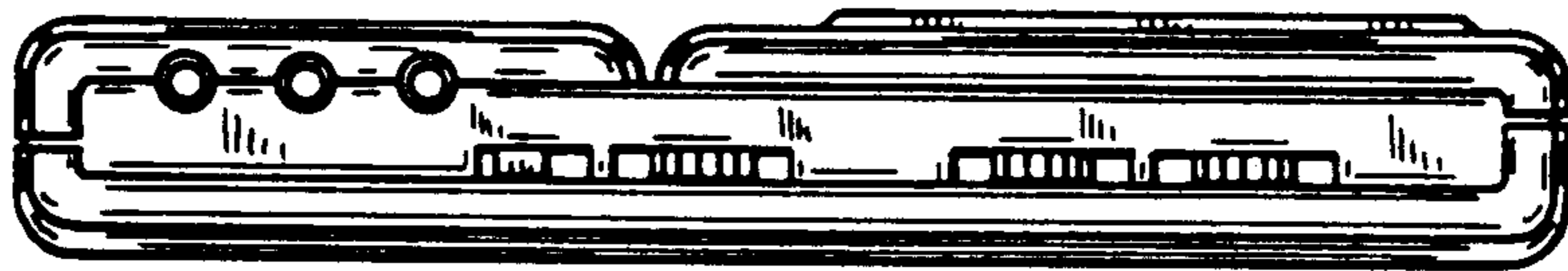

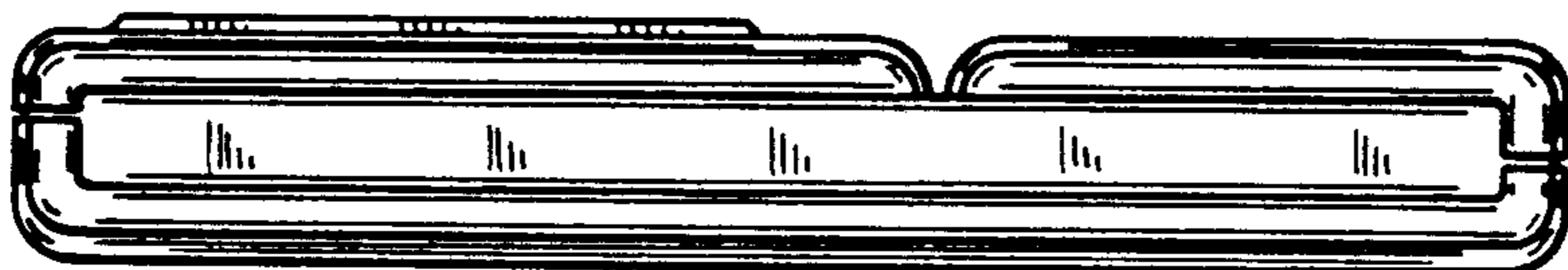
