[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined tape player and earphone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, and right-side perspective view of a combined tape player and earphone showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top, rear, and right-side perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top, front, and right-side perspective view thereof, shown with cassette holder in the open position;

FIG. 4 is a rear, top and right-side perspective view thereof, shown with earphone case in the open position and earphone extracted;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 7 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a right-side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof; and


FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view thereof.


















