DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a top perspective view thereof.

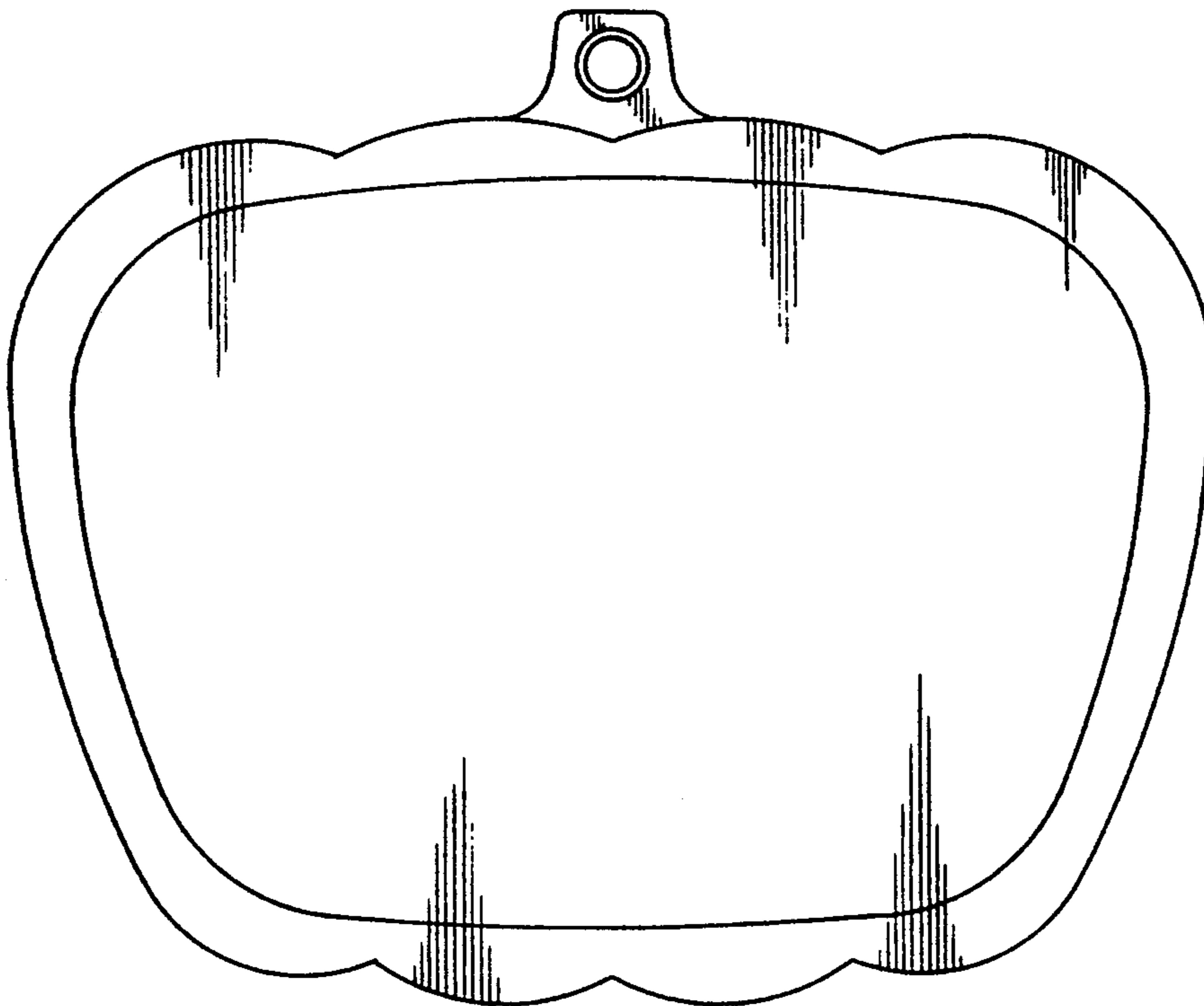

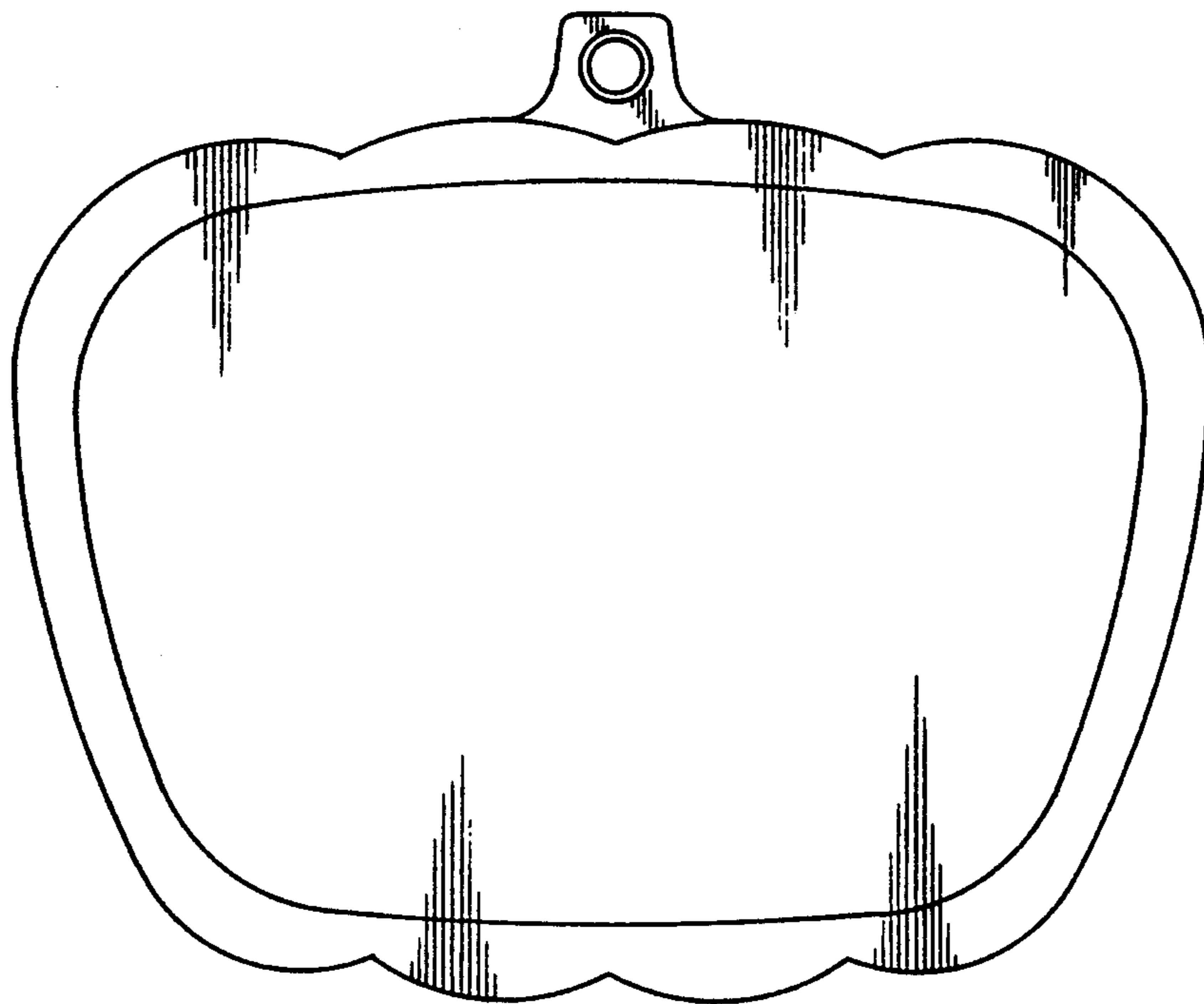

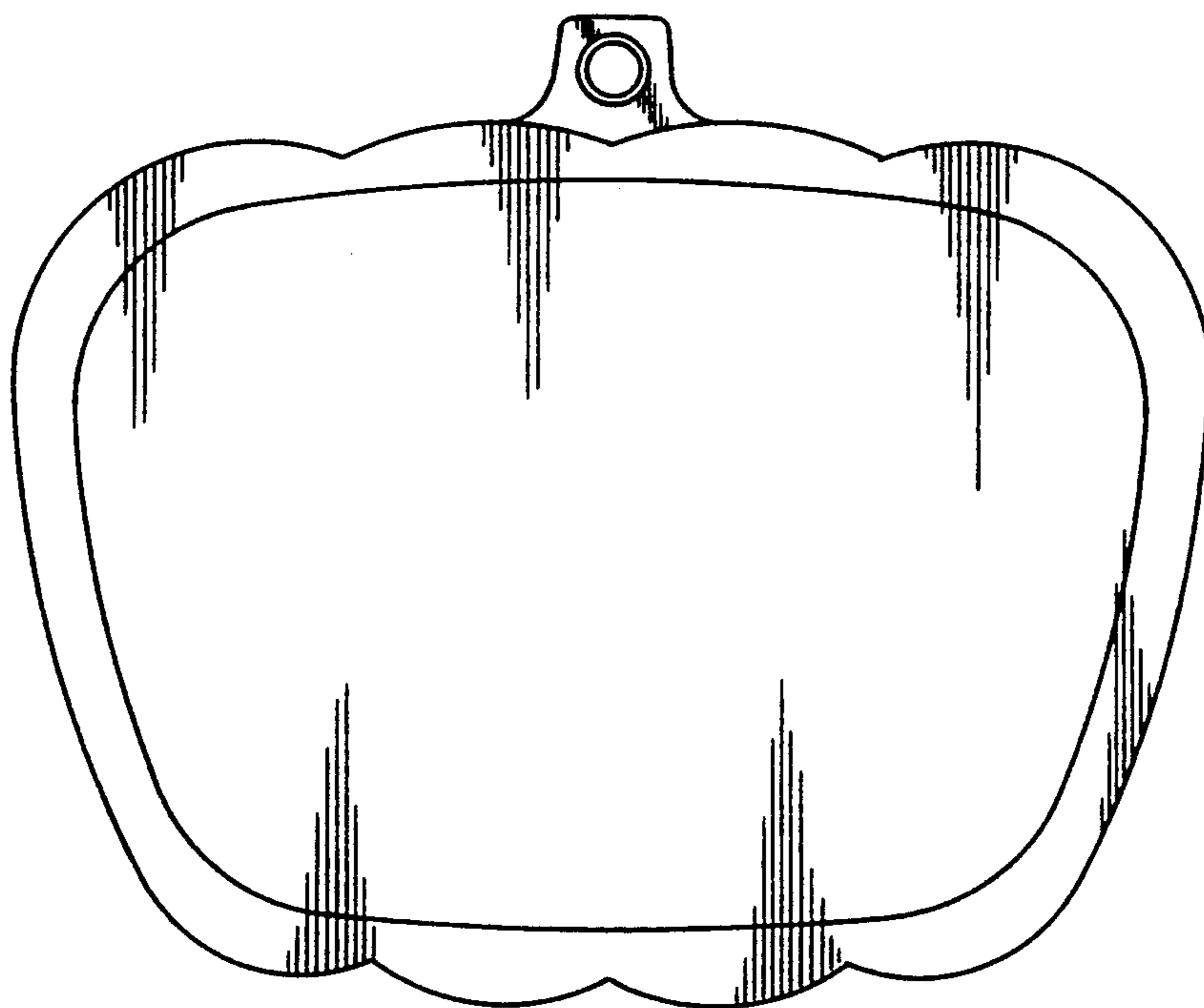

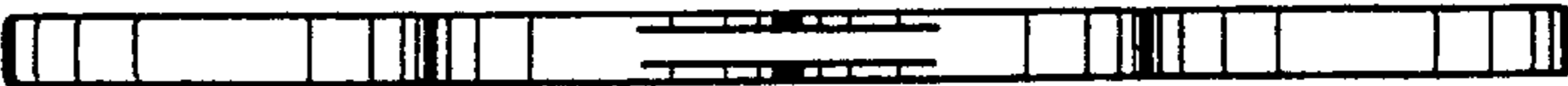
