The ornamental design for a ceramic tile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a ceramic tile showing my new design, the rear elevational view being plain and unornamented;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary front elevational view thereof.

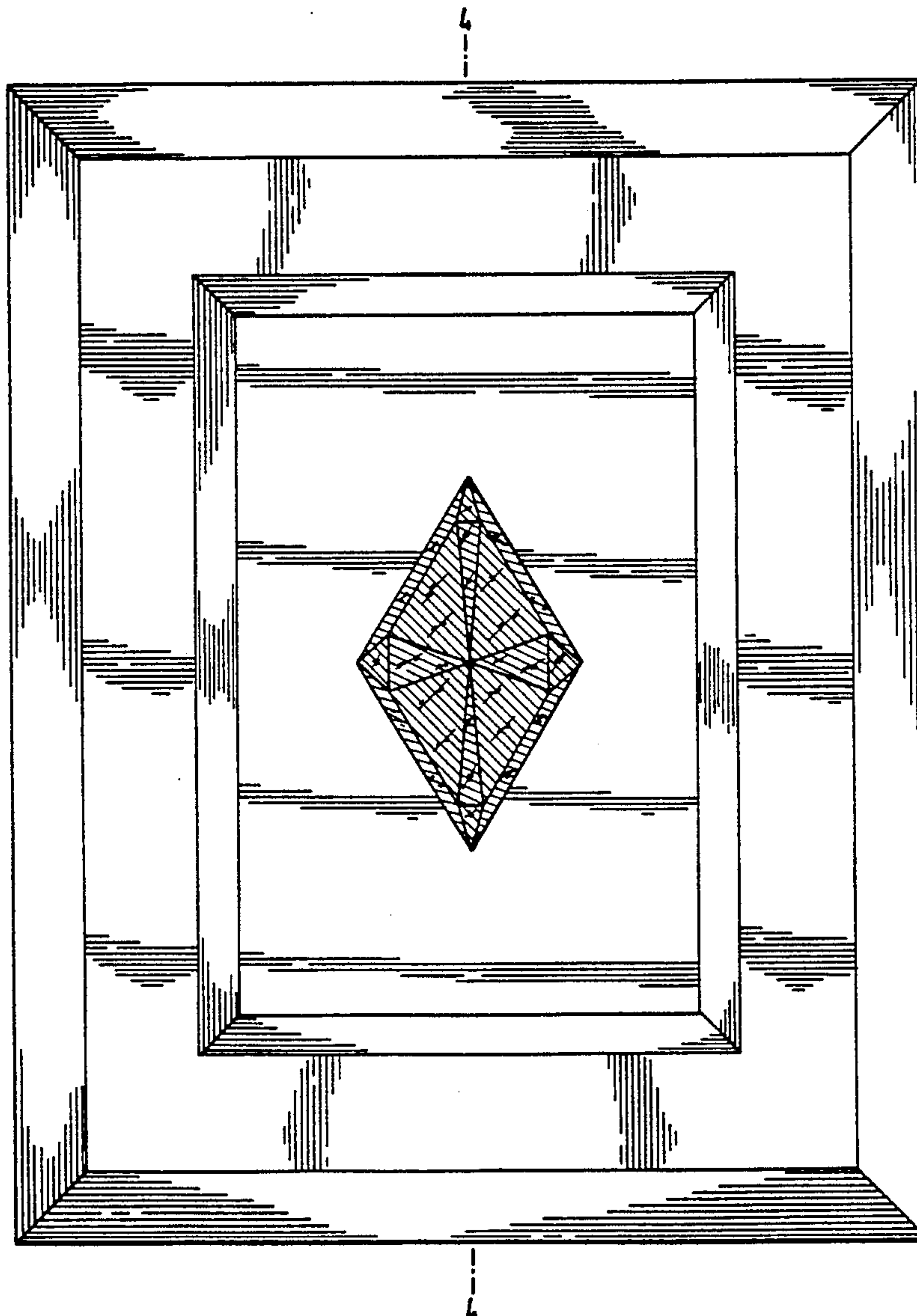

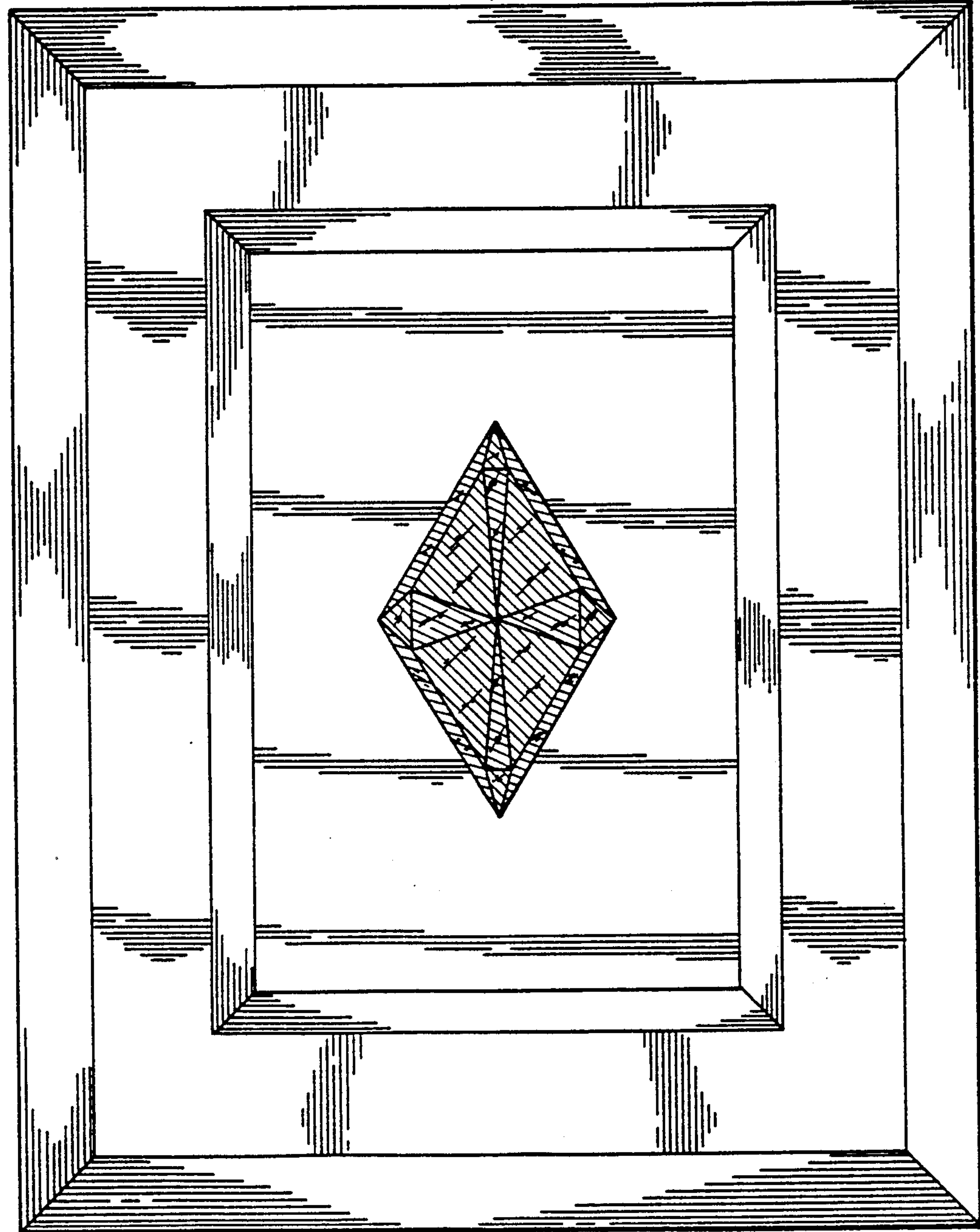

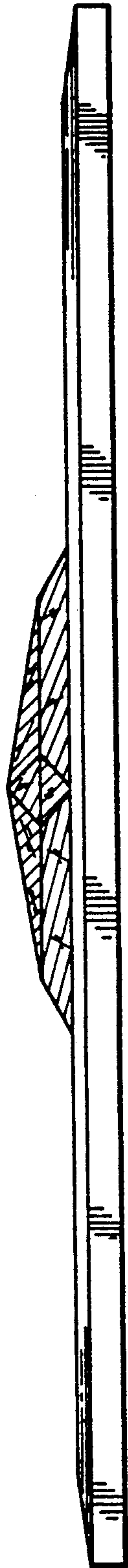

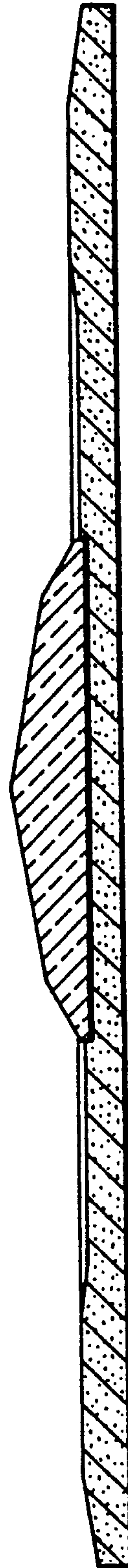
