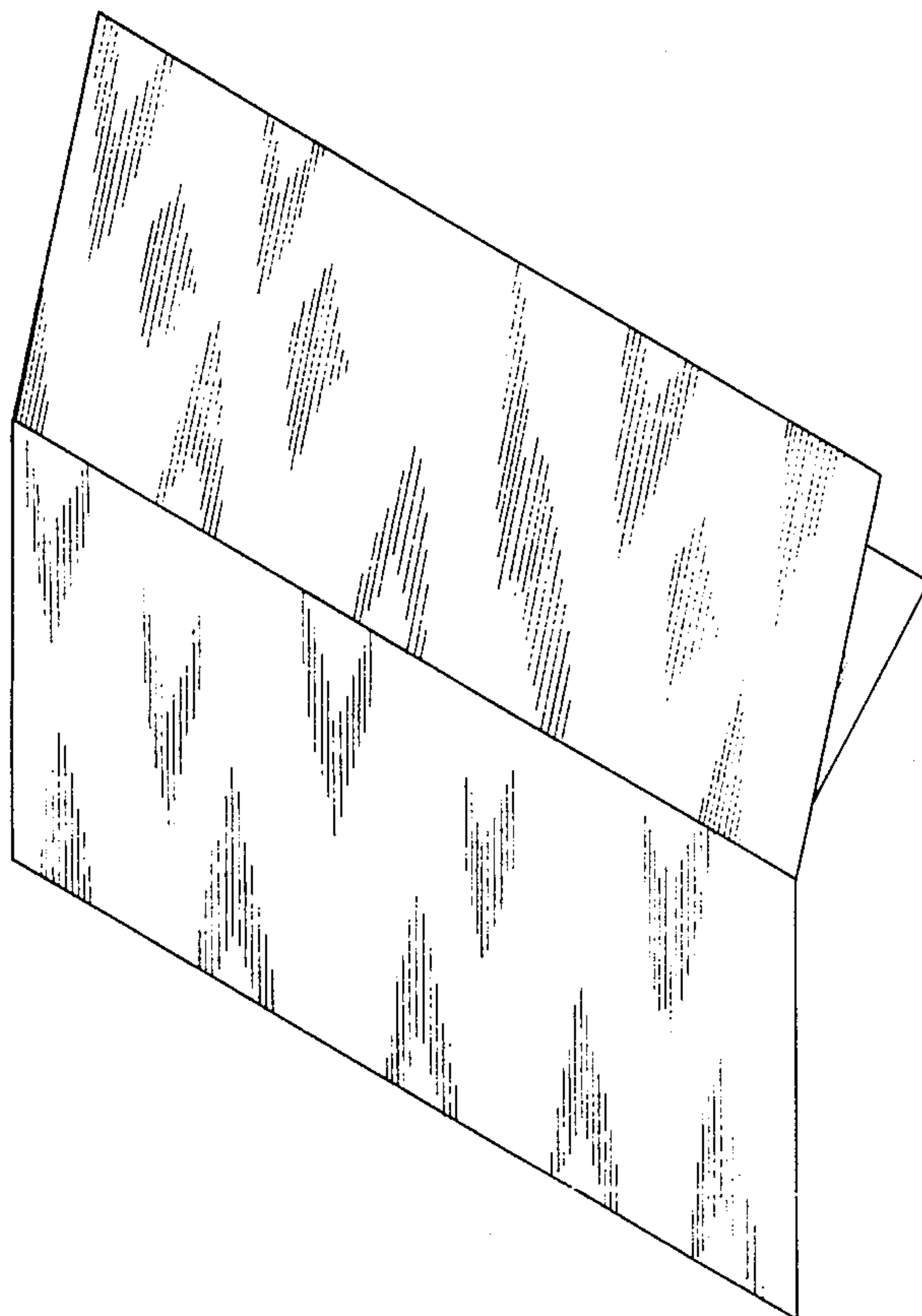
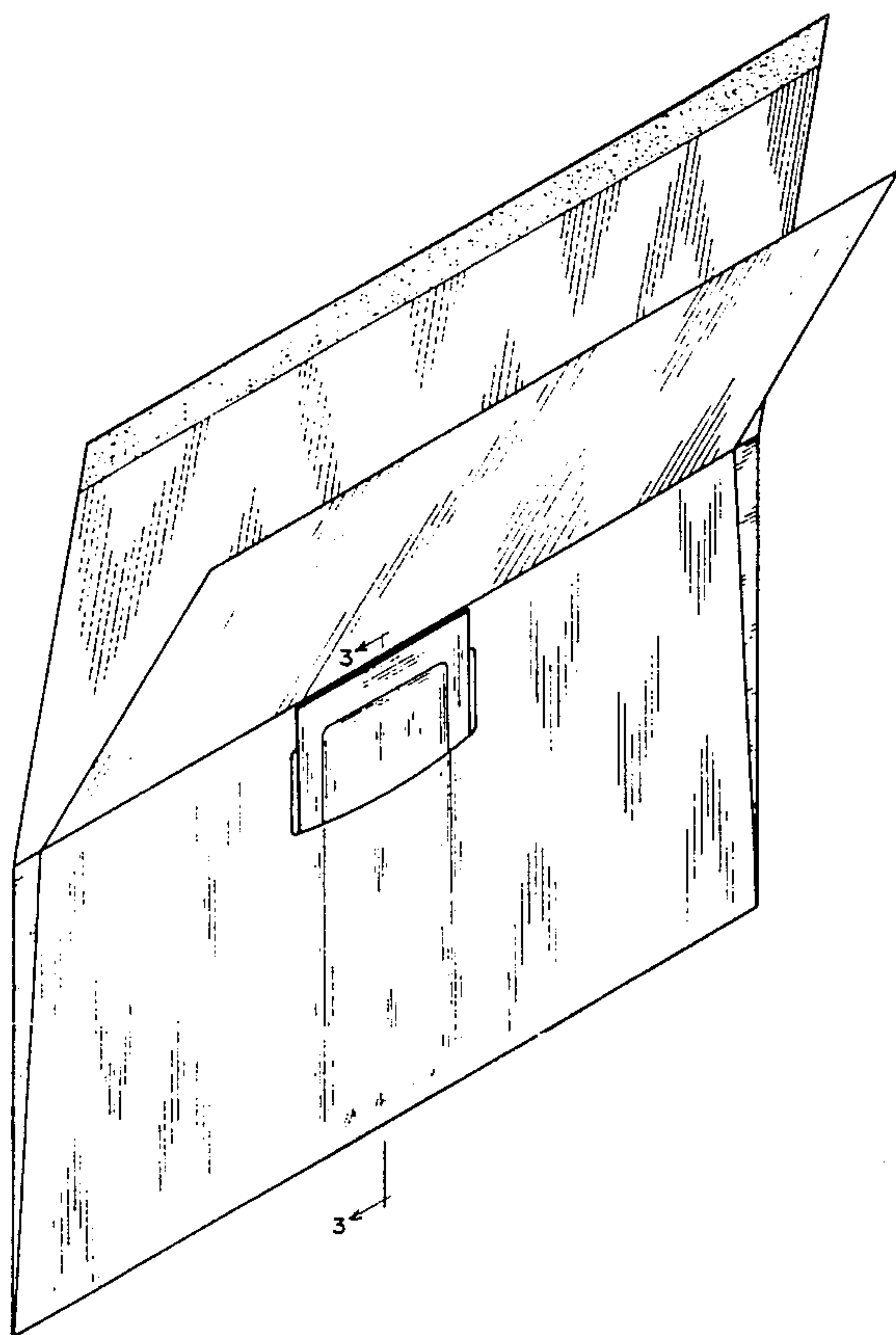
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a combined mailing envelope and sampler therefor, showing my new design in a partially opened position;

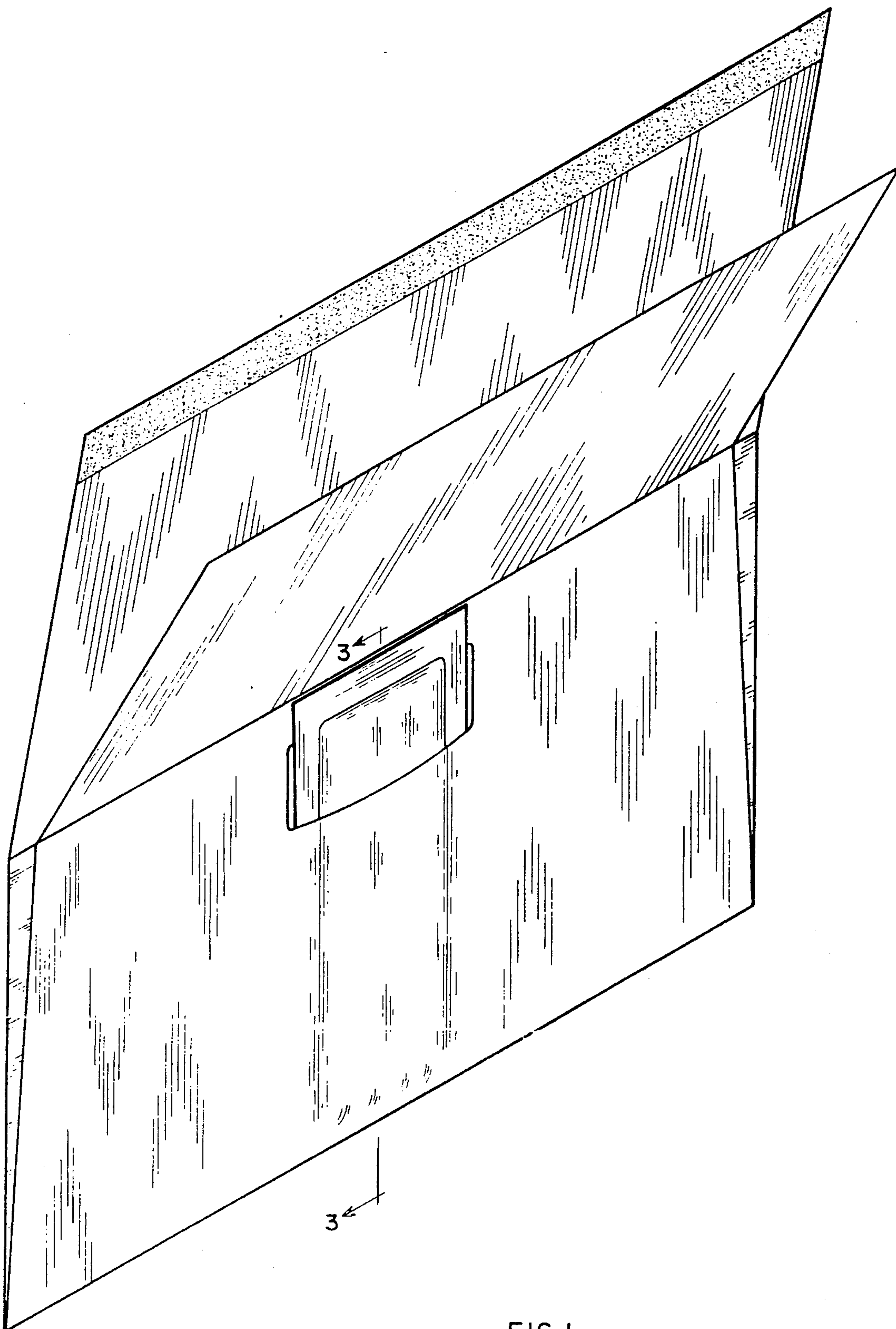

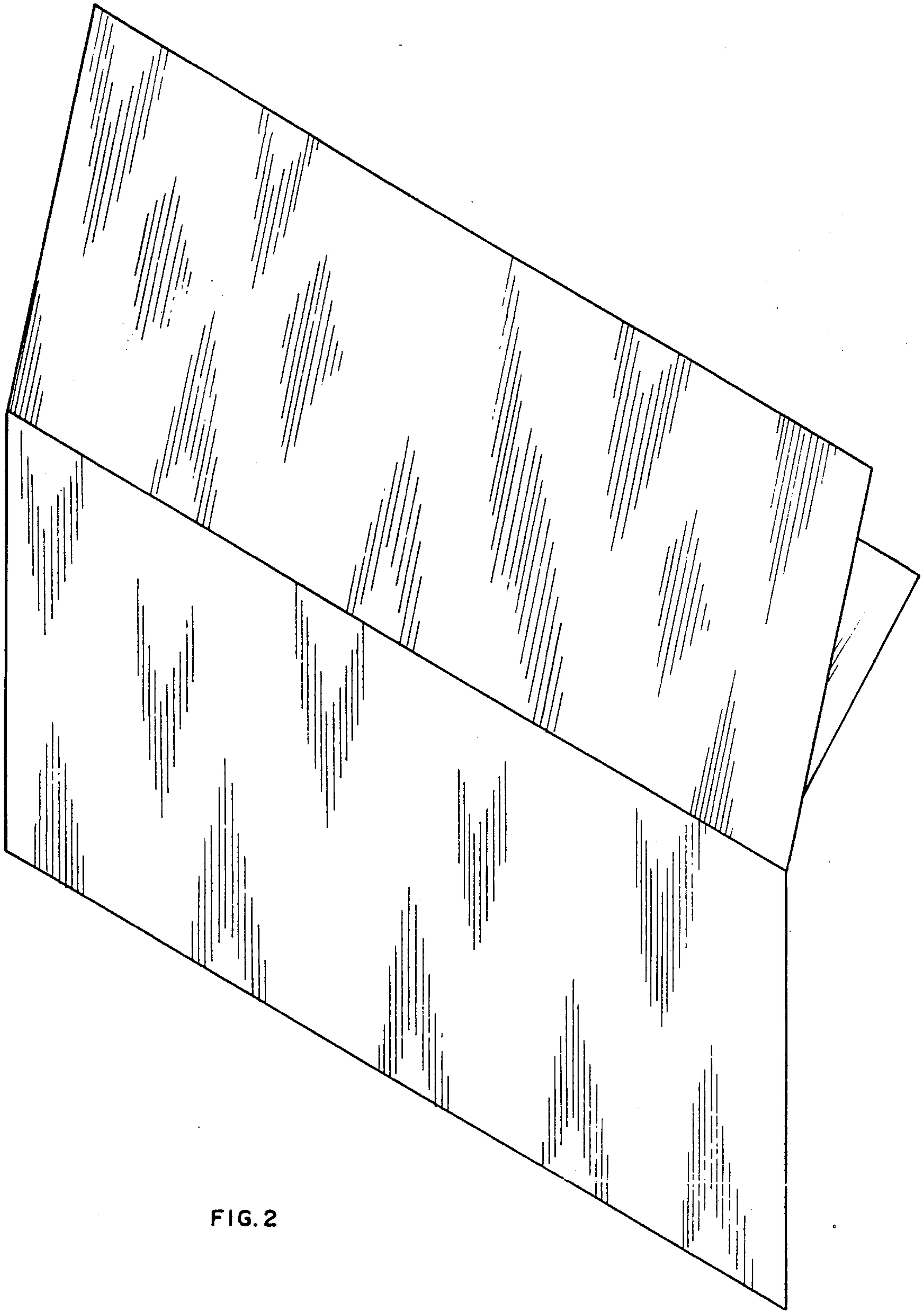
